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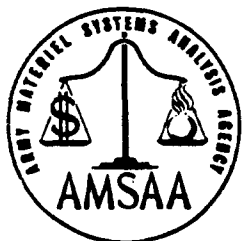

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ABSTRACT

Scaled models were developed which depict the size, composition and deployment of target types found in a Type North Vietnamese Army Infantry Regiment of a Type North Vietnamese Army Infantry Division in the 1970-1975 period. Composition of these target models is displayed in terms of:

- a. Unit strengths
- b. Weapons and equipment usually found with the unit
- c. Interval kept between personnel and the equipment on hand.

These idealized models include maneuver and fire support units as well as some combat service support installations. They are presented in various tactical dispositions.

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I. INTRODUCTION

The Army Materiel Systems Analysis Agency (AMSAA) and other weapon systems analysis groups require threat analyses of various enemy troop formations to allow evaluations and comparisons of weapon performance.

This report presents graphic models of selected North Vietnamese troop formations as they could appear in a future conflict. The principal unit depicted in this report is a North Vietnamese Army Regiment of a North Vietnamese Infantry Division. Representative units based on a postulated organization for combat are shown in formations typical of offensive and defensive situations. Divisional administrative and combat support troops are portrayed in situations representative of their mission. The models are stylized and generally present each target in an idealized circular, oval or linear configuration which ignores dynamic and limiting factors of terrain and opposing fire power.

The "building block" technique used to produce the models results in the creation of targets at squad, platoon, company and battalion levels. The models are intended to show the relationship between organic and supporting weapons and units and to indicate the size and composition of aggregated units which may comprise battlefield targets.

An additional consideration in the development of the models was to show the interrelationship of the various categories of units to each other while participating in the several battlefield activities. As an example, certain combat support units such as the 75mm recoilless rifle squads of the heavy weapons battalion are normally attached to infantry platoons. In the defense the recoilless rifles may be integrated into the rifle line but in the offense they may operate apart from the riflemen and support the advance from firing position areas to the rear or to the flank of the supported unit.

To show the interrelationship of units as realistically as possible, models for these were also developed using a "building block" technique. The 75mm recoilless rifle squad is again used as an example. First the squad is shown as it would appear occupying a firing position area alone (Figure A-23). Then the squad is shown as a member of its parent platoon (Figure A-25). In the defense the squad is shown as it would appear integrated into the supported unit's line (Figures A-48 and A-57). Finally, the squad is shown in relationship to the supported unit in an offensive situation (Figures A-45 and A-56).

Units are depicted in their most common role. Schematic drawings of typical deployments are attached (see Appendix B). The units depicted, based on a postulated organization for combat, are shaded on the schematics. However, the models contained in this report are not limited to those units which are shaded on the schematics.

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II. DEVELOPMENT OF MODELS

The bases of target model development were provided by a compilation of organizational data published by the U. S. Army Combat Developments Command (CDC) and concurred in by the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA). In addition, DIA and the Department of the Army intelligence publications pertaining to North Vietnamese Army organization were consulted in determining target sizes and shapes under battlefield conditions. The models were further developed from a postulated Organization for Combat of the hypothetical 66th Infantry Regiment and a listing of Support Troops of the 6th North Vietnamese Infantry Division. All unit designations are fictitious.

North Vietnamese Division organization can be classified into three general categories:

- a. Combat
- b. Combat Support
- c. Service Support.

Five broad categories of battlefield activities are depicted herein:

- a. The occupation and organization of assembly, headquarters, service and support areas (hereafter referred to as assembly areas)
- b. The conduct of dismounted and motor marches
- c. Offensive actions
- d. Defensive actions
- e. The occupation and organization of Firing Position Areas.

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III. USE OF MODELS

The target models developed and shown graphically in Part III of the Appendix are intended to be used as guides in fitting a particular set of target elements to a specific terrain. Accordingly, the models presented graphically in this report must be considered as idealized forms; they are not descriptive of any actual target until they have become part of target complexes such as those used for weapon systems analyses. The friendly weapons to be evaluated and the tactical environment to be considered determine the selection of models for the target complex. The tactical target configuration is determined by unit mission and the terrain.

The models attain their full utility when adapted to terrain on a large scale map or on enlarged portions of a tactical map.

Target arrays and organizational data used to develop the models in this report were, for the most part, derived from the U. S. Army Combat Developments Command (CDC) publication "A Type North Vietnamese Army Division and Brigade, 1970-1975" (U) dated July 1965 which was approved by the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA).

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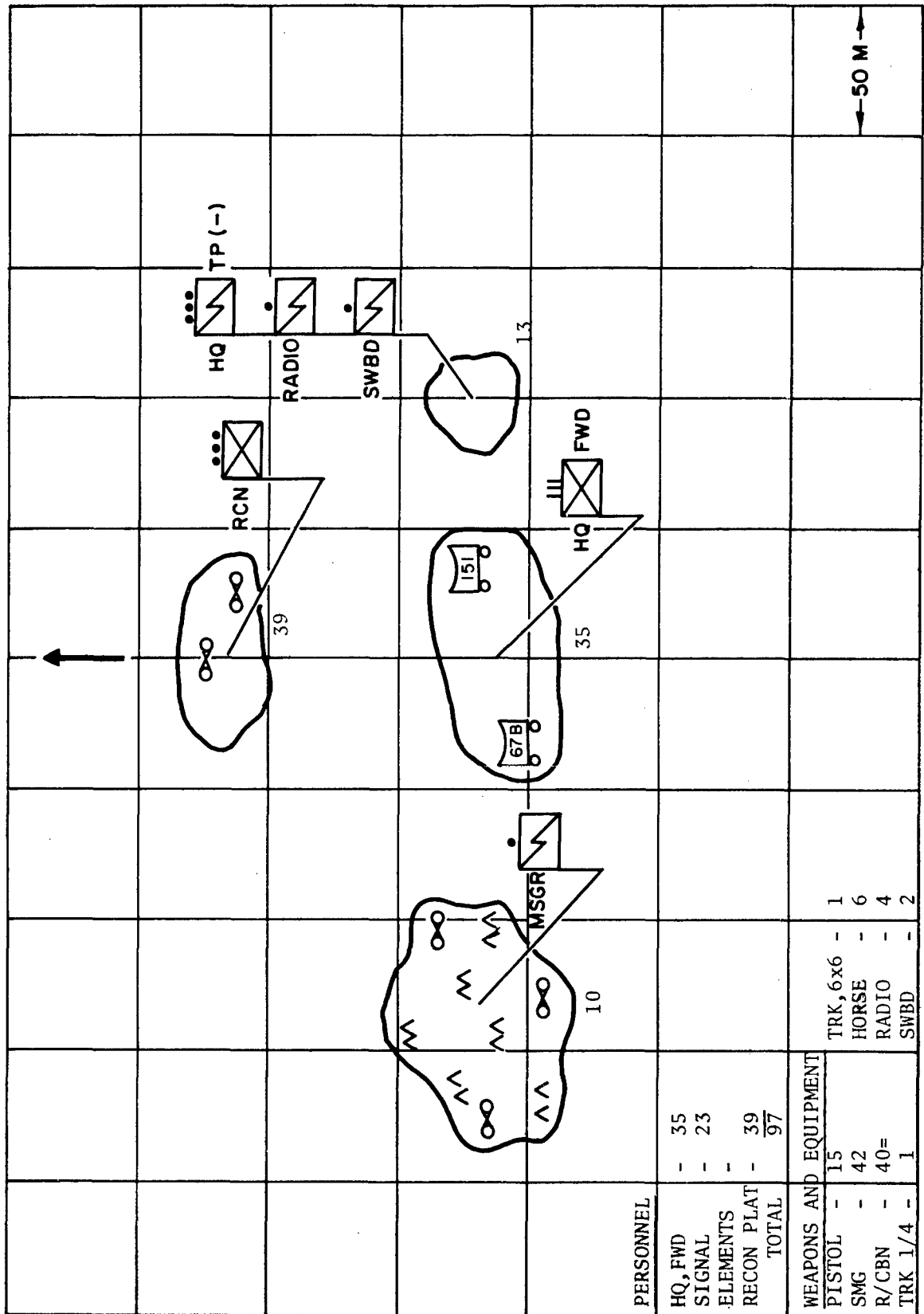


FIGURE A-1 (SECRET) HQ, FORWARD Infantry Regiment (U)

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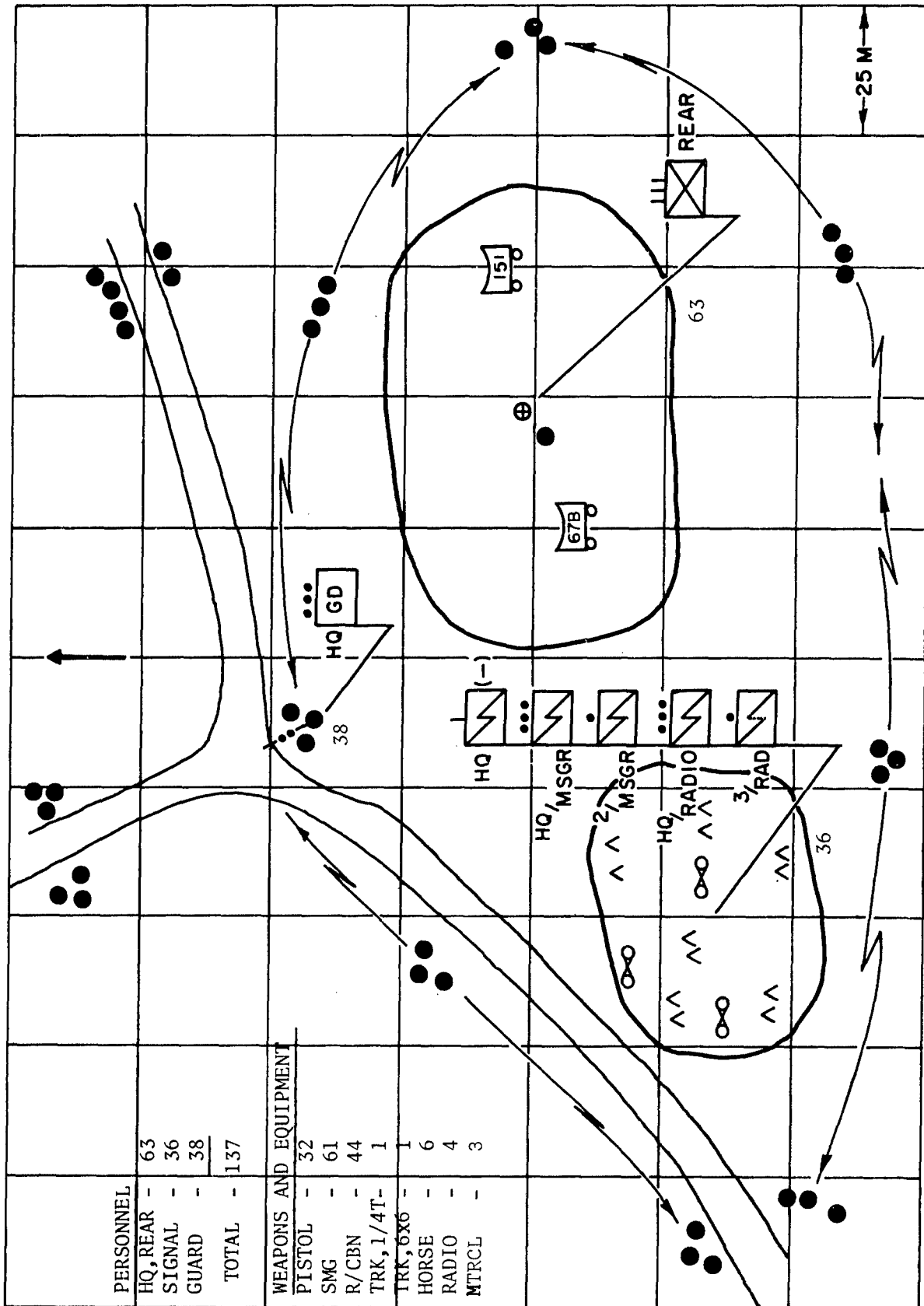


FIGURE A-2 (SECRET) HQ, REAR
Infantry Regiment (U)

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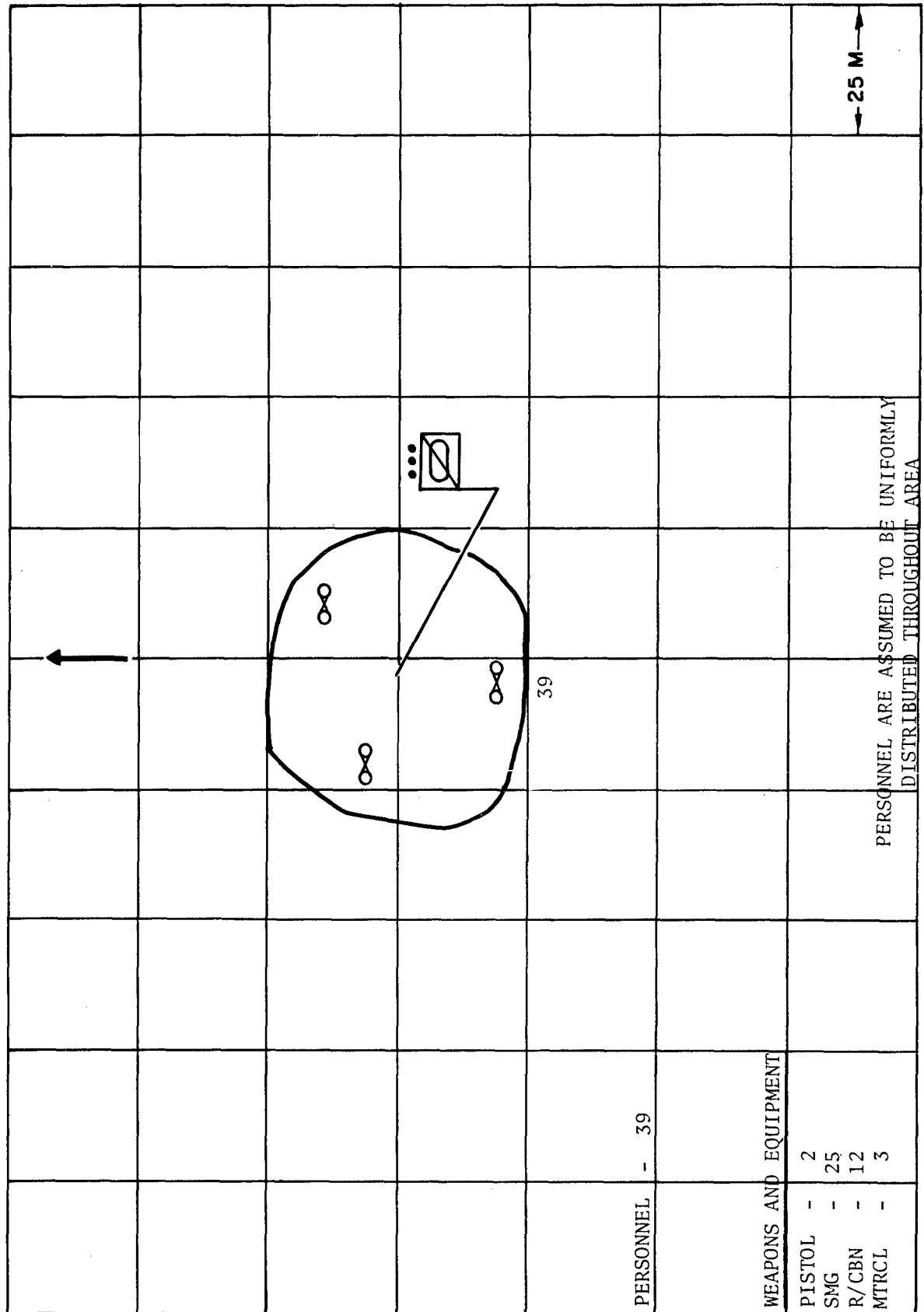


FIGURE A-3 (SECRET) RECONNAISSANCE PLATOON

(ASSEMBLY AREA) (U)

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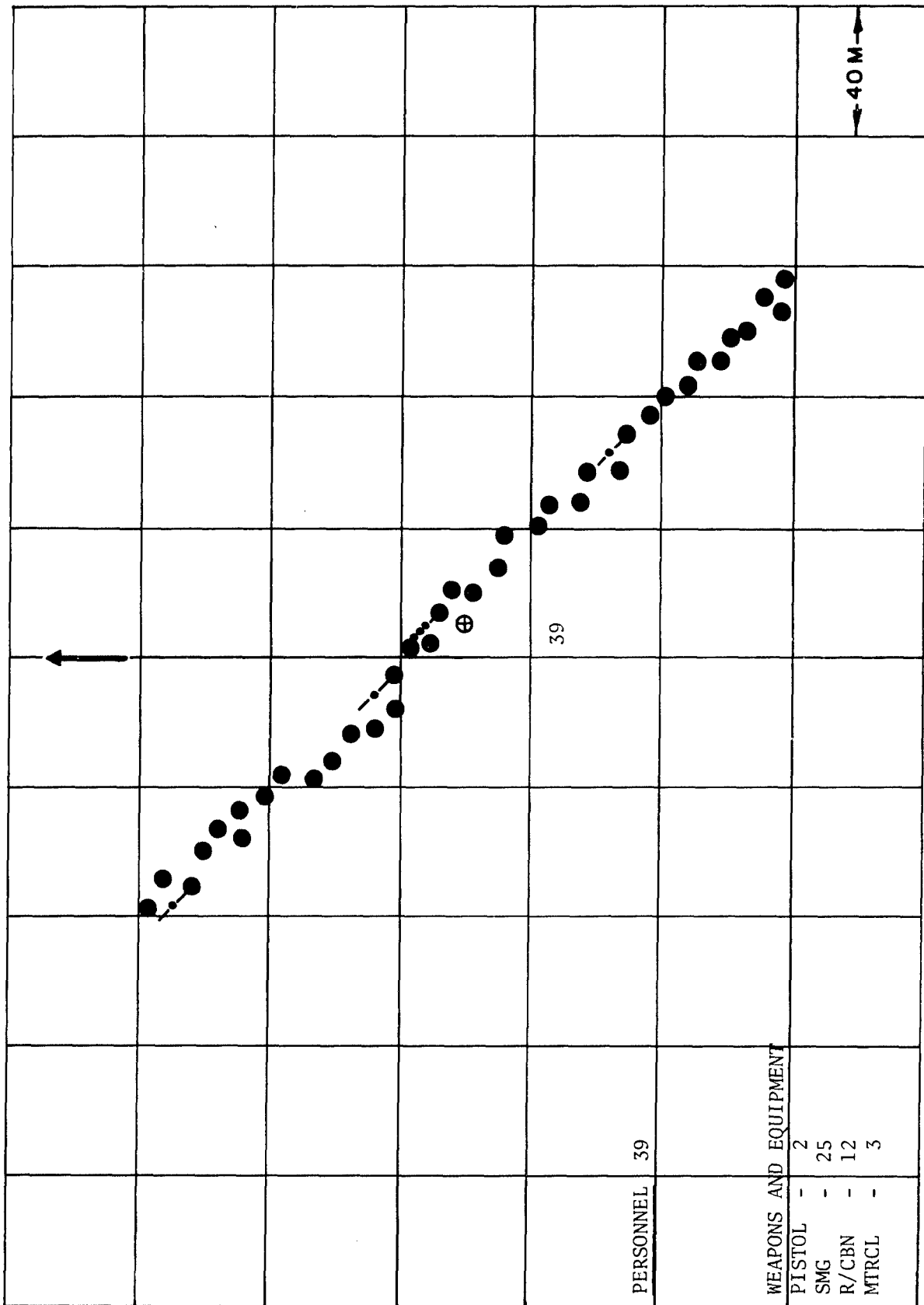


FIGURE A-4 (SECRET) RECONNAISSANCE PLATOON

(DISMOUNTED MARCH COLUMN) (U)

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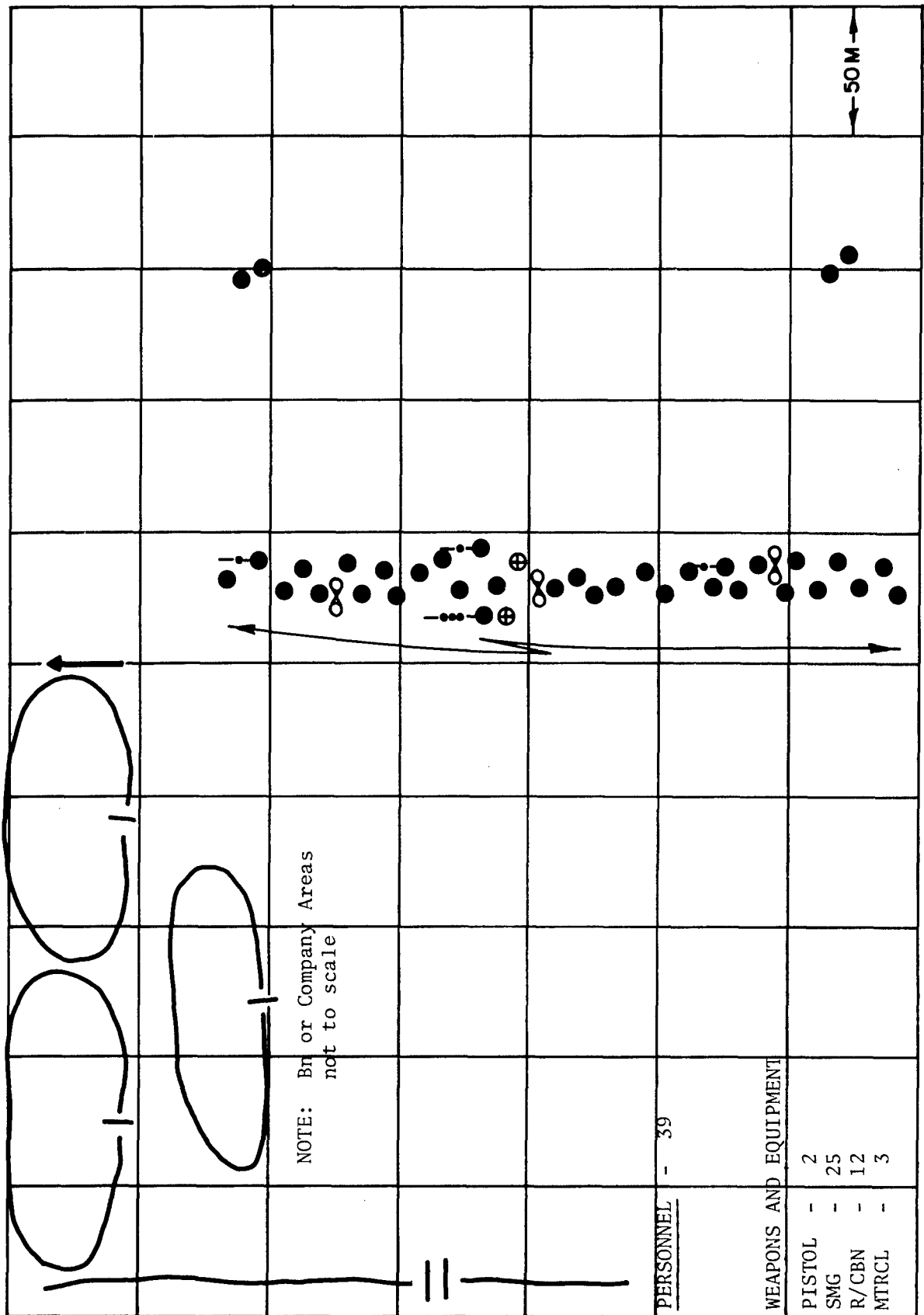


FIGURE A-5 (SECRET) RECONNAISSANCE PLATOON

(OFFENSIVE SITUATION) (U)

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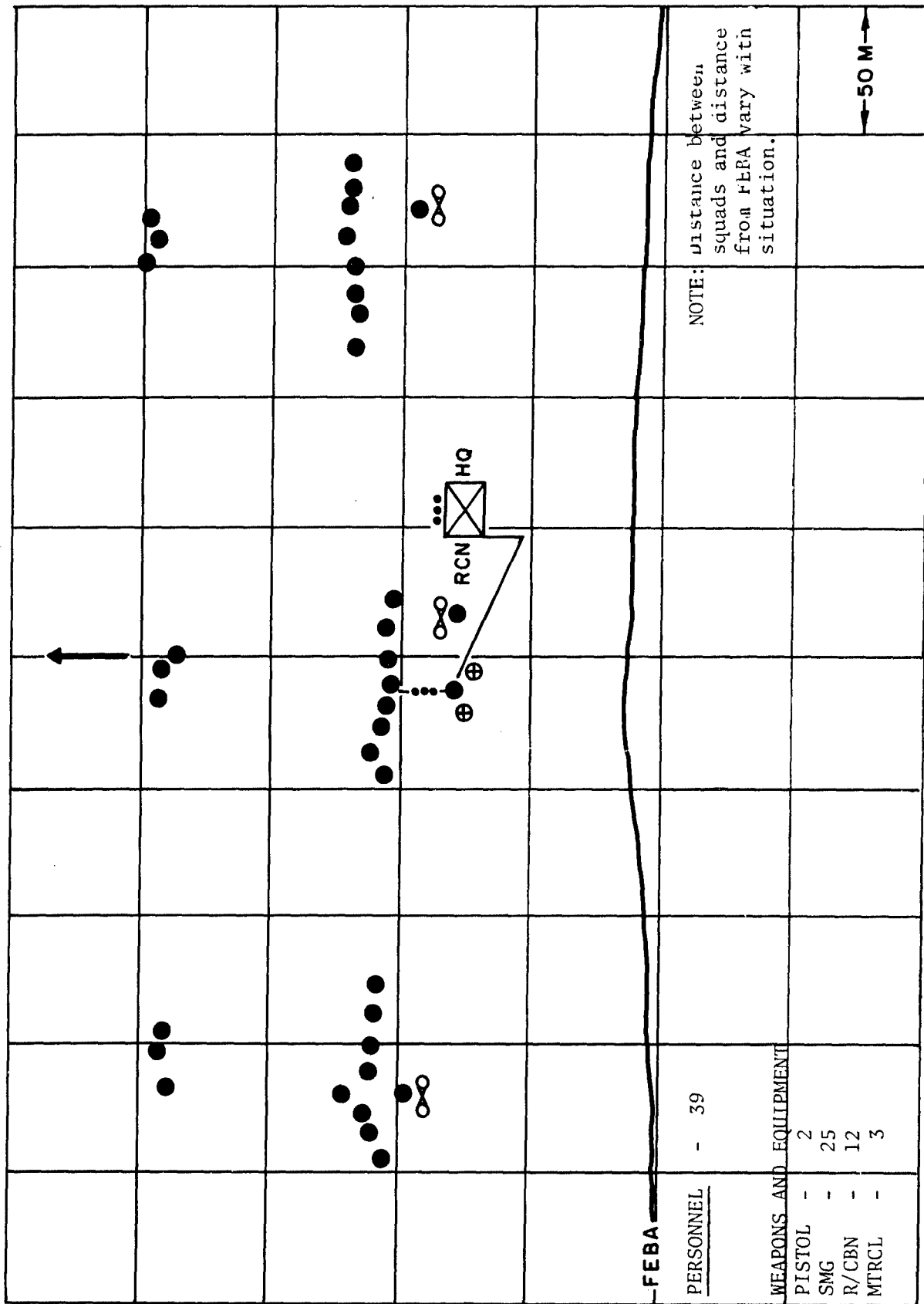


FIGURE A-6 (SECRET) RECONNAISSANCE PLATOON

(DEFENSIVE SITUATION) (U)

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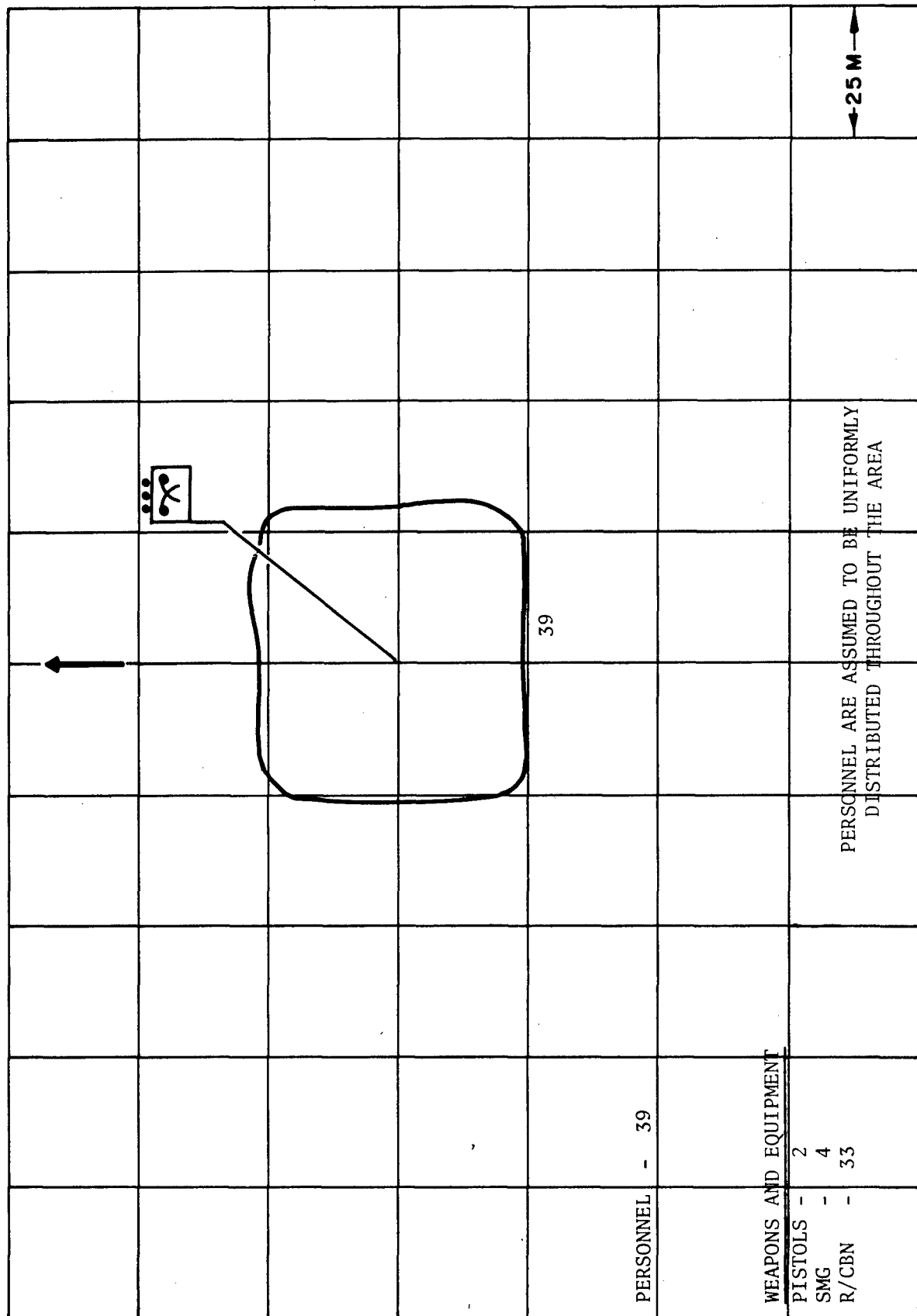


FIGURE A-7 (SECRET) **CHEMICAL PLATOON**

(IN ASSEMBLY AREA) (U)

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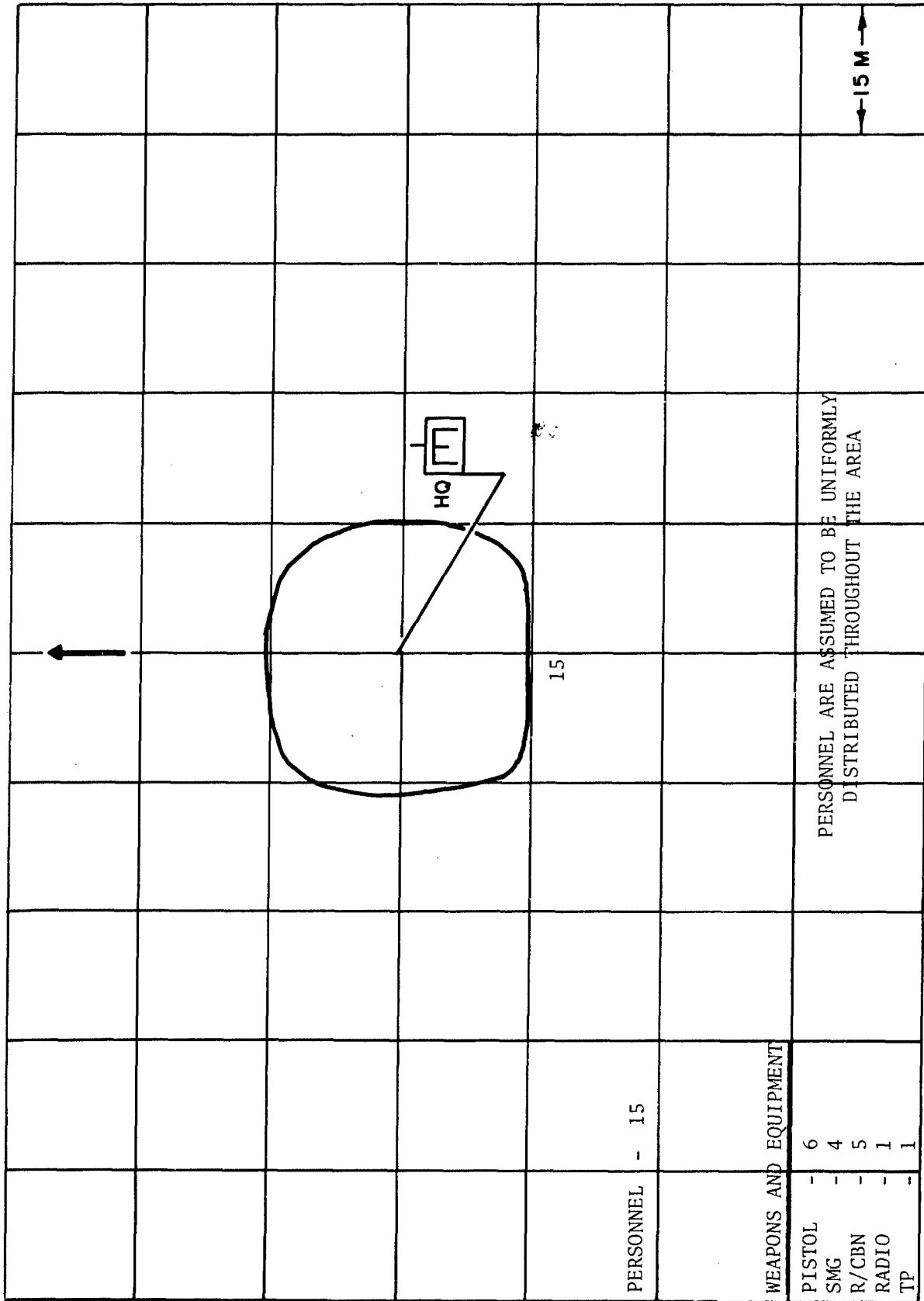
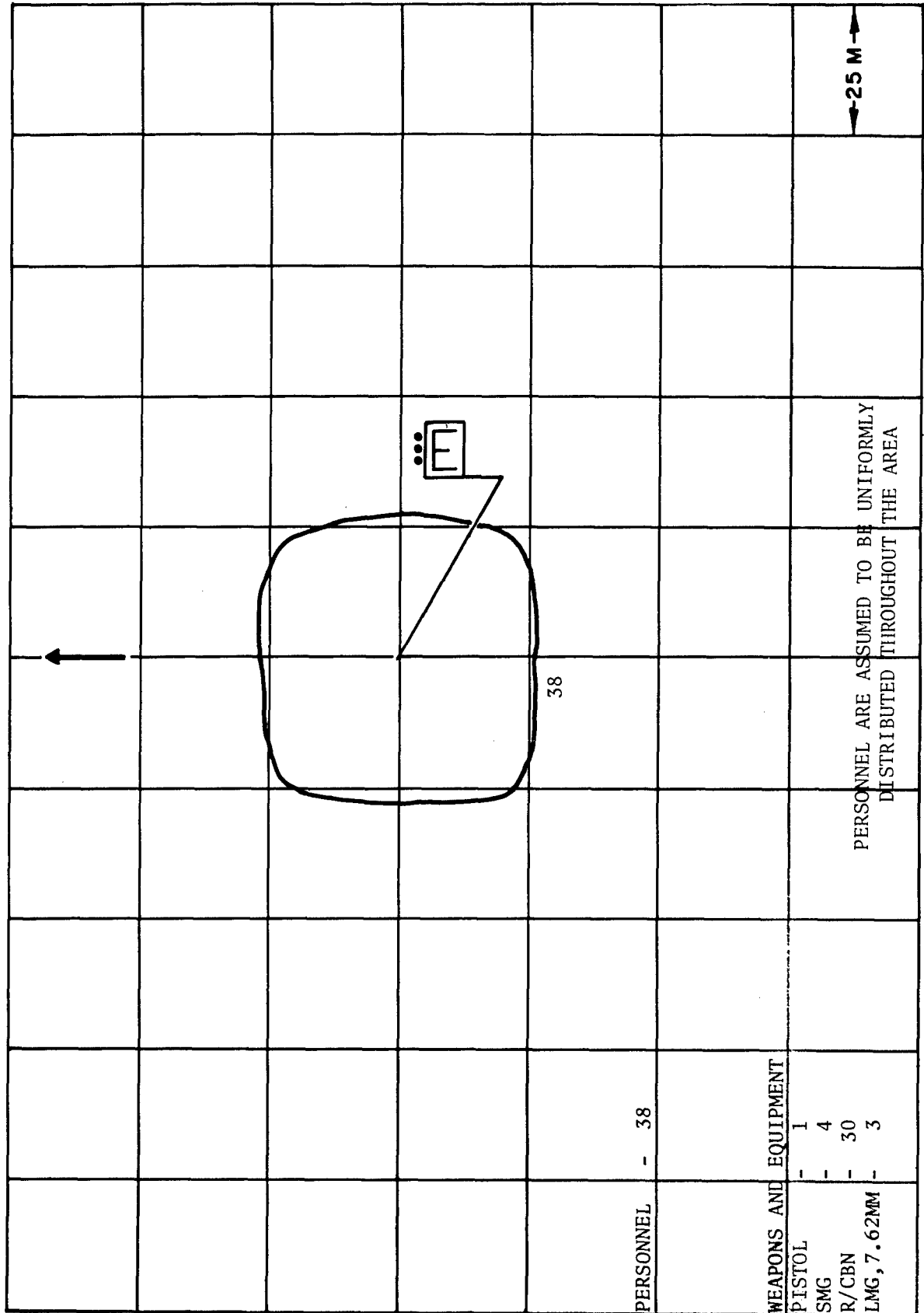


