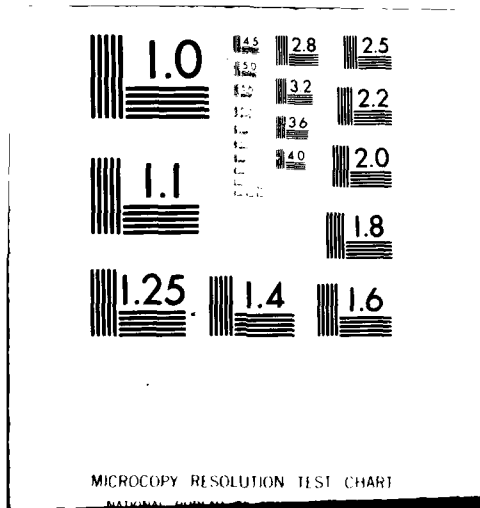

FOREWORD

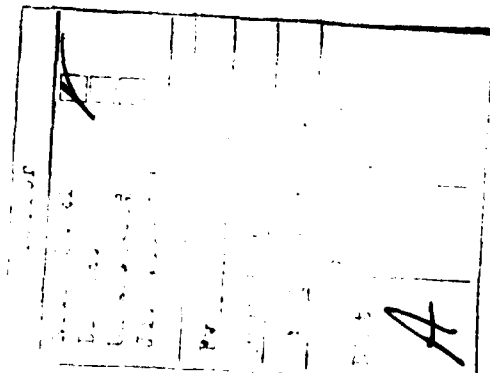
