In all, seven cruises were carried out in the ONR program, covering survey and mooring deployment cruises and the SeaSoar cruises conducted in cooperation with the Naval Research Laboratory. 15 different groups were funded by ONR to participate in this project.

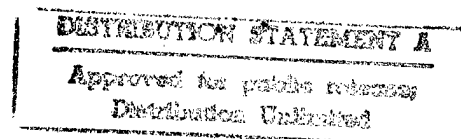
