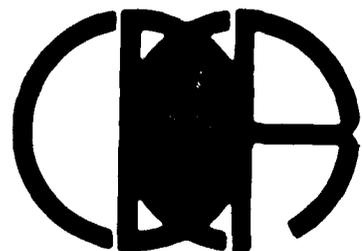

## FOREWORD

The federation, in July, 1967, of Case Institute of Technology with Western Reserve University, has made possible a broadening and deepening of resources available to the School of Library Science. Some indication of these changes begins to appear in the Bibliography of the Center for Documentation and Communication Research. An indication appears also of our increasing concern with the principles and philosophy underlying a program in library and information science; particular attention is directed to the last section of the Bibliography.

This Bibliography, revised in October, 1967, represents a selection of the variety of papers and reports contributed to the field since 1964 by the staff of the Center. As previously, earlier lists have been revised in order to restrict the Bibliography to current items, except when they have been retained to preserve a series. Requests for reprints, where these are available, may be directed to Edward Verhosek, Administrative Assistant of the Center. Stocks of some are limited or exhausted, however, and the fact of listing does not insure availability of any item.