FIGURE A-8 (SECRET) HQ, ENGINEER COMPANY

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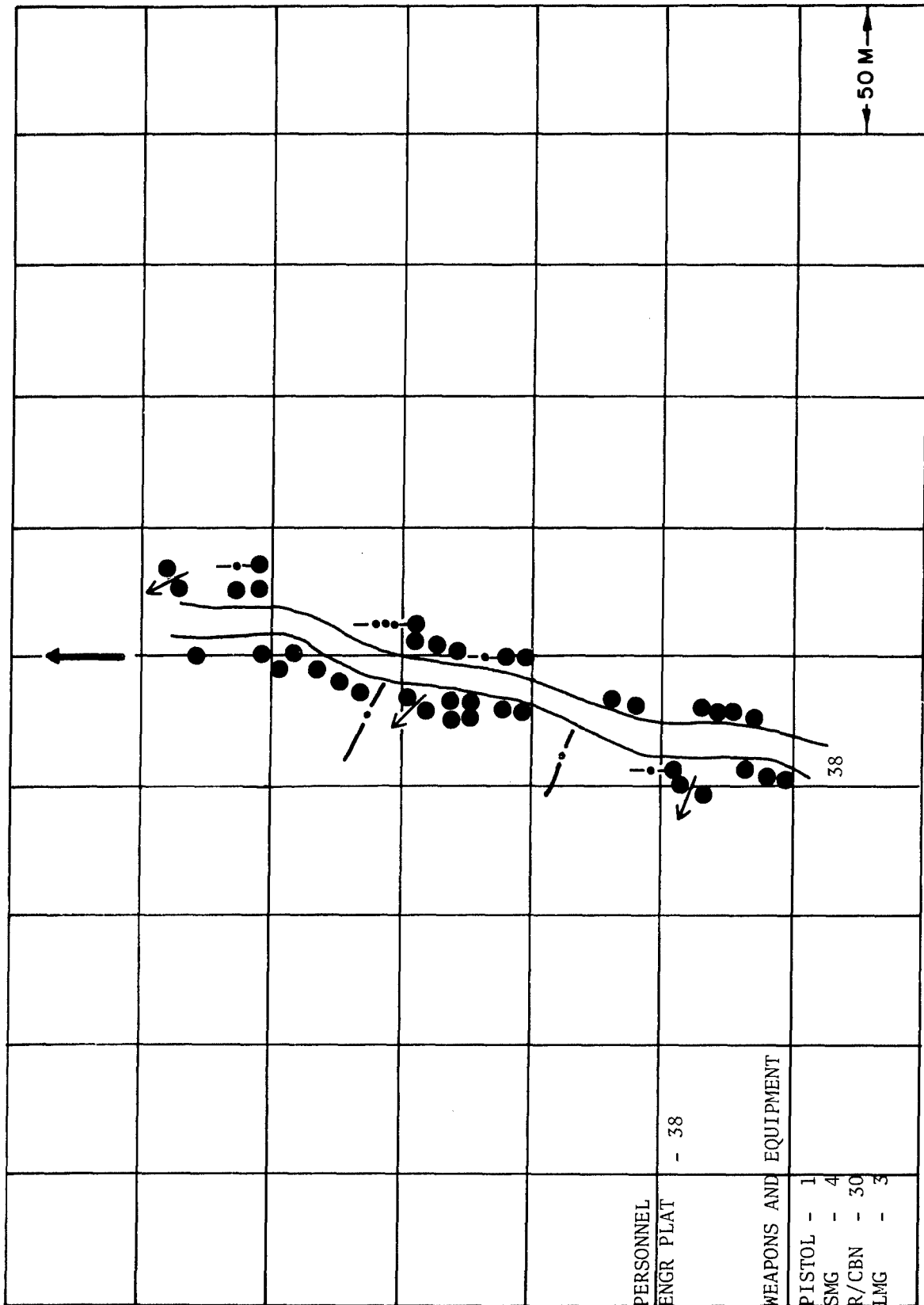

(OFFENSIVE SITUATION) (U)

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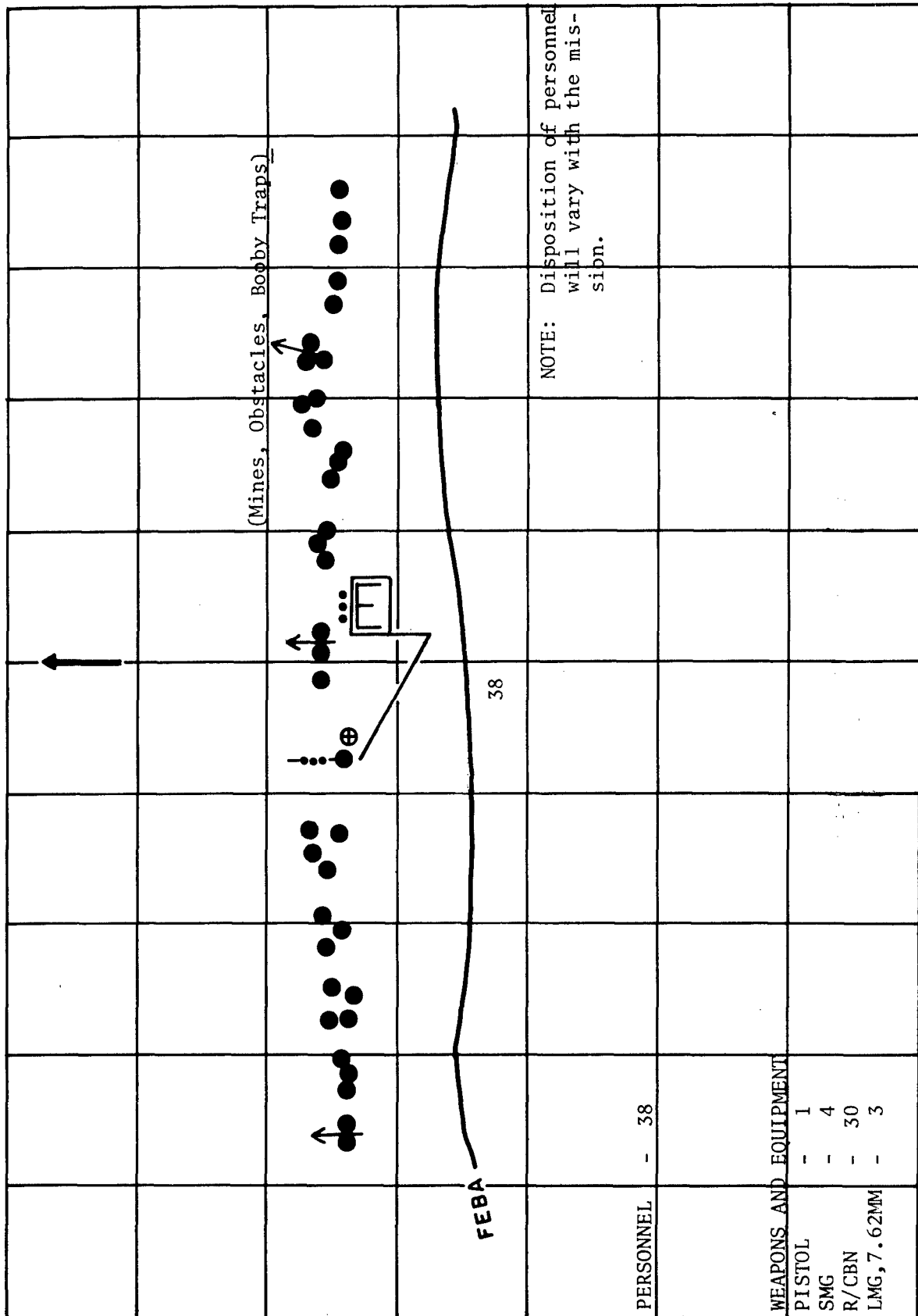


FIGURE A-11 (SECRET) ENGINEER PLATOON, ENGINEER COMPANY

(DEFENSIVE SITUATION) (U)

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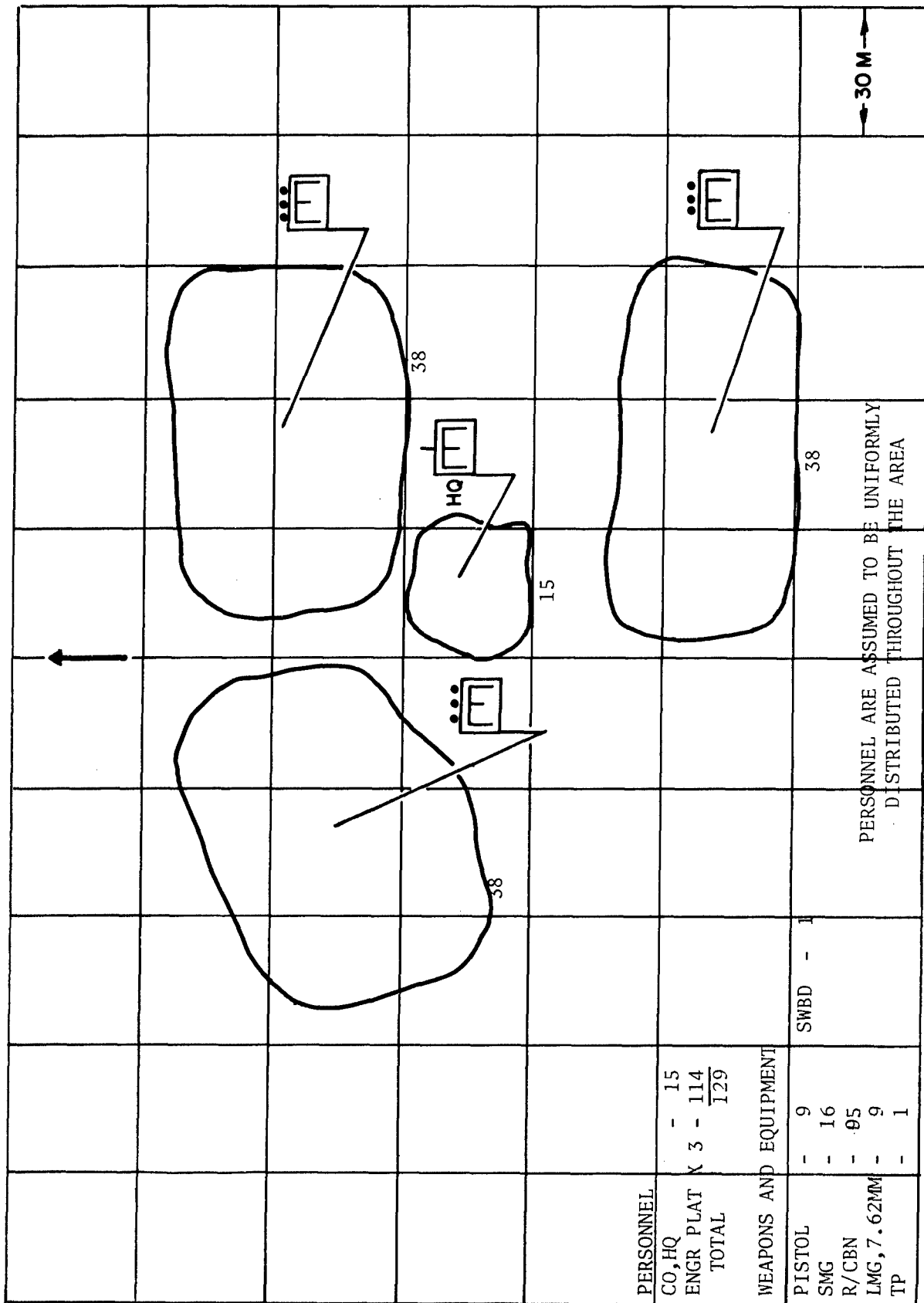


FIGURE A-12 (SECRET) ENGINEER COMPANY

(IN ASSEMBLY AREA) (U)

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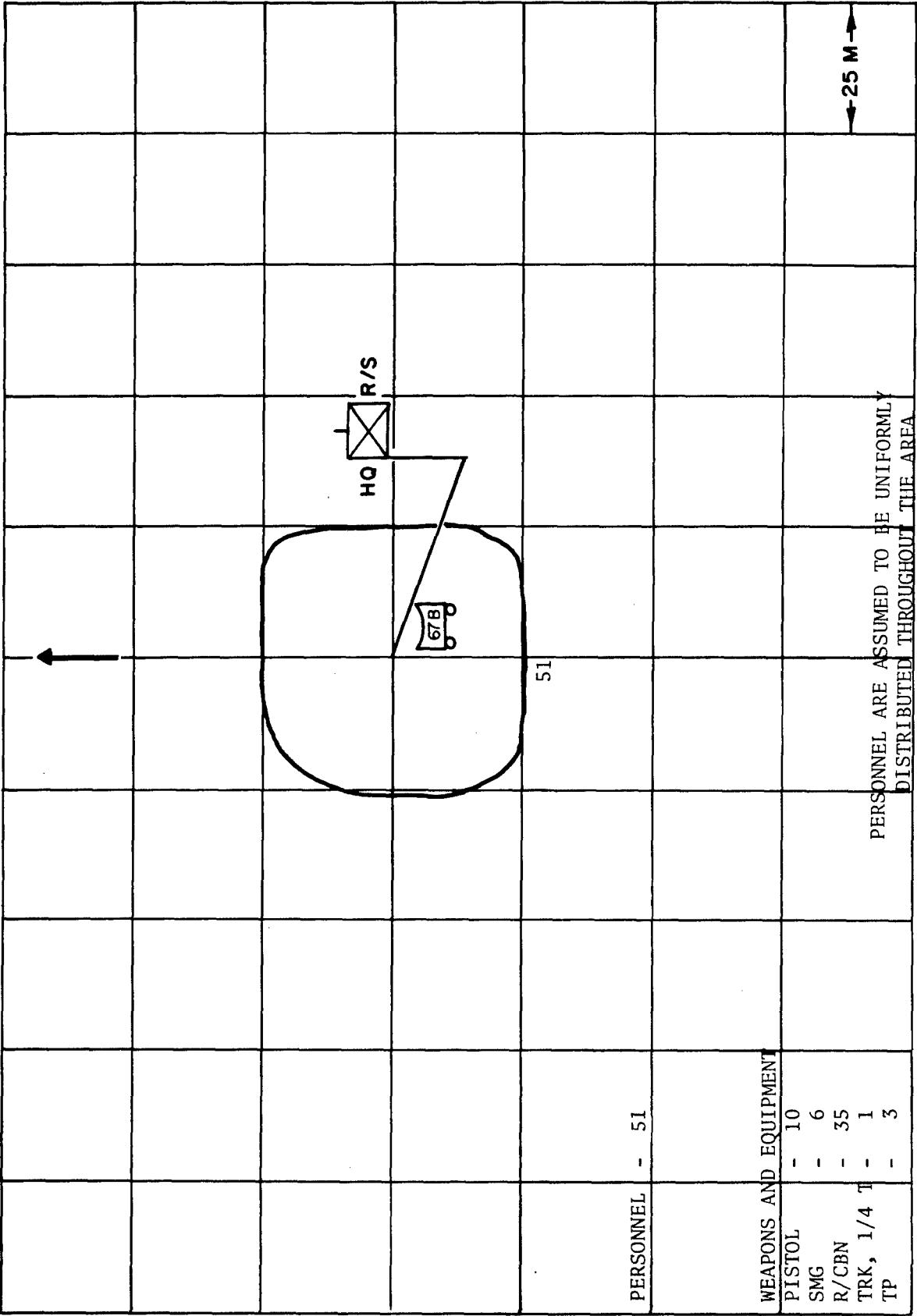


FIGURE A-13 (SECRET) HQ REAR SERVICE

(ASSEMBLY AREA) (U)

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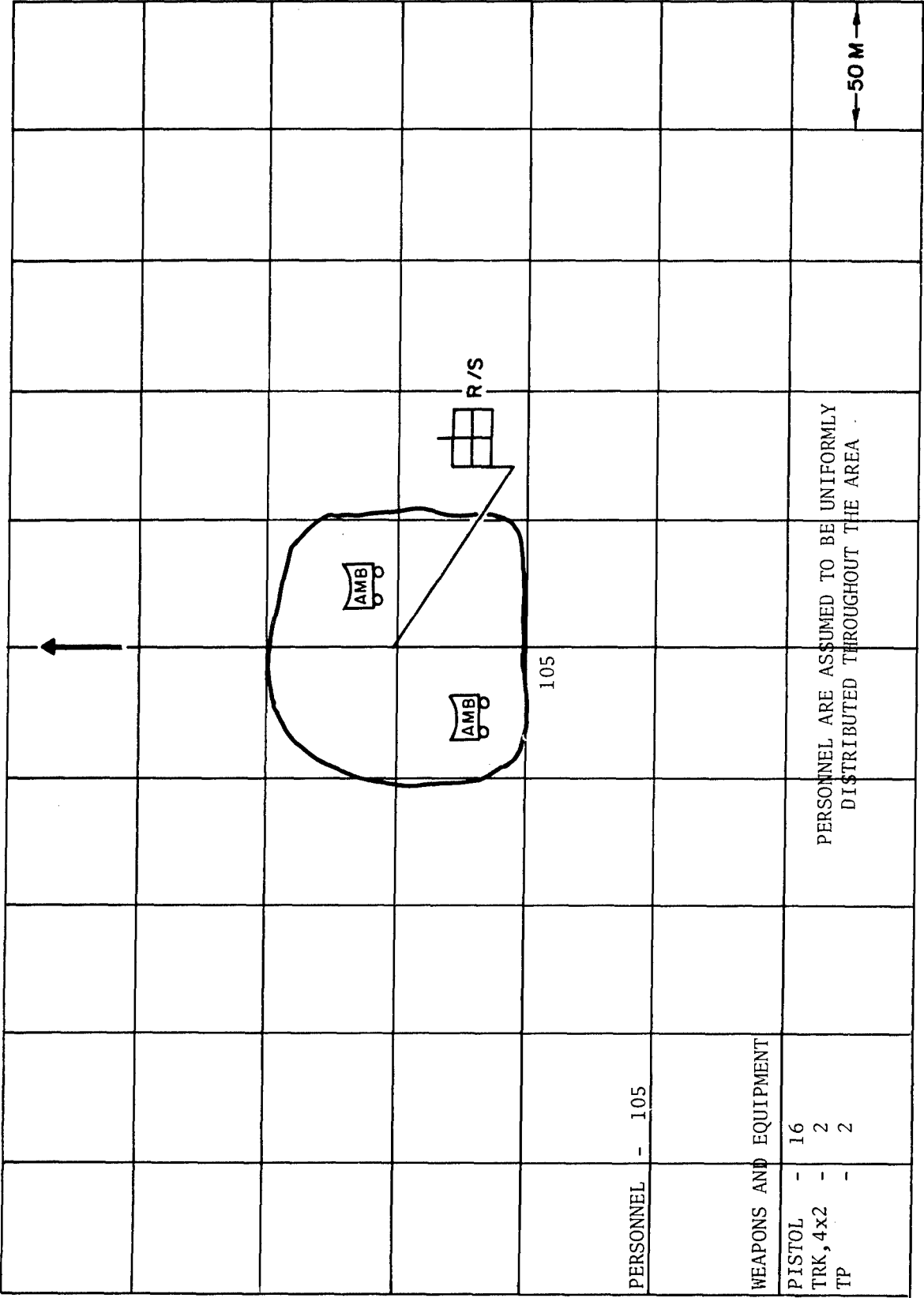


FIGURE A-14 (SECRET) MEDICAL CO, REAR SERVICE

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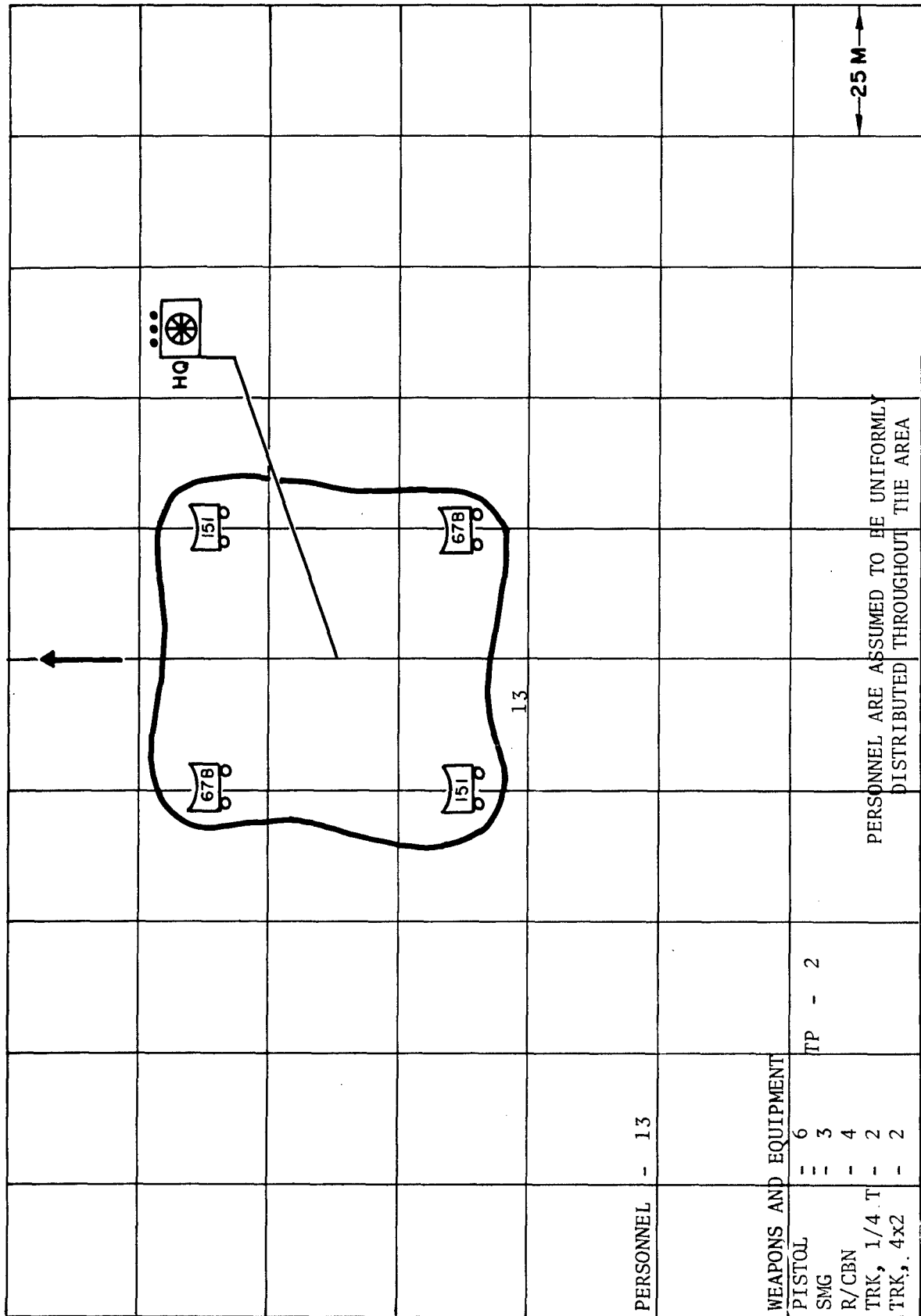


FIGURE A-15 (SECRET) HQ PLAT, TRANSPORTATION CO

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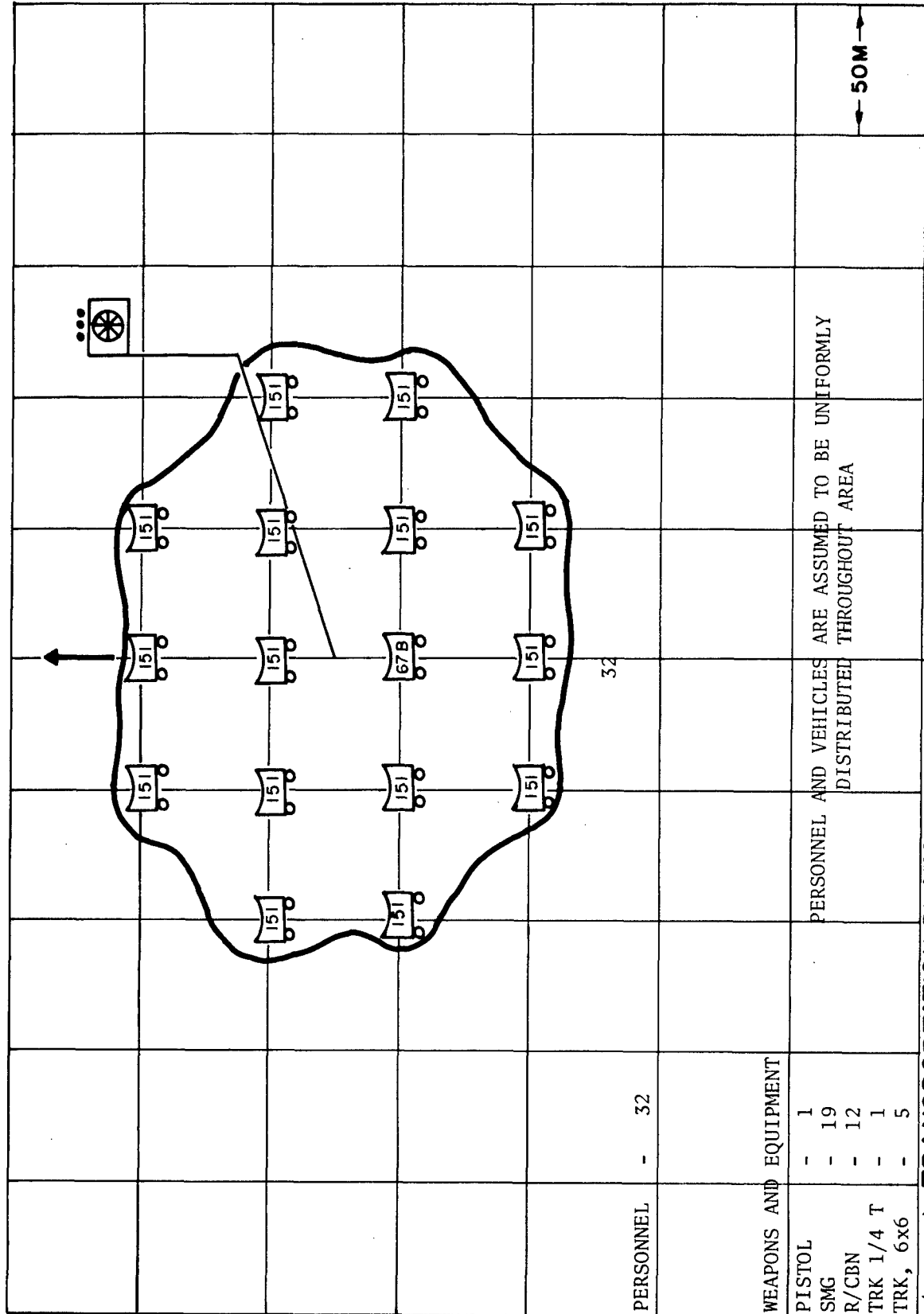
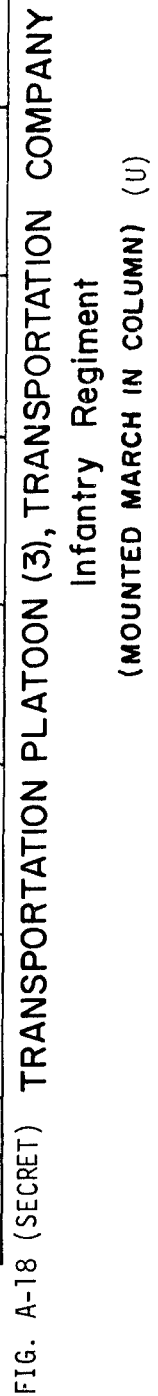


FIG. A-17 (SECRET) TRANSPORTATION PLATOON (3), TRANSPORTATION COMPANY

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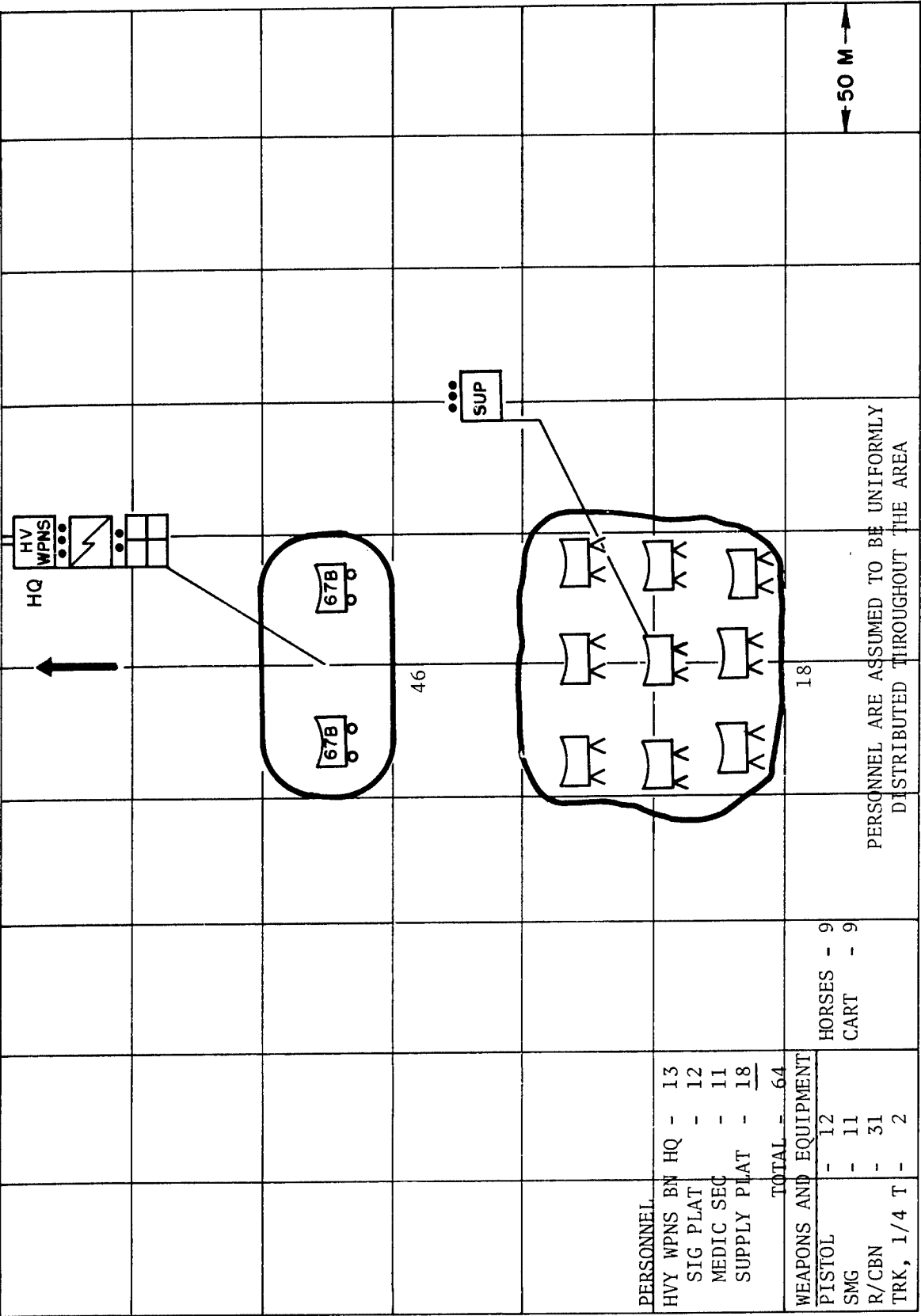


FIGURE A-20 (SECRET) HEADQUARTERS, HEAVY WEAPONS BATTALION

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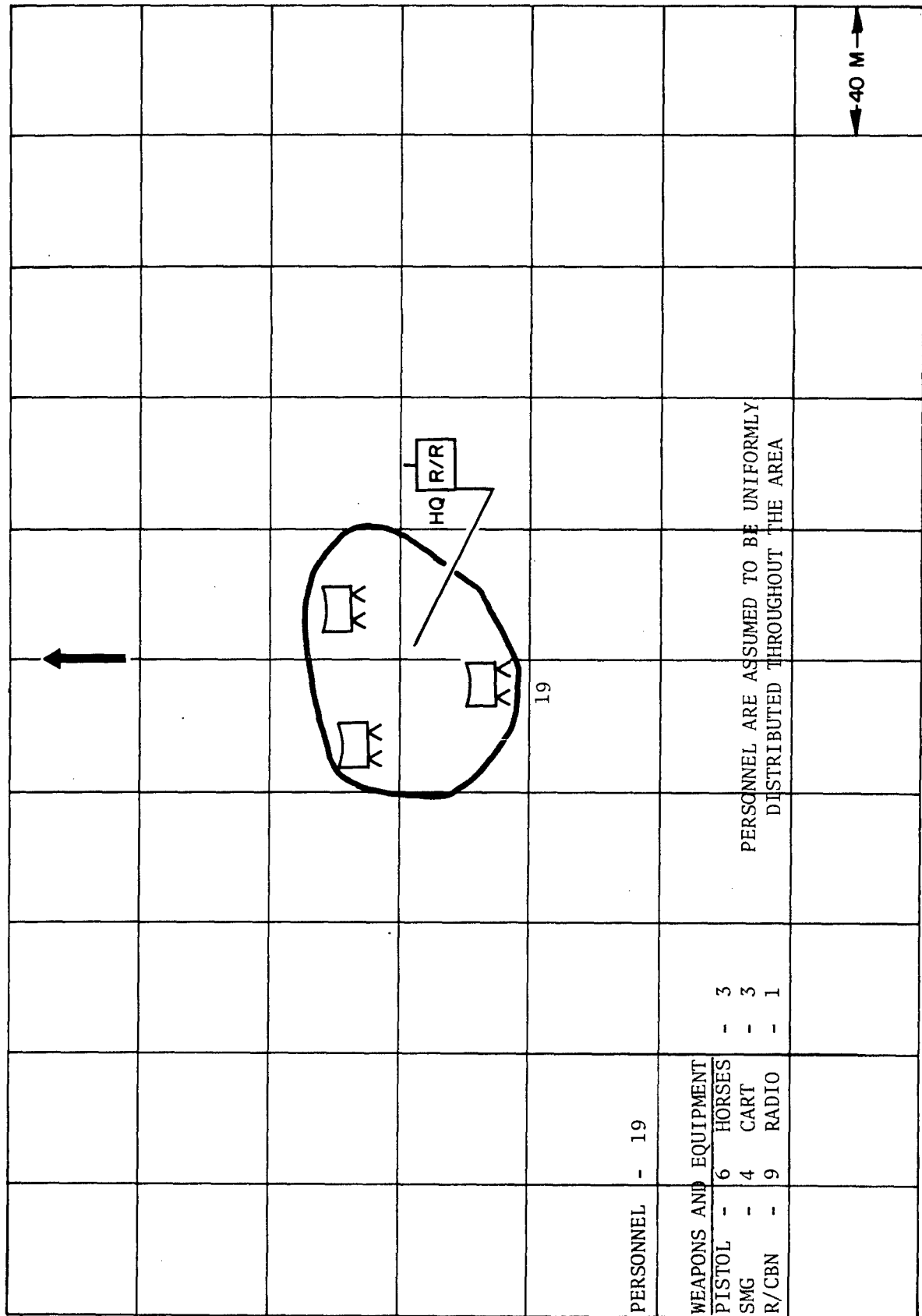


