Summary:

1. This report is the fifth in a monthly series on examinations for Submarine School. No general trends other than those noted in earlier reports are observed.¹

2. The appended enclosures are tabulations of failures in examinations for Submarine School. Enclosure (A) shows the number of enlisted men examined and the number rejected for various reasons for each of the past five months; and there is a tabulation for July according to the station supplying these men. Codes used in Enclosure (A) are explained in Enclosure (B)

3. Enclosure (B) is a copy of the July report to Bainbridge Naval Training Center. Similar reports are submitted routinely to every station listed in Enclosure (A).
