## INTRODUCTION

The data contained in this report have been derived from data files located in the Analysis and Research Unit, Work Force Information Section (OP-140F), Personnel Management and Evaluation Branch, Civilian Personnel Policy Division, Office of the Deputy Chief of Naval Operations (Manpower, Personnel and Training). The data were obtained from the following sources:

- Personnel Automated Data System (PADS)
- Computer Assisted Manpower Analyses System (CAMAS)
- Recurring or one-time special reports

Civilian personnel data cover full-time direct-hire civilian employees in the United States, territories and foreign countries unless otherwise designated. The data exclude the following categories: those on leave without pay for scheduled periods longer than 30 days; persons carried in any kind of leave status after the last day of active duty as specified in a reduction-in-force notice; persons on leave with pay pending disability retirement; disadvantaged youths under the Stay-in-School Campaign and the Summer Aid Program; Public Service Career employees; employees in developmental jobs; persons working without compensation; and persons serving at \$1.00 per year.

Navy military personnel data at those activities which employ civilians have been compiled from data furnished by the Naval Military Personnel Command.

The data displayed in this report are formatted so as to be usable by the reader. However, certain precautions should be observed when extracting or combining information or statistics from various tables and charts. Since several data bases have been utilized, each having a unique composition, some internal inconsistencies may occur.

The reader should take care to note the descriptive headings of all charts and tables and avoid combining or comparing those based on separate source data and/or populations.

Figures in all the charts and some of the tables have been rounded for clarity and have been so indicated.

In addition, there were 10,700 indirect hire foreign nationals at commands and activities located outside the United States. Since the September 1981 edition of the REPORT, there has been little change in the overall ratio of General Schedule/General Manager or similar (GS/GM) and Federal Wage System or similar (FWS) employment. GS/GM employees represents 50 percent of the direct hire work force. Civilian employment levels for Marine Corps are included in the above data. The following employees are excluded from the 30 September 1982 employment data:

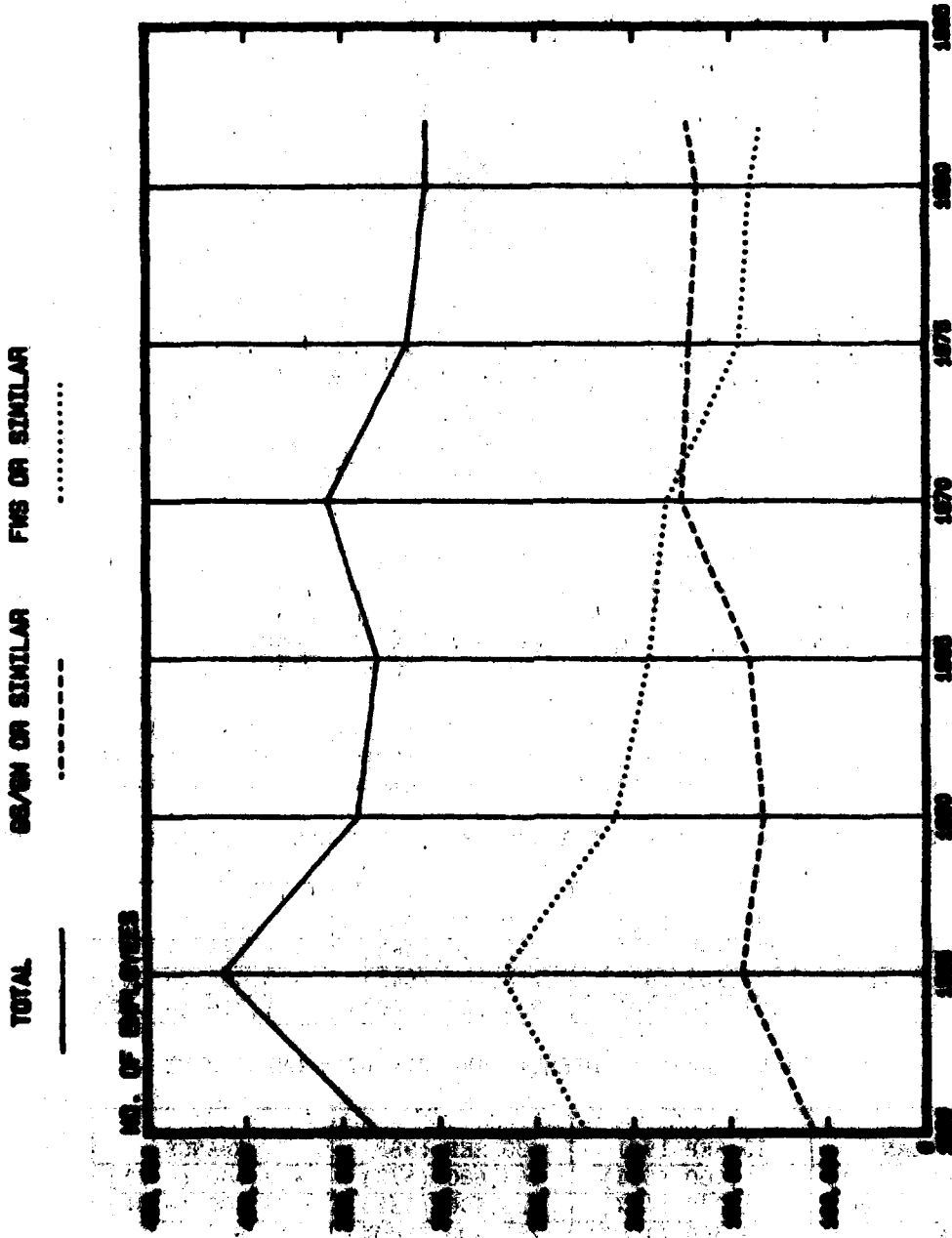

Since 1972, there has been a 9.0 percent reduction in the number of full-time civilian employees worldwide. General Schedule employment has increased by 1.7 percent and Federal Wage System decreased by 19.8 percent. During the past 5 years the full-time population has increased by 0.3 percent; General Schedule increased by 3.7 percent; and Federal Wage System decreased 5.0 percent.

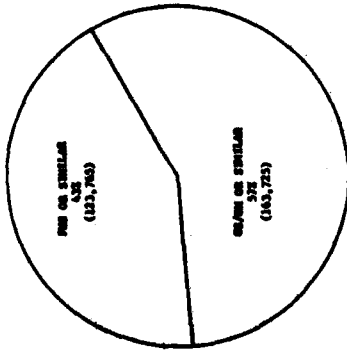

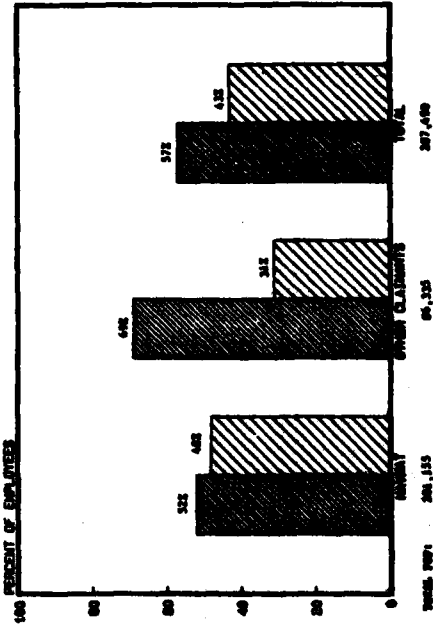
**CHART 2A - TOTAL NAVY**

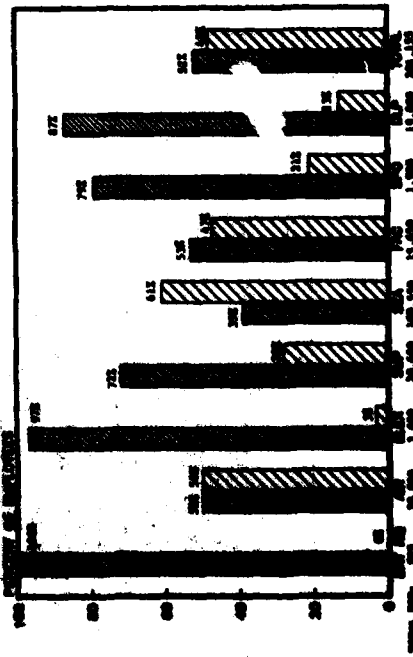
**CHART 2B - TOTAL NAVMAT/OTHER CLAIMANTS**

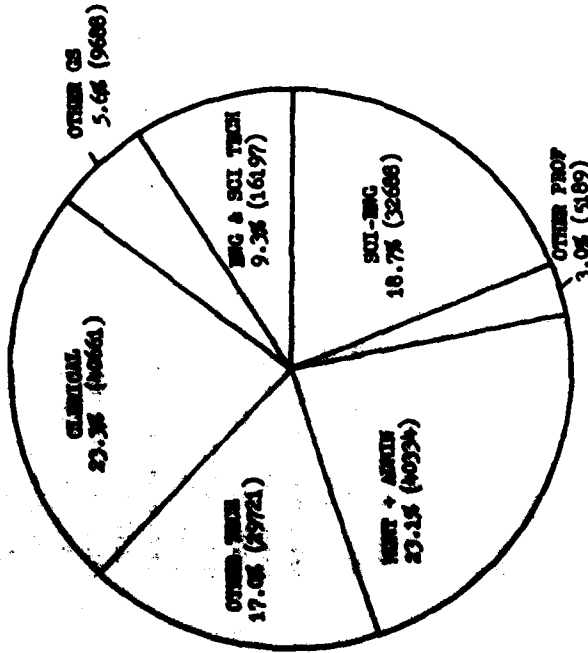

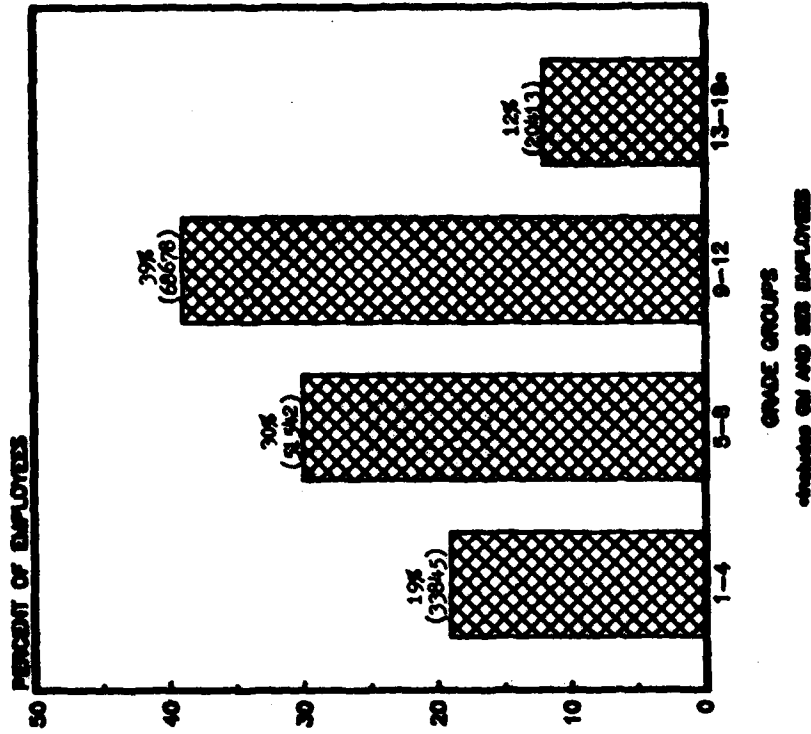
**CHART 3 - GS/GM OR SIMILAR POPULATION DISTRIBUTION

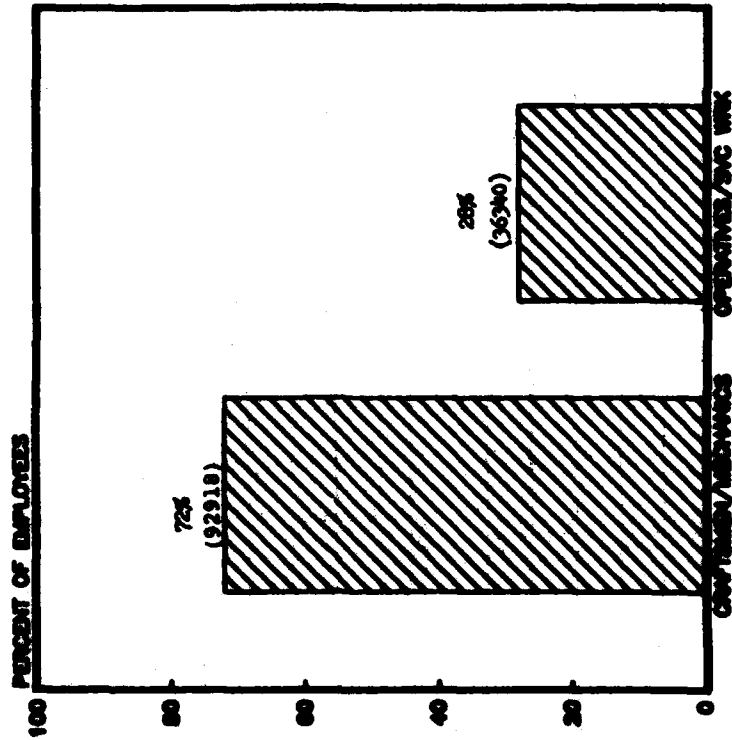

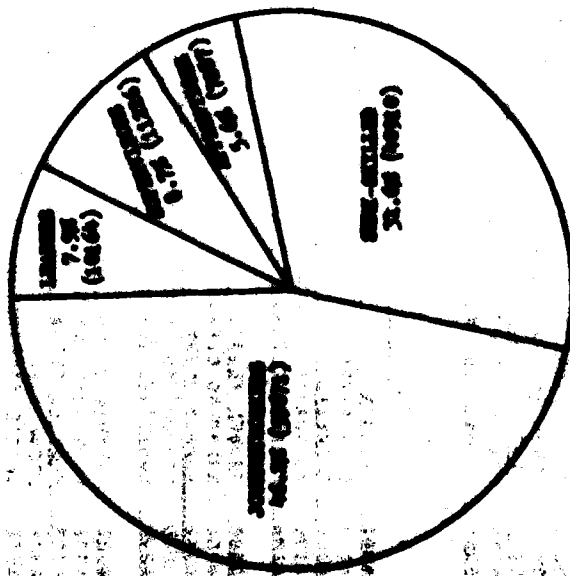
**CHART 4 - FWS OR SIMILAR POPULATION DISTRIBUTION

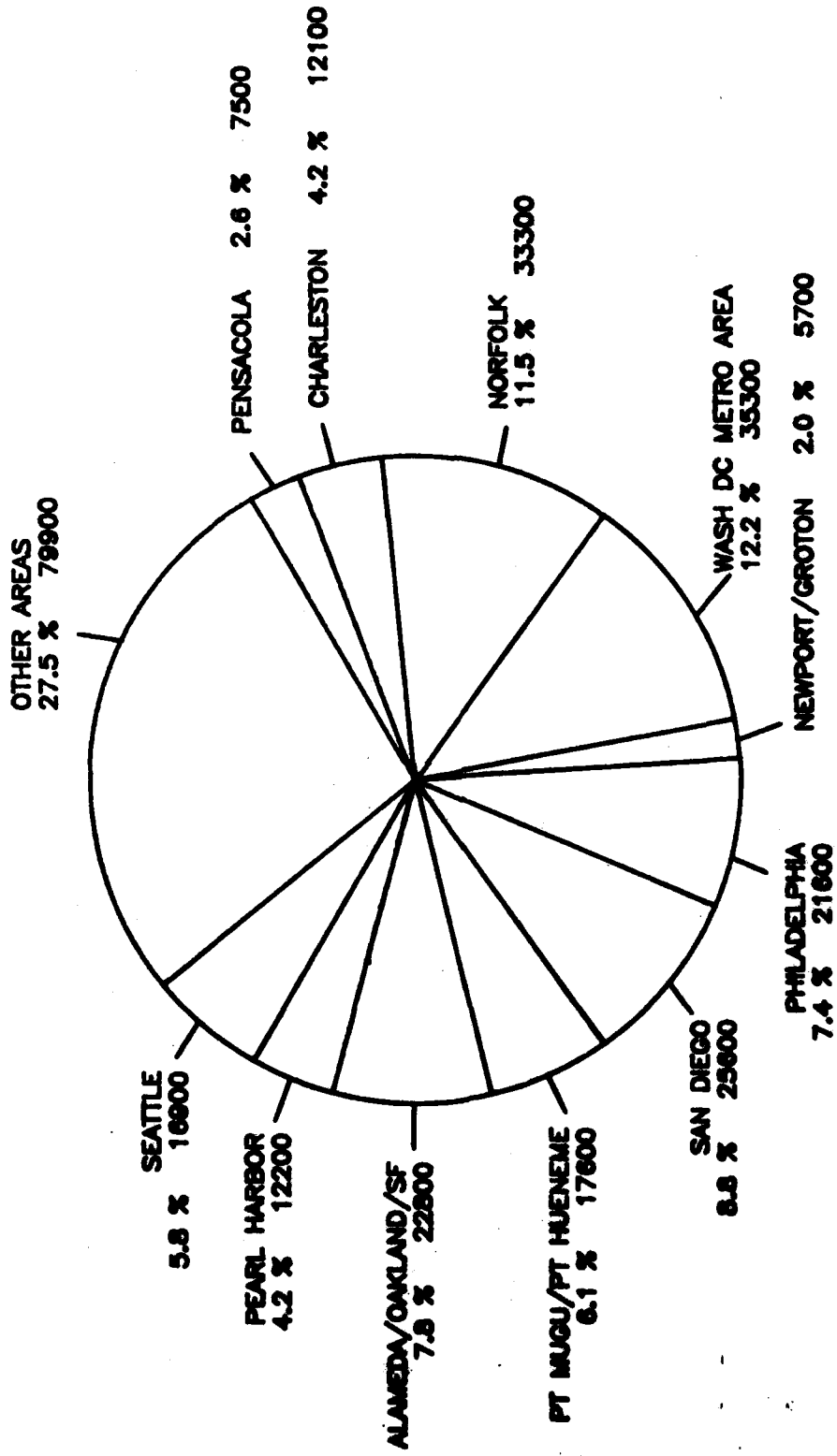

CHART 7A - U.S. CITIZENS/FOREIGN NATIONALS

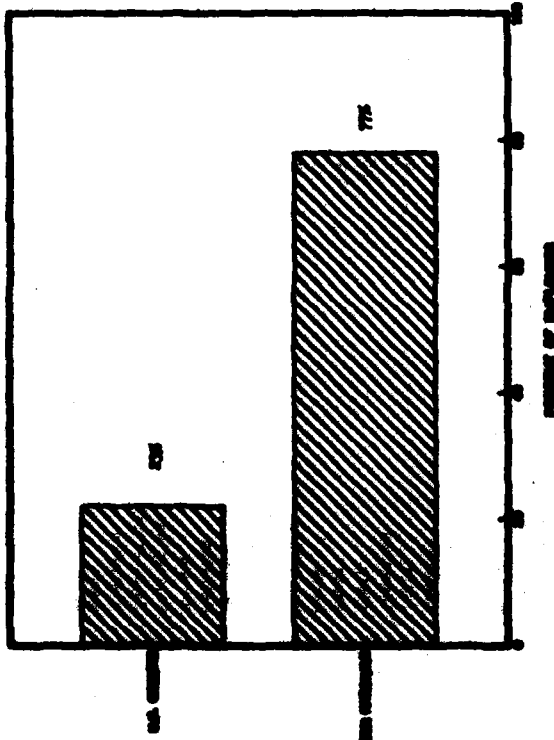


CHART 7B - FOREIGN NATIONALS

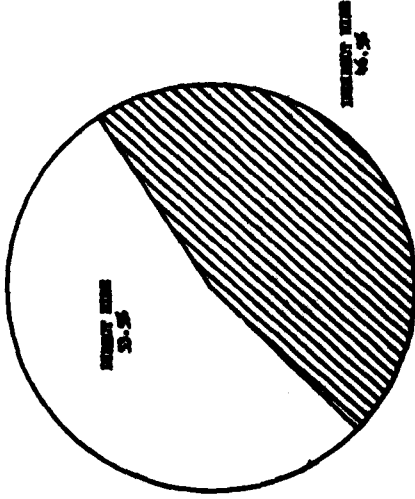

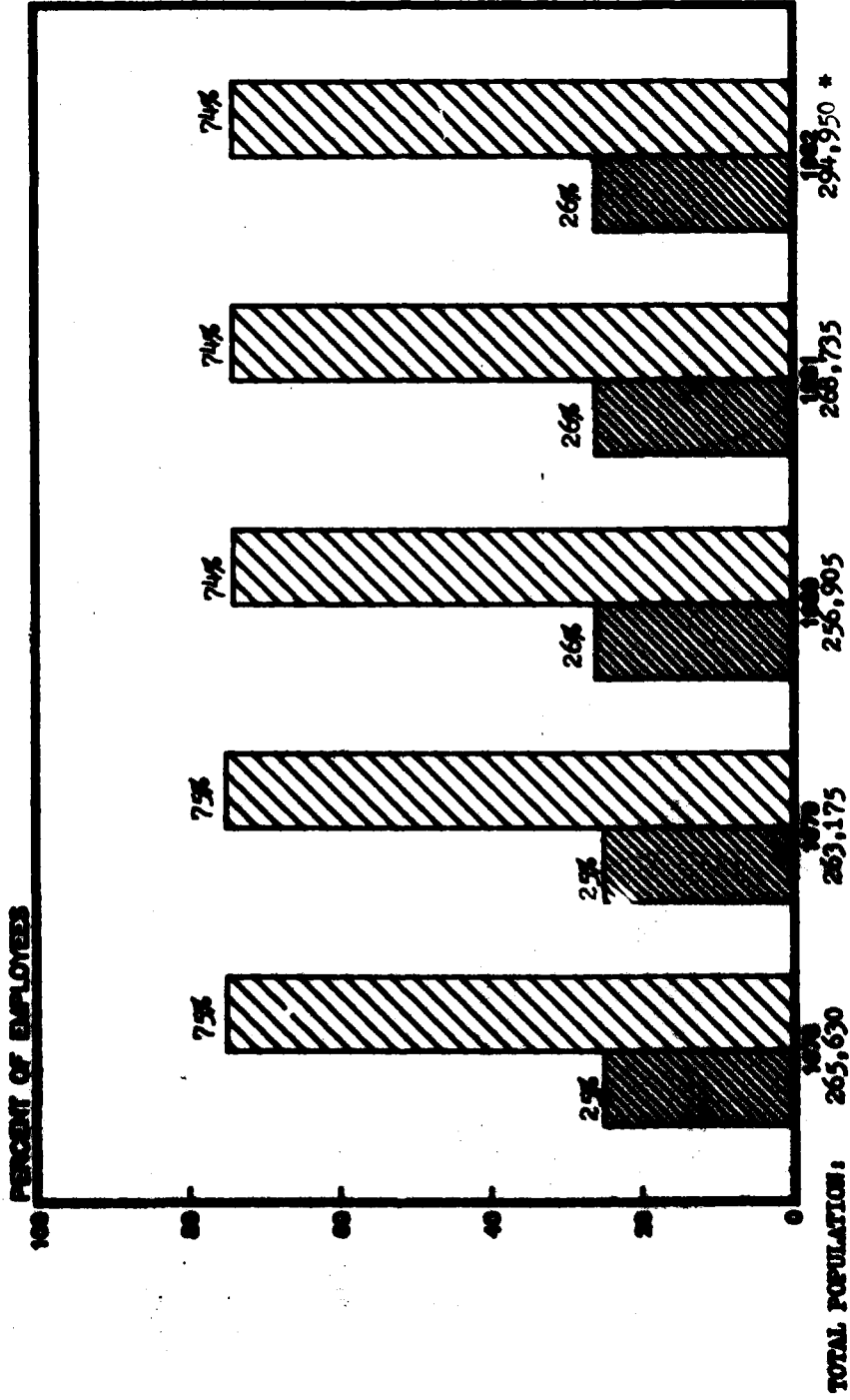

**TOTAL - FULL-TIME CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES**

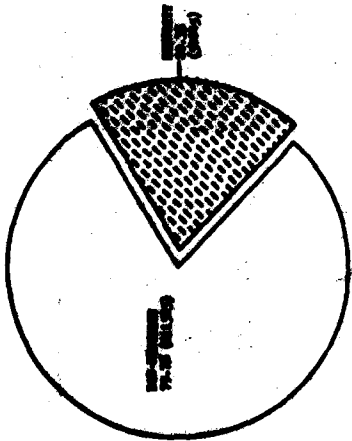