FIGURE A-21 (SECRET) HV WPNS BN, HQ PLATOON, R/R CO
ASSEMBLY AREA (U)

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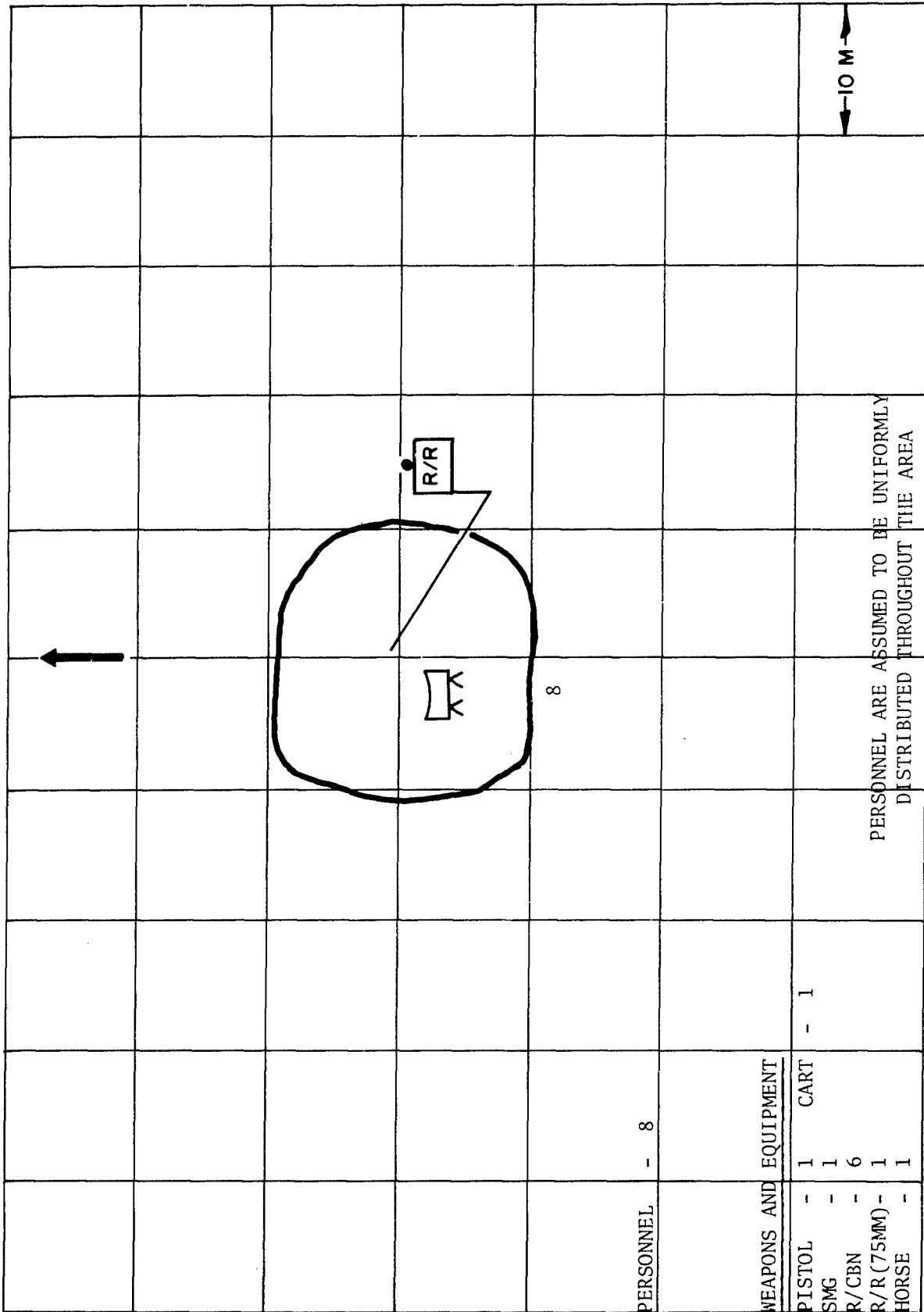


FIGURE A-22 (SECRET) RECOILLESS RIFLE SQUAD (75mm), R/R CO

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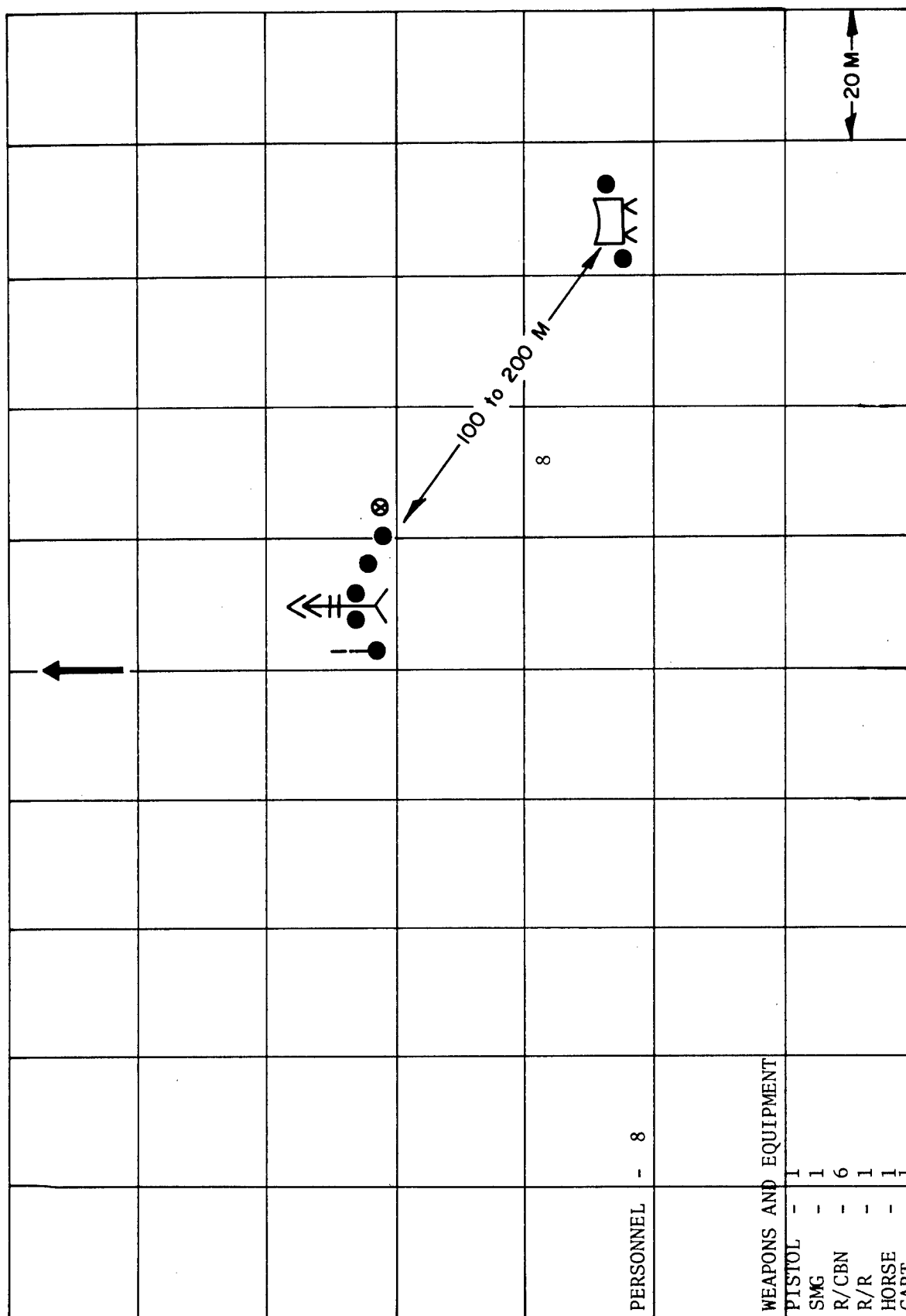


FIGURE A-23 (SECRET) RECOILLESS RIFLE SQUAD (75 mm), R/R CO

FIRING POSITION (U)

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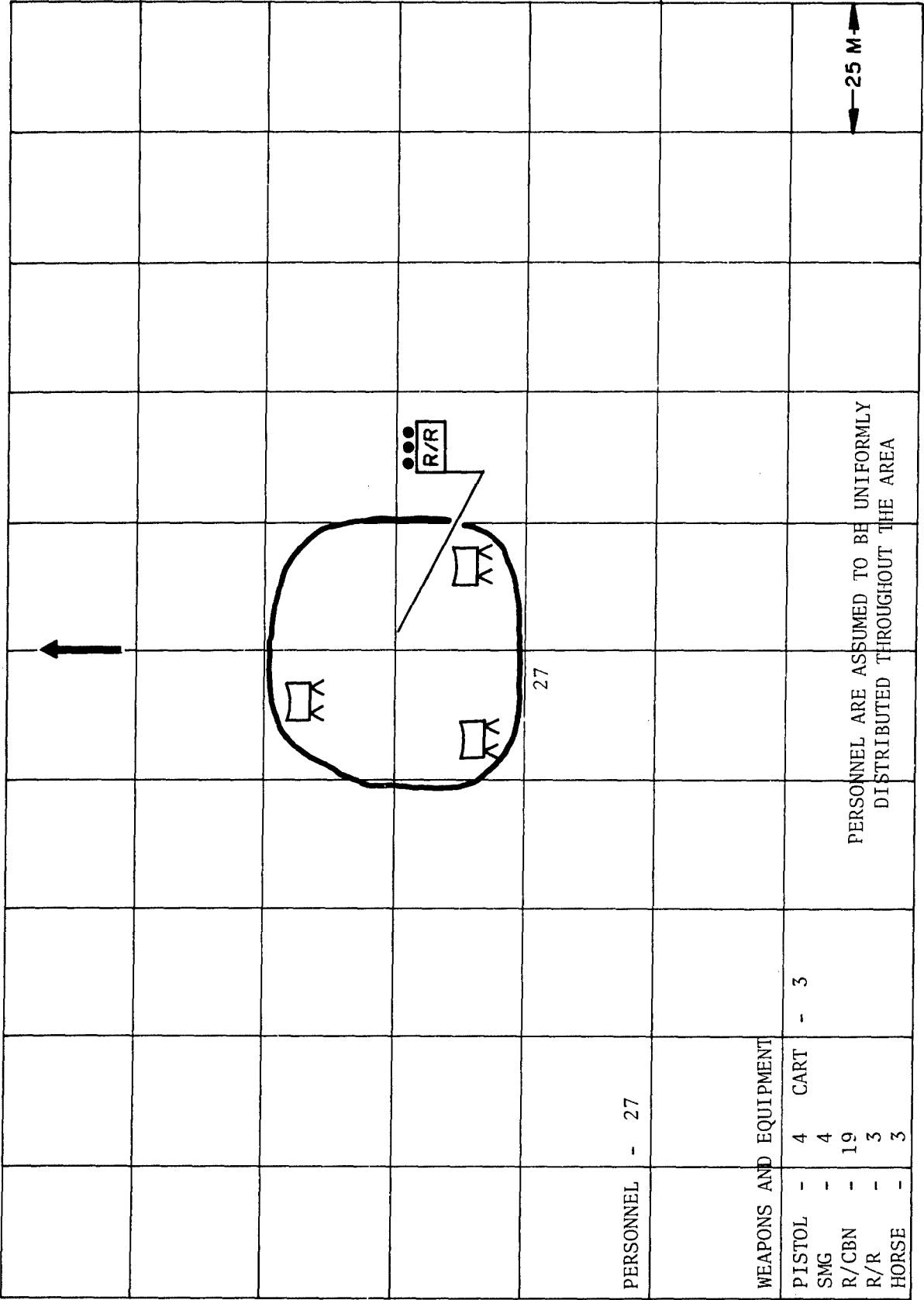


FIGURE A-24 (SECRET) RECOILLESS RIFLE PLAT (3), R/R CO

ASSEMBLY AREA (U)

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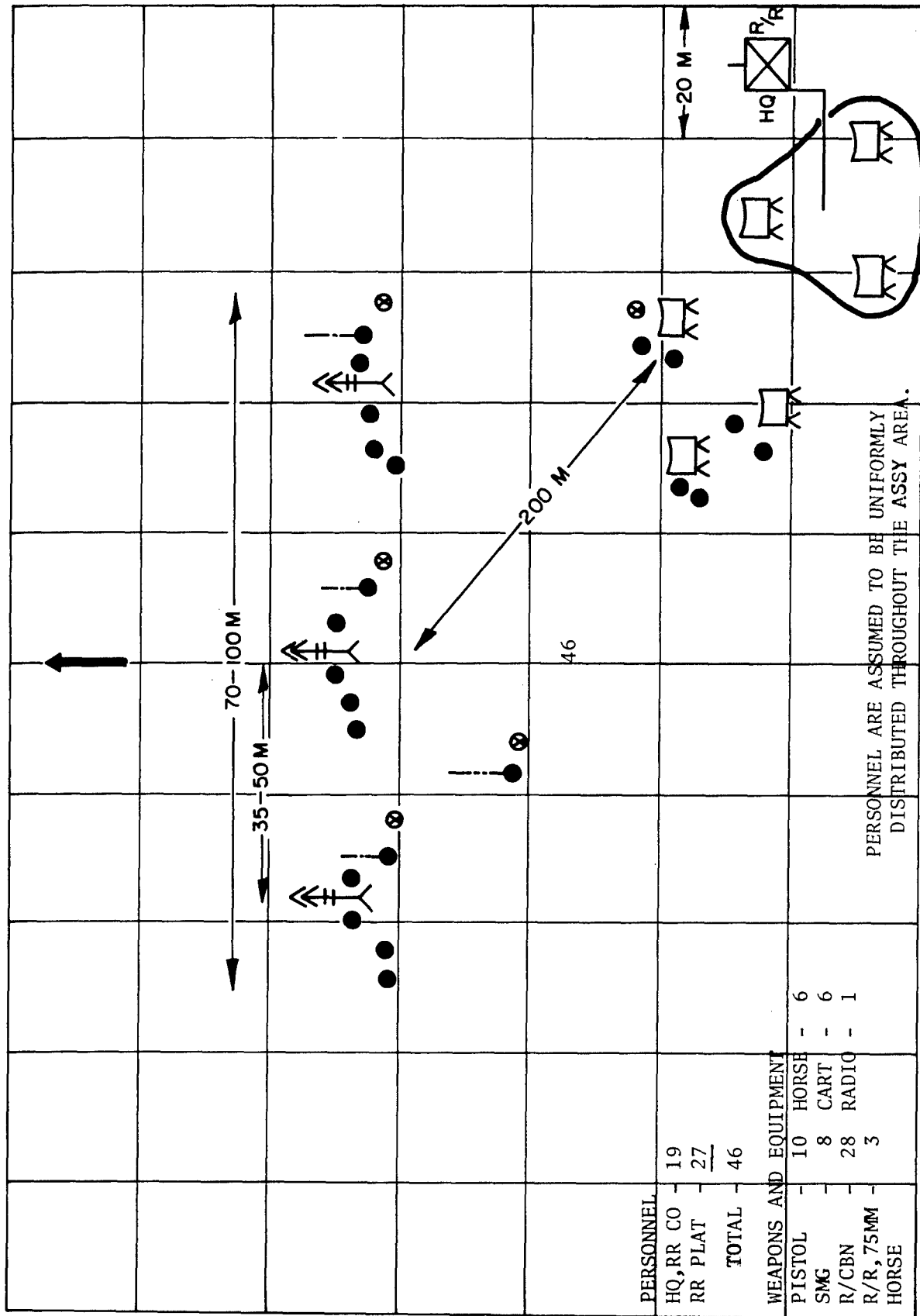


FIGURE A-25 (SECRET) HQ, RECOILLESS RIFLE CO, W/RR PLATOON

FIRING POSITION (U)

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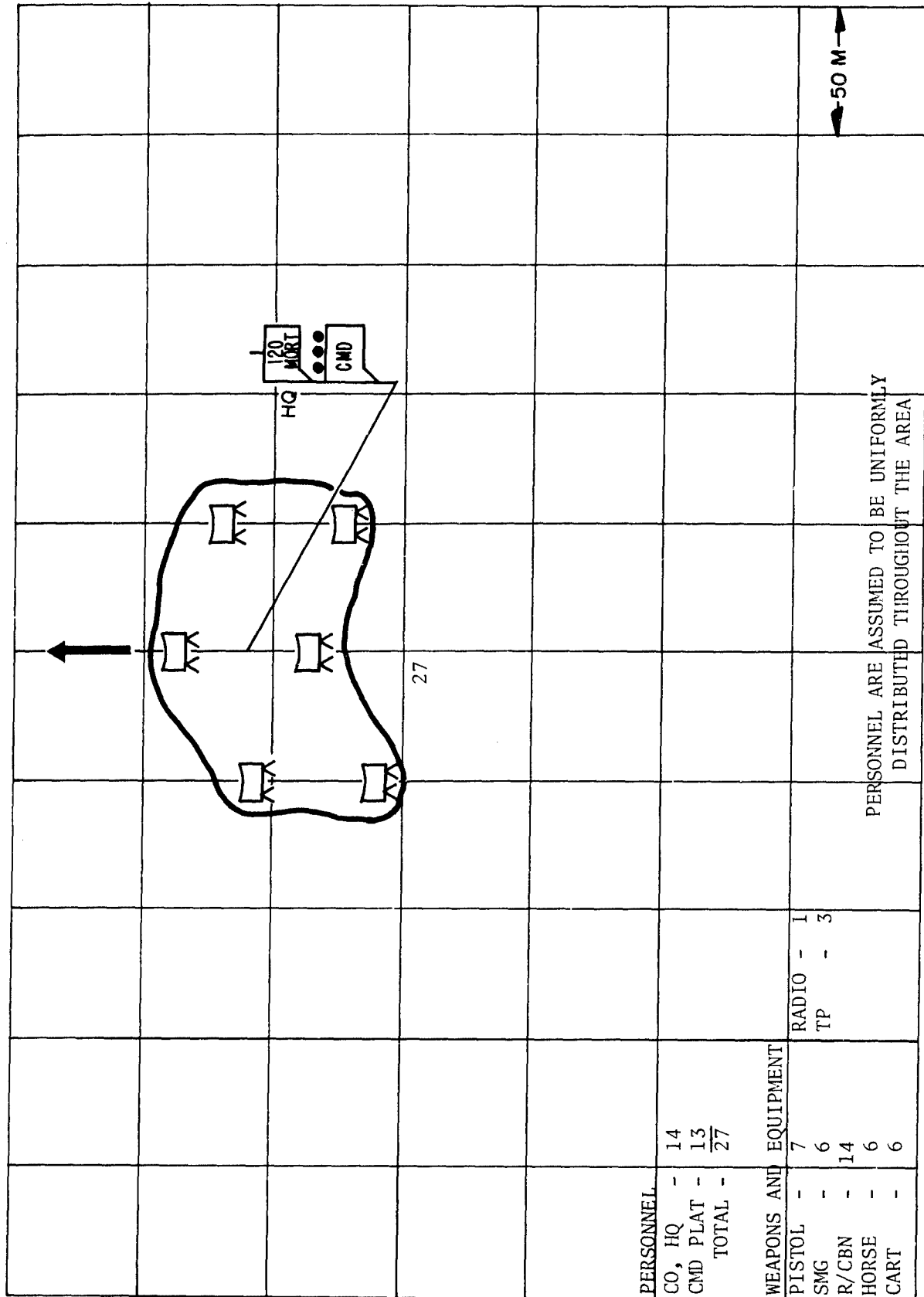


FIGURE A-26 (SECRET) HQ PLAT, 120MM MORTAR COMPANY

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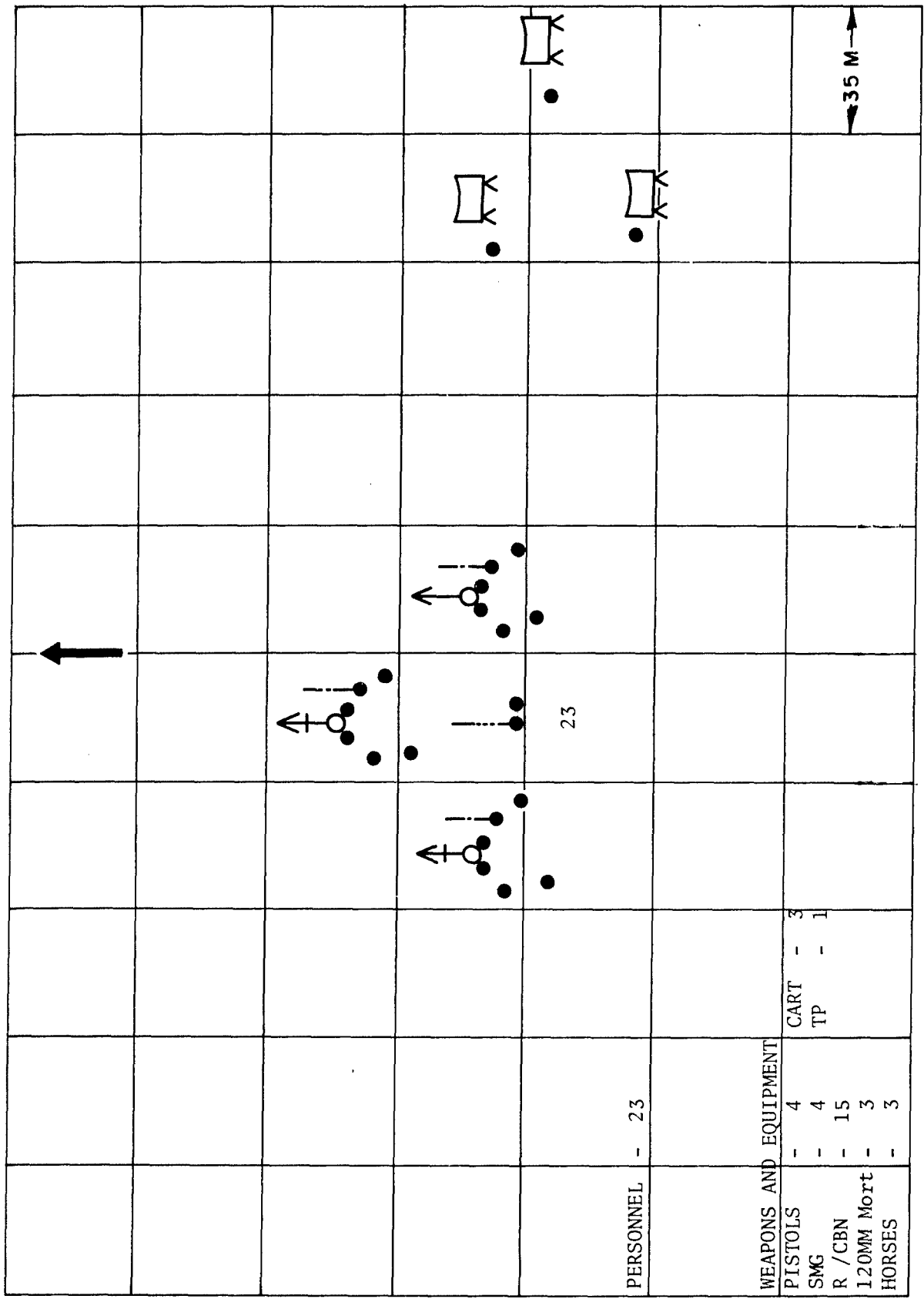


FIGURE A-28 (SECRET) 120 MM MORTAR PLATOON

IN FIRING POSITION (U)

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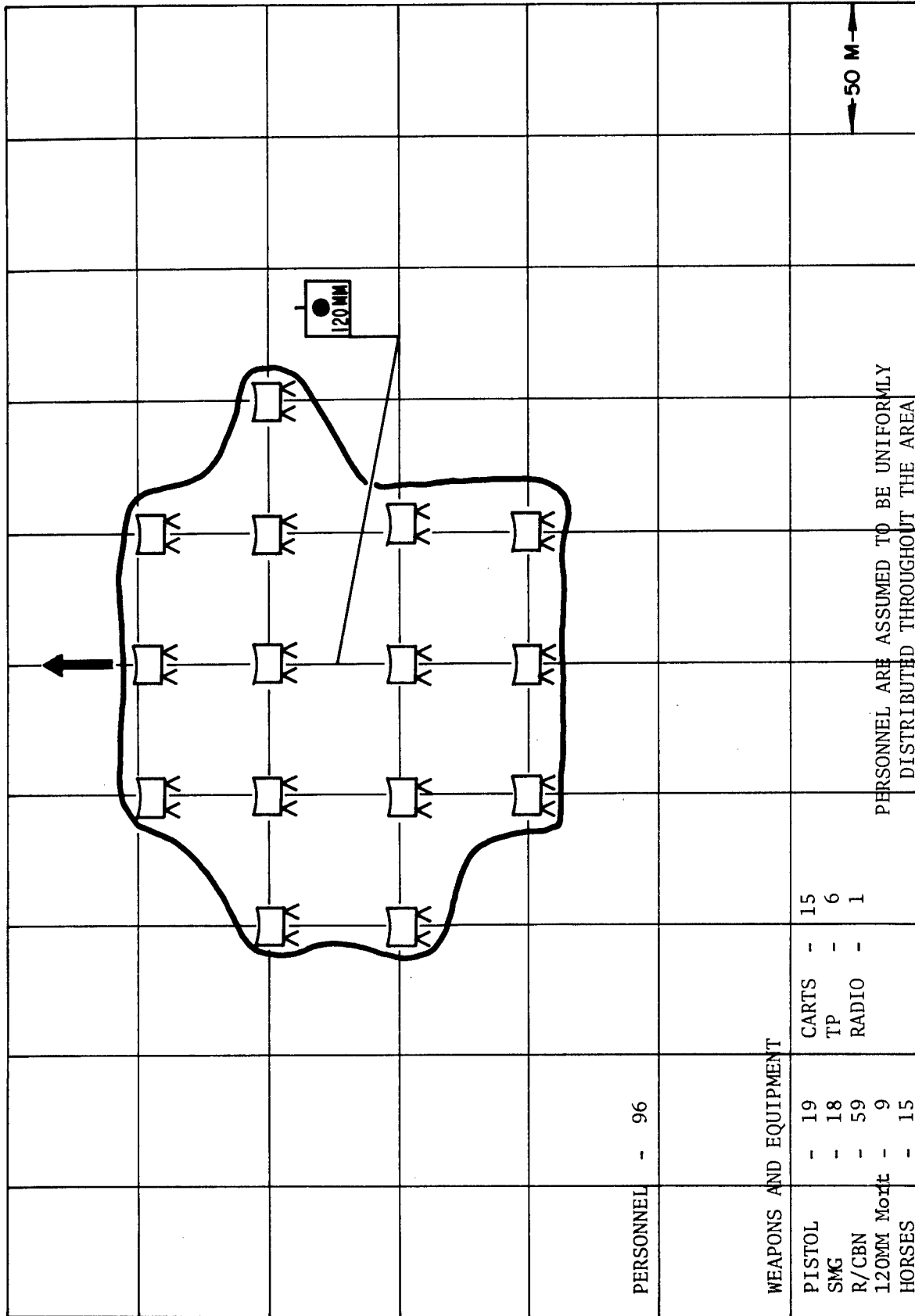


FIGURE A-29 (SECRET) 120 MM MORTAR COMPANY

IN ASSEMBLY AREA (U)

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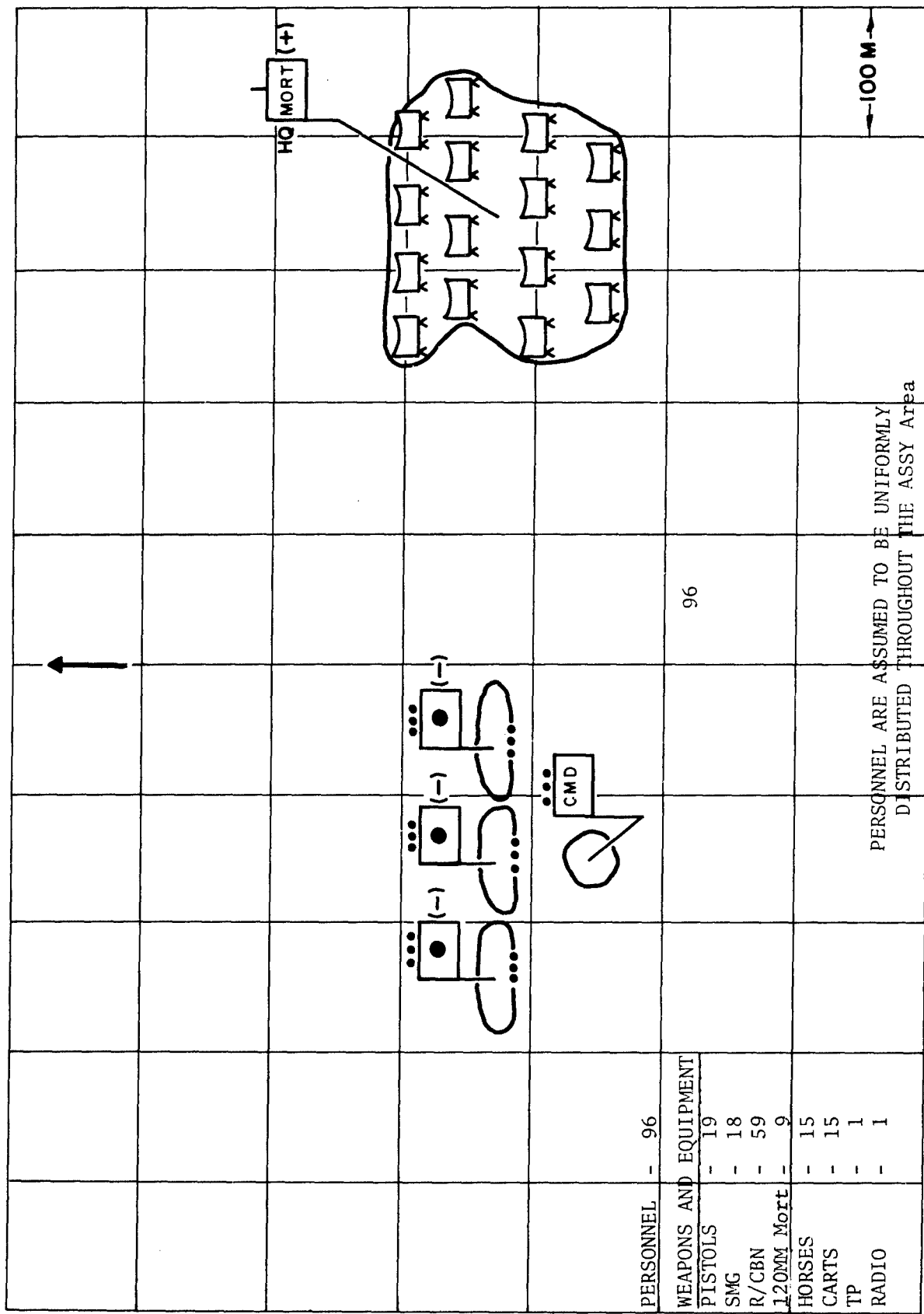


FIGURE A-30 (SECRET) 120 MM MORTAR BATTERY

IN FIRING POSITION (U)

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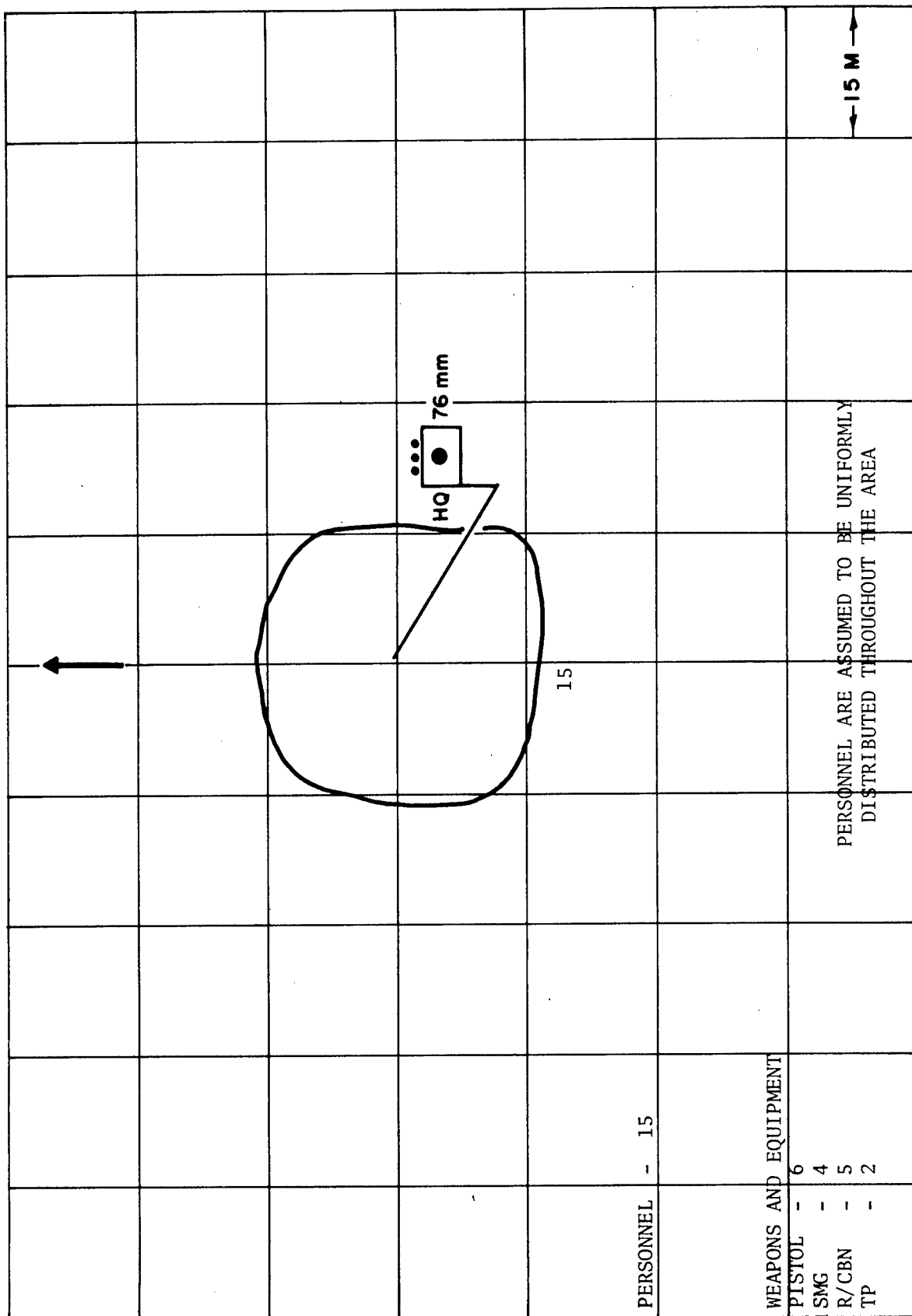


