DAILY BLAMES U.S. FOR DANGER OF NEW WAR

[Text] Pyongyang, 18 Jul (KCNA)--World peace and security are gravely menaced and the danger of a new war is growing due to the reckless moves of the U.S. imperialists to realize their wild ambition for world supremacy by "strength," declares NODONG SINMUN today.

The paper says:

During the last few months South Korea has been the scene of such powder-reeking war exercises staged by the U.S. imperialist aggressors almost every day as the "Team Spirit 83," fleet mobile exercise and "myollong (destroy communism 83." In this period, they staged entirely offensive military operations such as "parachuting operation," "landing operation," "ground operation" and "bombing exercise," by choosing areas and goals similar to the northern half of the republic. They are hastening war preparations in the European area, too, while making haste with the deployment of nuclear weapons.

JAPANESE WOMEN'S GROUP CALLS FOR U.S. WITHDRAWAL

SYMPOSIUM OF ALL KOREAN SCHOLARS OVERSEAS HELD IN JAPAN

Scholars Adopt Declaration

[Text] Pyongyang, 18 Jul (KCNA)--A "Kyoto Declaration for Independence, Democracy and Unification" was adopted at the Sixth Symposium of All Korean Scholars Overseas for National Unification which was held recently in Kyoto, Japan.

It stresses that the movement for democracy and national unification should be conducted under the banner of national independence against foreign forces.

Noting that the tensions on the Korean Peninsula must be based, the peninsula be turned into a nuclear-free, peace zone and the danger of nuclear war be removed from the peninsula, it says:

The foreign troops present in the South must be withdrawn along with all nuclear weapons deployed there. No part of the territory of the country must be left as a military base of foreign troops.

The joint military exercises with foreign troops, which have become an annual occurrence, must be brought to an end and a peaceful climate be created through disarmament.

A lasting and durable peace will come to the Korean Peninsula when the North-South division has been terminated and national unification realised.

We reaffirm our old assertion that the North-South dialogue should embrace only democratic and patriotic forces which act truly for unification, not in word, and, only when it is participated in by a wide range of representatives reflecting the will of people of various strata in the North and South and abroad, can the door of unification be opened.

The movement against dictatorship and for democracy is an important task to be carried out continuously and vigorously on the road of unification.

The movement for democracy of intellectuals, youth and students, former opposition figures and religionists in South Korea is rapidly growing in scope and strength into a struggle of a higher plane.

We warmly support their just, patriotic struggle with compatriotic sentiments.

For the future of the country and the nation, the Chon Tu-hwan military junta must immediately resign as demanded by the people and a democratic coalition government aspiring after independence, democracy and unification be established.

We demand that the United States rectify its policy toward South Korea and stop all its acts rendering military, political and economic support to the present bellicose dictatorial "regime" and opposing the unification of the Korean Peninsula.

The declaration stresses:

We will actively conduct the movement of peace, freedom, democracy and unification against foreign forces and for national chanjusong, availing ourselves of the favourable conditions that we are in foreign countries.

We will inform broad sections of world public of the realities of South Korea which has turned into a most dangerous complex nuclear base in the world and is fraught with the danger of becoming the hotbed of a new global war and will extensively wage a peace movement so that shouts opposing war and nuclear weapons may ring out from the South.

We will strive to thwart the South Korea-U.S.-Japan tripartite "security system" and smash the scheme of Japanese militarism to stage a comeback to our country.

Using every possible means, we abroad will conduct a brisk movement for reunion and exchange between compatriots in the North and South and bring to further maturity a climate and conditions for dialogue for unification.

Scholars Support National Unification

[Text] Pyongyang, 19 Jul (KCNA)--Chang Nyon-sok, professor at the Osaka University of Telecommunication, made a report "Let Us Open the Way to Peaceful Unification Through the Movement for National Independence Against Foreign Forces" at the Sixth Symposium of All Korean Scholars Overseas for National Unification held in Kyoto, Japan, according to a KNS report.

Noting that the cold war has been intensified and the situation on the Korean peninsula rendered extremely tense in accordance with the U.S. global strategy since the emergency of the ultra-rightist regime of Reagan in the United States and the Nakasone cabinet in Japan, the reporter said:

The United States has heightened with each passing day the strategic position of the Korean Peninsula, claiming that Korea is "its main stronghold in North-east Asia" and that "the security of South Korea is vital for its security." At the South Korea-U.S. "Security Council" meeting last April, it went so far as to state that "South Korea is vital for the interests of the United States."