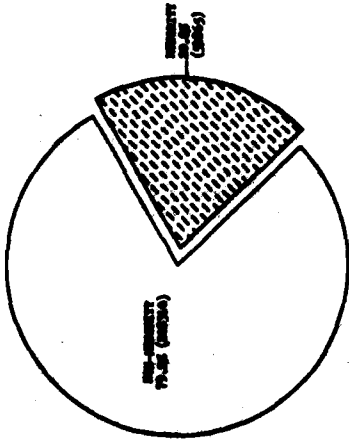
**CHART 9 - MINORITY TRENDS

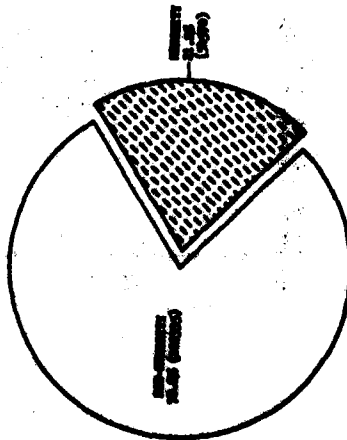

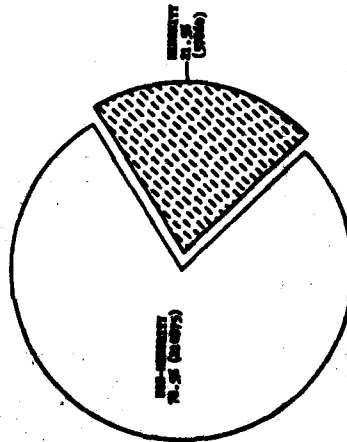

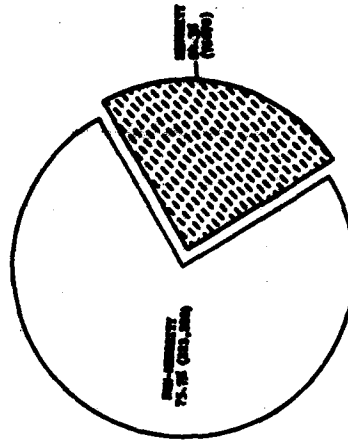

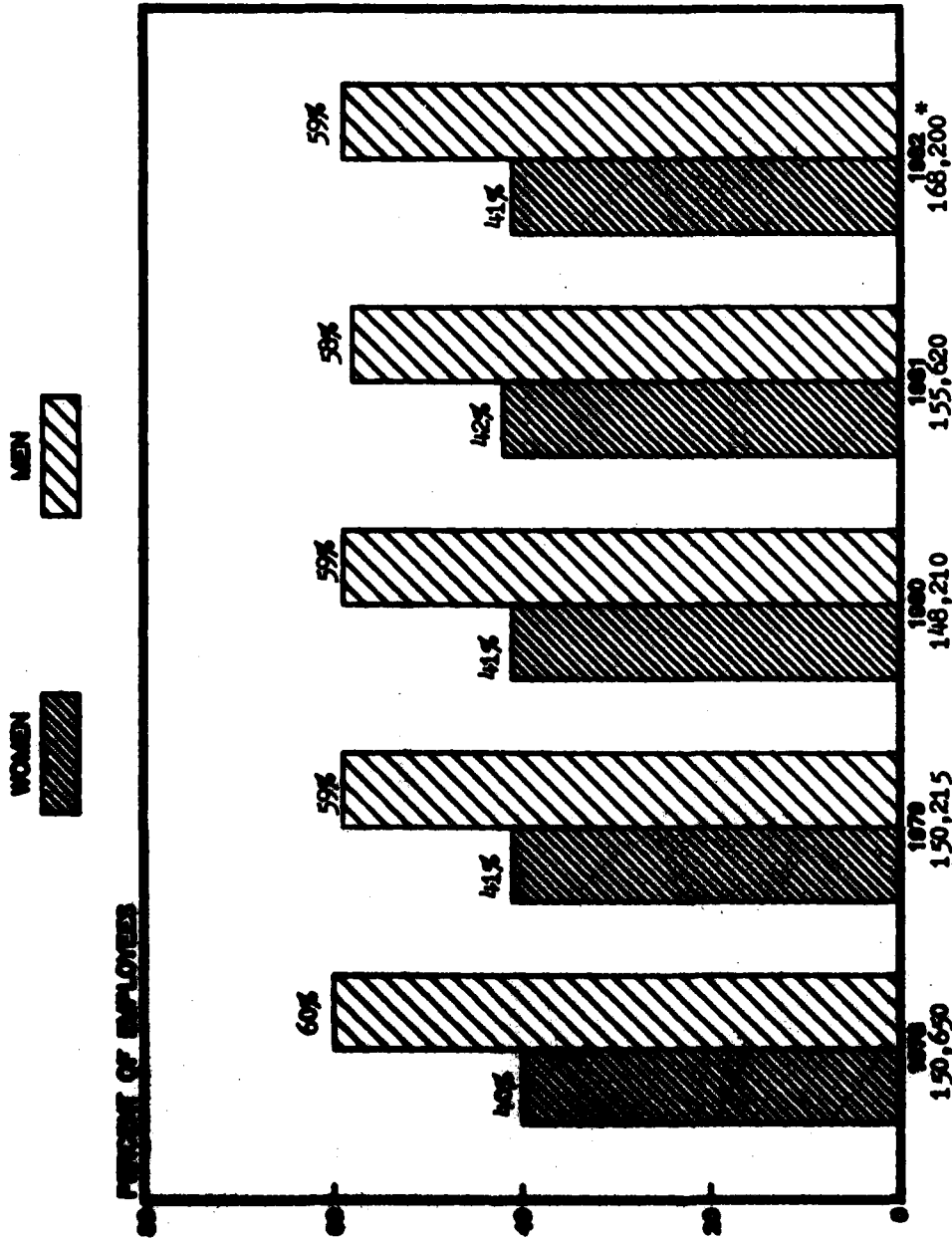

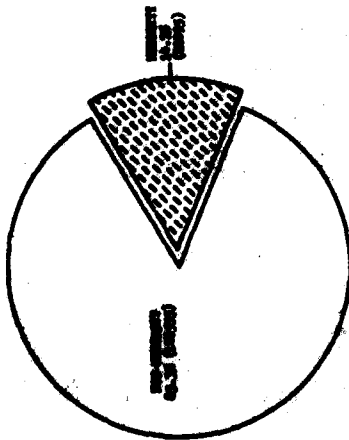