FIGURE A-31 (SECRET) HQ PLAT, 76 MM GUN COMPANY

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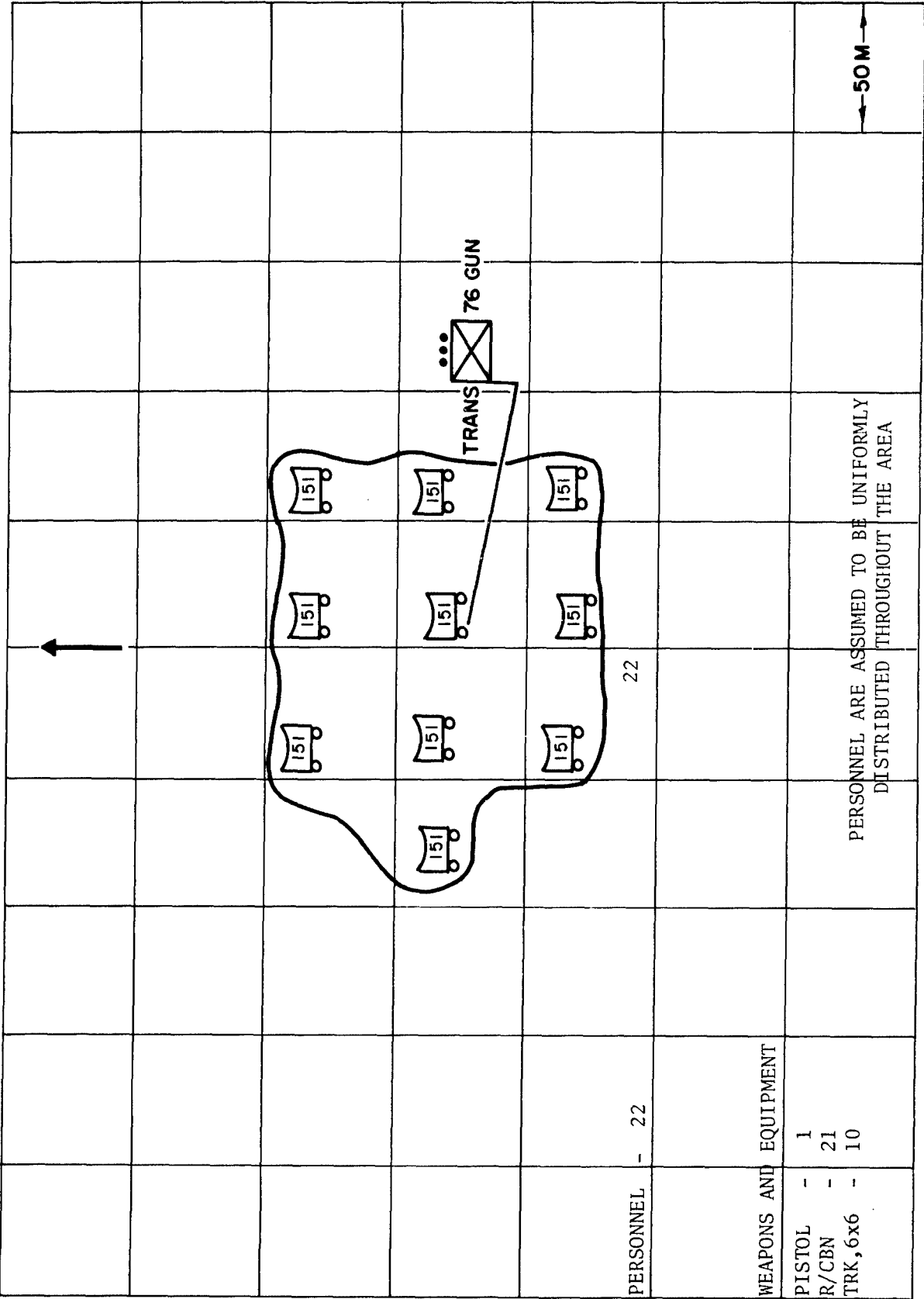
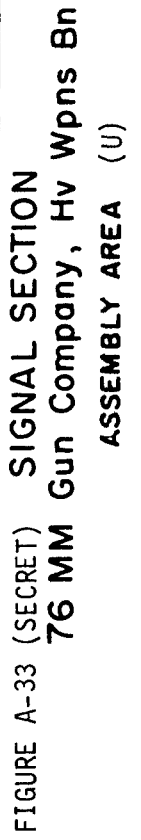


FIGURE A-32 (SECRET) TRANSPORTATION PLATOON

ASSEMBLY AREA (U)

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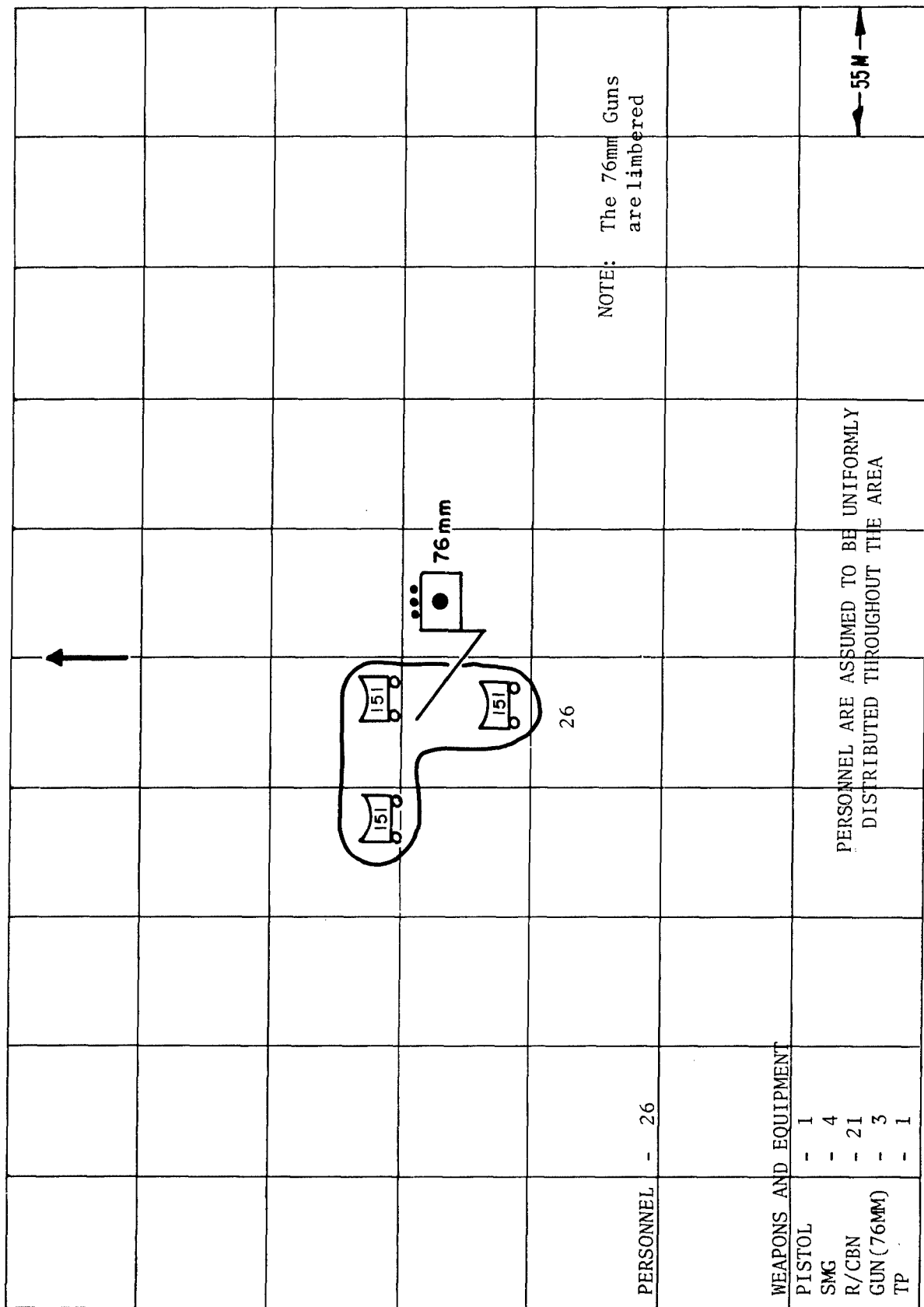


FIGURE A-34 (SECRET) 76 MM GUN PLATOON (3)

ASSEMBLY AREA (U)

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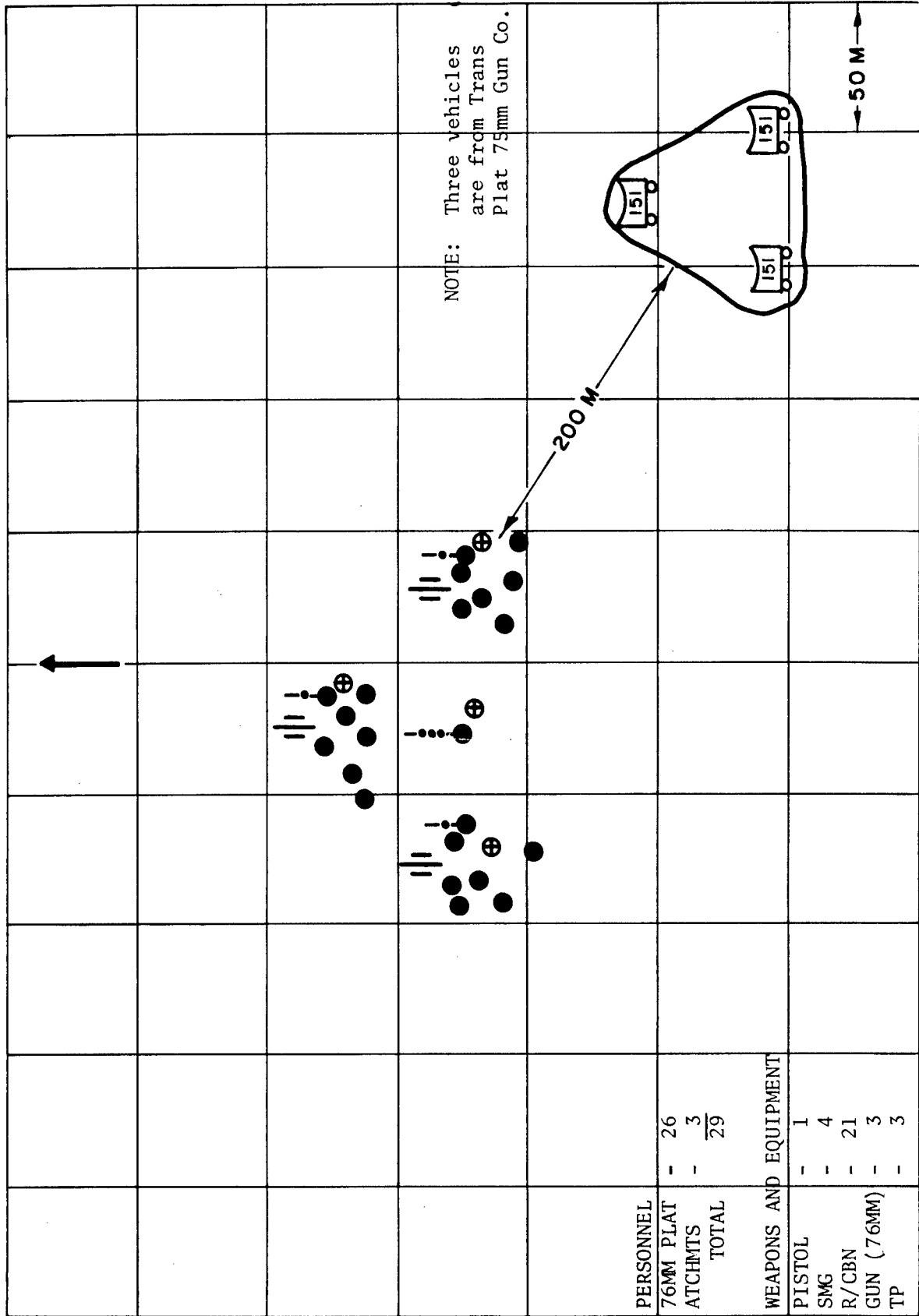


FIGURE A-35 (SECRET) 76 MM GUN PLATOON

(FIRING POSITION) (U)

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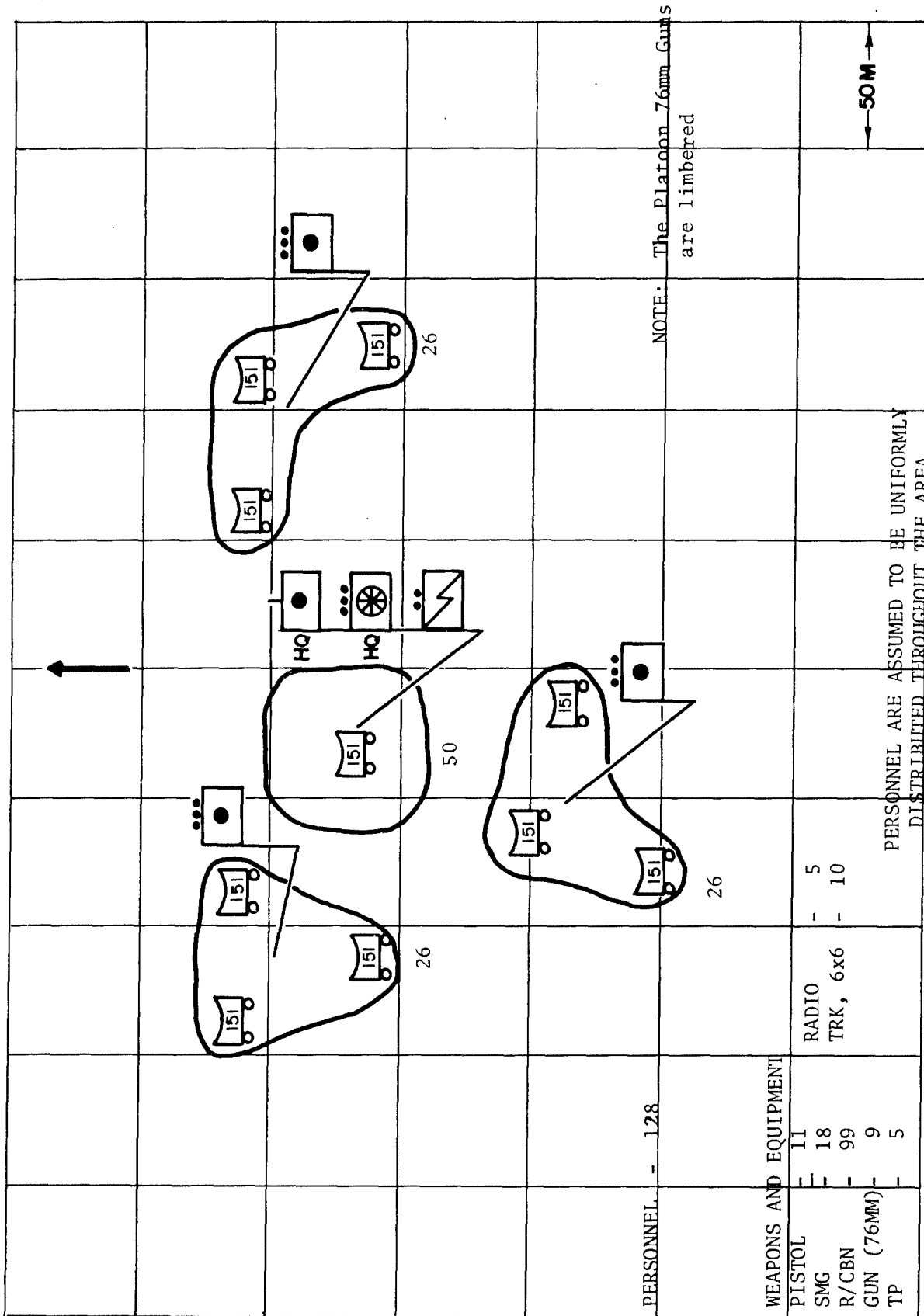


FIGURE A-36 (SECRET) 76 MM GUN COMPANY

ASSEMBLY AREA (U)

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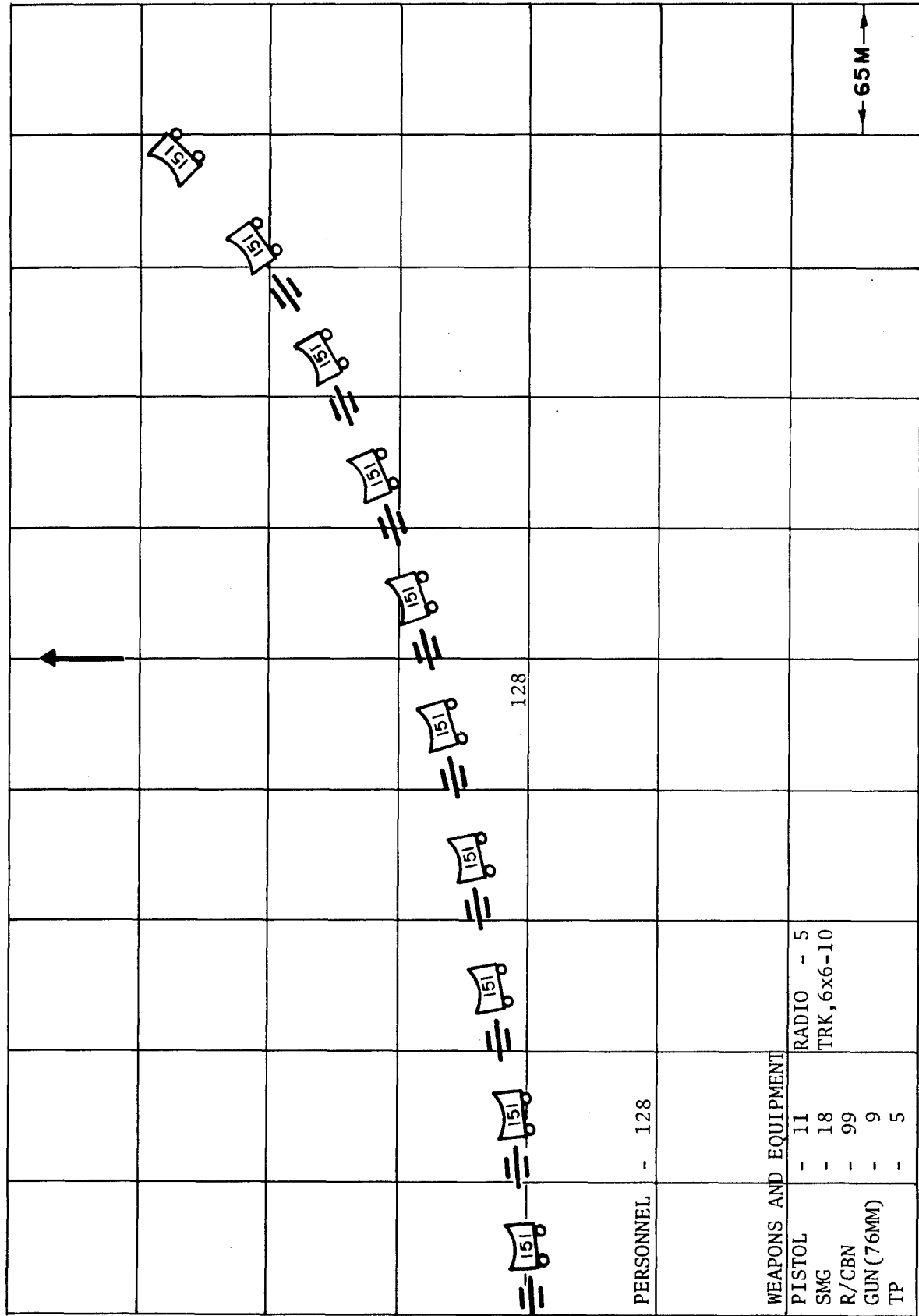


FIGURE A-37 (SECRET) 76 MM GUN COMPANY

MCUNTED COLUMN (U)

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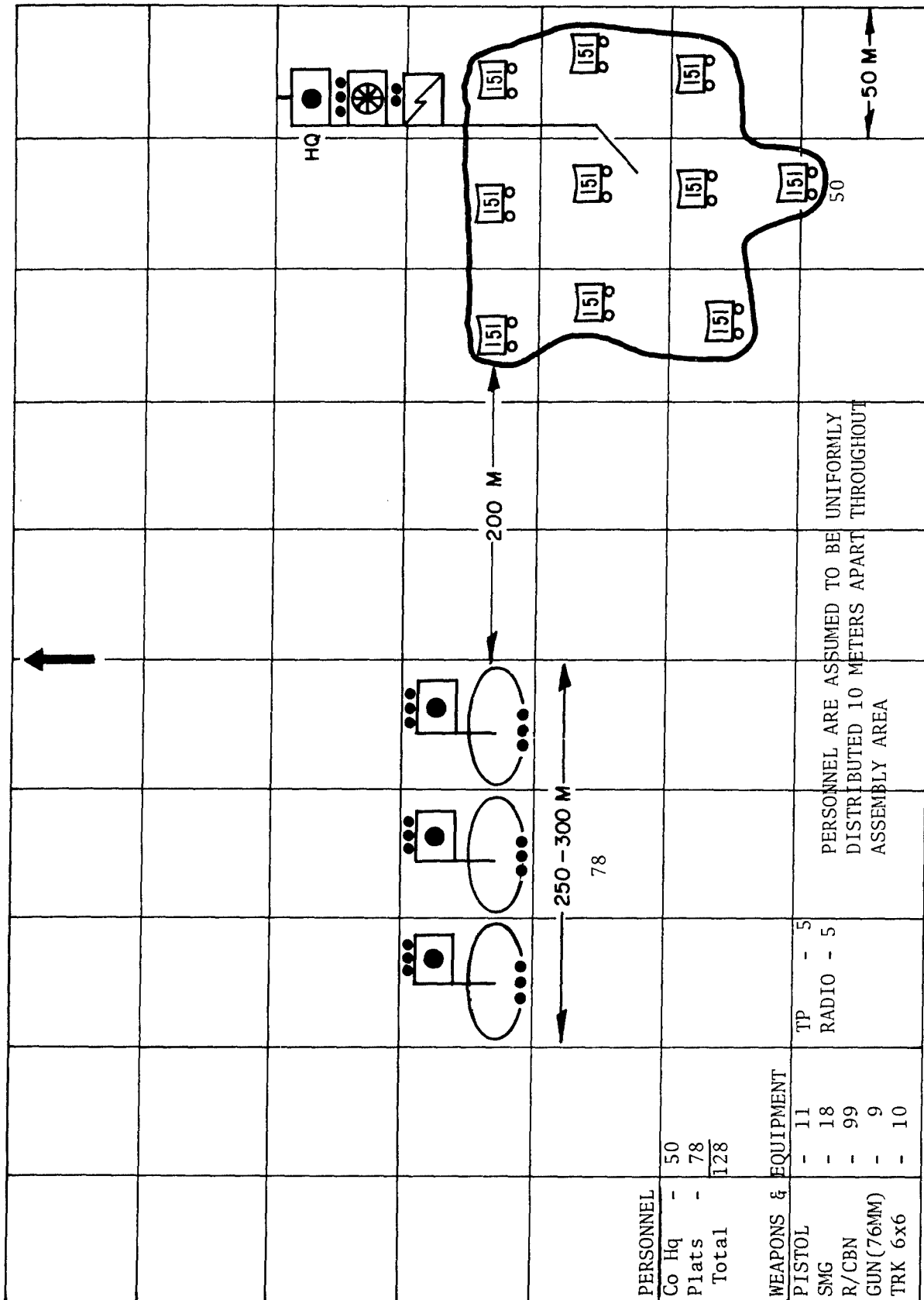


FIGURE A-38 (SECRET) 76 MM GUN COMPANY, HEAVY WEAPONS BATTALION

(FIRING POSITION) (U)

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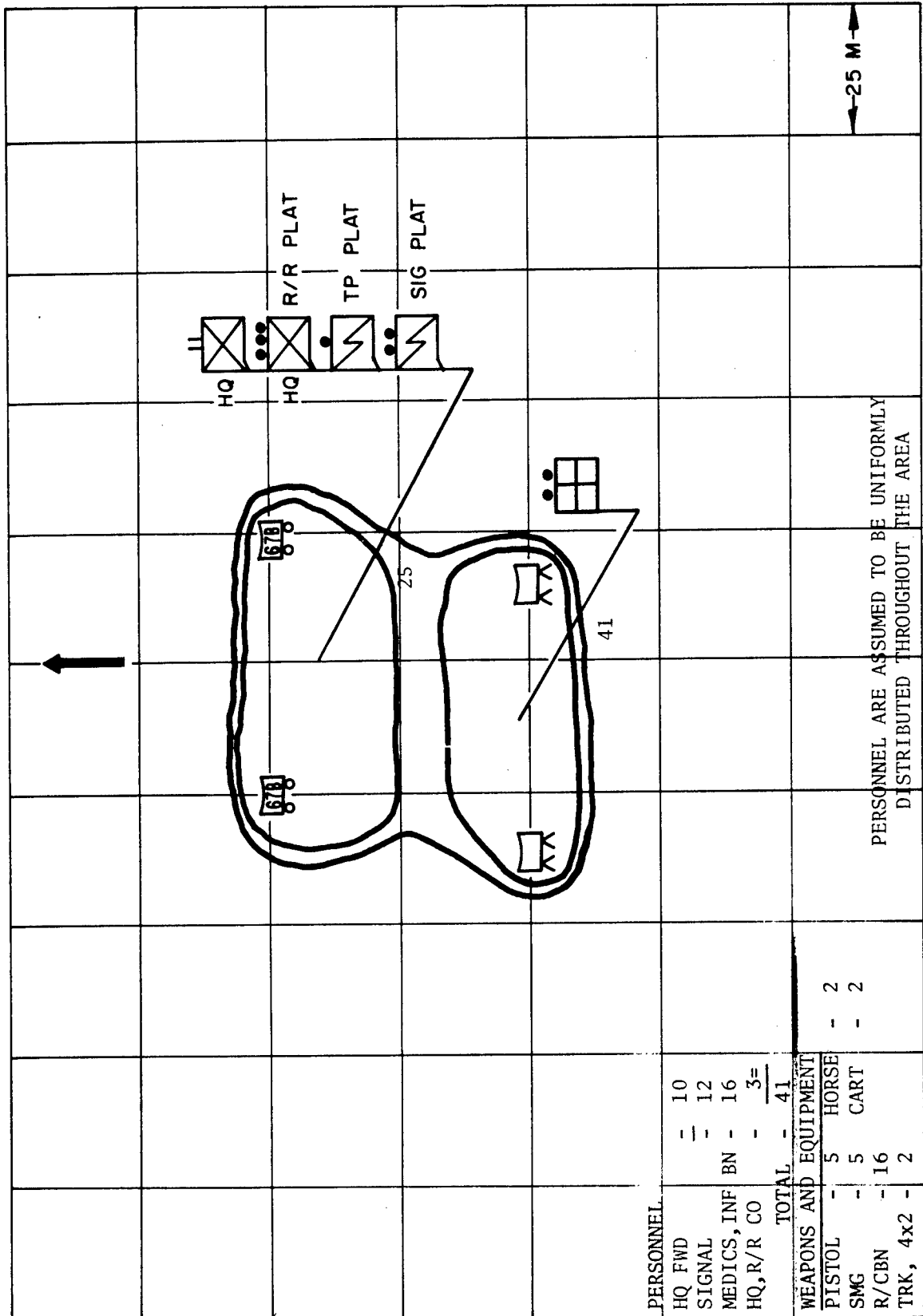


FIGURE A-39 (SECRET) HQ, FORWARD Infantry Battalion (U)

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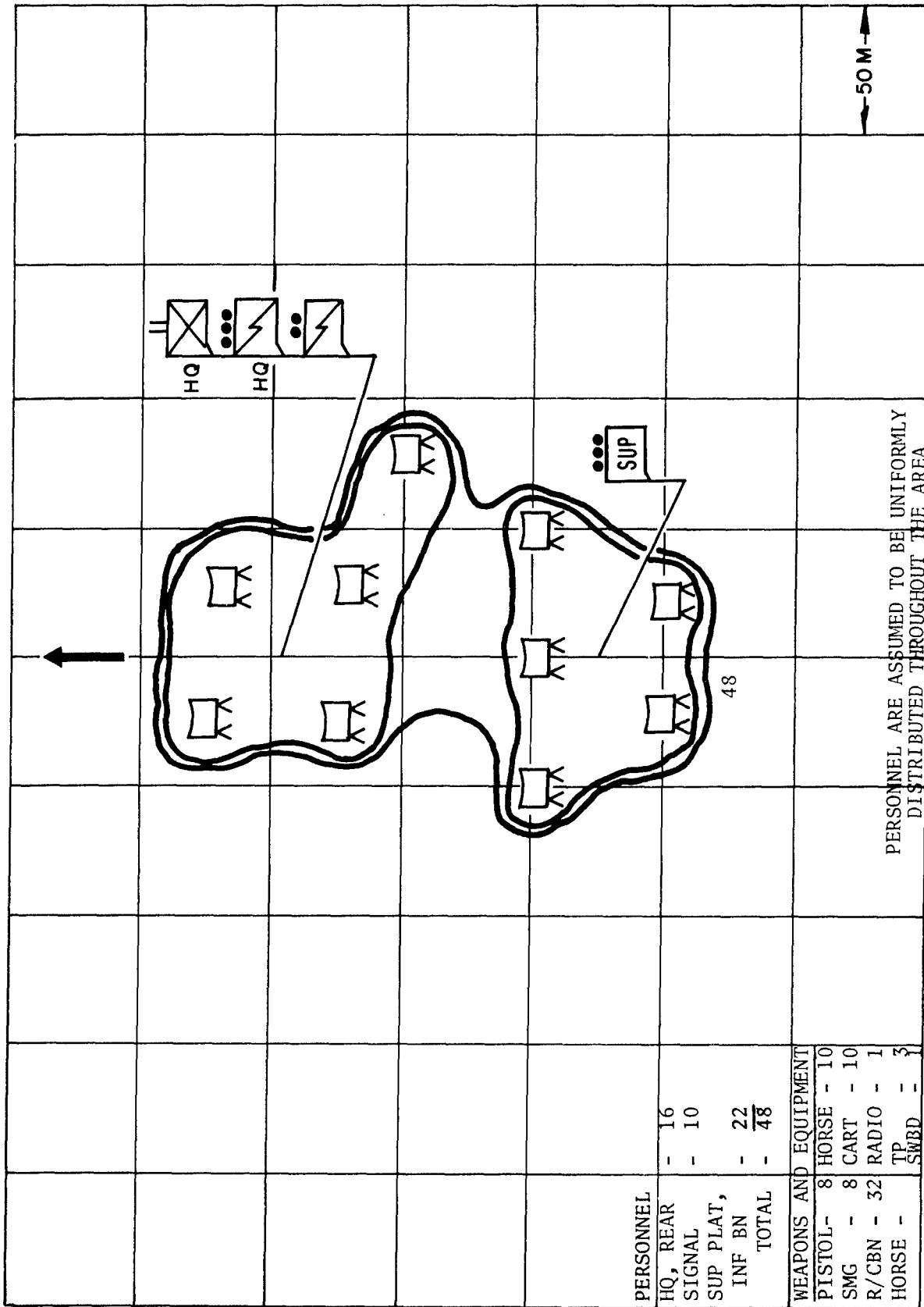


FIGURE I-40 (SECRET) HQ, REAR
Infantry Battalion (U)

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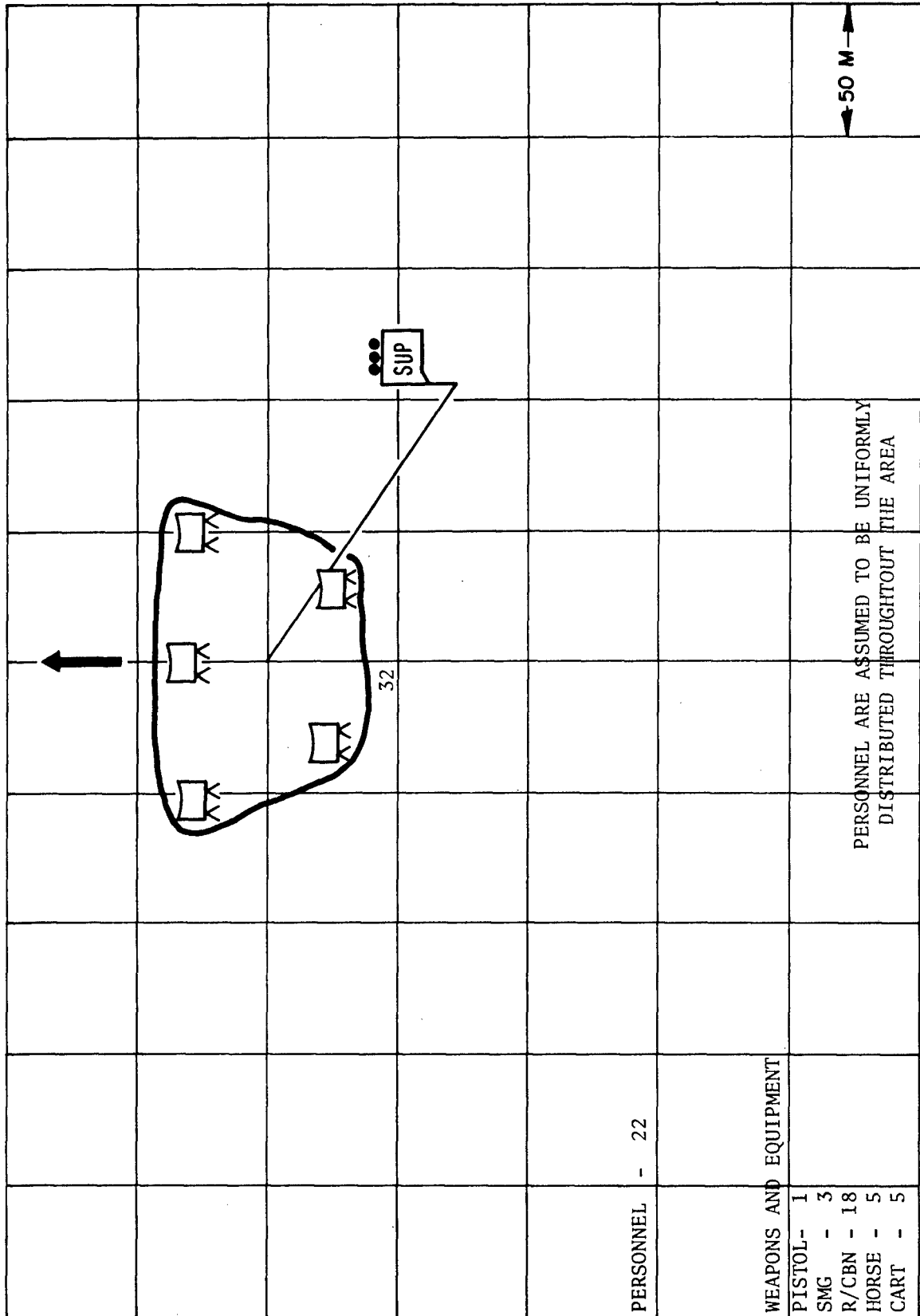


FIGURE A-41 (SECRET) SUP PLAT, HQ INF BN

ASSEMBLY AREA (U)

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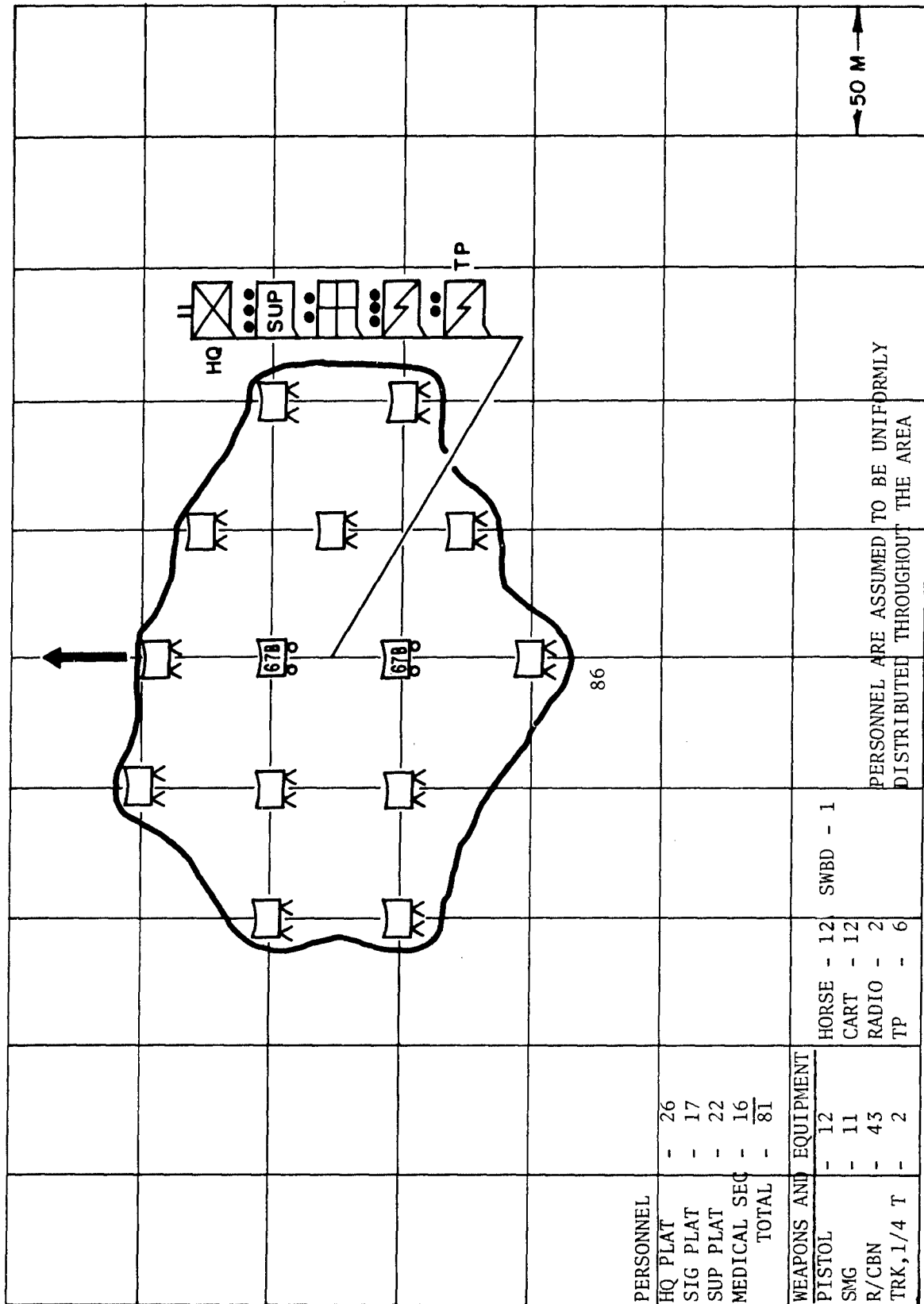


FIGURE A-42 (SECRET) HQ CO, INFANTRY BN

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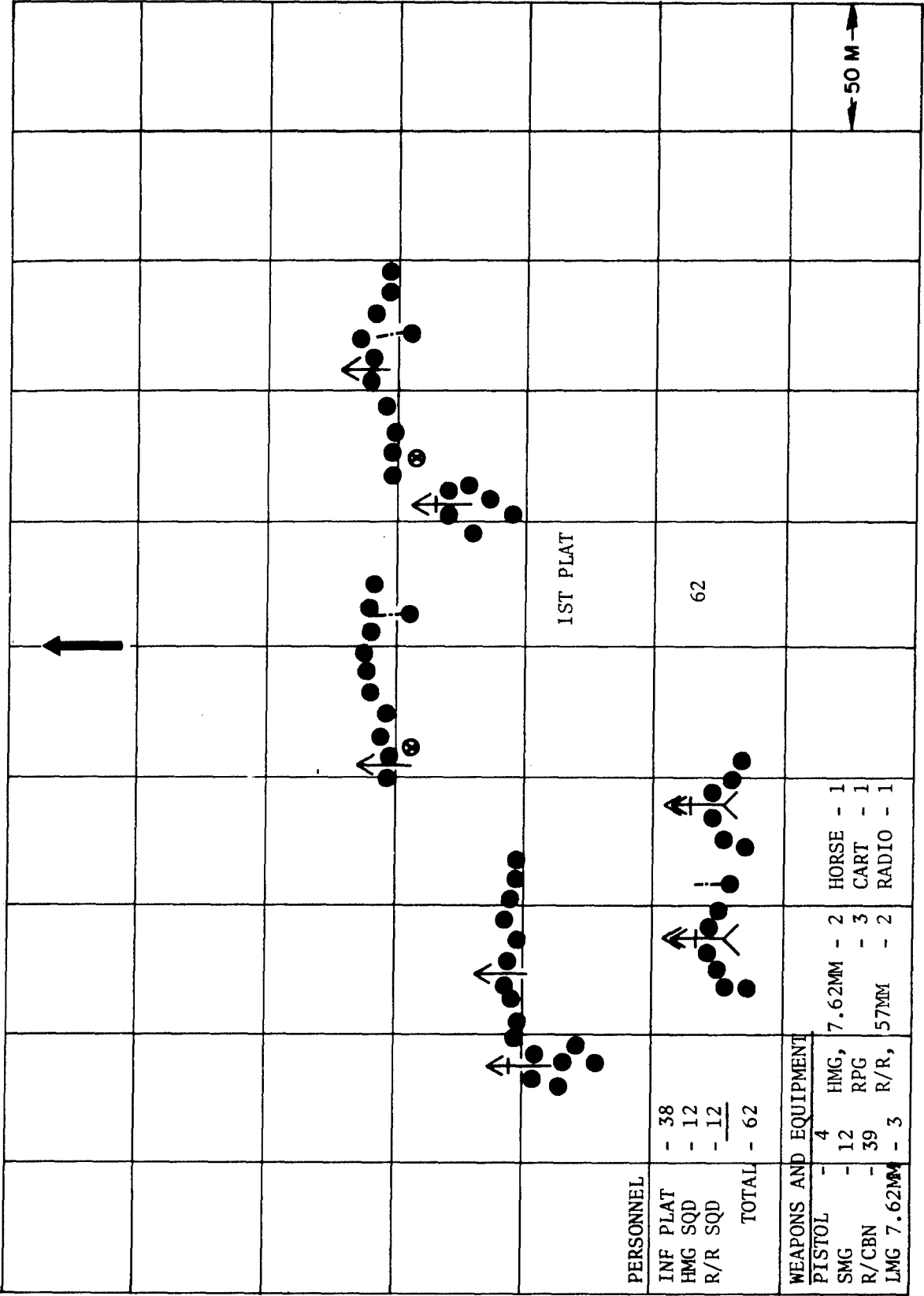


FIGURE A-44 (SECRET) RIFLE PLATOON(+), INFANTRY COMPANY

OFFENSIVE SITUATION (U)

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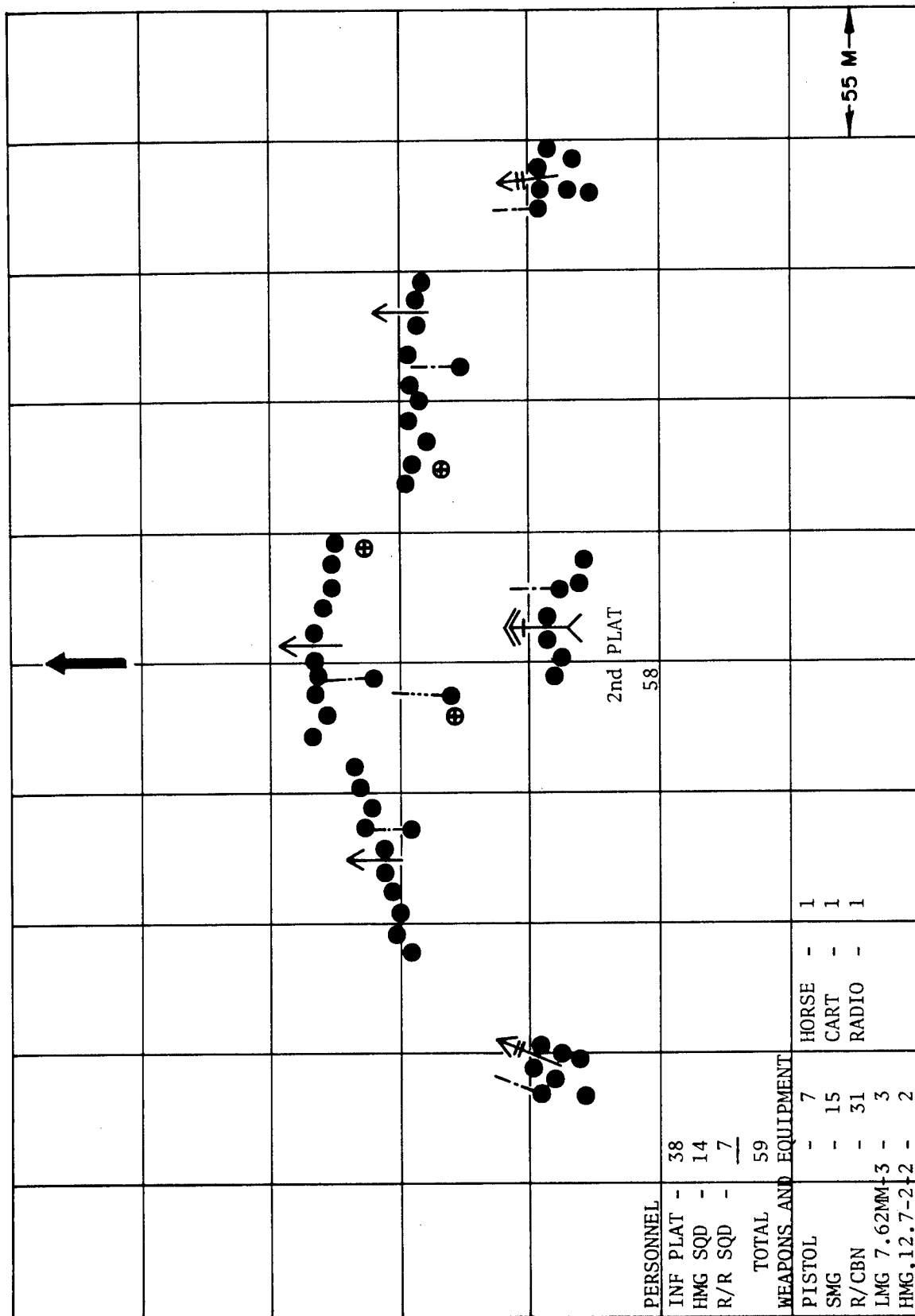


FIGURE A-45 (SECRET) RIFLE PLATOON (+) INFANTRY COMPANY

OFFENSIVE SITUATION (U)

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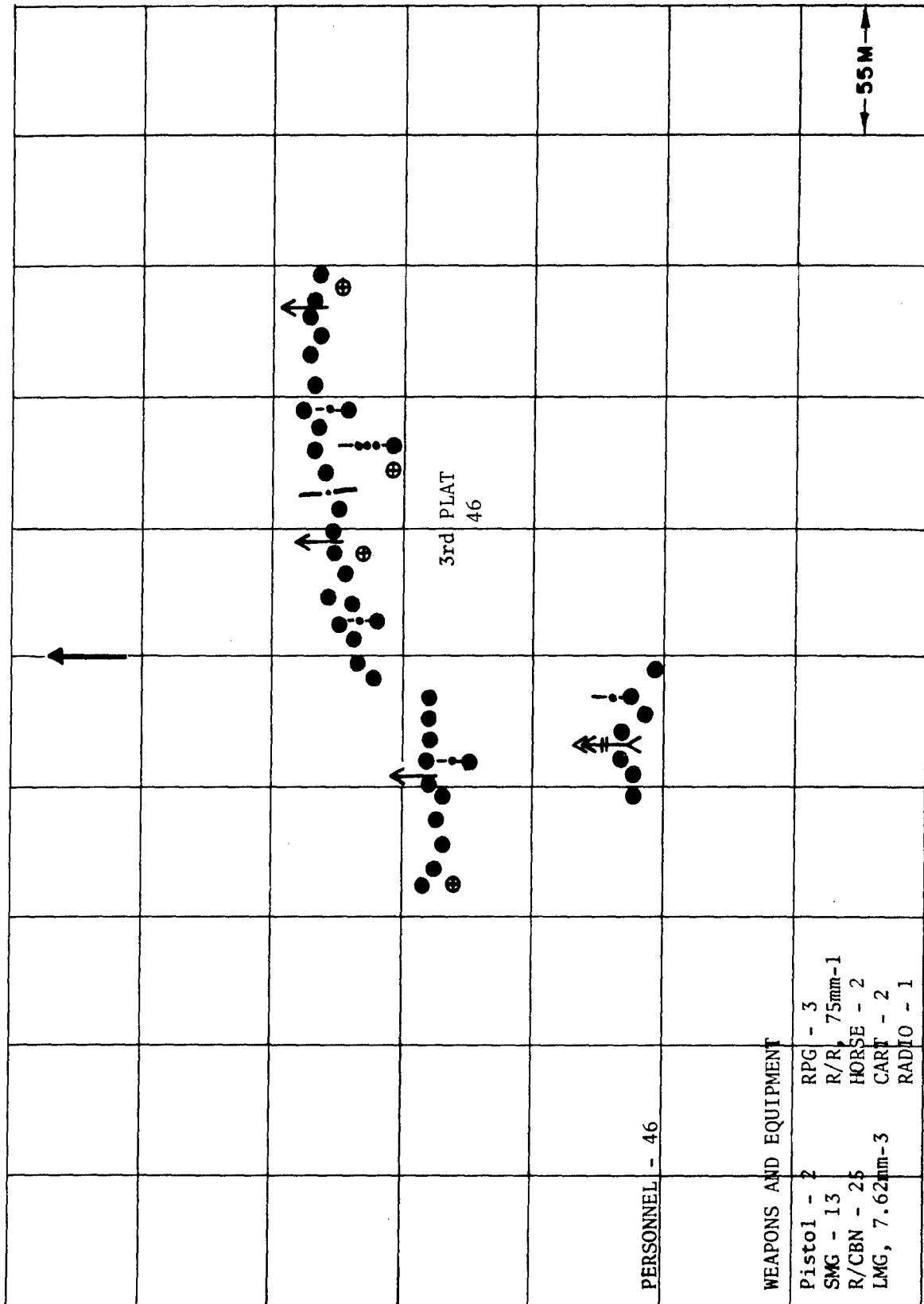


FIGURE A-46 (SECRET) RIFLE PLATOON (+), INFANTRY COMPANY

OFFENSIVE SITUATION (U)

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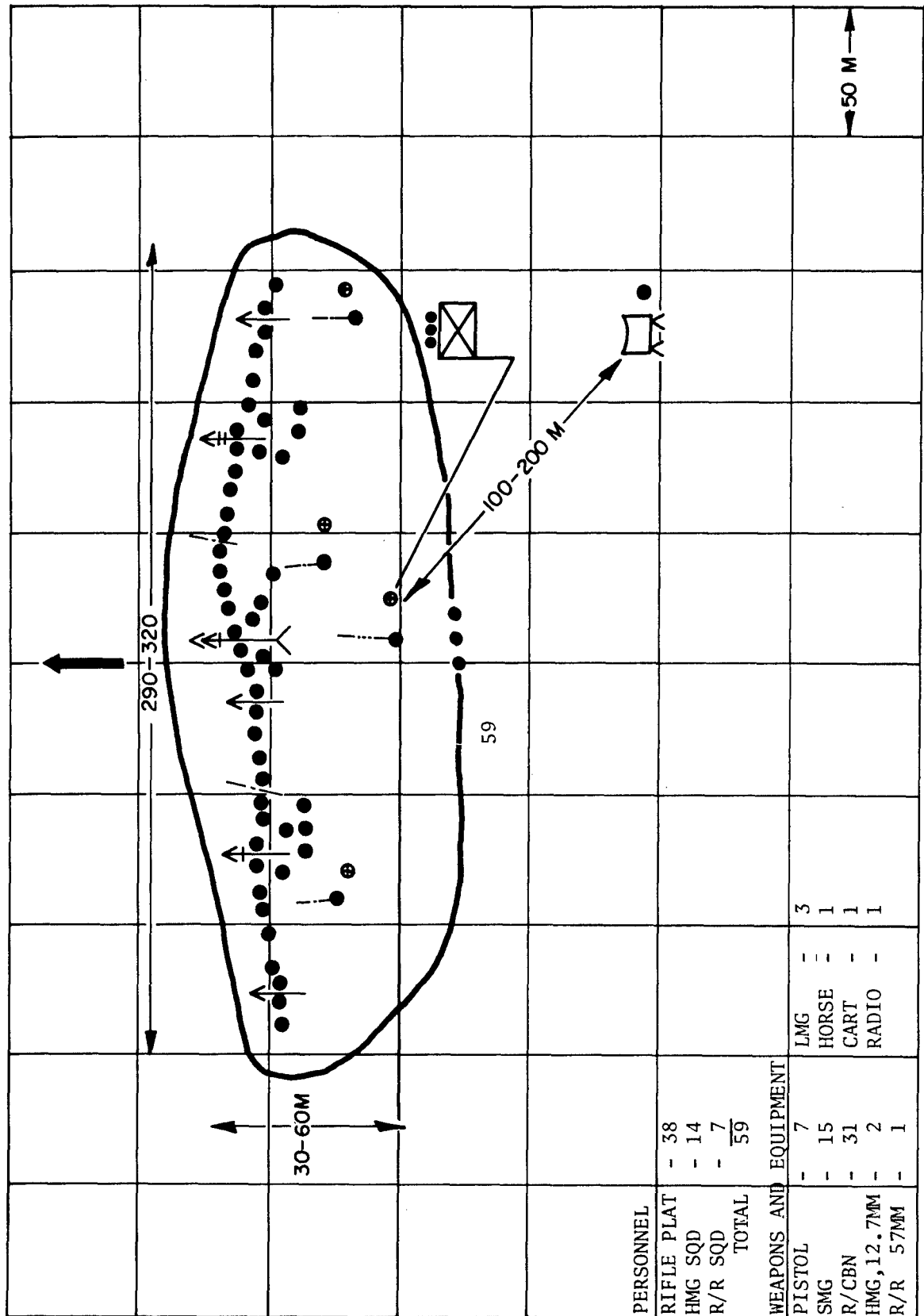


FIGURE A-47 (SECRET) RIFLE PLATOON (+), INFANTRY COMPANY

IN DEFENSE (U)

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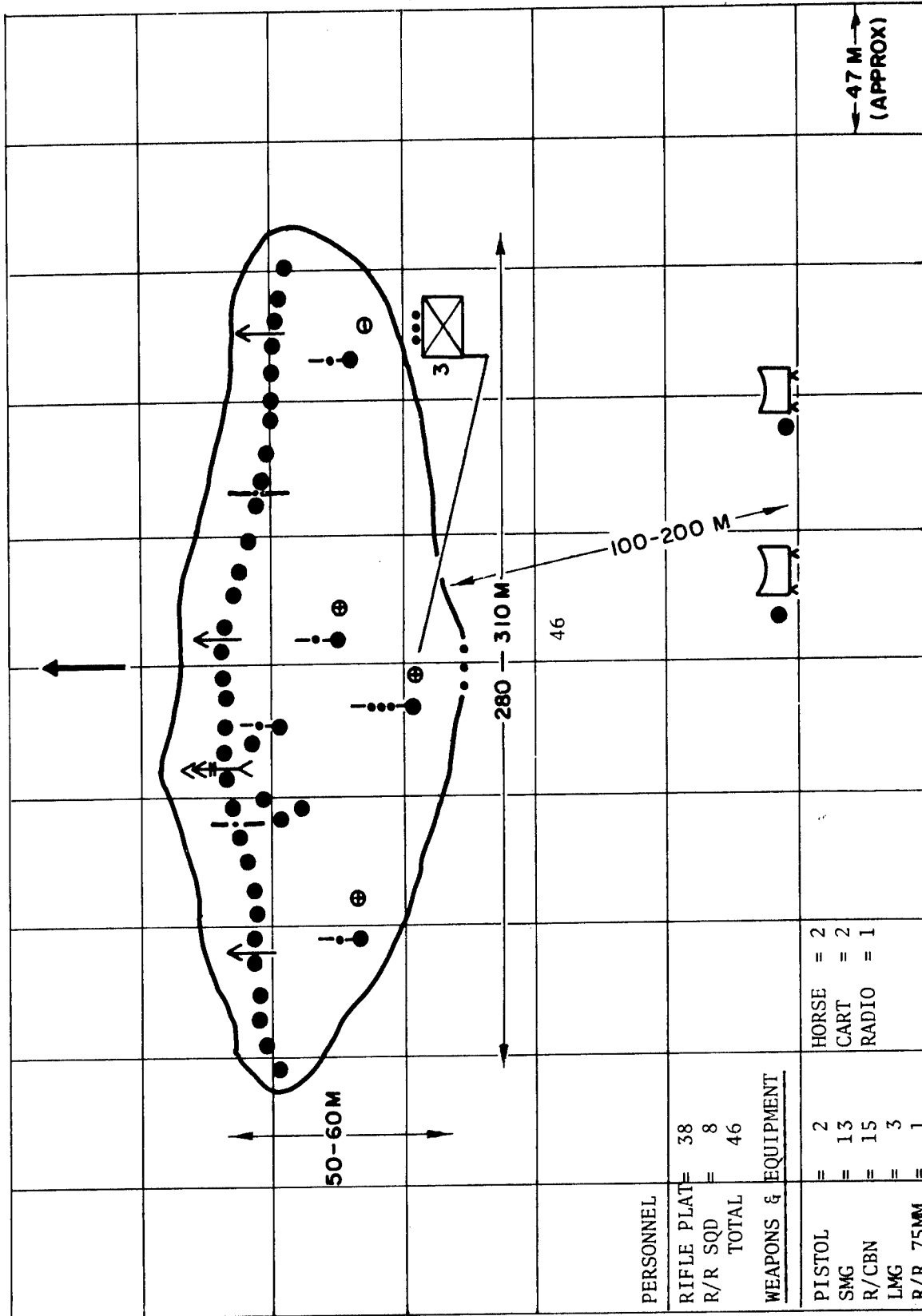


FIGURE A-48 (SECRET) RIFLE PLATOON (+), INFANTRY COMPANY

IN DEFENSE (U)

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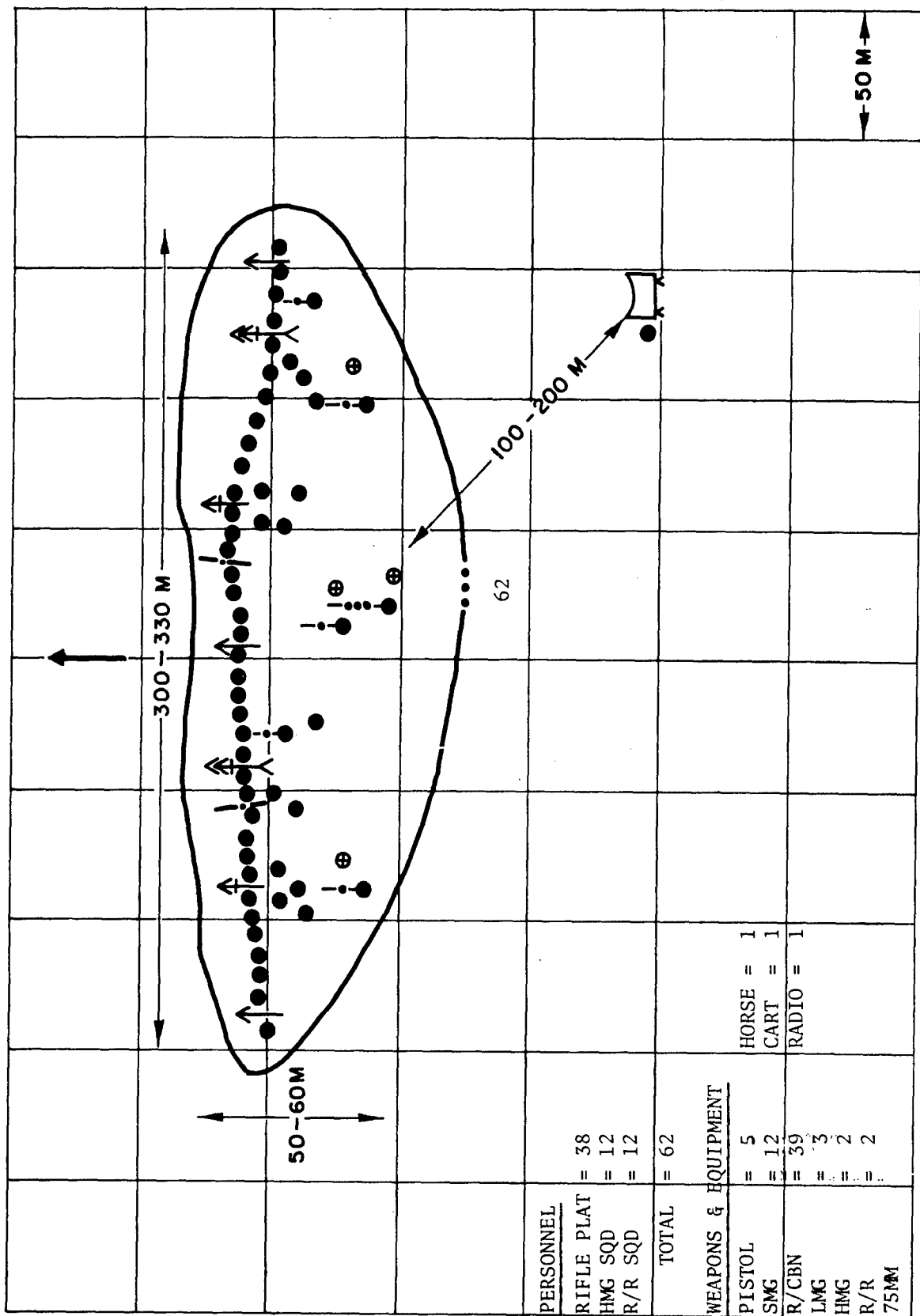


FIGURE A-49 (SECRET) RIFLE PLATOON (+), INFANTRY COMPANY
In Defense (U)

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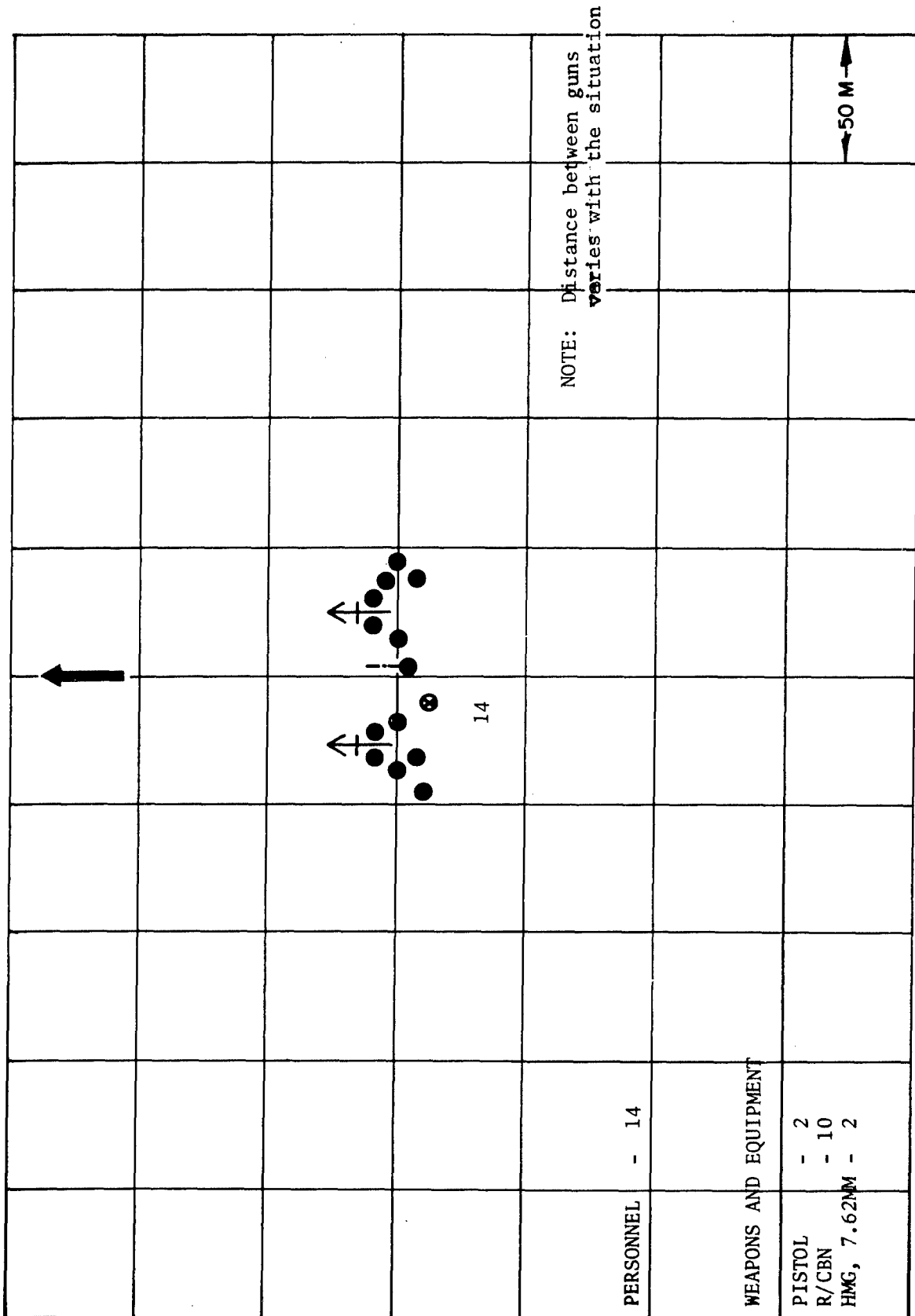


FIGURE A-50 (SECRET) WEAPONS PLATOON, INFANTRY COMPANY

FIRING POSITION (U)

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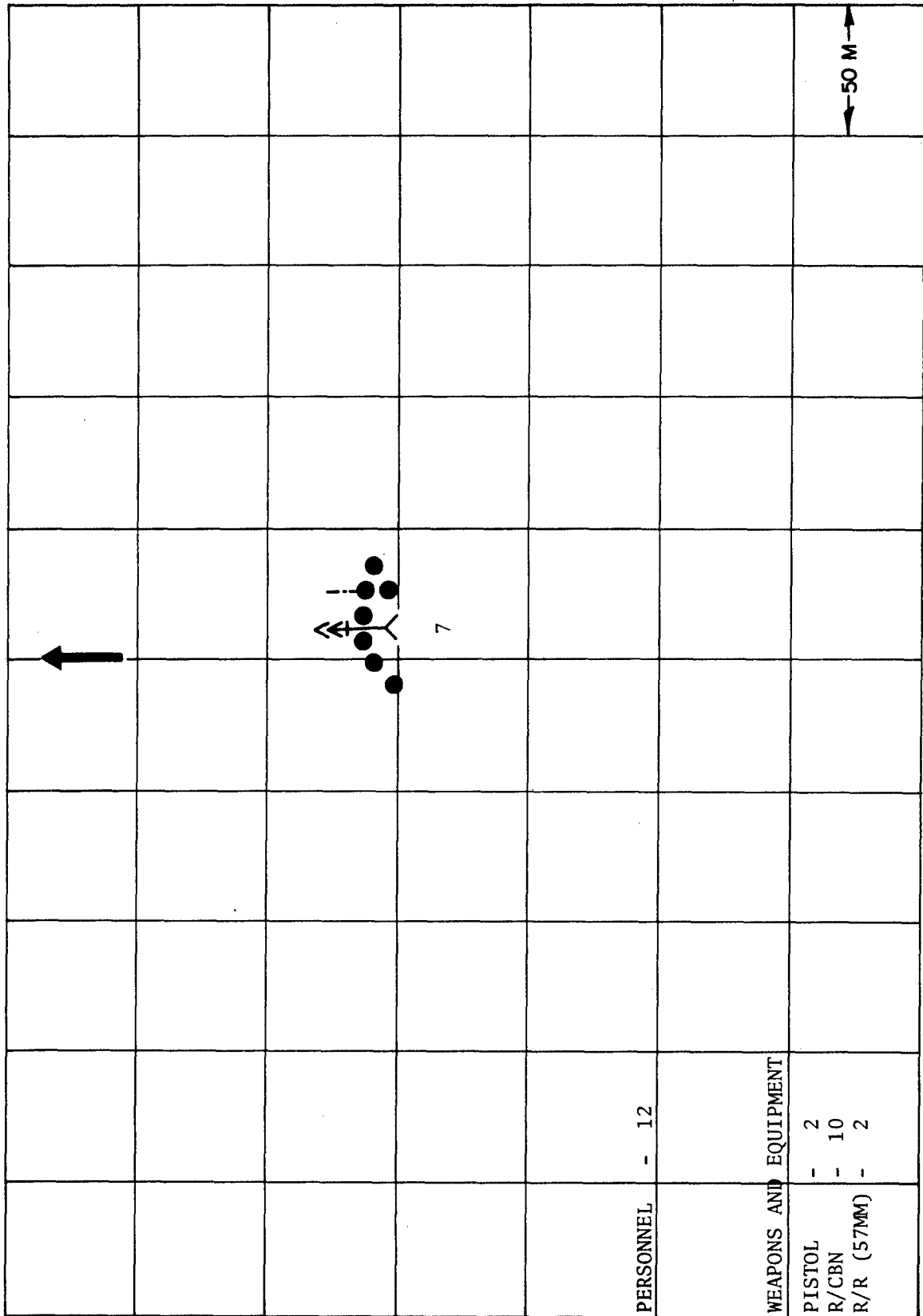


FIGURE A-51 (SECRET) WEAPONS PLATOON, INFANTRY COMPANY

FIRING POSITION (U)

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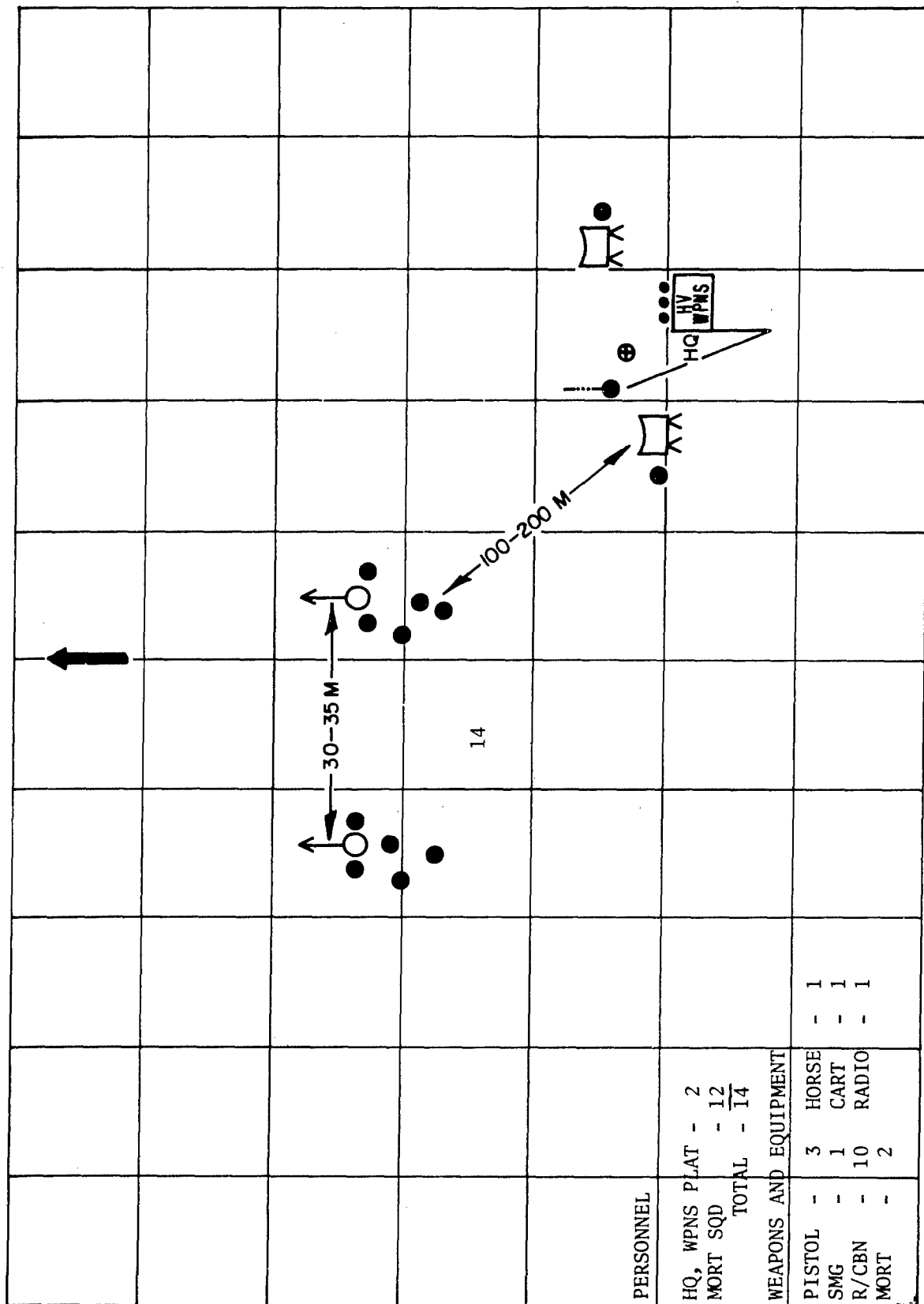


