The accompanying table presents the distribution by Army Grades of MA-1 part and total scores for 7 field stations, and the total of all stations combined. The results in terms of percentages agree very closely with the norms on MA-1, obtained from the original standardization population, and from a large sample of 2,000 cases tested at Ft. Belvoir in the spring of 1941. It will be noted that there are some differences between individual stations. An explanation of this is not offered at the present time. It is known, however, that uniform procedures have not been followed in selecting men for aptitude testing, so that in most cases it cannot be known how representative of the population available at an individual station the present distributions may be.