**CHART 10 - MEN/WOMEN TRENDS

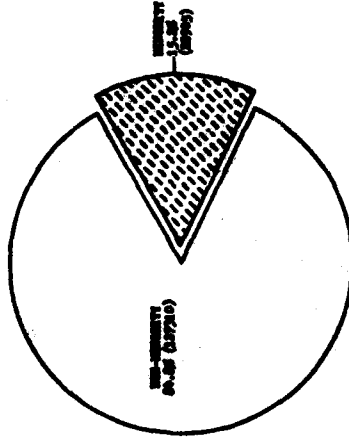
**CHART 11 - MINORITY TRENDS

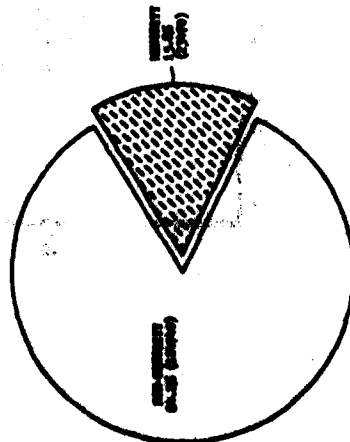

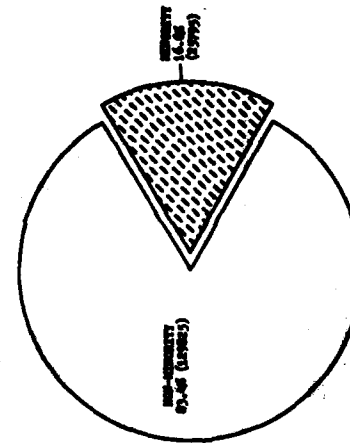

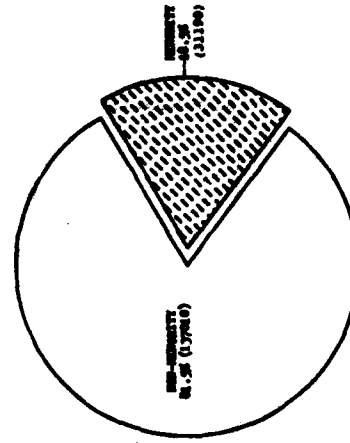

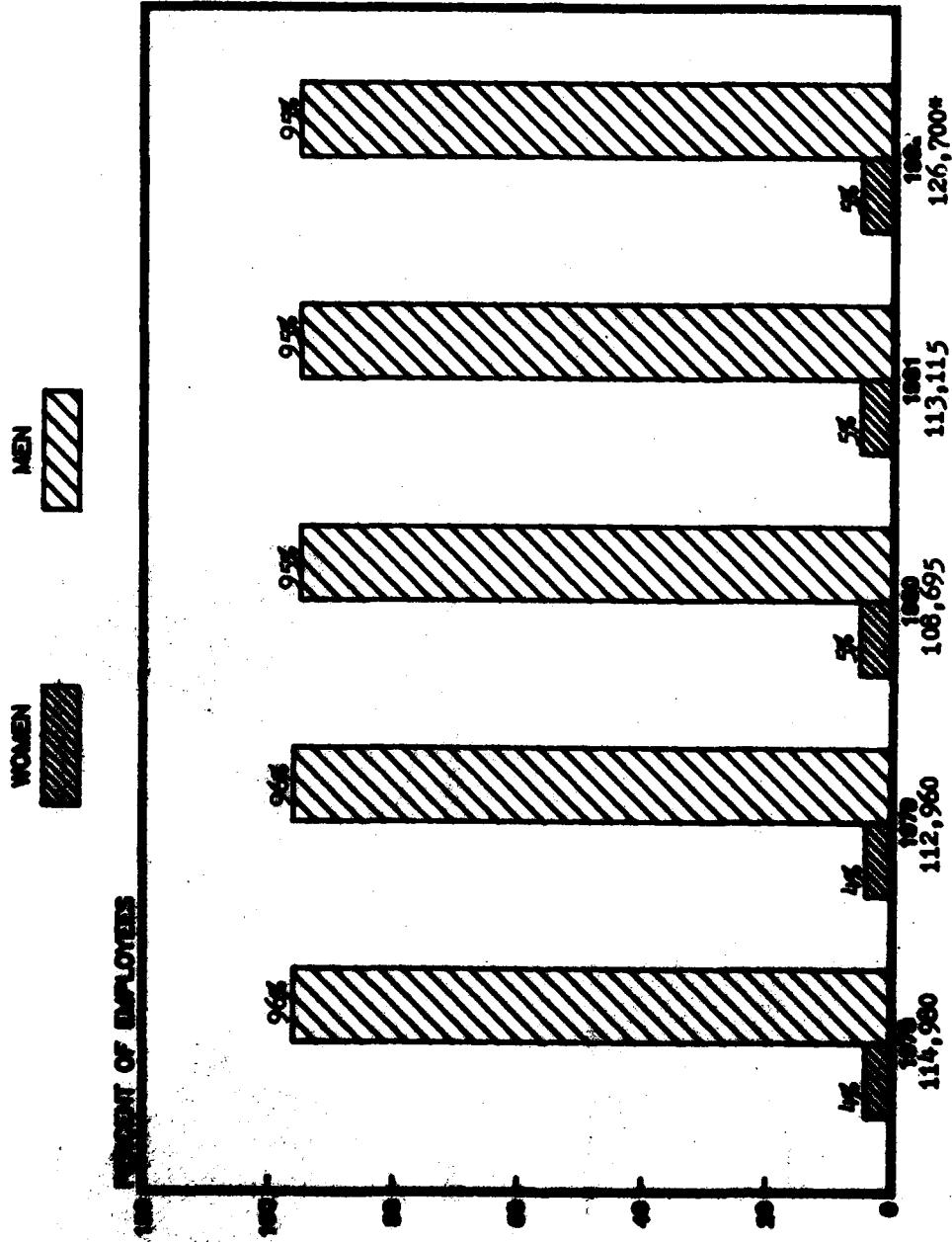

**FMS OR SIMILAR - FULL-TIME CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES**

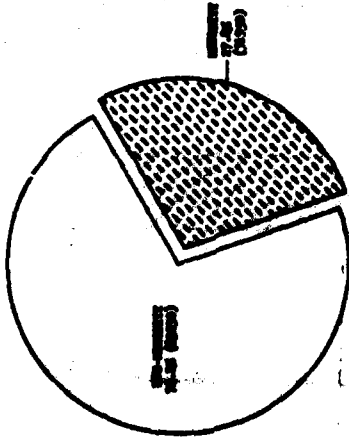

