The eyes of respected President Kim Il-song shone more brilliantly when he was referring to the question of Korea's reunification and his passionate words were full of conviction of victory.

Listening to the president's words, I felt more keenly that the U.S. forces, the foreign troops, must quit south Korea at the earliest date, the question of Korea must be solved by the Korean people themselves and Japan, the only victim of the atomic bomb in the world and a neighbor of Korea, must not obstruct the reunification of this country but stand for the withdrawal of the U.S. troops and nuclear weapons from South Korea.

In Korea I read the four-point proposal put forward by a joint meeting of political parties and public organizations to bring earlier national reunification. The partition of Korea is intolerable also from the humanitarian point of view. National division is the greatest tragedy in human society. Nobody can imagine what bitter sufferings the Korean nation has undergone due to the split.

I toured many parts of Korea and found everything changed beyond my imagination in 5 years. In 1972 I saw the Chollima Street that newly sprang up in Pyongyang. This time I found the new wide Pipa and Nagwon streets and high-rise modern houses standing in rows on either side of each street.

This is a fruition of the deep constant solicitude President Kim Il-song has shown for the life of all the people.

I have visited many countries, socialist and capitalist, but I have never seen such a country as the DPRK, which enforces a wonderful housing policy.

The system in Japan is different from that in Korea. But, I think, she has to learn many things from Korea's housing policy.

How wonderful is the Pyongyang metro!

All the metro stations are spacious and their floors, walls and pillars are built with famous marble of Korea. The walls are decorated with beautiful exquisite mosaics that remind one of a palace.

I went to Panmunjom by a big helicopter thanks to the special care of the DPRK side.

From the clear and azure sky I could see the industrial district along the Taedong-gang River and big construction sites. In the countryside, gigantic land amelioration projects and nonpaddy field irrigation are under way. The peasants live in modern brick houses.

Panmunjom drew my attention because I visited there right after the "Panmunjom incident."

I realized that the U.S. troops' attempt to cut down a tree in question under the pretext that it hampered their observation was a sinister one to achieve their political aim of advertising the "threat from the north." The "threat from the north" is a falsehood.

Kaesong lies not far from Panmunjom. I dined in Kaesong, where many multi-storied buildings and hotels and other buildings stand. Why has the north built such a big city near Panmunjom if it really intends to start "southward invasion"?

The two-kilometer-wide demilitarized zone extends along the northern and southern boundary of the military demarcation line. In the north there spread well-cultivated paddy and nonpaddy fields presenting beautiful scenery, whereas the area in the south is overgrown with grass. This fact convinced me that the "threat from the north" is a lie. I extend my sincere thanks to President Kim Il-song for his deep solicitude and cordial hospitality accorded me during my visit to the DPRK and reverentially wish him good health and a long life.

PRESIDENTIAL ORDER ON PROTECTING MARINE RESOURCES EXPLAINED

[Explanation of the Laws column: "On Positive Protection and Propagation of Marine Resources"]

[Text] The president of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, the great leader Comrade Kim Il-song, issued Presidential Order No 7, "On Positive Protection and Propagation of Marine Resources."

Upholding the on-the-spot guidance the great leader, Comrade Kim Il-song, gave to Kangwon Province and South Hamgyong Province recently and the programmatic instructions he gave at the Conference of Activists in the Fisheries Sector of the Eastern Maritime District, workers throughout the country are vigorously engaged in grand socialist construction under the banner of the three revolutions--ideological, technical and cultural-bringing about a new great upswing in fishing. This reality of today requires that the marine resources be more thoroughly protected and developed.

In Presidential Order No 7, "On the Positive Protection and Propagation of Marine Resources," we find the mammoth plan of the respected and beloved leader to enhance our people's diet in epochal proportions, beautify the fertile terrain of our fatherland and make it into a pleasant paradise on earth, and hand down to posterity even better living conditions and plentiful resources.

In the past period, our party and the government of the republic, upholding the teachings of the great leader, set up the positive protection and propagation of marine resources as one of the important guidelines for developing fisheries. As the result of the vigorous struggle to implement this, fish are plentiful in all the places where there is water both in the country's coastal areas and on land, and marine resources are increasing daily. These plentiful marine resources which we have prepared are one of the country's important natural sources of wealth and our people's valuable treasure.

As a means of creating much more marine resources and having them effectively mobilized and utilized, the positive protection and propagation of marine resources is of very great significance to developing the people's economy and further enhancing the livelihood of the people.

In our country, which is bounded on three sides by ocean and where crystal clear rivers and streams flow, and which has many large and small lakes and reservoirs, there are many kinds of fish and many shallow water cultivation resources.

