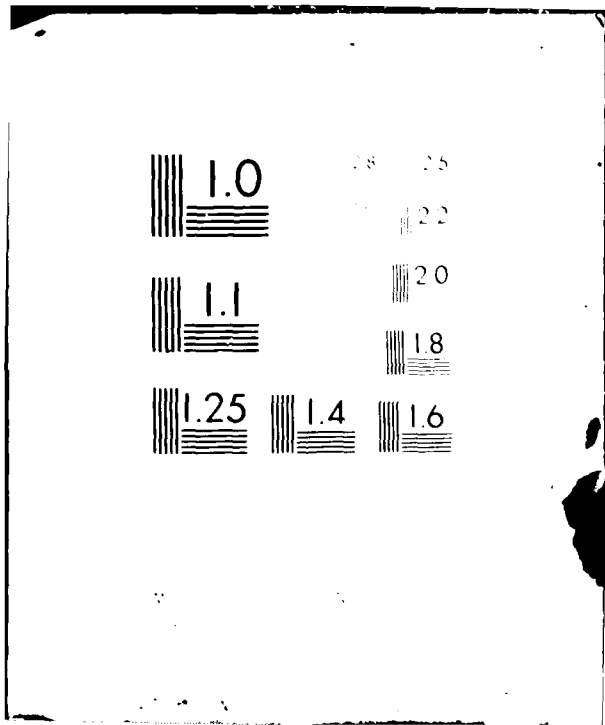

FORWORD

This bibliography covers military articles appearing in 31 periodicals. Emphasis is on Artillery Aerial Observation which is airborne reconnaissance performed for the directing or adjusting of fire. The first artillery air observations were conducted at Fort Riley, KS on 6 Nov 1912. Techniques have obviously become more sophisticated since those first air-artillery radio contacts.

This number is arranged in two parts. Part one lists periodicals by an arbitrarily devised acronym. Part two contains the full citation. Selection has been made from journals owned by the Morris Swett Library. Inclusion of an item, or omission, does not imply USAFAS indorsement or sanction of the compiler's point-of-view.