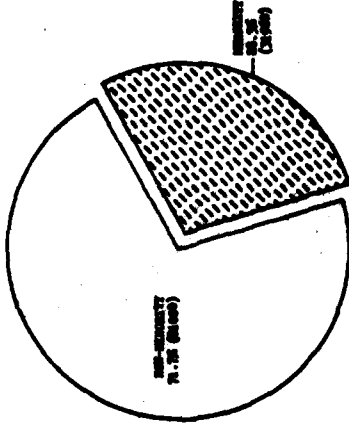
**CHART 13 - MINORITY TRENDS

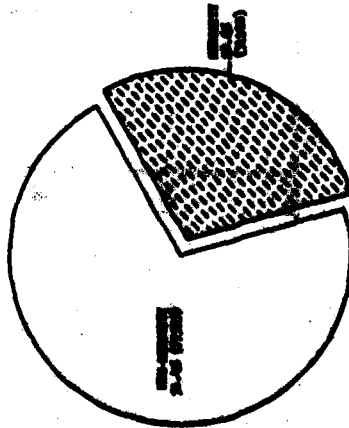

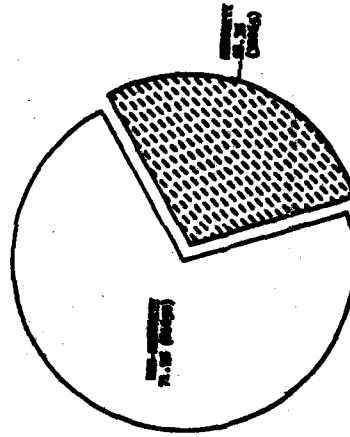

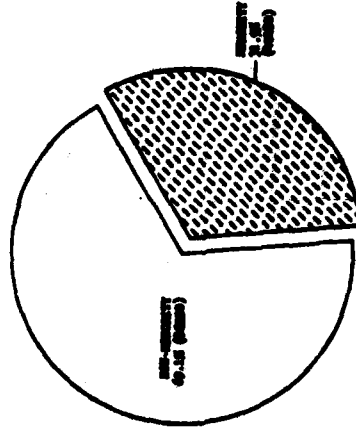

TOTAL - 30 SEPTEMBER 1982

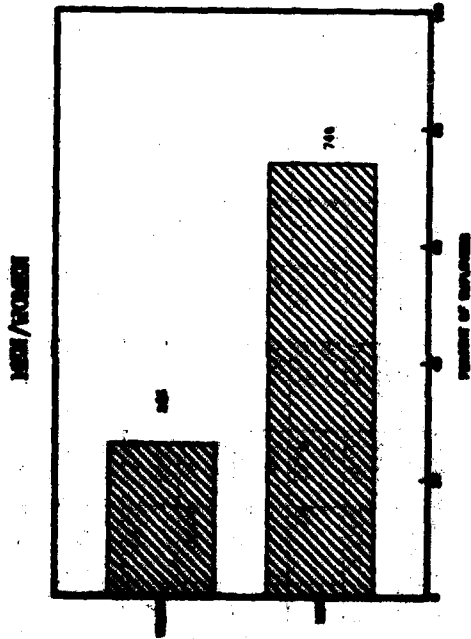
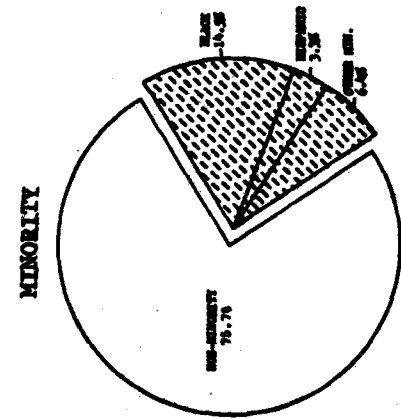