As raw materials for the foodstuff, chemical and pharmaceutical industries and as important feed for the cattle and poultry industries, these marine resources are valuable resources which are indispensable for developing the people's economy.

In particular, the positive protection and propagation of marine resources such as fish, sea slugs and tangle has become a matter of great importance to improving the people's diet and workers' health under the conditions of recent years, in which grain production has increased by leaps and bounds, the food question has been completely solved, and even the vegetable problem has been solved and much more oil has been produced and supplied as well.

In addition, the positive protection and propagation of marine resources is a great long-range task for not only beautifying our country's scenery but also for handing down plentiful natural resources to posterity.

All functionaries and workers in state organs, business enterprises and cooperatives must have a deep understanding of the importance and significance of protecting marine resources and thoroughly implement Presidential Order No 7, "On the Positive Protection and Propagation of Marine Resouces," thereby actively contributing to protecting and incessantly increasing the country's marine resources.

The great leader, Comrade Kim Il-song, taught as follows: "...[We] must work to protect fishes in a planned manner and propagate stationary fishes and must launch an intensive struggle against catching them wherever they are found and thus destroying them." (Kim Il-song Selected Works, Vol 2, p 429)

In the presidential order, the great leader concretely clarified the basic requirements and tasks arising in the protection and propagation of marine resources and, at the same time, presented the task of positively protecting, above all, those in our country's coastal waters. For the positive protection and propagation of coastal marine resources, it is important to adhere strictly to the established period of protection, size of fish, fishing equipment and methods, and protected areas in the coastal fishing grounds and thoroughly protect non-migratory fishes and young fish.

The coastal marine resources are limited in size by natural conditions. Consequently, if they are exploited without artificial control or thorough protection, it would affect natural propagation, making it impossible to increase them.

Thus, the organizations, enterprises and cooperatives in the fisheries sector must give thorough protection to non-migratory fishes and fry; in the coastal fishing grounds in particular, they must prevent the indiscriminate exploitation of fish and other marine animals and plants during the spawning season.

Along with this, they must prevent trawl, dragnet and trap fishing in the protected areas which the state has established except in the winter pollack and "torumegi" season and must see to it that non-migratory species like flatfish, crabs and sea slugs are caught by only the approved fishing methods of gill netting, hooking and dive fishing.

In addition, they must accurately determine the size of the net openings in accordance with the special nature of the fish species so that when fry enter, they can be released.

Also, they must have fishing of marine resources such as large and small clams, sea slugs which are found along the eastern and western coasts, conducted by state-approved units and held to the authorized limit.

An important matter relative to the protection of coastal marine resources is, next, to establish favorable living conditions for marine animals and plants and to actively increase them.

Marine resources, unlike other natural resources, have different habitats in different seasons, Accordingly, for those resources which come in to spawn according to the season and those which remain in definite areas, necessary living conditions must be provided according to the living habits of the fish and their particular biological nature.

Local organs of power and appropriate organizations of each level must be well aware that the establishment of living conditions is one of the important requirements for protecting and propagating marine resources and must perform work to provide such conditions by long-range planning.

It is important here that work be performed in a planned manner to allocate fishing areas properly and provide favorable conditions for marine resources.

The competent organs must reassign coastal fishing areas to enterprises and the organizations and enterprises which receive assignments must vigorously carry out the struggle to furnish favorable living conditions for marine resources, such as the cleaning of rocks, stone-emplacement and seeding of clam shells.

Along with this, they must establish measures for positively protecting and propagating clam resources.

On the west coast, which has plentiful clam resources, areas designated as clam seeding areas must be established in each district and clamming must be prevented within such areas.

One of the important requirements for securing living conditions for fish and protecting and propagating them is not cutting the marine vegetation which are necessary to protect spawning and fry.

As the great leader has taught, just as there are no deer or pheasants on a mountain without a single tree, if marine vegetation is cut, the fish would have no place to stay or hide or lay their eggs.

The functionaries and workers in the appropriate sectors must see to it that when marine vegetation necessary for the livelihood of the people and the people's economy like seaweed, tangle and sea lichens are cut, sufficient seedlings are left and that the plants needed to protect spawning and fry are not cut.

To protect coastal marine resources, it is important to heighten the sense of responsibility on the part of the appropriate specialized organs and organizations and enterprises of the marine sector.

The functionaries in this sector must conduct joint operations every year to investigate marine resources regarding those to be protected and must adopt substantial measures to positively protect and propagate such resources.

[Text] In Presidential Order No 7, "On Positive Protection and Propagation of Marine Resources," the great leader, Comrade Kim Il-song, presented the task concerning positive protection of fresh water fish along with coastal marine resources.

Our country has abundant fresh water fishery resources and possesses favorable conditions for increasing and protecting them.