FIGURE A-52 (SECRET) HQ, WEAPONS PLATOON, INFANTRY COMPANY

FIRING POSITION (U)

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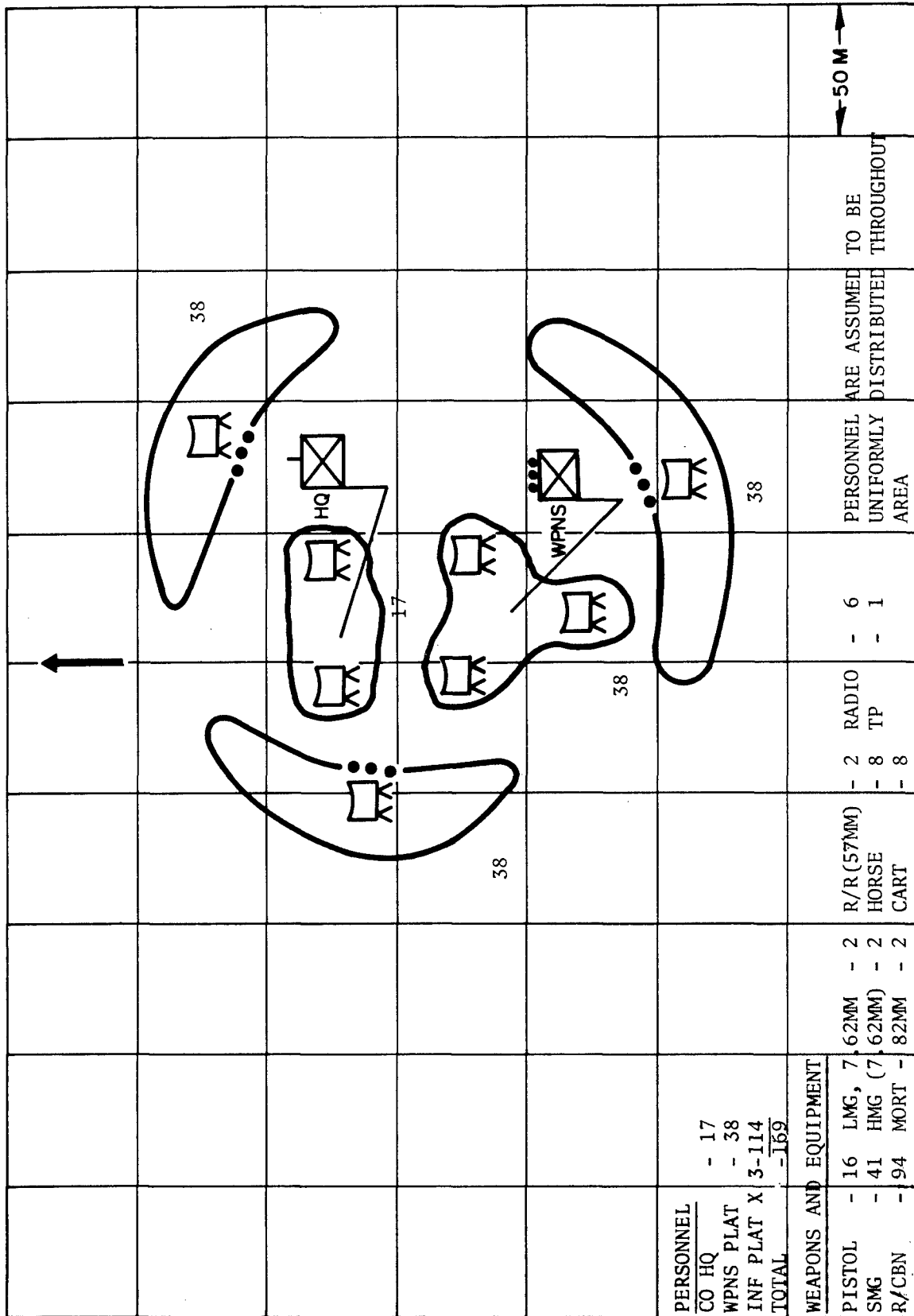
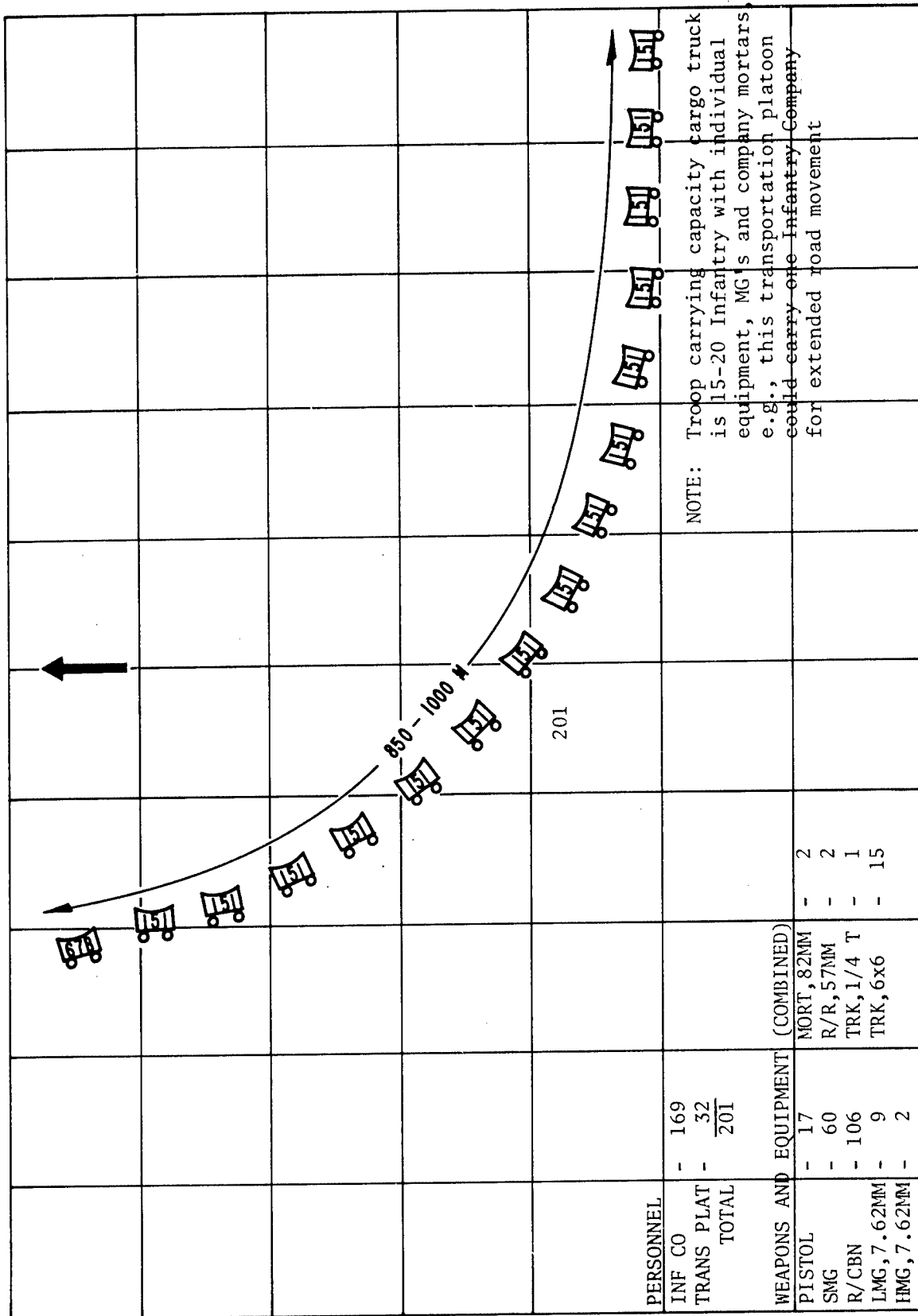


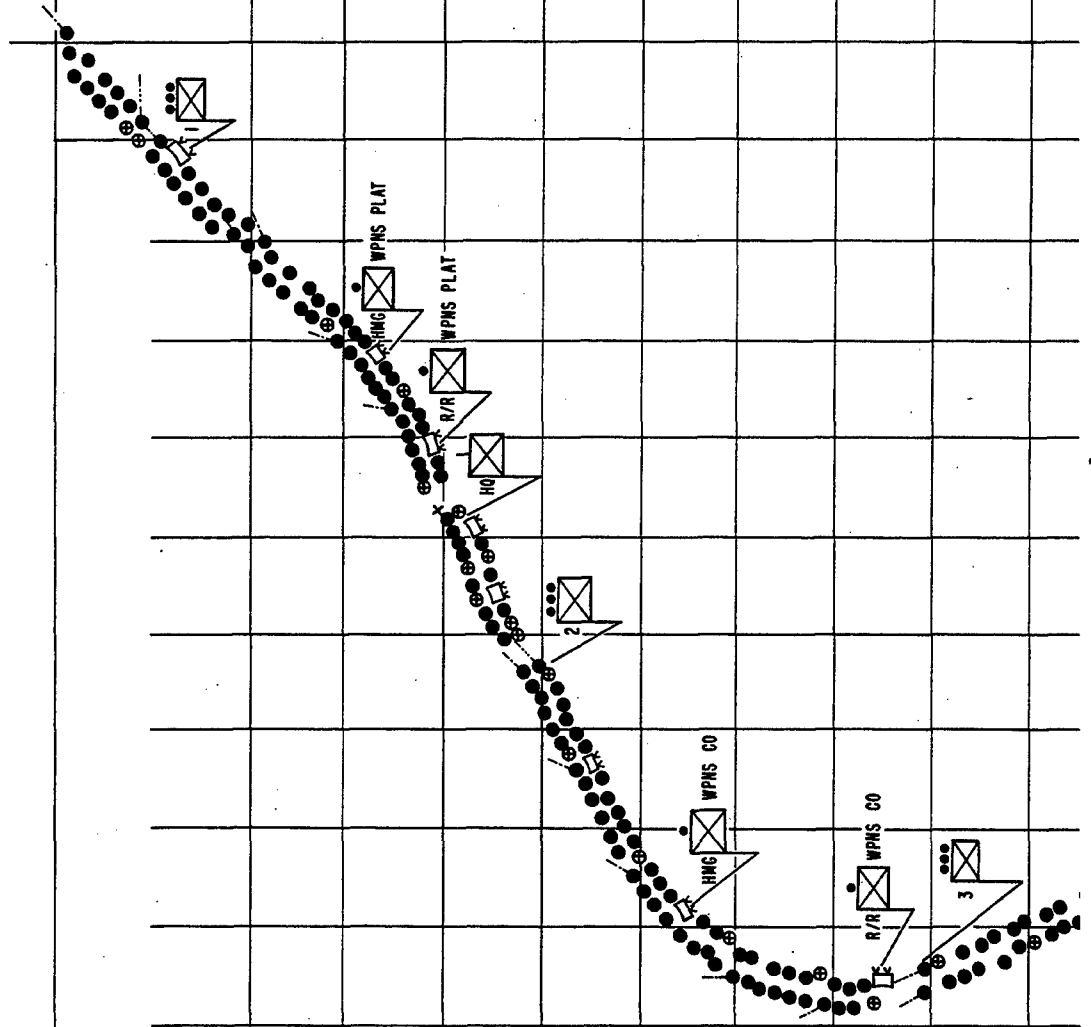
FIGURE A-53 (SECRET) INFANTRY COMPANY

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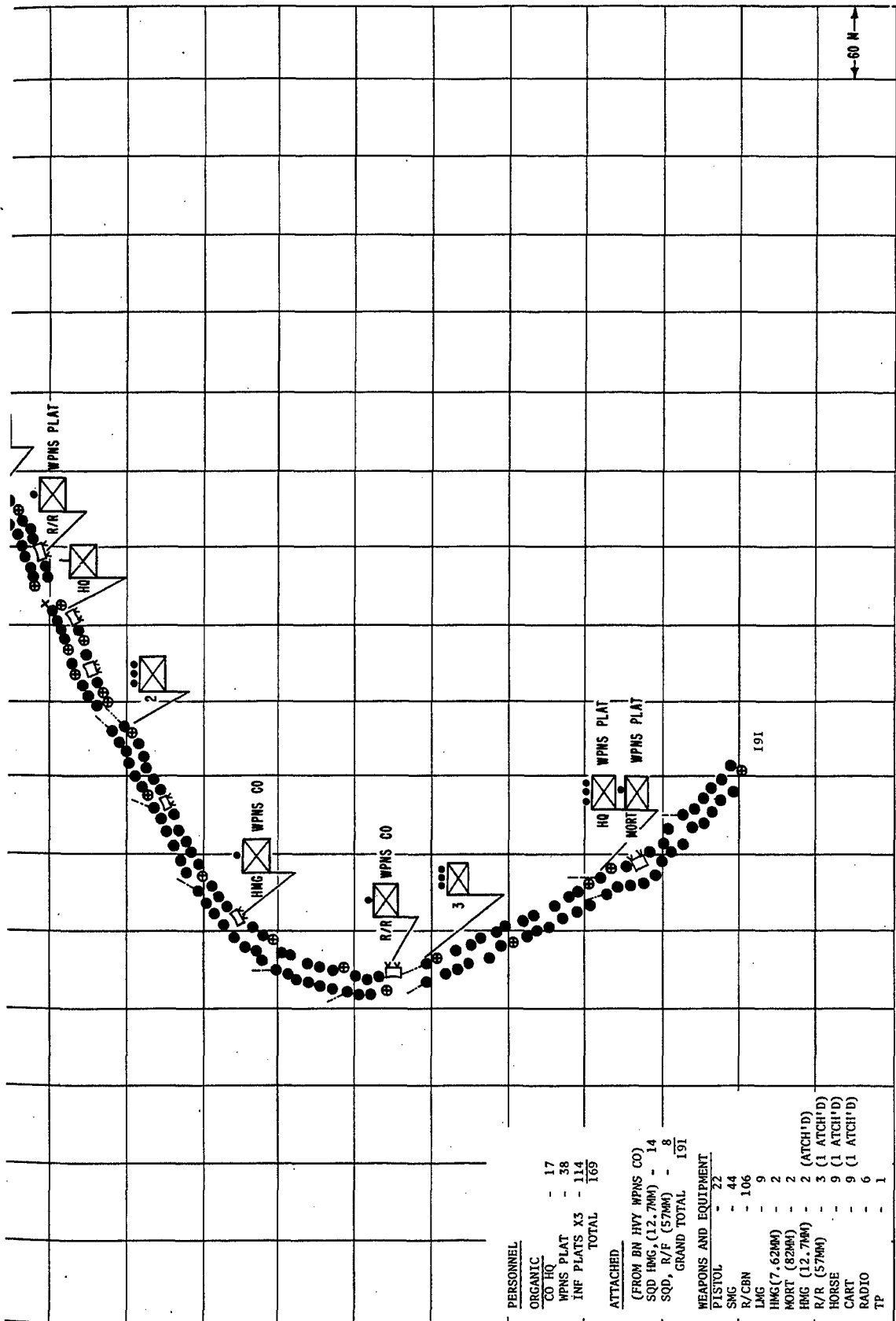


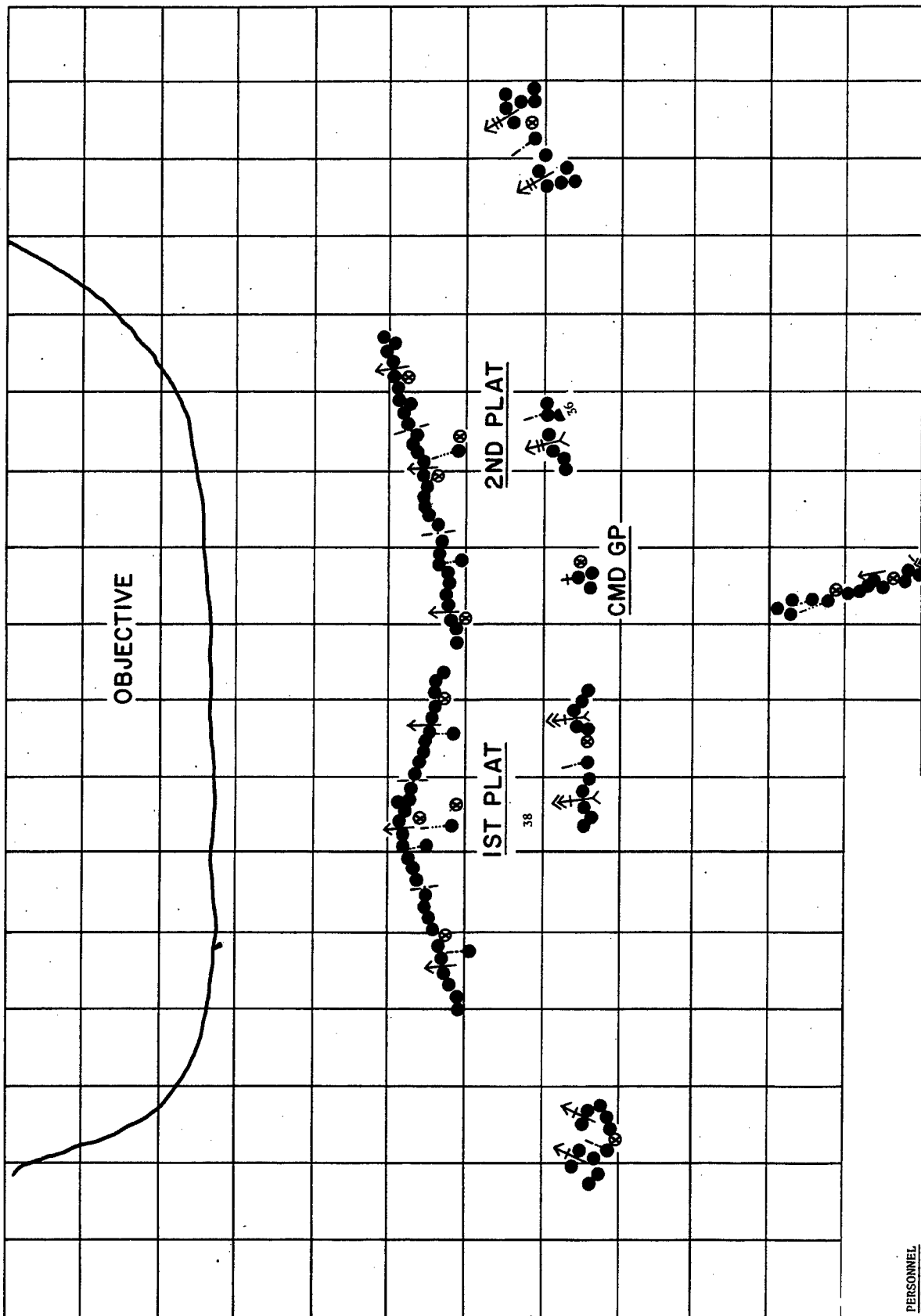
FIGURE A-55 (S). INFANTRY COMPANY (+) (U)
Dismounted Approach March

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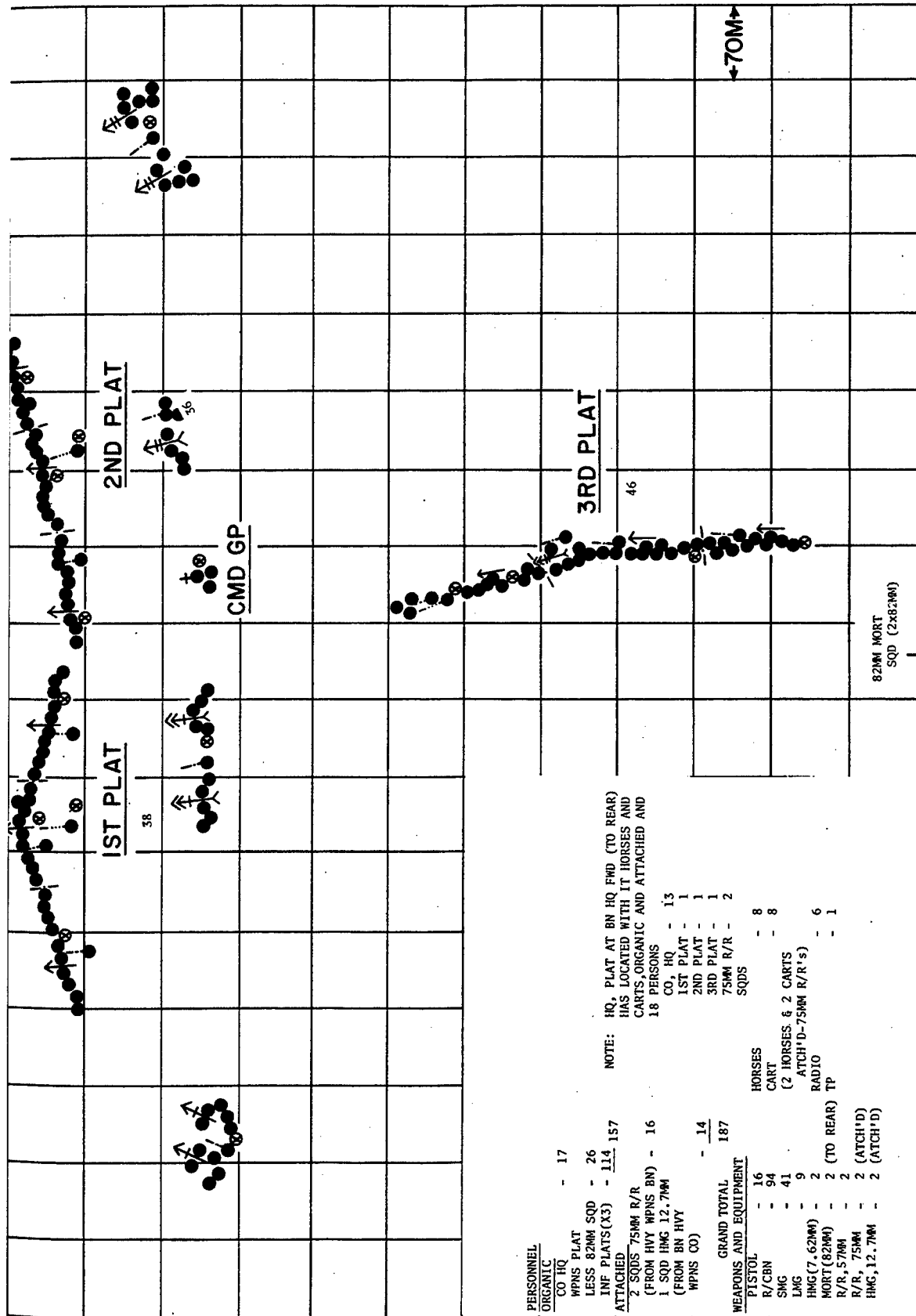
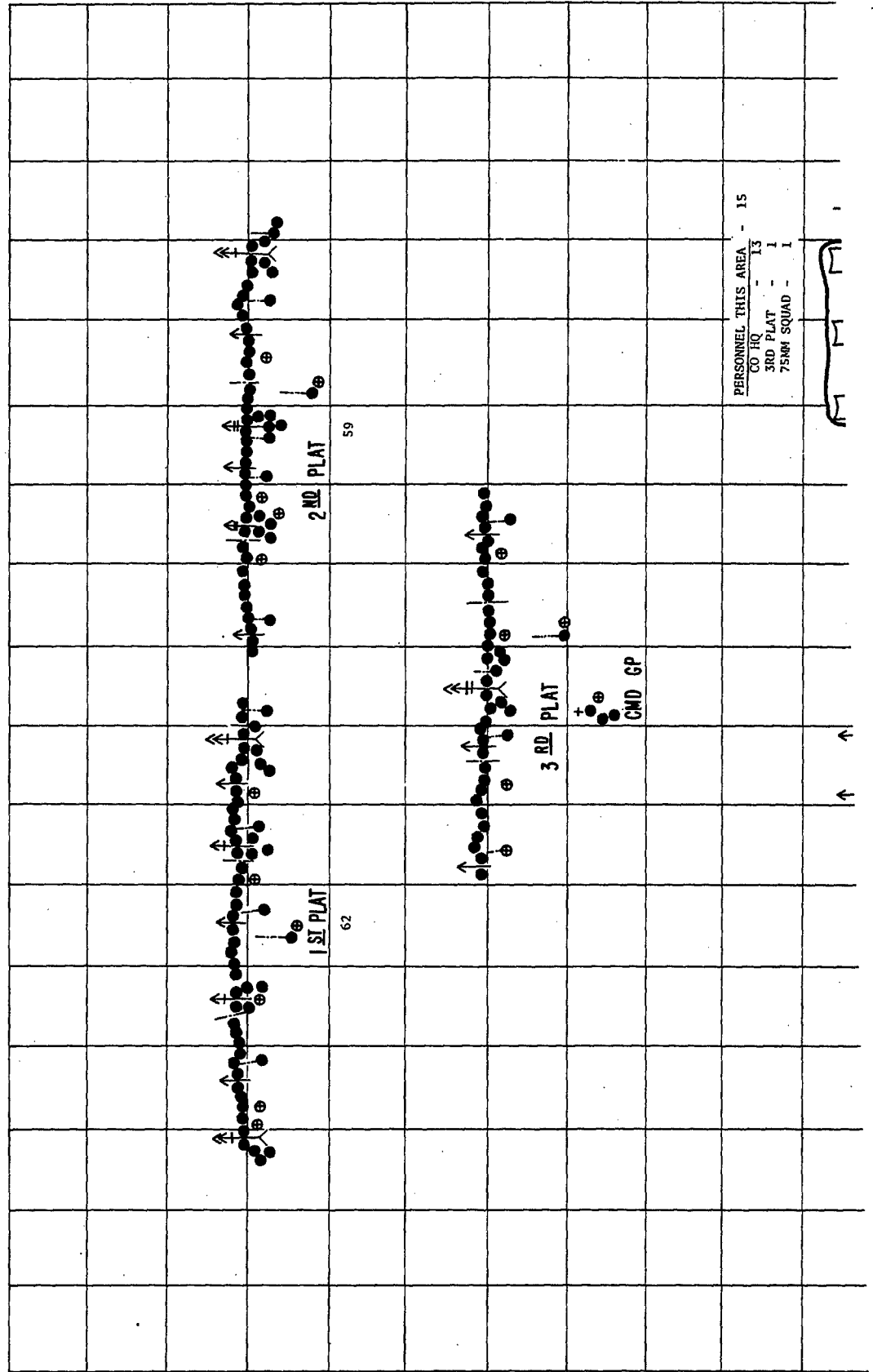


FIGURE A-56 (S). INFANTRY COMPANY (+) (U)

In the Attack

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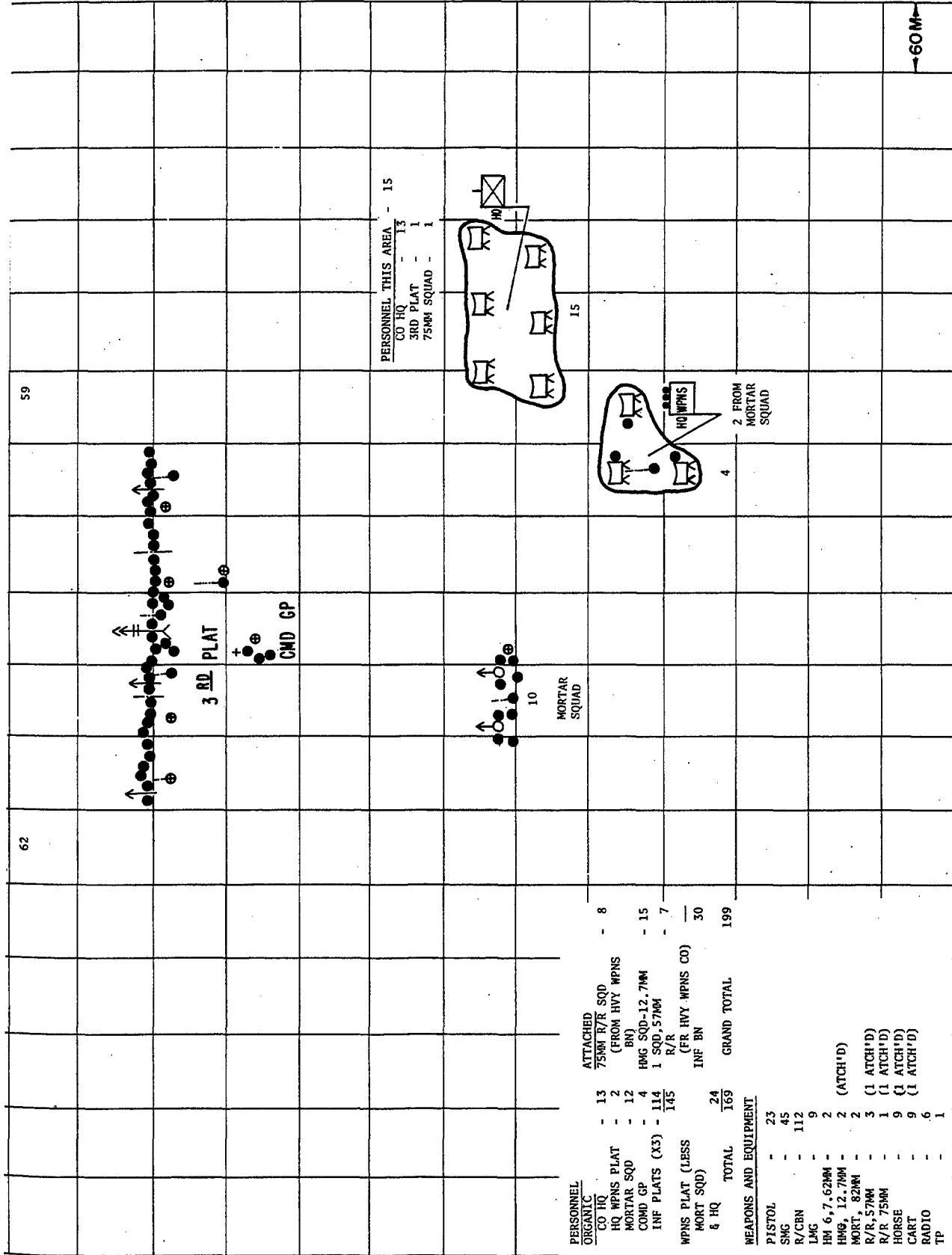
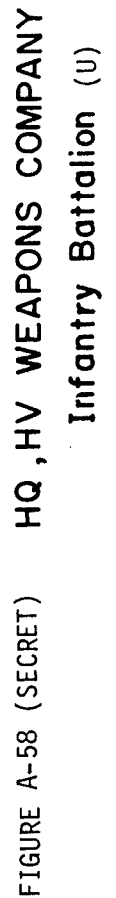


FIGURE A-57 (S). INFANTRY COMPANY (+) (U)
IN THE DEFENSE

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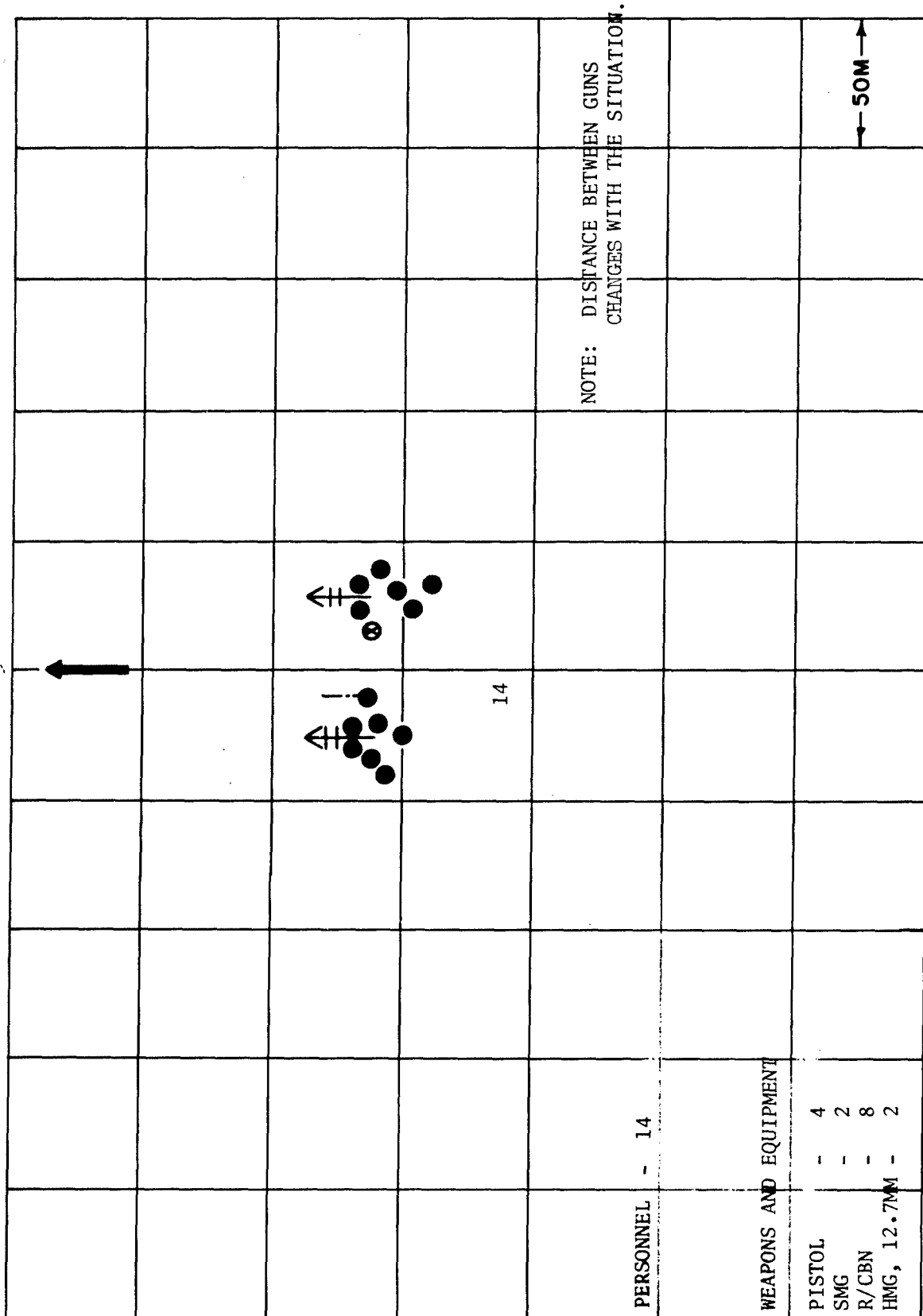


FIGURE A-59 (SECRET) HEAVY MACHINE GUN SQUAD (12.7mm)

