

FOREWORD

This pamphlet contains a distribution of military prime contract awards of \$10,000 or more each by Service Category and Federal Supply Classification for fiscal years 1963, 1964 and 1965. Data by these classifications are not available prior to 1963.

The report consists of three sections:

- (1) Section A covers awards for experimental, developmental, test and research work (EDTR). EDTR codes were adapted from the 33 broad divisions contained in the Armed Services Technical Information Agency <u>Distribution Guide</u>. The Guide, which was used to catalog documents filed with that agency (now the Defense Documentation Center), is no longer available.
- (2) Section B covers Other Services and Construction. The 14 major divisions and 124 individual classes were developed specifically for prime contract reporting and are considered to be self explanatory.
- (3) Section C covers the Federal Supply Classification structure composed of 76 groups and 568 individual classes. This system was developed primarily for supply management of items known to be in the supply system of the Federal Government. Definitions of the classes appear in the Cataloging Handbook, Federal Supply Classification, Part 1, Groups and Classes, H2-1, which may be purchases from the Superintendent of Documents, U. S. Government Printing Office, Washington, D. C. 20402.

While there is comparability between the Federal Supply Classes used in this publication and the Standard Industrial Product Codes used by the Census Bureau of the Department of Commerce, the exact points of agreement and disagreement have not been ascertained. Moreover, it should be observed that in many of the Census reports, the SIC data are based on the principal product of an establishment, rather than on the individual products produced by that establishment. In addition to differences in code content, data from this pamphlet and certain Bureau of the Census reports do not coincide as to period covered or as to point in time when reported. The former are fiscal year figures measuring contract awards before delivery has taken place, while the latter are calendar year figures measuring shipments or production which may take place as much as several years after the contract award.

It is important to note several characteristics of the material presented in this pamphlet. First is the fact that data cover only prime contracts (those placed directly by the Department of Defense) and do not reflect the large amounts of subcontracts for basic and

intermediate materials and components. Thus, for example, most of the steel plate for ships is purchased by Defense prime contractors, and only a small portion is obtained by direct DOD purchase (see Code 9515). Similarly, a large dollar amount of electronics is purchased by Defense contractors who have received prime contracts for missiles or other weapons systems.

Second is the exclusion of contracts and purchases below \$10,000 each for which product and service information is not collected. In each of the fiscal years 1963, 1964 and 1965, these small transactions totalled more than \$3 billion. This exclusion tends to understate procurement of commercial type items and services more than military hard goods items which usually are bought in large dollar amounts. It is known, for example, that Subsistence (FS Group 89) is severely understated for this reason. However, information concerning the composition of the \$3 billion in small purchases is not sufficient to identify all the categories of commodities and services which are affected to an important degree.

A third characteristic is the fact that, for security reasons, various contracts have been reported without a Federal Supply Classification or with a classification other than the one describing the item purchased. Therefore, data for a number of the Federal Supply Classes shown are incomplete.

A fourth characteristic is that this report covers procurement from all sources; that is, from educational and non-profit institutions, other Federal Government agencies and foreign contractors, as well as from U. S. business concerns. In this respect figures differ from other commodity data published by this office which have been limited to contracts placed with U. S. business concerns. The amounts procured from the four major sources in transactions of more than \$10,000 each were as follows:

It will be noted from the above that overall procurement declined \$700 million between fiscal years 1963 and 1964, and \$900 million between fiscal years 1964 and 1965. In the case of EDTR contracts, the decreases were \$399 million in fiscal year 1964 and \$1,044 million in fiscal year 1965, most of which was concentrated in Guided Missiles (Service Class A12).

Other Services and Construction had increases of \$306 million in fiscal year 1964 and \$57 million in fiscal year 1965. In fiscal year 1964 the increase was brought about by Transportation Services (Service Group V8) and Construction (Service Group Y8) which were up by \$105 million and \$221 million, respectively. The most notable changes in fiscal year 1965 were an increase of \$52 million in Technical Representative Services (Service Group L5), and \$45 million in Architect, Engineer, Expert and/or Consultant Services (Service Group R6). The decrease in Housekeeping Services (Service Group S7) and the corresponding increase in Construction (Service Group Y8) was largely caused by the fact that painting, maintenance, repair and alteration of buildings was transferred from the category of Housekeeping Services to the category of Construction in fiscal year 1965.

The total for Supply and Equipment was down \$607 million in fiscal year 1964 and up \$9 million in fiscal year 1965, of which the principal changes by FS Group were as follows:
