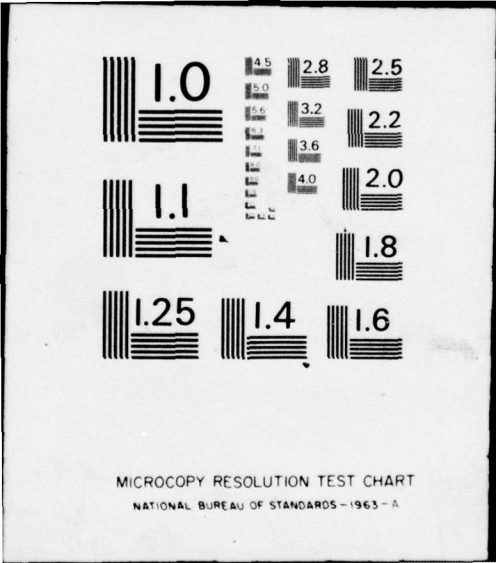

FORWARD

As presented in Field Manual 22-100, "Military Leadership," dated June, 1973, leadership in the United States Army is required for the fulfillment of the military mission. As this has evolved, it is now recognized that this goal can not be accomplished if it means loss of human dignity for the individual soldier. The commander must consider this along with his other command responsibilities. This FM also addresses the many principles and concepts which comprise the subject of leadership. All service members are encouraged to familiarize themselves with its contents, as each plays a part in fulfilling the goal - at different levels in the command picture. Too, the position of the individual soldier is spelled-out in FM 21-13, "The Soldiers Guide," dated 22 August 1961 (now under revision).

In addition to these position statements, the topic of leadership has long been a popular subject with military writers. It is the intent of this bibliography to assist the reader in identifying a representative sampling of some of the more significant writing in this area, particularly those in various military journals held by the Morris Swett Library. The reader is reminded that the articles cast a historical light on the subject as it continues to develop. At no time should these articles be construed as comprising official Department of Army philosophy towards the topic on a per individual writer basis. They can, however, reveal the thinking which has gone into the development of this official position as covered in the FM's noted above on a composite basis.

Inclusion of an item or omission does not imply USAFAS indorsement or sanction of the compiler's point-of-view nor does it guarantee accuracy of content. Comment and criticism concerning this list is solicited.