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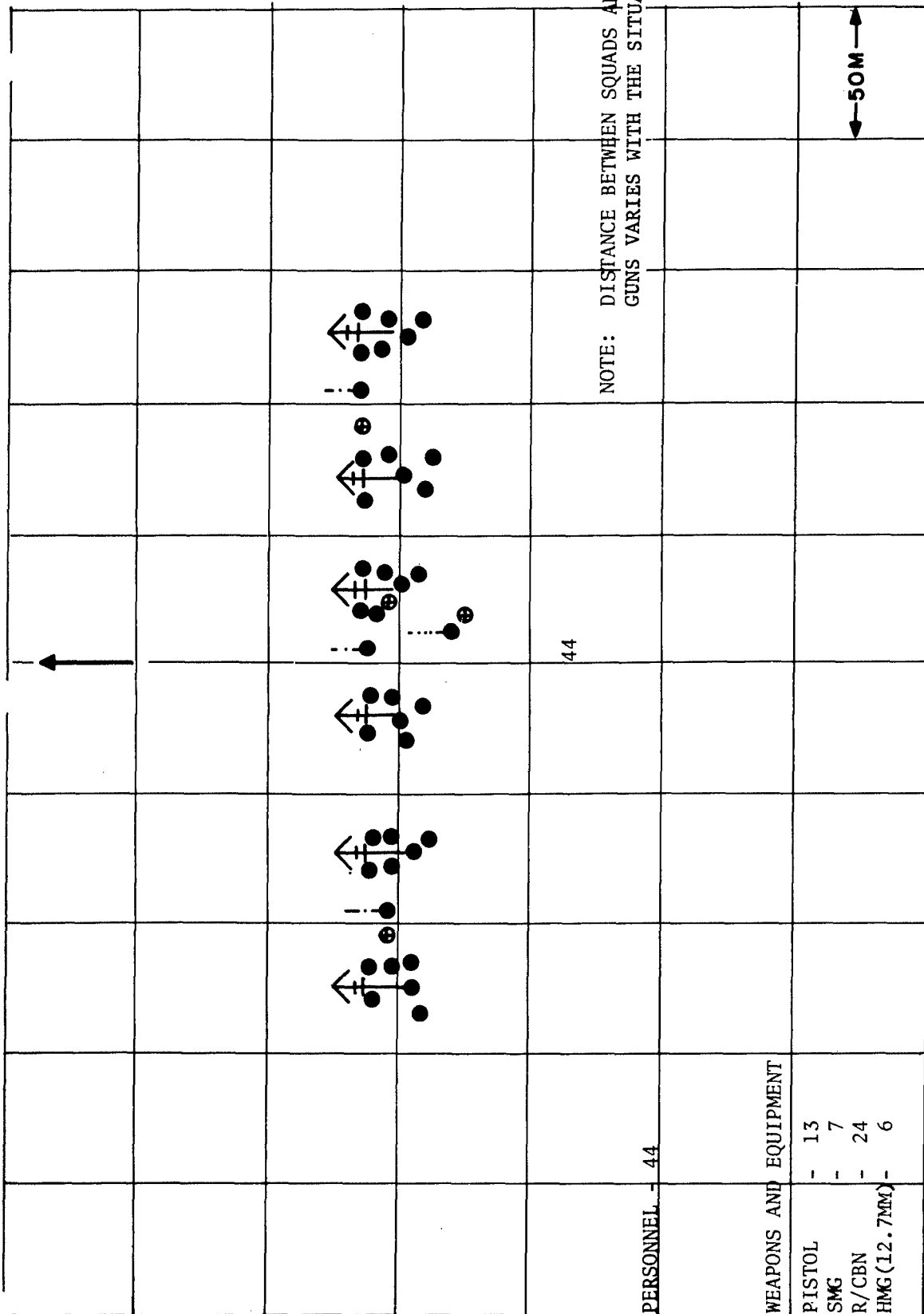


FIGURE A-61 (SECRET) HEAVY MACHINEGUN PLATOON (12.7 mm)

FIRING POSITION (U)

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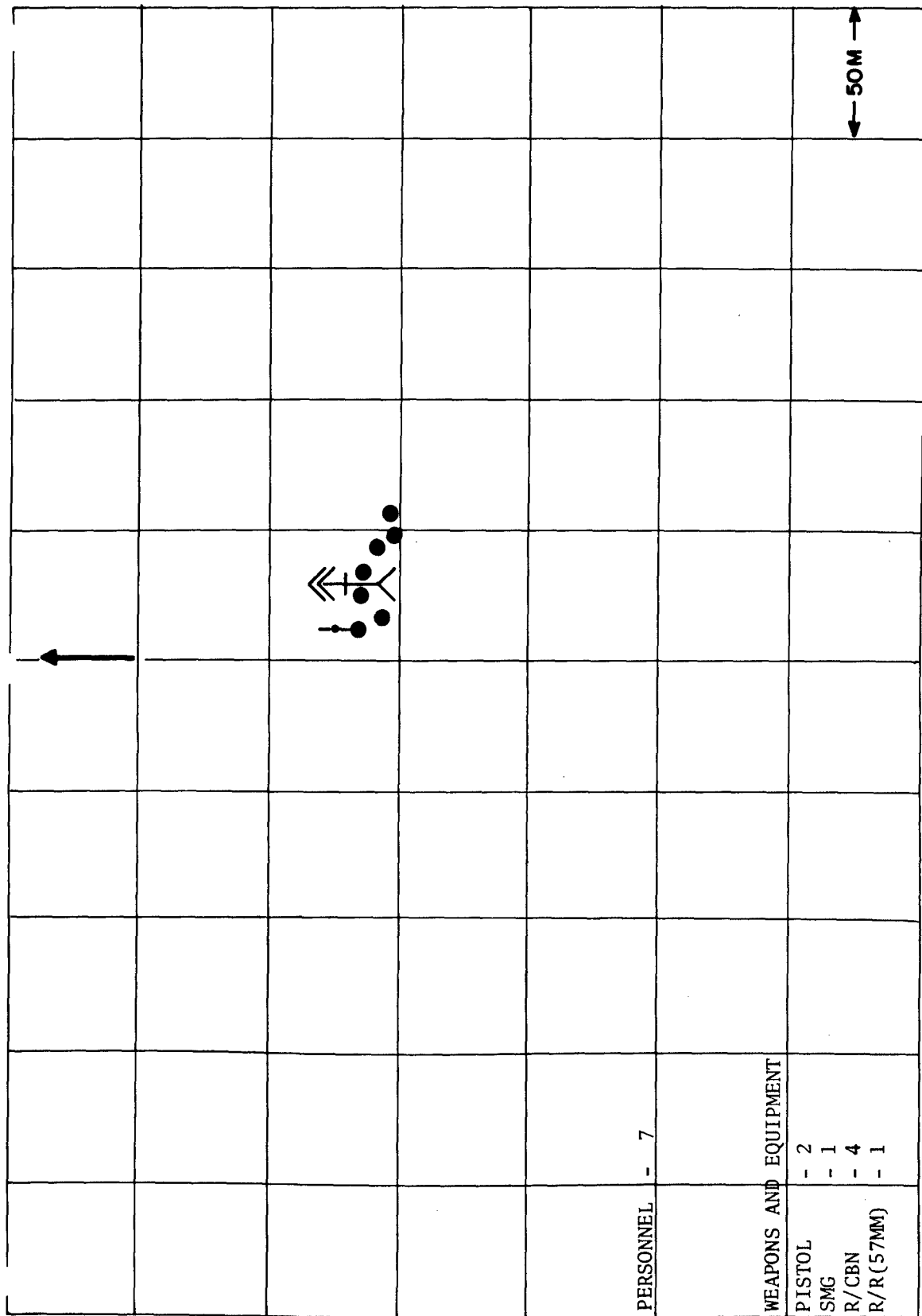


FIGURE A-62 (SECRET) RECOILLESS RIFLE SQUAD

FIRING POSITION (U)

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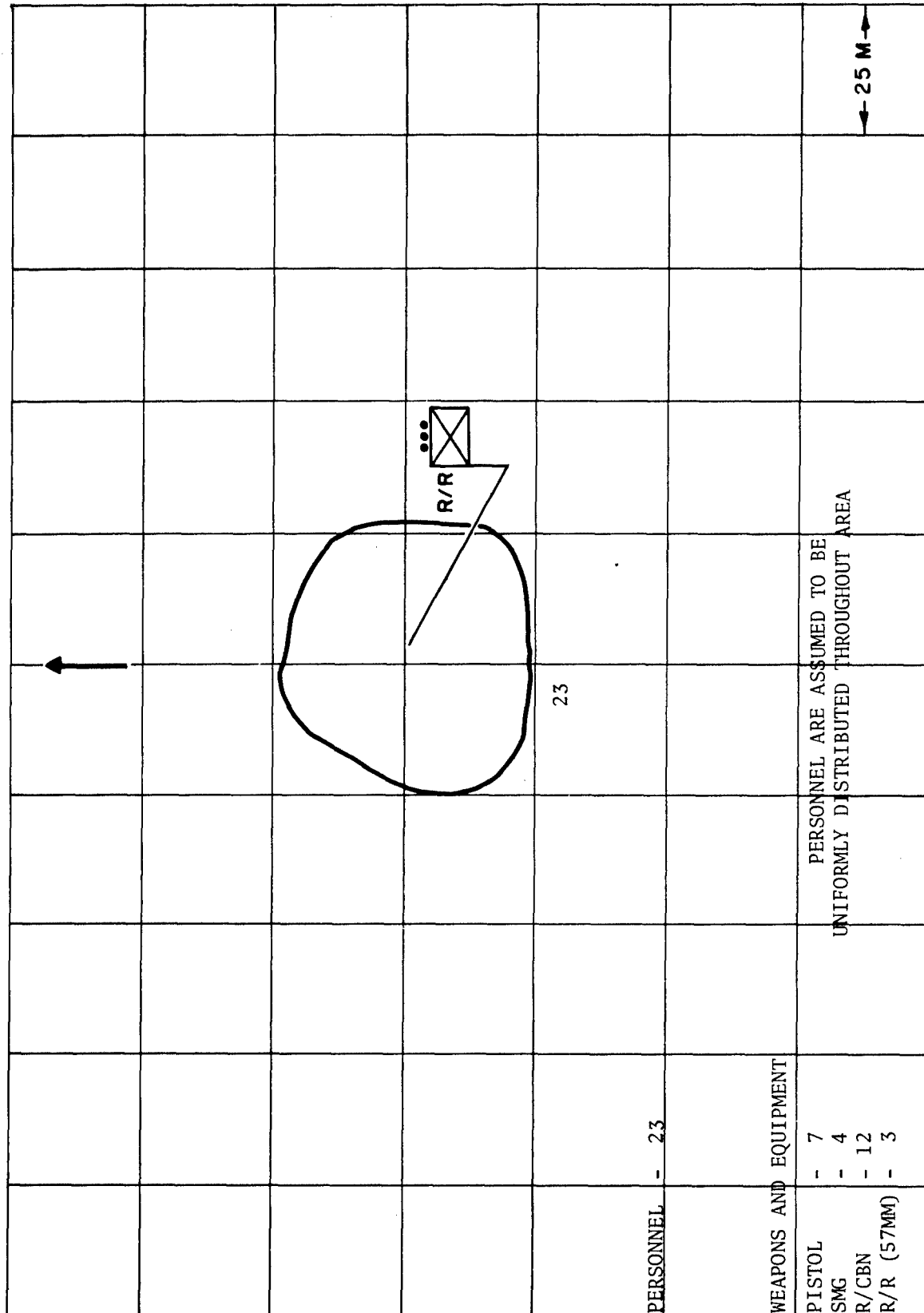


FIGURE A-63 (SECRET) RECOILLESS RIFLE PLATOON

ASSEMBLY AREA (U)

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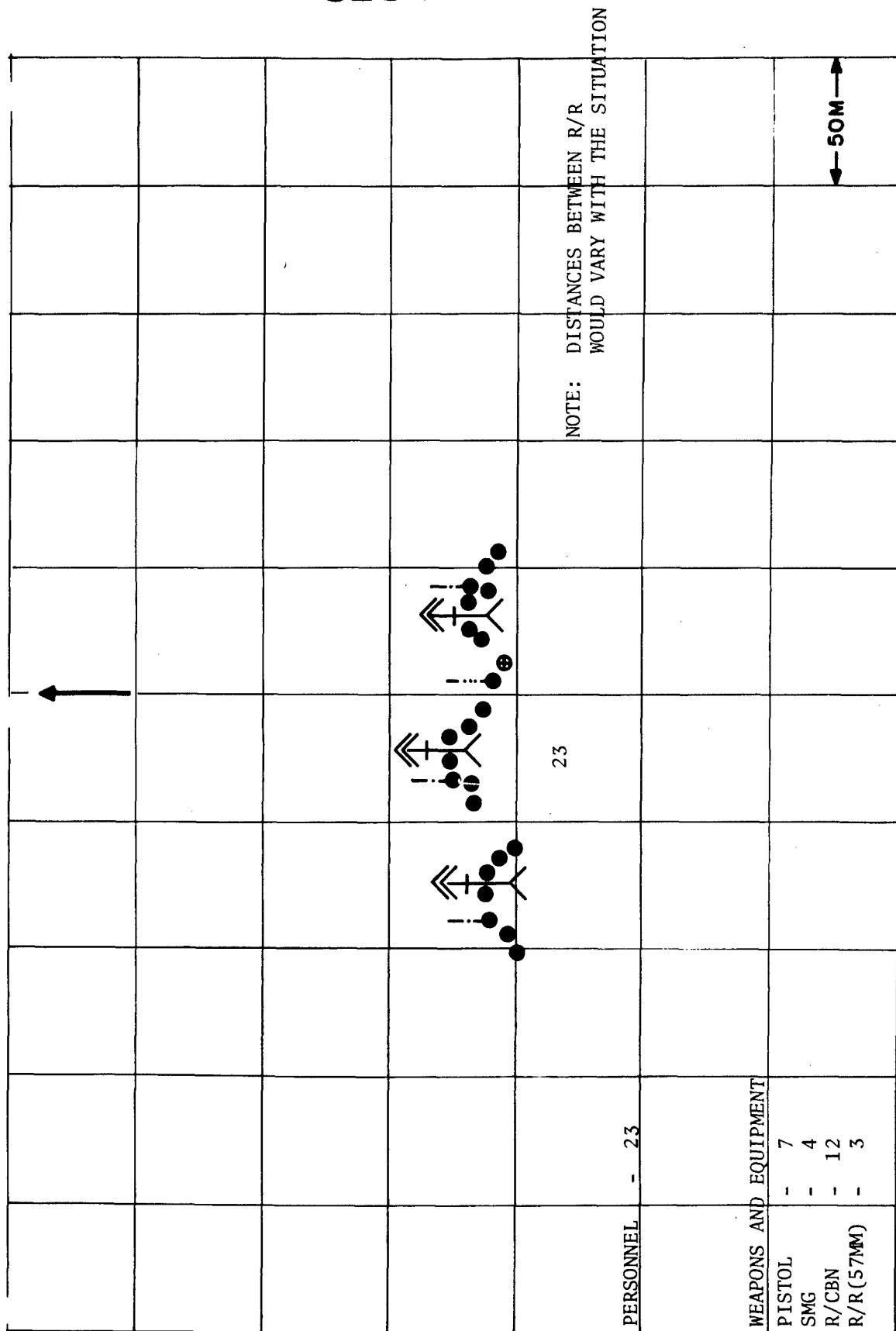


FIGURE A-64 (SECRET) RECOILLESS RIFLE PLATOON

FIRING POSITION (U)

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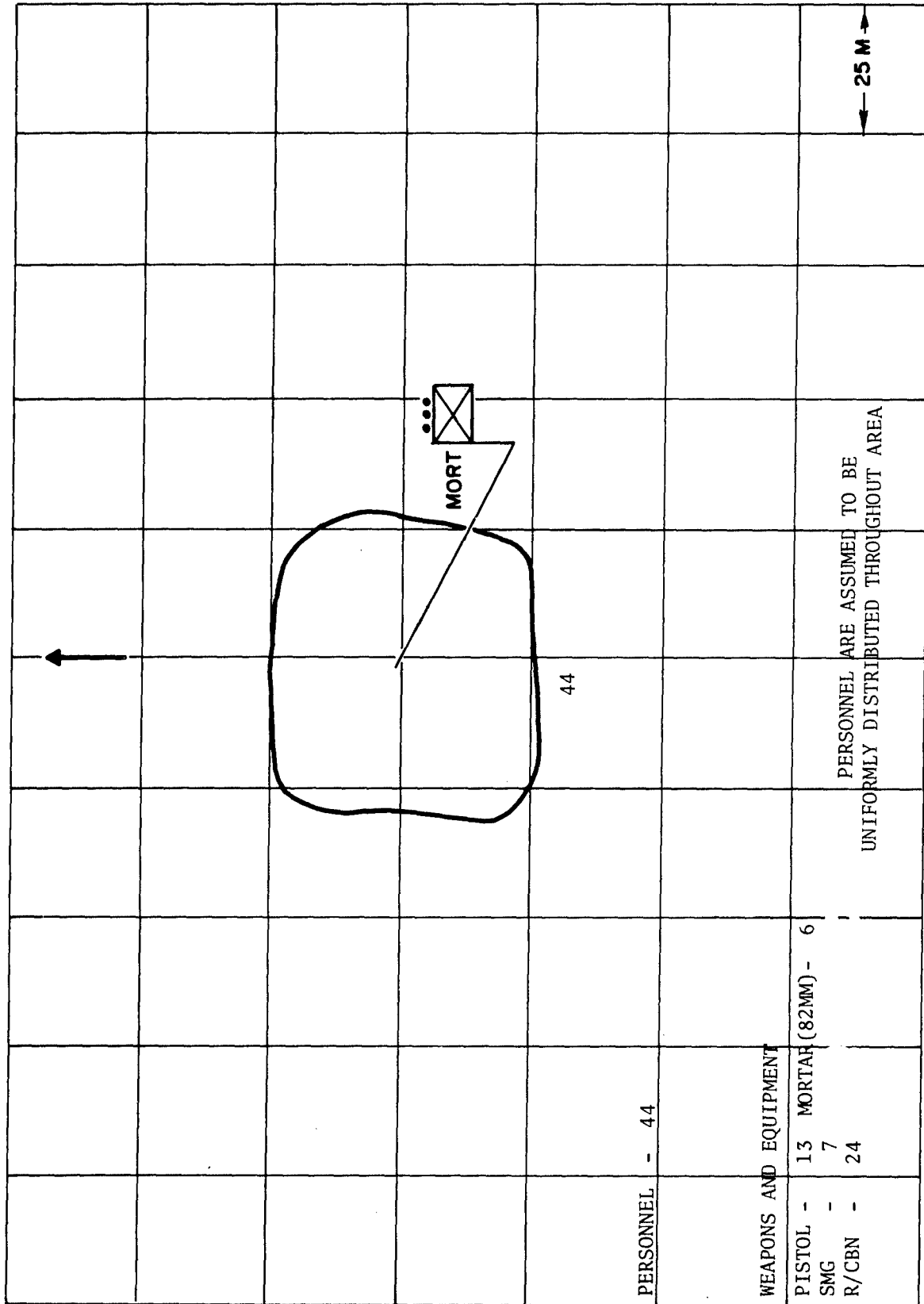


FIGURE A-65 (SECRET) MORTAR PLATOON

ASSEMBLY AREA (U)

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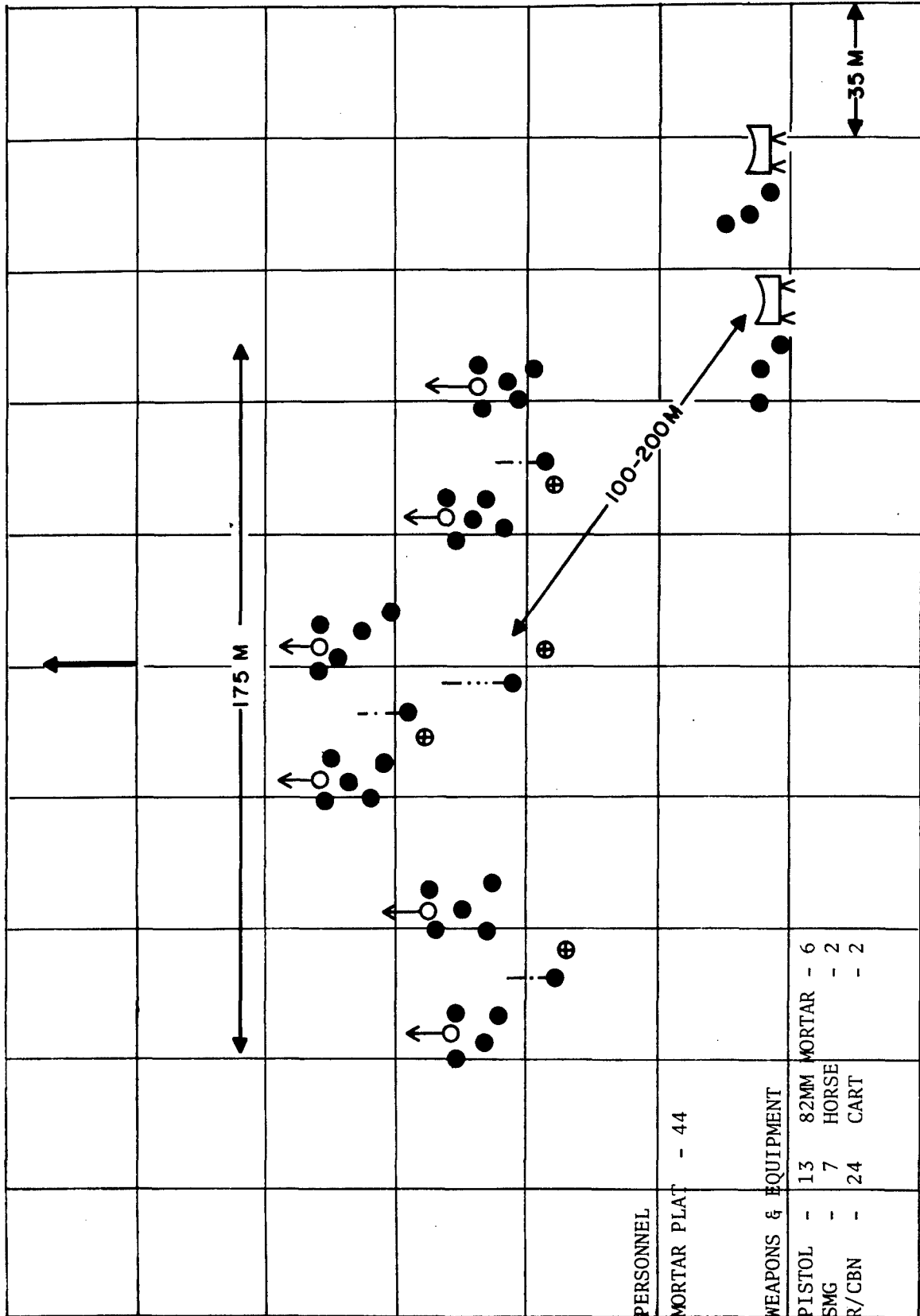


FIGURE A-66 (SECRET) MORTAR PLATOON

FIRING POSITION (U)

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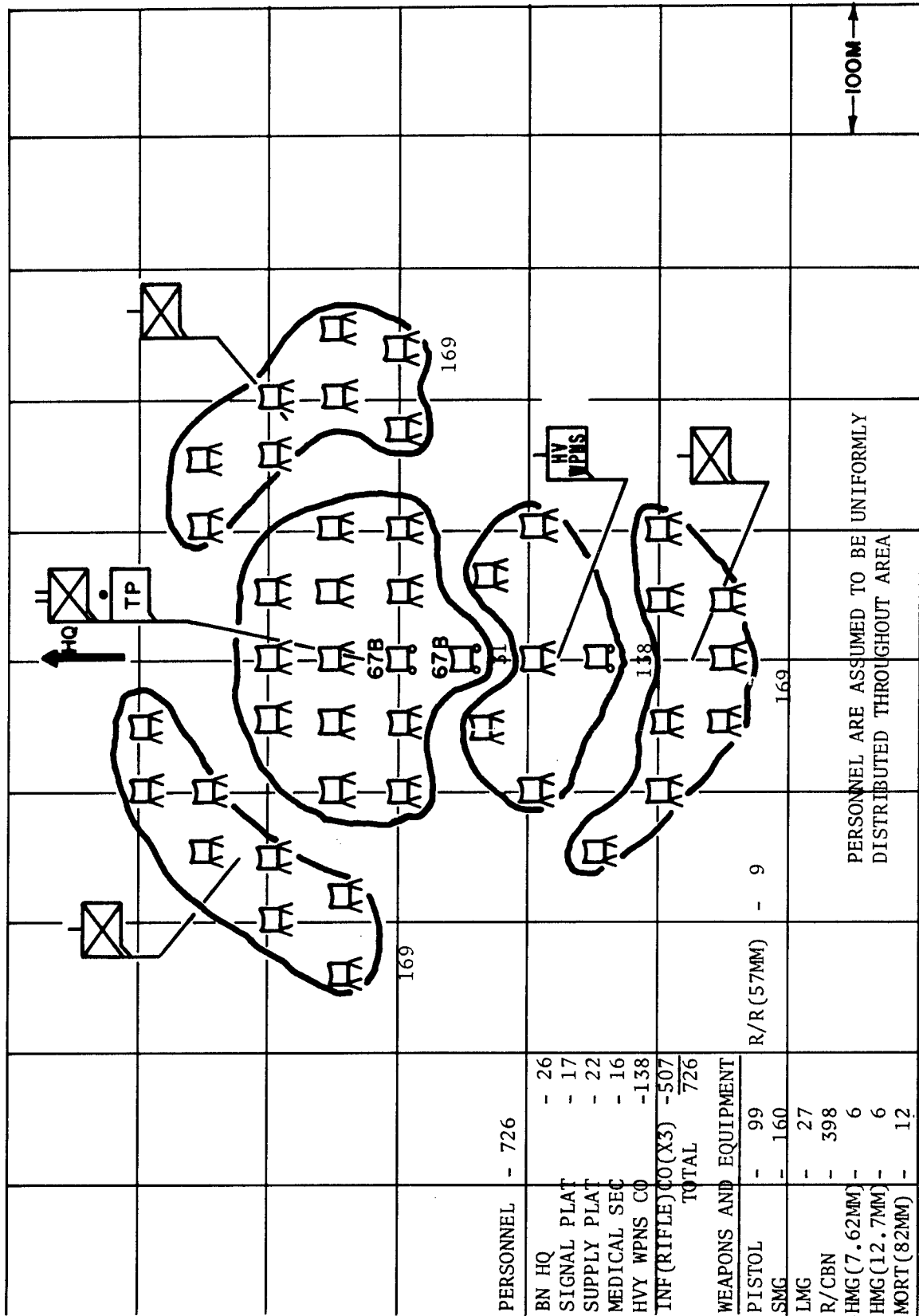


FIGURE A-68 (SECRET) INFANTRY BATTALION

(ASSEMBLY AREA) (U)

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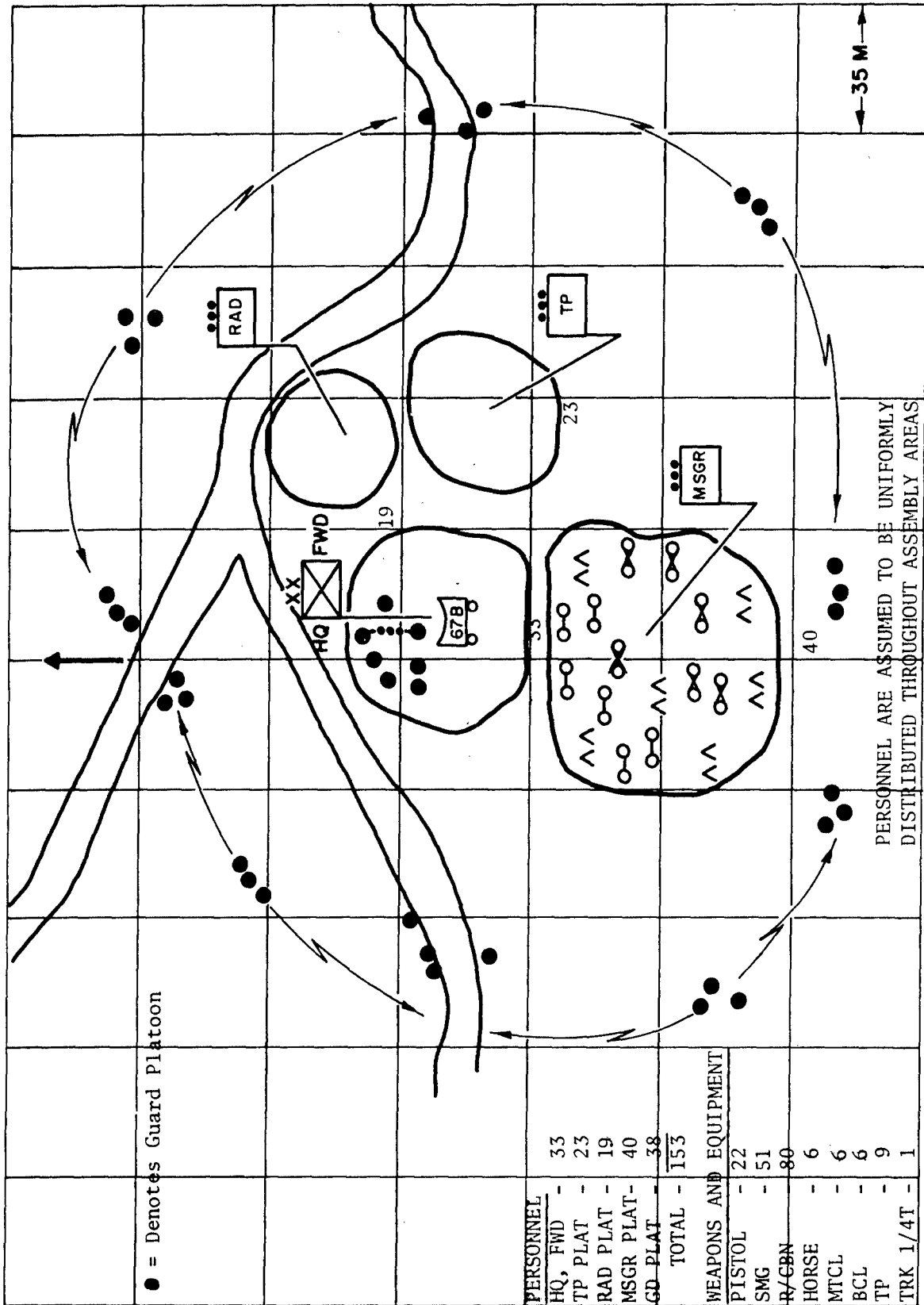


FIGURE A-69 (SECRET) DIVISION HEADQUARTERS (FWD) (U)

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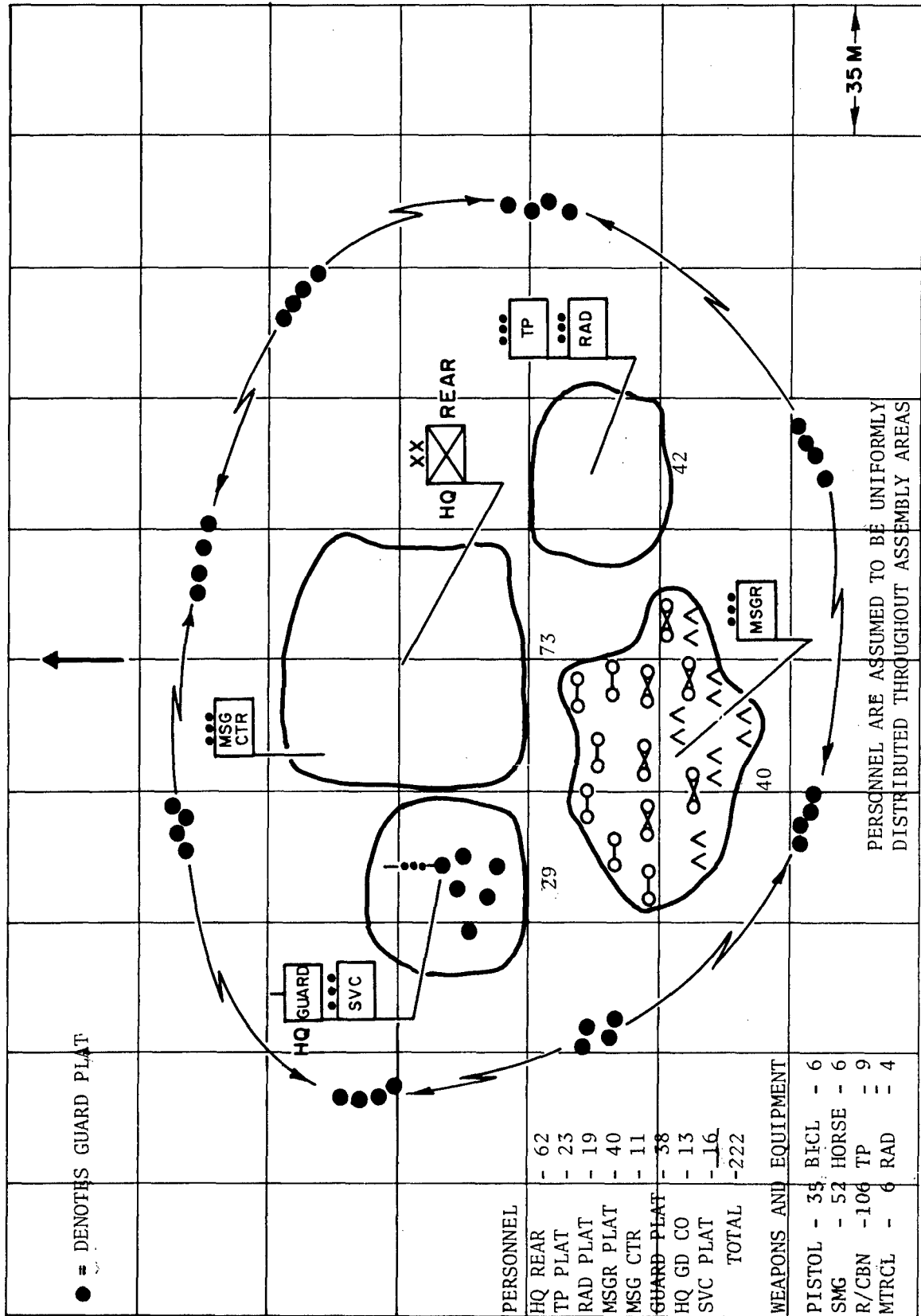


FIGURE A-70 (SECRET) DIVISION HEADQUARTERS (REAR) (U)

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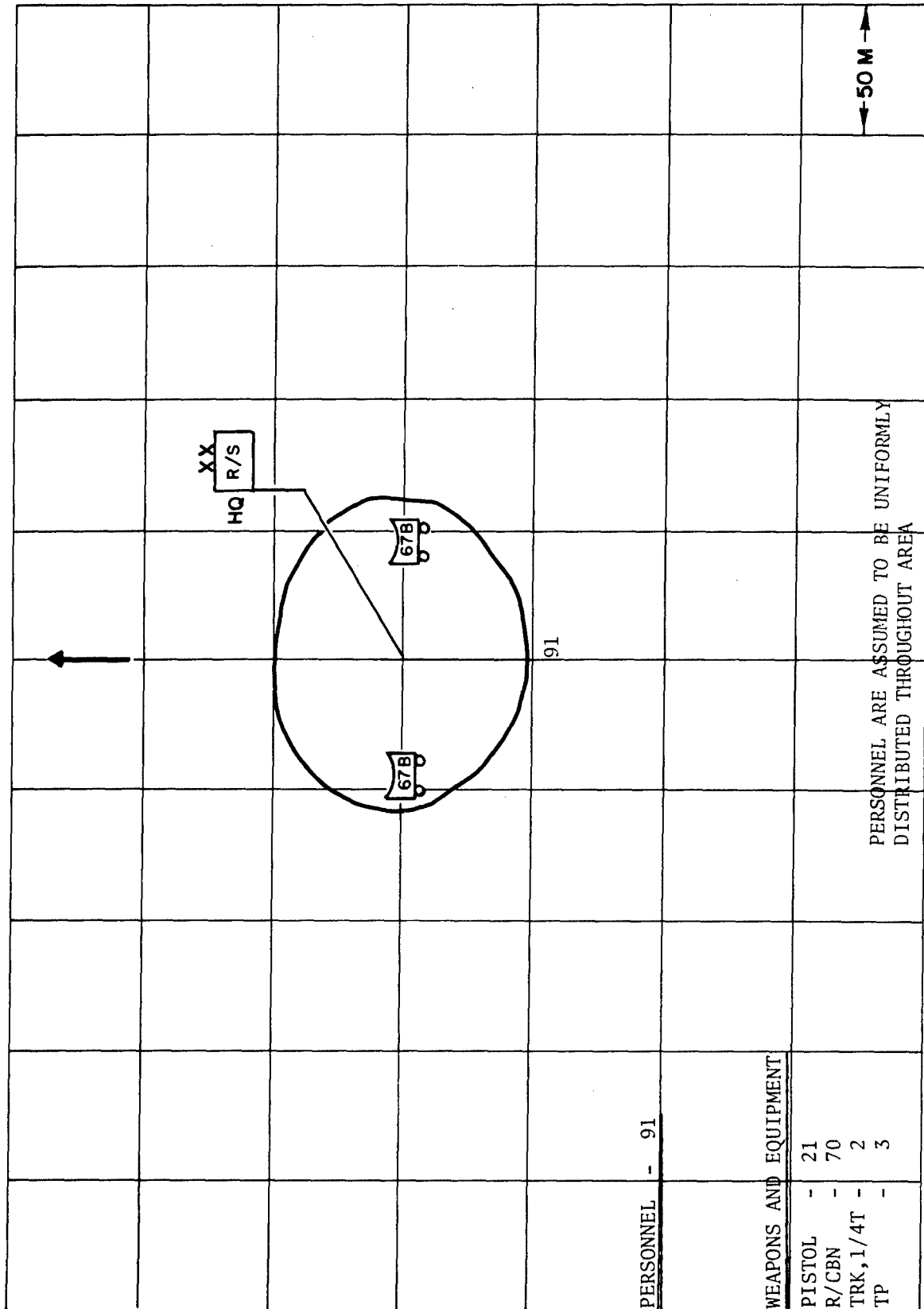


