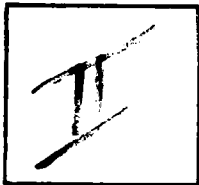

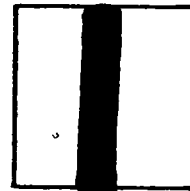

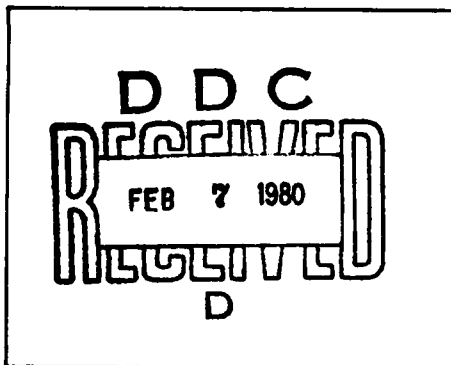

Following is a resume of Telecon Col Nelson, AG, Camp Desert Rock, Nevada and Capt St Pierre, AG, Camp Irwin: "Capt St Pierre: I talked to Col Butler AG of 6th A reference the activation of Hq Exercise Director, Exercise Desert Rock VII. (Provisional) Unit was activated at Camp Irwin by 6th A General Order 165, dtd 10 Aug 56. Now we have the problem of moving the Hqs to Camp Desert Rock, Nevada. Col Butler told me in a telephone call at 1000 hrs, 1 May 57 that the Exercise Director has authority to issue a movement order moving the headquarters from Camp Irwin to Camp Desert Rock. Use as authority WCCC Sixth Army 1 May 1957. Also, Col Butler said, "Do not issue a General Order closing Hqs at Irwin and opening at Desert Rock because such an order would require Sixth Army action. "