CHART 14A-1 - MEN/WOMEN BY GRADE GROUP

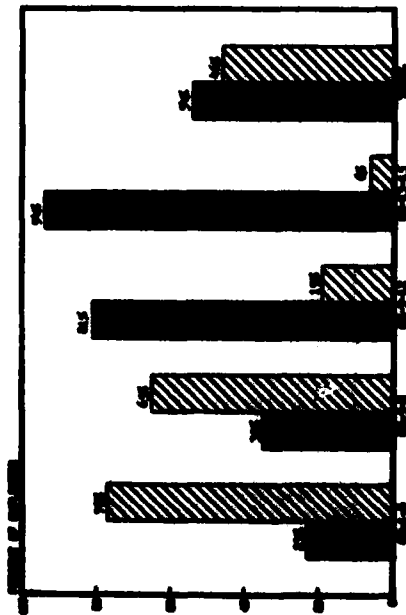


CHART 14A-2 - MINORITY

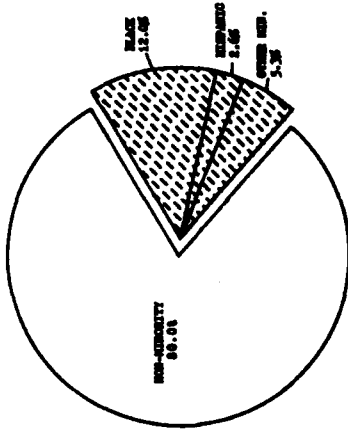

CHART 143-1 - MEN/WOMEN

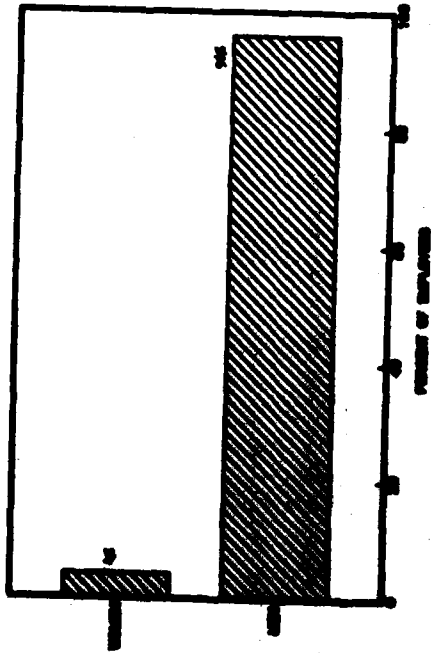


CHART 143-2 - MINORITY

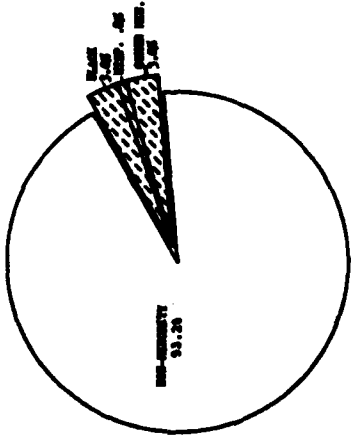

CHART 14C-1 - MEN/WOMEN

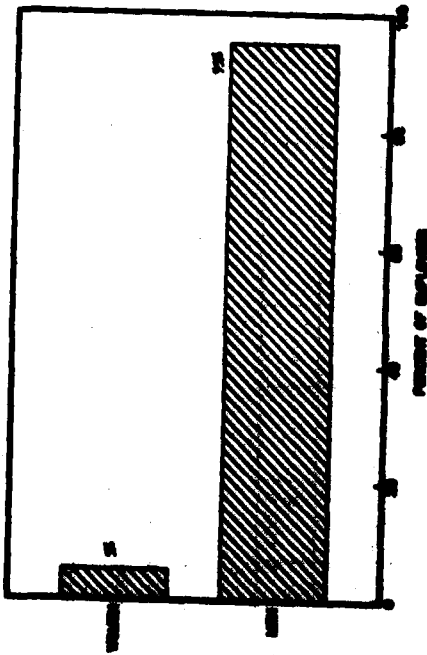


CHART 14C-2 - MINORITY

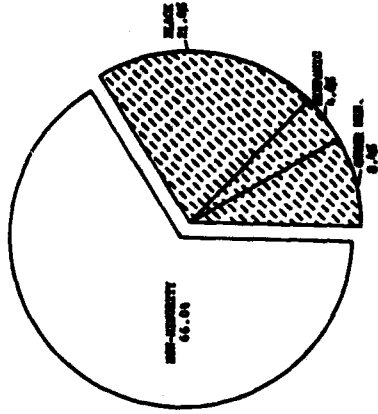

CHART 14D-1 - MEN/WOMEN

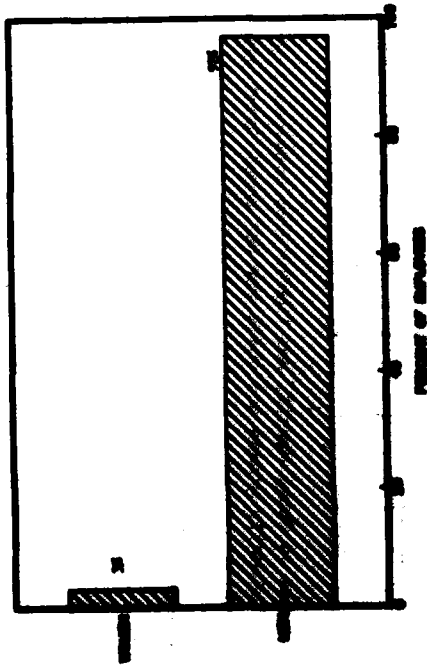


CHART 14D-2 - MINORITY

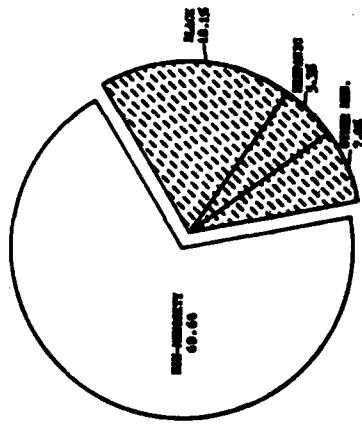

CHART 14E-1 - MEN/WOMEN

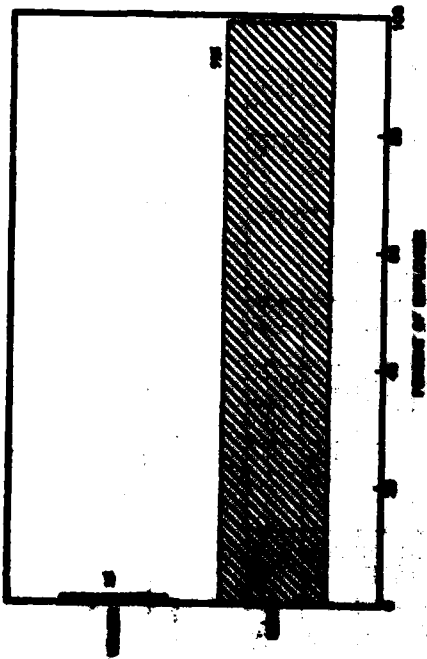


CHART 14E-2 - MINORITY

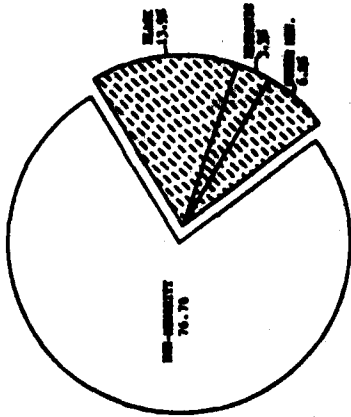

CHART 14F-1 - MEN/WOMEN

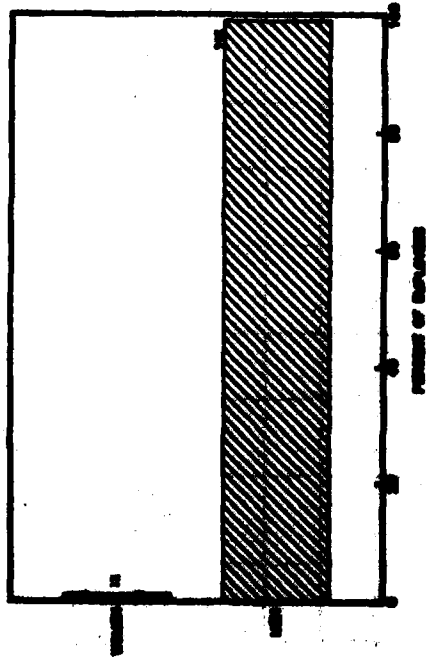


CHART 14F-2 - MINORITY

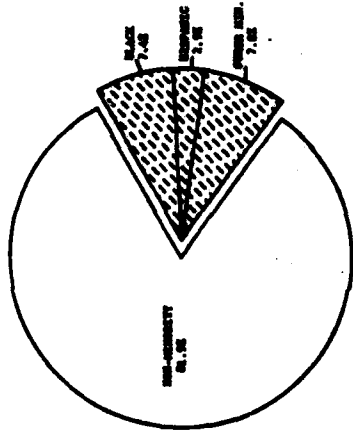

CHART 14G-1 - MEN/WOMEN

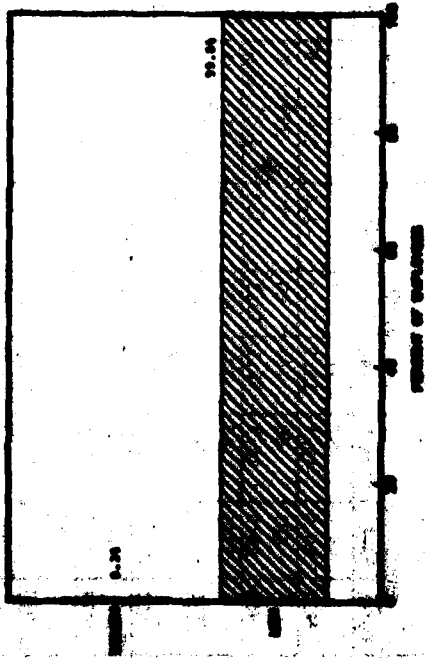


CHART 14G-2 - MINORITY

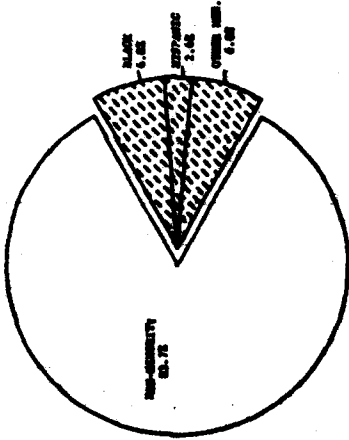

CHART 14H-1 - MEN/WOMEN

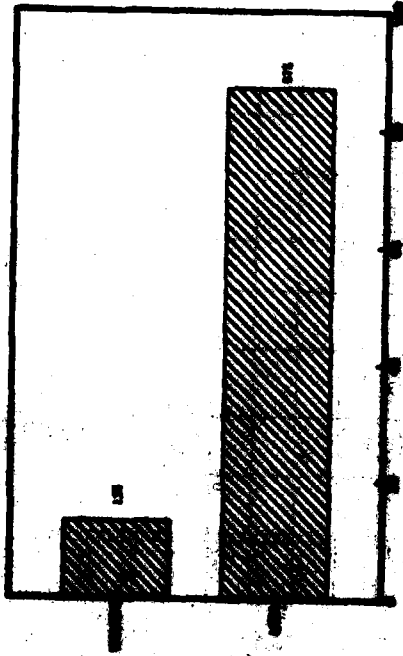


CHART 14H-2 - MINORITY

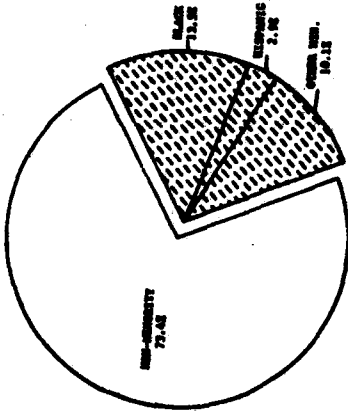

CHART 141-1 - MEN/WOMEN

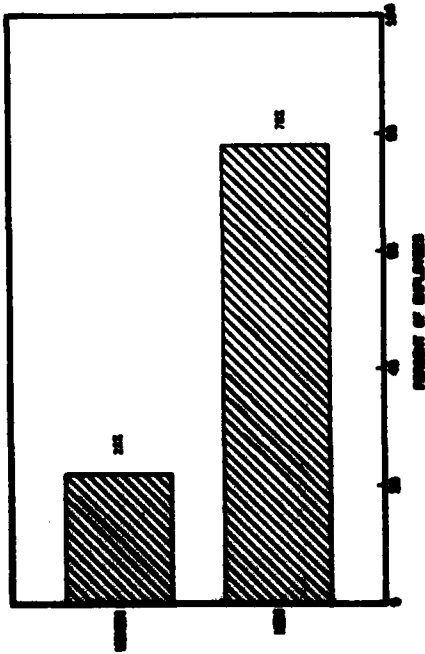


CHART 141-2 - MINORITY

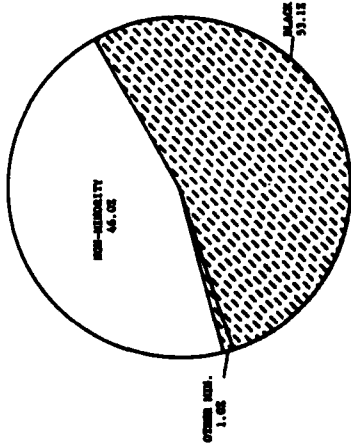

CHART 14J-1 - MEN/WOMEN

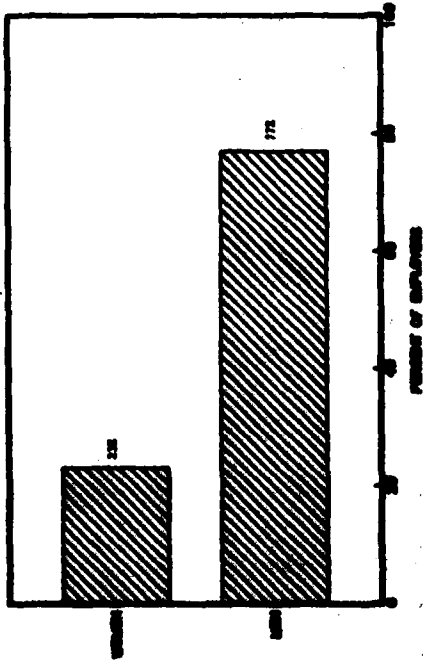


CHART 14J-2 - MINORITY

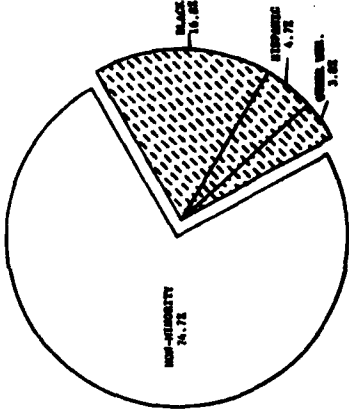

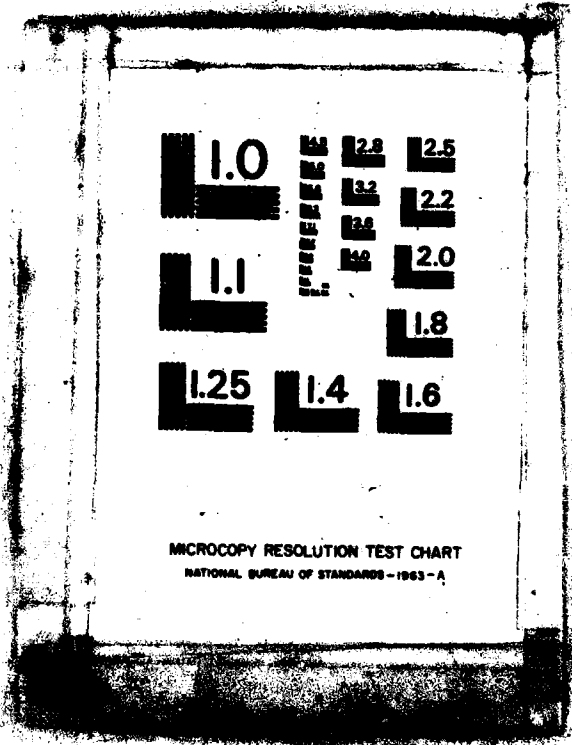