The U.S.-Japan-South Korea tripartite "security system" has rapidly strengthened with the emergency of the Nakasone cabinet in Japan and Nakasone's tour of South Korea and the United States early this year as an occasion.

Recently the United States deployed 133 tactical nuclear weapons, 21 nuclear mines, 63 nuclear warheads for 8-inch howitzers and 31 nuclear warheads for 155-mm howitzers in the area near the military demarcation line and plans to deploy neutron weapons in South Korea.

Noting that it poses a serious problem to avert the danger of war and preserve peace, the reporter went on:

We demand that the armistice agreement be replaced by a peace agreement with the 30th anniversary of the signing of the 27 July armistice agreement as an occasion.

Our anti-war peace movement must be connected with the movement for the independent and peaceful unification of the country.

We are given a task to realize independence, democracy and national unification.

The popular uprising in Kwangju showed that unless we are freed from dependence on the United States it is impossible to attain our goal and that liberation from foreign forces, self-reliance and national independence are the task of history.

Through the Kwangju incident, the students and genuine democratic forces of South Korea clearly realised that the United States is the backstage manipulator and real criminal who plunged Kwangju into a sea of blood and caused a shocking tragedy, too horrible to see, and became aware that unless they win victory in the fight with the backstage manipulator, neither restoration of genuine democracy nor national unification can be achieved.

Through the struggle for democracy in the 60's and 70's full of vicissitudes and trials and the Kwangju tragedy, anti-U.S. sentiments have been widely spread and become universal among students, progressive religionists, intellectuals and all other segments of people.

We have the internal forces to wage the anti-U.S. struggle for national independence and national consciousness capable of accepting the struggle of such a high stage.

We reached the conclusion that a movement against foreign forces and for national independence must be launched in order to preserve peace and achieve unification on the Korean Peninsula under the strained situation with the Sixth Symposium of All Korean Scholars Overseas for National Unification as an occasion, the reporter noted and said:

We must lift up our voices to indict the hegemonist policy of the United States toward South Korea and demand national sovereignty and turn out more vigorously to defend the dignity of the nation.

We regard the U.S. troops' presence in South Korea as aggression and interference in our internal affairs and strongly demand the U.S. Government to withdraw its troops from South Korea.

We demand that all nuclear weapons deployed in South Korea be withdrawn along with the troops.

We should expose to the world the realities of South Korea which has turned into a most dangerous complex nuclear base and serve a warning against the danger of nuclear war in Asia and the world with the Korean Peninsula as the train.

We must keep a watch over the moves of the United States to rearm Japan, link it with the South Korean military "regime" and bring the Japanese armed forces into South Korea, and must check and foil in cooperation with the Japanese democratic forces the scheme to round off the U.S.-Japan-South Korea "security cooperation system."

We must struggle to replace the present military dictatorial "regime" of South Korea by a democratic government through intensified movement against dictatorship.

Three Students Arrested

This signal victory meant safeguarding the independence of the country and the gains of revolution with honour, brought about the beginning of downhill slide of US imperialism, and gave a strong impetus to the anti-imperialist, anti-US imperialist struggle of the revolutionary people the world over.

The US imperialists should have gone home, drawing a due lesson from their ignominious defeat in the Korean war. But today they are still entrenched in south Korea, infringing upon the sovereignty of our nation and frantically manoeuvring to unleash another war. At the same time they are dead set against the independent reunification of our country, while persistently pursuing a "two Koreas" policy.

The great leader President Kim Il Sung said:

"The occupation of south Korea by the US imperialists and their policy of aggression are the root cause of all our nation's misery, the main obstacle to the reunification of our country and a constant source of war in Korea."

The Workers' Party of Korea and the Government of the Republic have throughout affirmed as their basic principle that the country should be reunified in the interests of the nation, by the Korean people themselves without any interference from outside forces. Proceeding from this principle, they put forth concrete proposals and ways and means reasonable for national reunification and made all sincere efforts to put them into practice. However, each time the US imperialists rejected our proposal. Today in order to realize their vicious aggressive end they are intensifying their policy of colonial subjugation in south Korea and resorting to more undisguised moves to trigger off a way.

Because of their reckless war moves, today the situation in our country is so strained that a new war may break out at any moment.

The US imperialist steadily reinforce their aggression forces and armaments in south Korea.

They have already increased there F-16s and A-10s and also many warships including frigates and guided missile-equipped destroyers.

And they deployed numbers of nuclear weapons there, and of late they have been planning to bring in even neutron bombs. It is known to everyone that they formed the "Rapid Deployment Force" to be moved to the Korean peninsula in case of emergency and put them on the alert.

While turning south Korea into an arsenal for war and concentrating huge aggression forces around the Korean peninsula, the US imperialist are frantically staging dangerous war games.

As reported already, in collaboration with the Chon Du Hwan puppet clique the US imperialists held the "Team Spirit 83" war exercise in south Korea in the period from February 1 to mid-April this year. KCNA ON INCREASE OF DPRK TEXTILE OUTPUT

[Text] Pyongyang, 18 Jul (KCNA)--In Korea textile output jumped 80 percent last year.

In the first half of this year the output of staple fibre-vinalon mixed-spun textiles was 40 percent up on the like period of last year and that of vinalon suit materials showed an increase of one million metres.

Korea met from long ago the home demand for fabrics by herself.

Textile industry was next to nil in the area of today's northern half of the republic before liberation. In those days the per capital textile output was no more than 14 centimetres.

It was not until after liberation that the foundation of the textile industry was built under the wise leadership of the great leader Comrade Kim Il-song.

Textile industry made a rapid development particularly in the postwar period. The destroyed textile mills were rehabilitated in a short period and large-scale modern textile mills and small- and medium-scale knitwear and textile mills were built in all parts of the country.

Textile industrial bases capable of producing 400 million metres of fabrics annually had been built by 1970.

The material and technical foundations of the textile production bases were further consolidated during the last decade, during which the number of the spindles showed an increase of 1.75 times and the number of the knitting machines more than trebled.

The capacity of the existing spinning and weaving equipment has increased further still in recent years.

Entering this year, the Pyongyang Textile Combine and the Sinuiju Textile Mill have increased the number of rotations of spindles by several hundred as against last year.

Many textile mills have attached new apparatuses and devices to the textile machines to suit the use of domestic fibre, making it possible to boost production further still.

Knitwear output has gone up with the modernization of knitting equipment.

Solid chuche-based chemical fibre production bases for the increase of textile production have been laid.

The production capacity of the chemical fibre mills has shown a marked increase. In the six-year plan period (1971-1976), the production capacity of the 8 February Vinalon Complex reached 50,000 tons and that of the Chongjin and Sinuiju Chemical Fibre Mills augmented to tens of thousands of tons.

Industry of new chemical fibres including movilon has been founded in recent years to open a broader road of solving the textile problem by its own efforts.

The Seventh Plenary Meeting of the Sixth Central Committee of the Workers' Party of Korea held some time ago set forth the task to beat ahead of schedule the 1,500 million metre target of textiles, one of the ten long-term objectives of socialist economic construction for the 1980's. The textile production bases are being built up more solidly thanks to the endeavours of the chemical fibre and textile industrial workers for carrying through the decisions of the plenary meeting.

FACTORY COLLEGE SYSTEM MARKS 32D ANNIVERSARY

The Factory College of university level, a new-type college where workers study while on the job, was set up on 15 July 1951, in the period of the fatherland liberation war, at the initiative of the great leader Comrade Kim Il-song.

Factory colleges built at large factories and enterprises in all parts of the country under the wise guidance of the great leader have today become reliable bases with well-regulated educational system for training qualified technicians.

The number of factory colleges, only 40 or so in 1970, has now increased to nearly 90 including branch colleges. Four more factory colleges including the Chongjin Shipbuilding Industrial College and the Taegwan Industrial College made their appearance last year.

At the 4 June Rolling Stock Factory, a leading rolling stock production centre of the country, more than 90 percent of technicians including deputy chief engineers and workshop chiefs are factory college graduates. Over 5,000 technical innovation proposals advanced by them were introduced into production to

save 482,000 mandays of labour and bring economic benefits amounting to 3,897,000 won to the state.

The factory colleges are equipped with excellent educational facilities and conditions. They are provided with better conditions for experiment and practice and thousands of kinds of textbooks and reference books were written for the workers-students.

The workers-students at the Wonsan Industrial College are receiving theoretical lectures and learning modern science and technique, while operating over 620 technical means and experimental equipment of more than 200 kinds including programme lathes and supersonic defect detectors.

The work of the factory colleges has been further strengthened and developed in recent years under the energetic guidance and care of the dear leader Comrade Kim Chong-il.

He gave meticulous guidance for the building of more factory colleges and branch colleges and for the completion of the educational contents to meet the requirements of the developing reality. "On-the-spot study groups" will be organized at all factory colleges from September this year, where the entire members of work shops or workteams of more than one unit will study.

In Korea where the intellectualisation of the whole of society is being vigorously pushed forward, there are the university on TV, farmers' colleges and fishermen's colleges of university level along with factory colleges of university level where people study while on the job.