An important matter in reference to the positive protection of fresh water fishery resources is strict adherence to the designated protection period, fish size and areas and seeing to it that nothing harmful is done to the protection and habitation of marine resources. Our party and the government of the republic have designated protection periods in the country to create more plentiful marine resources and to have them more effectively utilized for the development of the people's economy and the improvement of the people's livelihood and have established protection districts for various purposes in places deemed necessary.

All state organs, enterprises and all workers must be thoroughly familiar with the purposes of establishing protection periods and districts and must not fish within such districts and periods.

Along with this, they must see to it that there are not instances of reducing fresh water fish in streams, lakes and reservoirs by using explosives, insecticides, poisons, electricity or draining.

Units in charge of reservoirs and water pumps must install metal screens or make and set up necessary facilities so that the young fish cannot get into areas being pumped out.

An important matter in the protection of fresh water fishery resources is the positive protection and propagation of fish which migrate from fresh to salt water.

The reality of today--that the five guidelines for remaking nature which the great leader presented are being upheld and reservoir construction and river and stream reclamation work is being vigorously pursued everywhere in the country--requires that proper countermeasures be established to obtain facilities necessary for fish protection and propagation.

Local executive organs at all levels and the rural economic sector must be profoundly cognizant that the work of protecting and propagating marine resources is also a rewarding work which looks far into the future and must give appropriate attention to this matter.

When erecting structures to block rivers and streams it is necessary that channels be made for fish which migrate between river and ocean. In addition, those units in charge of fish hatching areas in rivers and streams must make places for the fish to lay their eggs and provide thorough protection so that the mother fish coming upstream to spawn are not caught.

In the protection and propagation of fresh water fish, it is likewise important that artificial breeding be intensified to control the natural growth process of fresh water fish.

At the advent of spring in our country, many young eels, mullet and dace and fair sized young prawns come swarming to the shore.

Consequently, in the appropriate sectors including units in charge of breeding areas, work must be vigorously performed as a mass movement to catch the young fish swarming in and place them in nearby lakes and reservoirs to grow. Along with this, personnel in these sectors must be well versed in the kinds of fish and their living habits and have many more roe hatched and placed in rivers, reservoirs and lakes in accordance with scientific and technical requirements.

In addition, they must designate our country's indigenous fish resources as objects under special protection and thoroughly protect them.

An important matter in protecting and propagating marine resources is the prevention of pollution in rivers, streams and the ocean.

Due to the great leader's sagacious leadership and our party's correct land management policy, our country has no air pollution, which is sweeping through the capitalist world today; the water in the rivers, streams, ocean and lakes is clean and clear; fish food is plentiful, and there are favorable conditions for protecting and propagating marine animal and plant resources.

All factories, enterprises and cooperatives must be deeply aware that the prevention of pollution in the ocean, rivers and streams is one of the important measures for insuring the necessary living conditions for protecting and propagating marine animal and plant resources and must set up comprehensive countermeasures to prevent pollutants from flowing into the rivers and the ocean.

Iron and coal mines must prevent slag from flowing into rivers and must have debris from ore dressing filtered out so only clear water is sent through.

Factories in the metallurgical, chemical and industrial sectors must have purification facilities and release only clean water.

Cooperative farms must set up necessary countermeasures to prevent fish damage due to agricultural sprays such as herbicides and insecticides.

In the presidential order, the great leader taught that mass indoctrination work must be vigorously performed and system and order established in order to intensify the work of protecting and propagating marine resources.

The respected and beloved leader, Comrade Kim Il-song, taught:

"If we but only inform our people of such things as which species of fish are non-migratory and which are migratory, when each species lays its eggs, when certain species should not be caught, what serious consequences ensue when fish are not protected and propagated but caught any time, then they will refrain from catching fish indiscriminately and destroying the roe."

The work of protecting and propagating fish is for the sake of the popular masses and, consequently, the broad masses must consciously take part in this work if it is to be successful.

Using various forms and methods such as lectures, explanations, discussions, etc., all levels of local executive organs and other organizations involved must conduct widespread explanation and dissemination of the instructions of the great leader on protecting and propagating marine resources and the laws of the state embodying them and have the working people clearly see the importance and significance of protecting marine resources and positively engage themselves in this work.

[Text] Marking a new upsurge on the transportation front is one of the most important revolutionary tasks assigned to socialist construction this year. By registering an epochal turning-point in the transportation of raw materials, fuel and other resources by the field of railroad transportation--the nation's artery and vanguard of the people's economy--we can operate the existing factories at full capacity, build more factories, and smoothly guarantee the comprehensive development of the people's economy.

