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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report presents a summary analysis of CHAMPUS beneficiary utilization by Department of Defense service branch. The analysis included all claims processed during Fiscal Year 1992. (CHAMPUS utilization in Europe was excluded from the analysis.) The report was prepared at the request of the Managed Care Division, Directorate of Programs and Resources, Office of the Surgeon General, U.S. Air Force.

The utilization summary is presented in three sections: (A) Total CHAMPUS Beneficiary Utilization; (B) CHAMPUS Beneficiary Utilization - Specific Programs: Outpatient Care, Inpatient Care; and (C) CHAMPUS Beneficiary Utilization - Specific Programs: Dental Care, Handicapped Program, Drug Reimbursement. In all sections, utilization is presented separately for Army, Navy, and Air Force beneficiaries. Utilization data for each of the services is further itemized by billable medical treatment facility (BMC). Outside catchment area totals include the CHAMPUS Reform Act Initiative (CRI) areas of California and Hawaii. All tables include counts for the total beneficiaries treated. In addition, the total counts are broken out and itemized by patient gender, beneficiary category, sponsor rank, and patient age group.

The claim records analyzed in this study--institutional services, inpatient and outpatient professional services, handicapped program, dental care, and vendor and consolidated drug reimbursements--were extracted from the Tri-Service CHAMPUS Statistical Database Project (TCSDP) Main Relational Database. Army, Navy and Air Force claim records with voucher processing dates of Oct 1991 through Sep 1992 were extracted. Service branch assignment was based on billable branch of service as derived by OCHAMPUS fiscal intermediaries during adjudication.

Utilization was defined as an individual having at least one adjudicated and non-rejected treatment encounter with any CHAMPUS provider. Thus, any records which were zero for the three amounts--total government cost, total patient cost, and total amount allowed--as well as those where the fiscal intermediary denied the claim, were deleted prior to summation. For each branch of service, the extracted claim records were sorted by beneficiary and specific program, and reduced to one record per beneficiary per program. Data were then summarized to obtain the beneficiary counts presented in Sections A-C.

In Section A and in each specific CHAMPUS program in Sections B and C, a beneficiary contributed to the utilization of only one BMC, even if more than one BMC occurred among the given claim records for an individual. (Within a given category, the BMC on the first record OCHAMPUS processed for a beneficiary was the BMC which received the utilization count.) That fact means that the utilization shown for some BMCs may be less than what actually occurred. However, it also means that the grand totals for branch of service in Section A and the

subtotals for each program tabulated in Sections B and C were obtained without duplicate counts of any individual. In other words, the grand totals in Section A show the number of different individuals in each service who utilized one or more of the CHAMPUS programs; and the subtotals in Sections B and C show the number of different individuals, by service branch, who utilized each specific CHAMPUS program. Consequently, if the total utilization of all specific programs (Sections B, C) were summed for each service branch, these totals may surpass the totals presented in Section A, because a beneficiary could have used more than one specific program during the study period.
