



ERC letter, CMOS Final VDD, dated 30 Jan 91, states that the SDD will not be updated prior to PCA. Since the CSUs identified in the SDD must also be identified in the SPS and vice versa, it is obvious that the SPS (Applications and Communications) cannot be finalized at this point. Recommend publishing the final baselined SPS upon completion of a final SDD.

- 2. CU1C0520 appears in the SDD, but is not in the Directory File Listing of the SPS.