The degree of upsurge marked on the transportation front greatly influences success or failure in performing preparatory work to occupy the heights of a new prospective plan while consolidating the brilliant victories and achievements already attained during the execution of the six-year plan in every sector of the people's economy.

In order to alleviate the strain in transportation this year and smoothly meet the daily increasing demand for transportation in all sectors of the people's economy, we should construct and operate on a large scale concentrated freight stations under a concentrated transportation system, the superiority of which has already been established.

The respected and beloved leader Comrade Kim II-song taught us: "We should wage an active struggle to properly operate railroad freight stations including concentrated freight stations and to mechanize loading and unloading processes."

The great leader's instruction on the operation of concentrated freight stations on a large scale constitutes a programmatic guideline which we should faithfully follow in alleviating the strain in the railroad transportation and more quickly and revolutionarily meeting the rapidly increasing demand for transportation. With the continuous progress of grand socialist construction and the construction of new and modern factories and enterprises everywhere, the production linkage between units, sectors and local areas of the people's economy has become more complicated, and the cargo has increased in quantity. Such being the case, it is suggested that the railroad should concentrate on transporting a large quantity of cargo to the concentrated freight station, from which trucks are properly used for short-distance transportation. This method will not only guarantee mobility in transporting a huge quantity of cargo but will also meet the demand for transportation of cargo to the consumer.

Operating concentrated freight stations on a large scale as instructed by the great leader will not only help smoothly alleviate the present strain on transportation through the effective use of existing transportation means but also will constitute a creative and scientific method of enhancing transportation capability.

The superiority of the method of operating concentrated freight stations has already been established through the application of this method. At the Panju freight station, which [?is] triple the size of the existing coal-loading site in Congjin and to which a large quantity of coal is brought every day, loading time has been reduced to one-fourth, while the work is performed in an easy way with the same amount of effort as that of the past, thus immediately clearing freight cars.

The Myongan and Changpyong concentrated freight stations which, having established cement and fertilizer warehouses, recently started operation, have made available many reserve freight cars by unloading arriving cargo more quickly than before, thus reducing freight car idle time in the station by half.

By vigorously expediting the work to establish concentrated freight stations on a large scale, all functionaries and workers of the transportation front, including the railroad transportation field, should carefully formulate measures to alleviate the strain in transportation and increase transportation capability.

The most important thing in operating concentrated freight stations and marking a new turning point on the transportation front is to firmly provide the material and technical foundation for this purpose. Under the conditions whereby the concentrated freight stations are specialized in handing a specific item of cargo in a large quantity, it is important to expedite the construction of cargo warehouse and tracks, increase the amount of cargo handled, and load and unload cargo on time so as to clear freight cars in time to receive the next cars.

While effectively utilizing existing loading and unloading equipment, it is also necessary to provide the concentrated freight stations with modern loading and unloading equipment such as mobile cranes, automatic loading equipment and railroad cranes. Widely introducing loading and unloading equipment will not only permanently relieve workers from toilsome labor but will play a very significant role in alleviating the strain in operations and increasing transportation capability. Leading functionaries of the rail transportation sector should specialize the loading and unloading equipment production bases, improve technical equipment at these bases, and fully demonstrate the superiority of the concentrated freight stations.

The truck transportation sector should thoroughly establish measures to quickly transport the cargo waiting for transportation at the concentrated freight stations. Leading functionaries and workers of the truck transportation sector should mark a new turning-point in truck transportation by widely adopting the method of collective management invented by the great leader and by more quickly transporting more cargo through the use of trailers.

In view of the fact that the concentrated freight stations will receive more cargo than before, the railroad bureaus at the same time should quickly take measures to transport on time collectively transported cargo by establishing a good relationship with the concentrated freight stations, by strengthening the guidance of transportation, and by properly organizing a schedule of train operations for the concentrated freight stations.

The work of organizing a concentrated transportation system and operating concentrated freight stations on a large scale cannot be performed through the effort of the transportation sector alone. Leading functionaries of factories and enterprises in various sectors of the people's economy should, with a lofty sense of responsibility, render material, technical and labor aid to the construction of the concentrated freight stations and warehouses.

At the same time, enterprises concerned including machinery plants should produce more loading and unloading equipment such as railroad cranes, belt conveyors and internal transportation vehicles so that they can supply this equipment to the concentrated freight stations. (word indistinct) transport systems including cableway transport systems should also be widely introduced.

In order to increase transportation capacity and to properly manage the concentrated freight stations, we must further enhance the responsibilities and role of the functionaries and workers of the railway transportation sector, the masters and the workers directly in charge of the transportation work. For proper management of the concentrated freight stations, all must carry out their assignments with a lofty awareness of their revolutionary duties, coping with all difficulties and obstacles.