## GLOSSARY

**TERRITORIES** - Republic of Panama; Puerto Rico, Guam; Midway Island; and Trust Territories of Pacific Islands

**FOREIGN COUNTRIES** - Outside both the United States and the territories.

**GENERAL SCHEDULE/  
GENERAL MANAGER  
(GS/GM)** -All employees currently on board in General Schedule and General Manager positions and employees performing duties similar to employees in this category; consultants and experts; academic staff at the Naval Academy, Naval War College, and Postgraduate School; and the Secretary of the Navy and his assistants.

**FEDERAL WAGE SYSTEM  
(FWS)** - All employees other than General Schedule currently on board.

**OTHER THAN FULL TIME** - Regularly appointed employees who perform services on an irregular or occasional basis where the hours or days of work are not based on a prearranged schedule and compensation is paid only for the time actually rendered, and those who perform services on a regular schedule when the hours or days of work are less than the prescribed hours or days of work for full-time employees in the same group or class.

**DIRECT HIRE** - Employees that are directly on Navy payrolls. Includes full-time permanent, full-time temporary, part-time, and intermittent employees.

**INDIRECT HIRE** - Foreign Nationals under Master Labor Contracts. They are employees of the agency of their own government. The U.S. Government has a contract or agreement with the Foreign Government which hires and pays the employees.
