Background



- ◆ **EO 13423 identified that Env Mgt Systems will be implemented at all appropriate organizational levels.**
 - ◆ OFEE developed implementing instructions
 - Further guidance identified multi-site Organization EMS
 - ◆ The ANG had been implementing an organizational EMS since 2006
 - OFEE guidance allowed ANG to adjust appropriate facility status—78 appropriate facilities, now 1 EMS



ANG Installations



◆ ANG has 174 locations

- ◆ 85 flying units—82 located on civilian airports
- ◆ The rest of the locations are GSUs w/combat engineering or communication units
- ◆ Typically 1 environmental functional, but only at Wing level
 - Env Mgrs=Jack of all trades—master of some
 - Subject Matter Experts at ANGRC
 - Centrally manage programs—installations implement



How to implement multi-site EMS: ANGRC



- ◆ EMS procedural elements defined at ANGRC
- ◆ Centrally develop/manage operational controls at programmatic level
- ◆ Centrally define processes (activities that impact environment)
- ◆ Centrally identify aspects by program area
 - ◆ Prioritized for ANG as a whole
- ◆ Objectives established for ANG by program area





How to implement multi-site EMS: Installation



◆ Supplement & Implement

- ◆ Installations supplement procedural elements, operational controls, and aspect prioritization
- ◆ Objectives and targets support ANG and installation
- ◆ Programming/funding tied to significant aspects



Clicking on the Environmental Documents folder or on any "Related Documents" link on the different pages will take you to this library. At the ANG level, only VEMO PMs have access to manage the documents—anyone can view though. At the installation, it is similarly managed with installation VEMO managers having access. NOTE: ANG VEMO Program Managers will also have the ability to manage documents at your installation. The purpose will be for us to post documents and items that we centrally manage here but are related to your installation within that PM



In order to have a document show up on the correct programmatic page or site, you must associate these items within the document properties. This automatically happens when you upload single documents, but if you upload multiple documents this doesn't happen. At anytime, you can edit the document properties, by clicking the drop down associated with the document. You can only do this when you are in the document library; when you are at the program pages and you see the related documents on that page, you are not actually in the document library, it is more a link to the document.

Choose the correct related program, and add it to the shuttle box, determine whether it is an EMS document, and identify the document type. We have intentionally limited the document types to only a few, we have also provided examples. Hit OK and it will now show up on the appropriate page. If you choose multiple program areas or EMS elements it will show up on all those sites and grouped by the document type.