FIGURE A-71 (SECRET) HQ, REAR SERVICE BUREAU
(ASSEMBLY AREA) (U)

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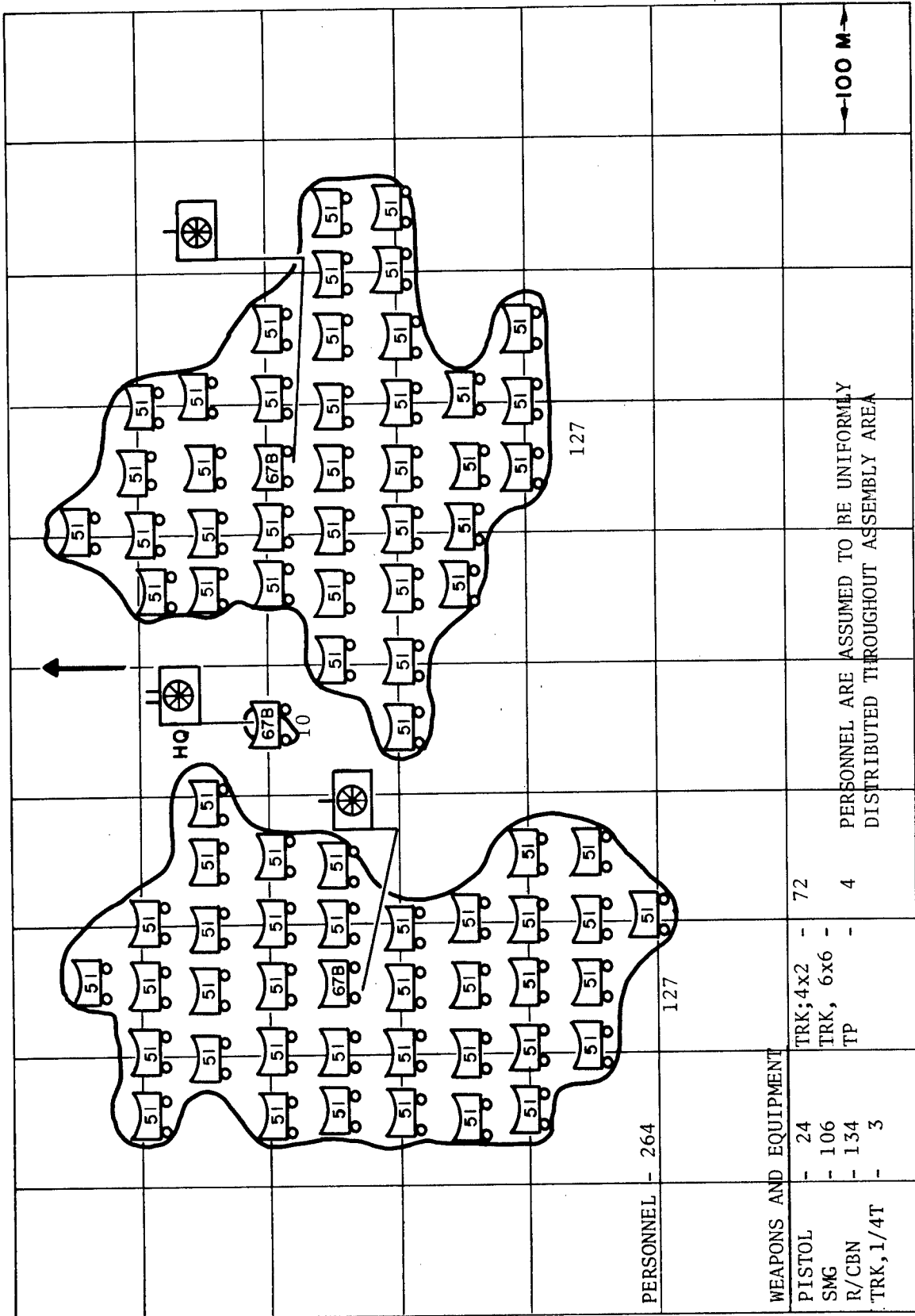


FIGURE A-72 (SECRET) TRANSPORTATION BATTALION
ASSEMBLY AREA (U)

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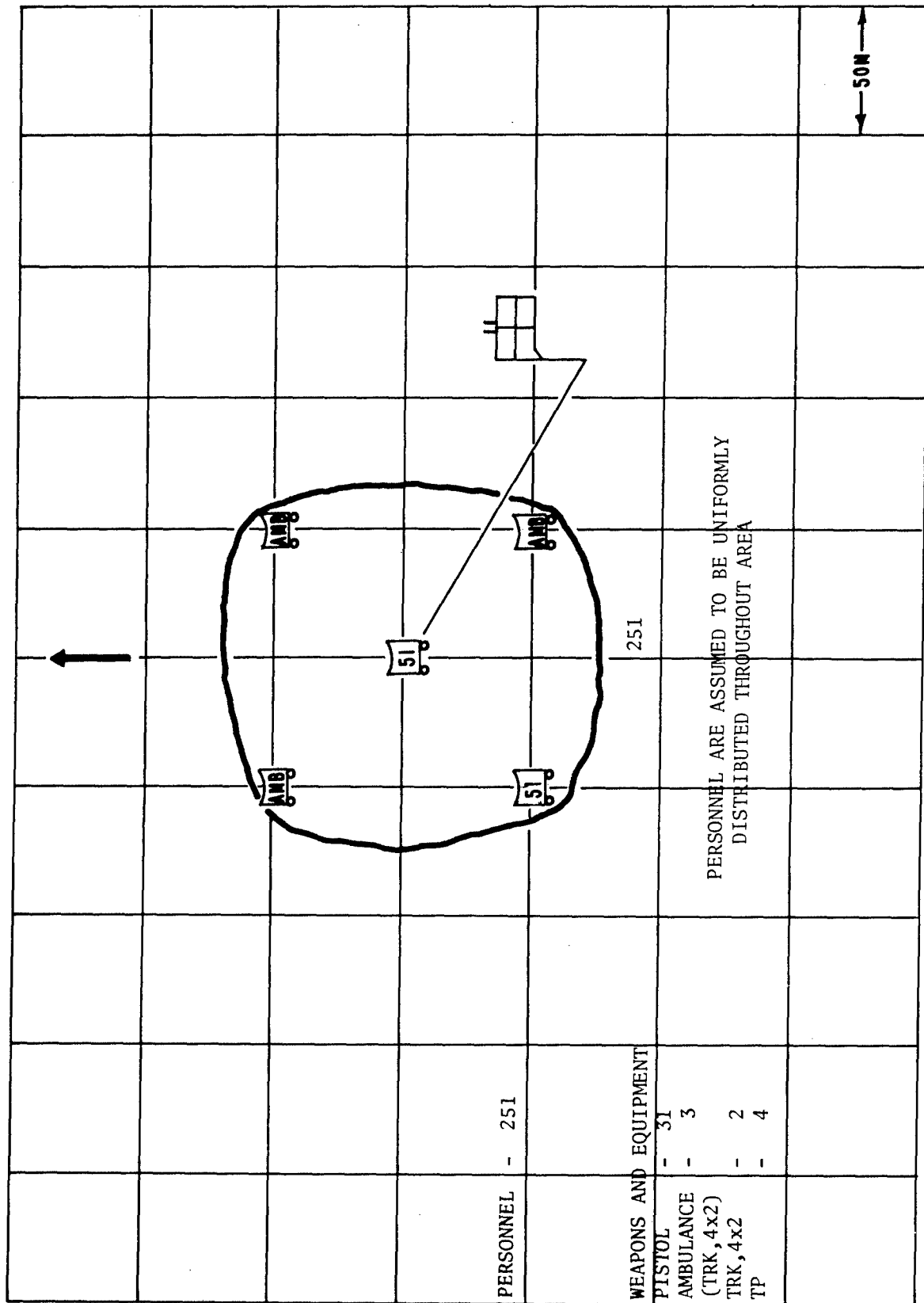


FIGURE A-73 (SECRET) MEDICAL BATTALION R/S
(ASSEMBLY AREA) (U)

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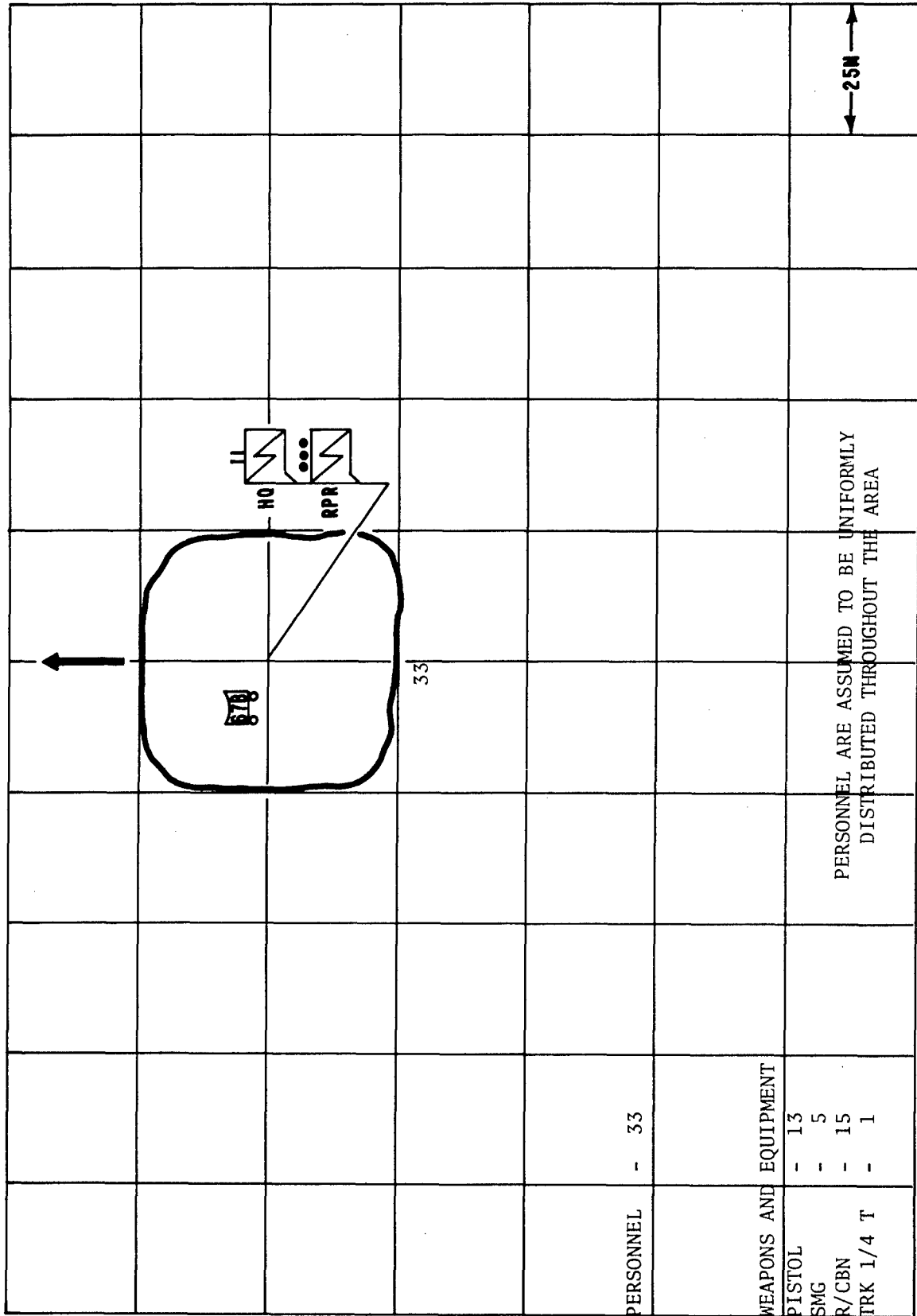


FIGURE A-74 (SECRET) HQ, SIGNAL BATTALION

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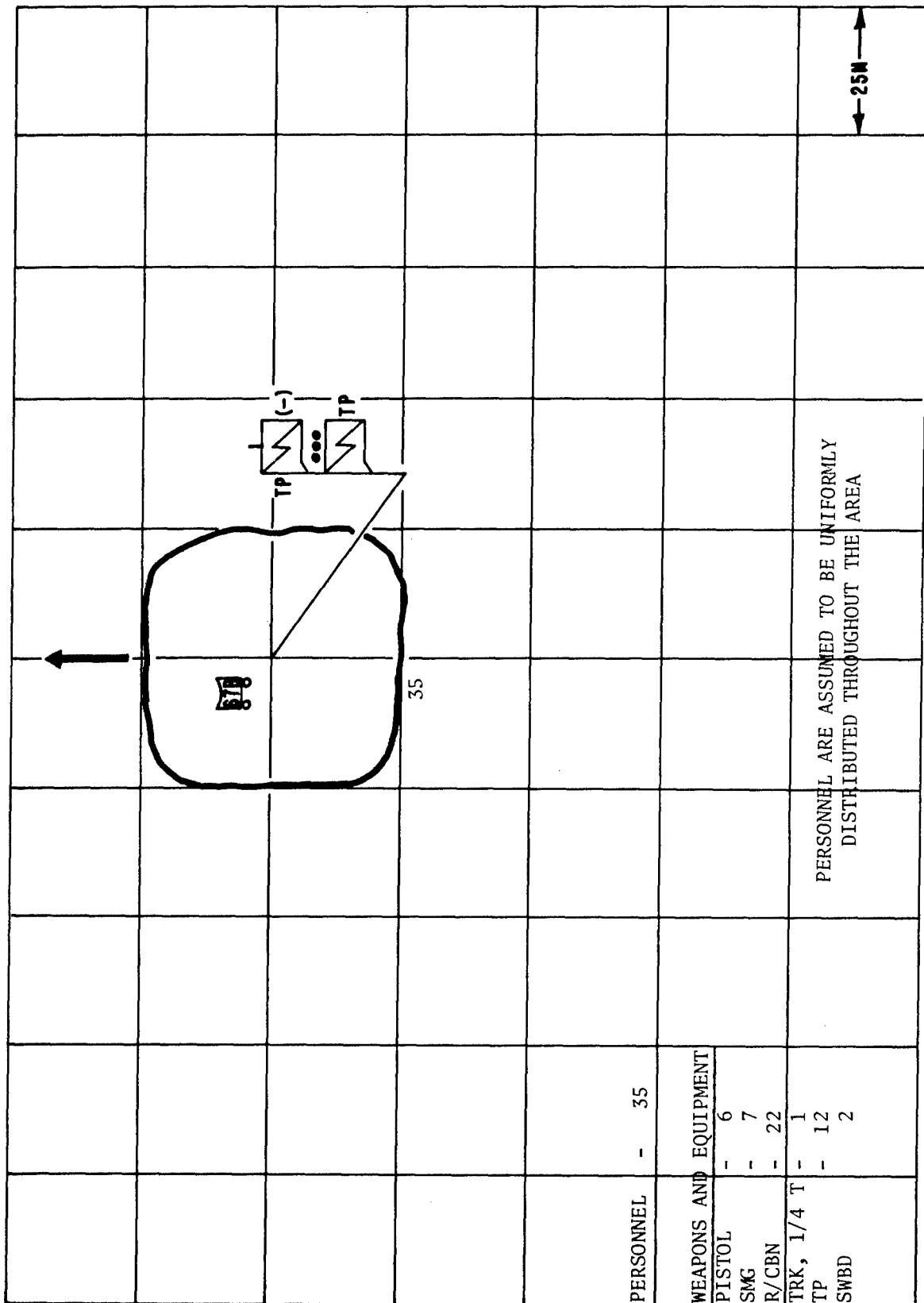


FIGURE A-75 (SECRET) HQ, TELEPHONE COMPANY

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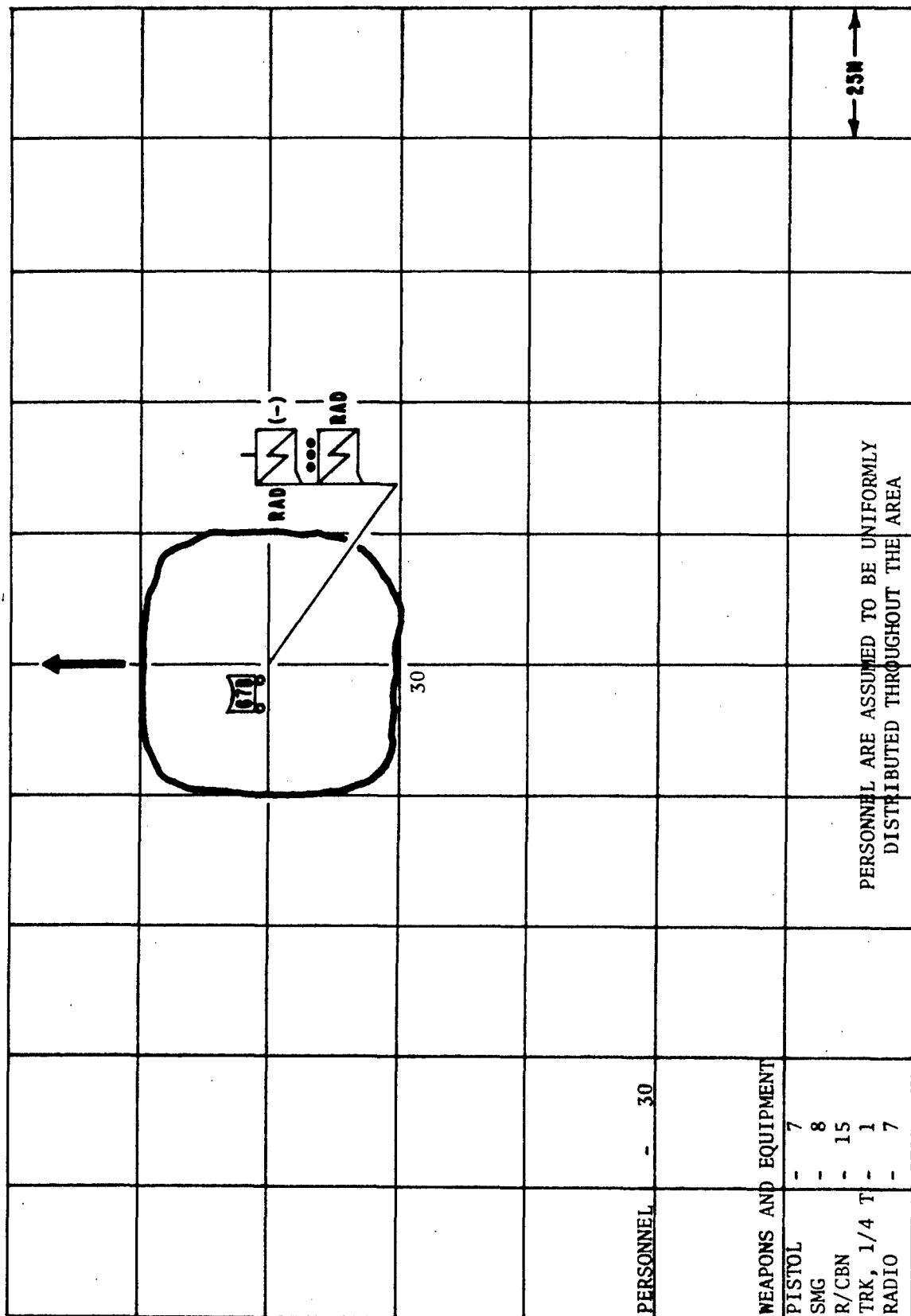


FIGURE A-76 (SECRET) HQ, RADIO COMPANY

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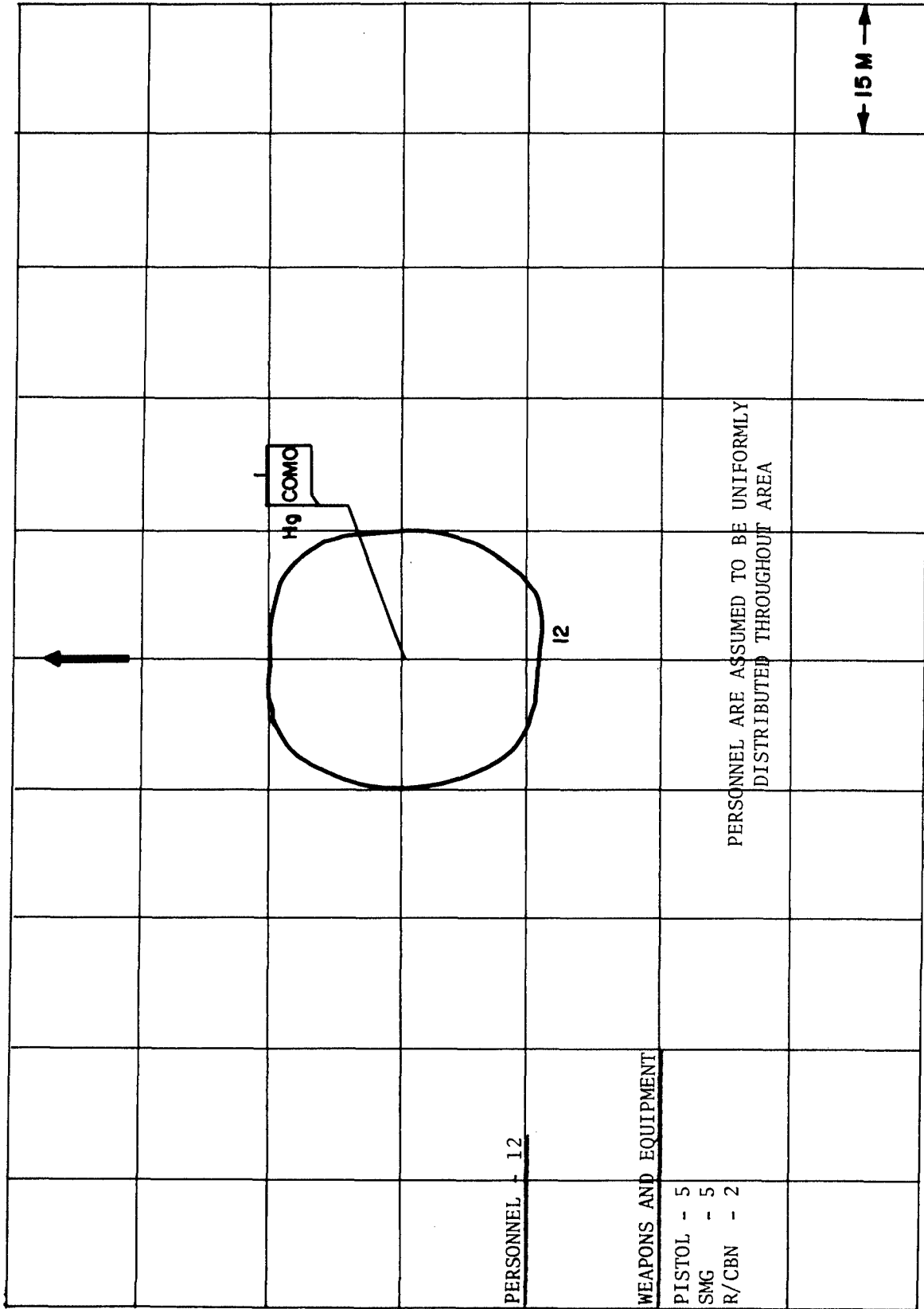


FIGURE A-77 (SECRET) HQ, COMMUNICATION COMPANY (-)

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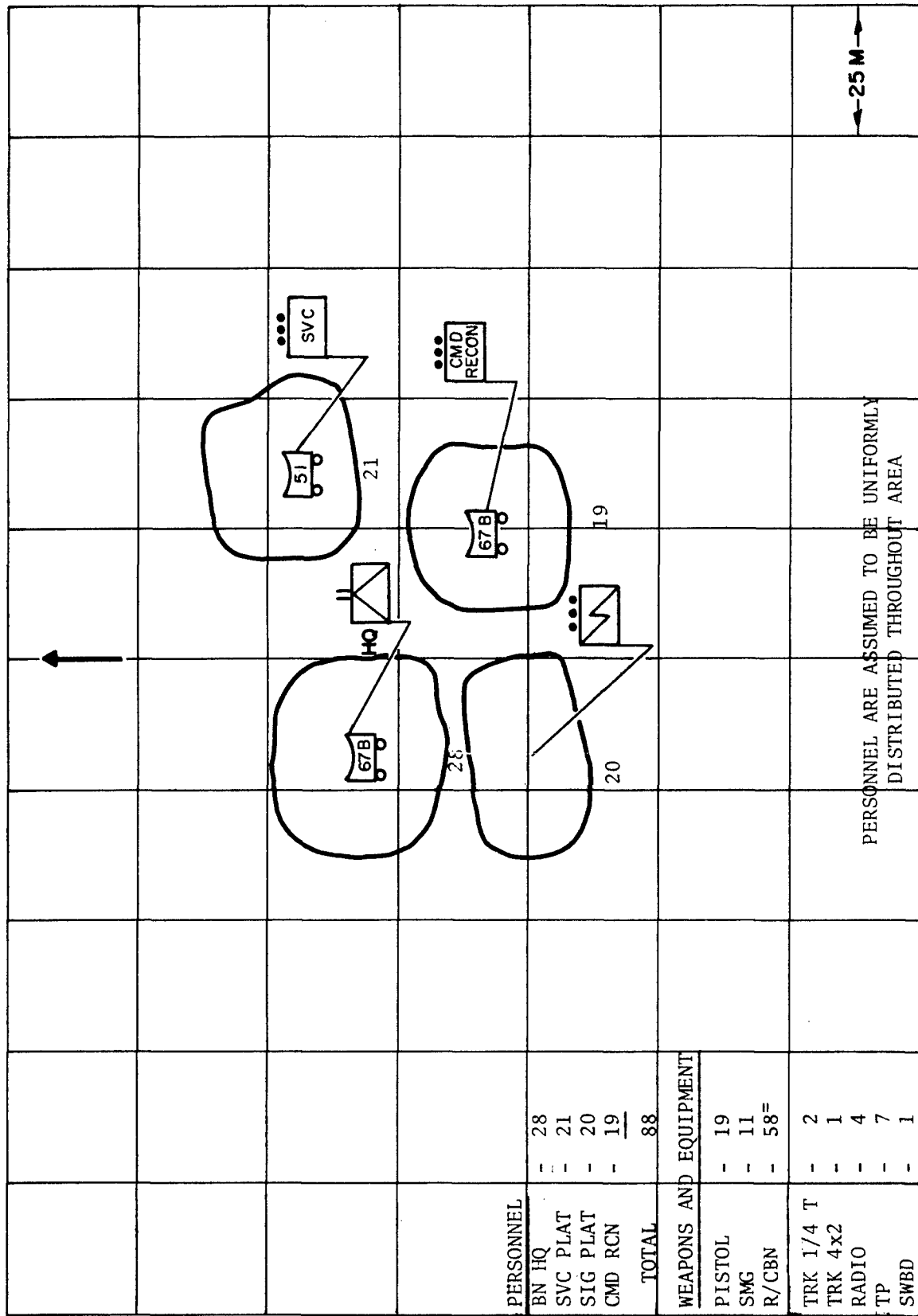


FIGURE A-78 (SECRET) HQ, ANTITANK BATTALION (85 MM) (U)

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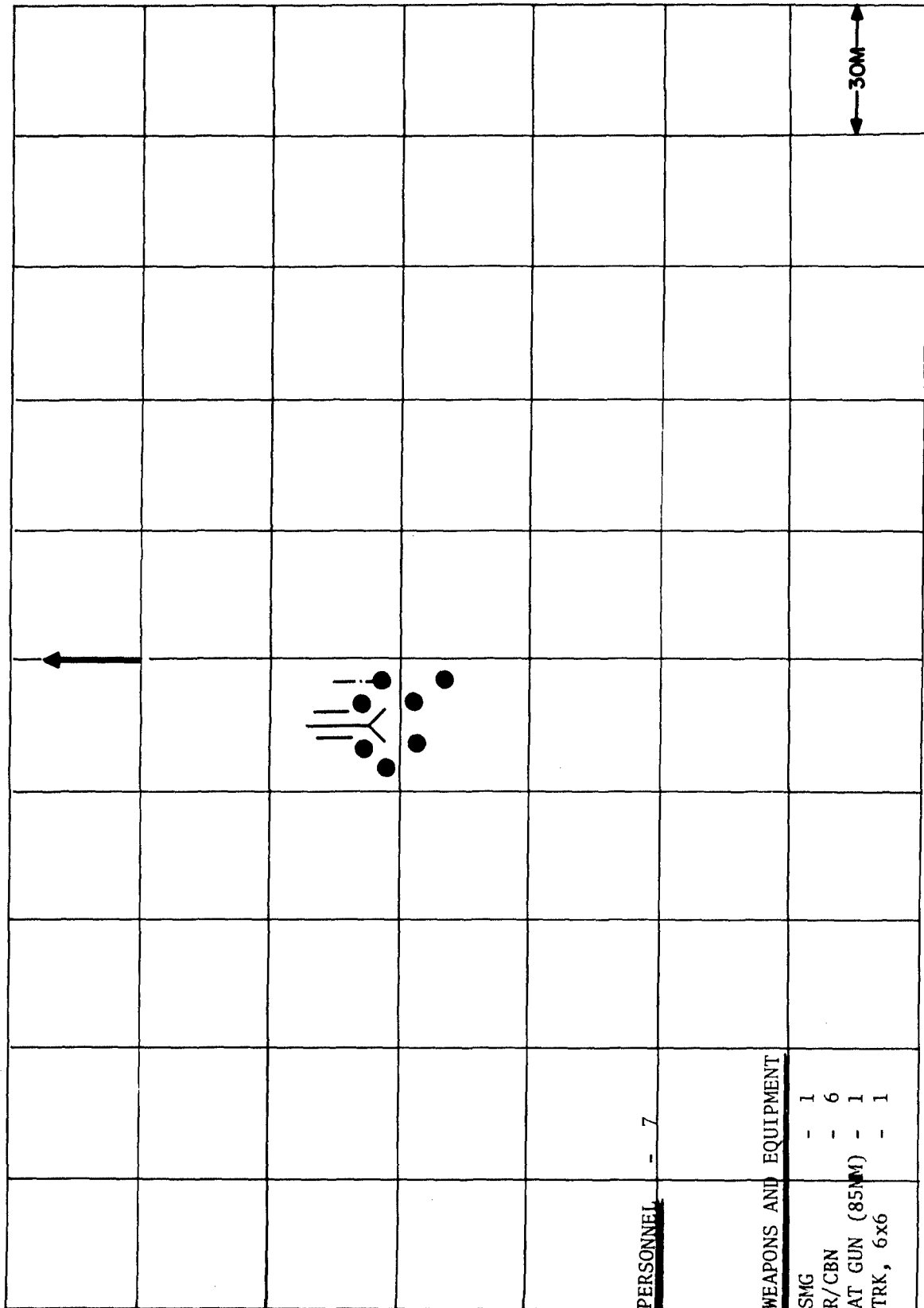
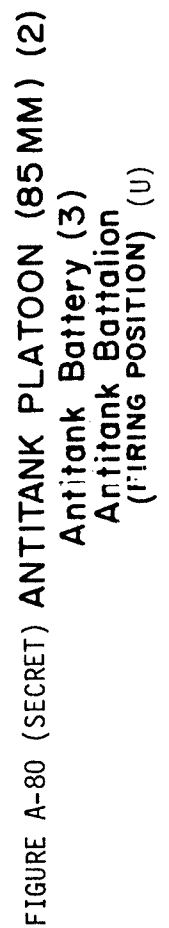


FIGURE A-79 (SECRET) ANTITANK SQUAD (85 MM) (4)

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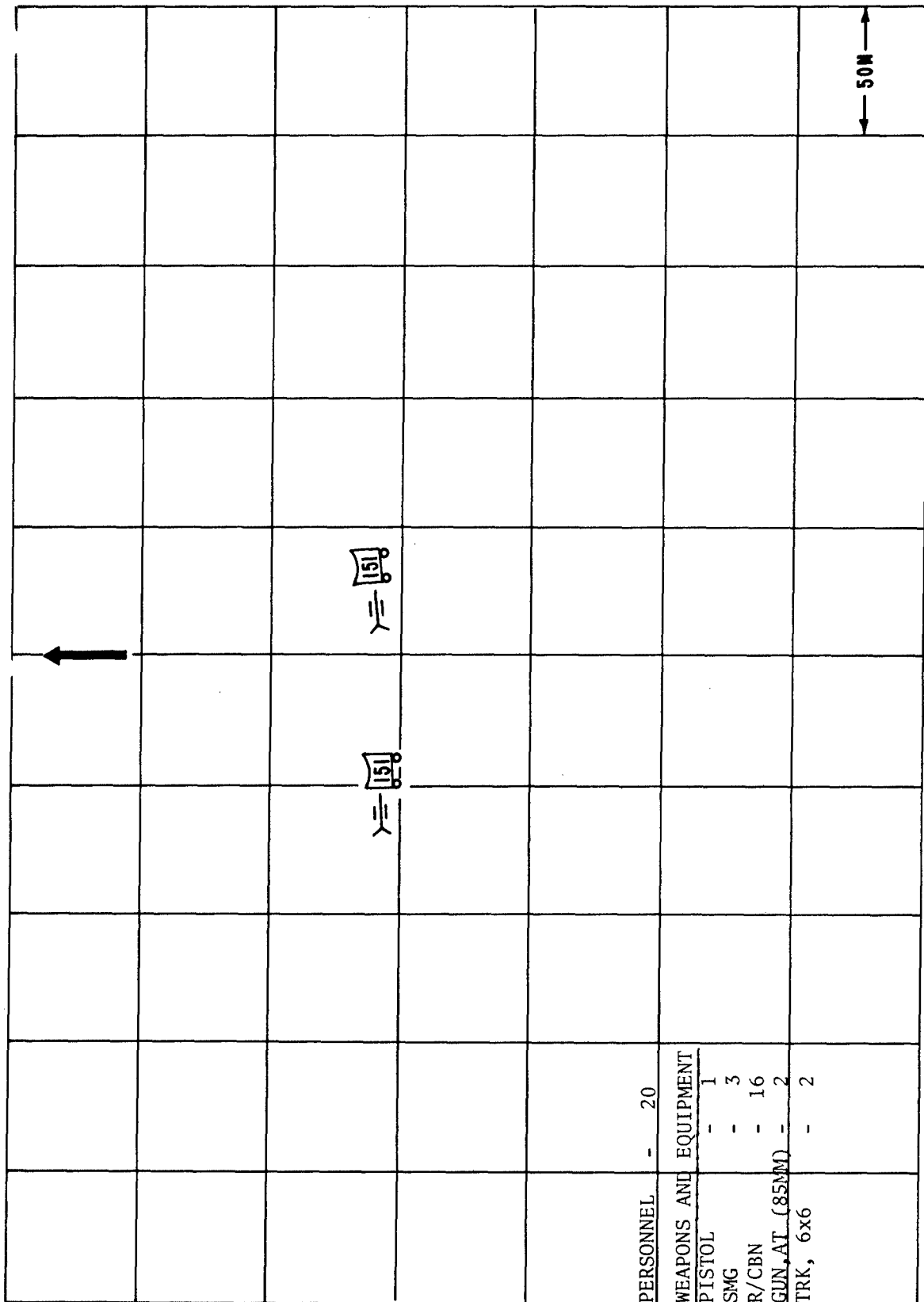


FIGURE A-81 (SECRET) ANTITANK PLATOON (85mm) (2)

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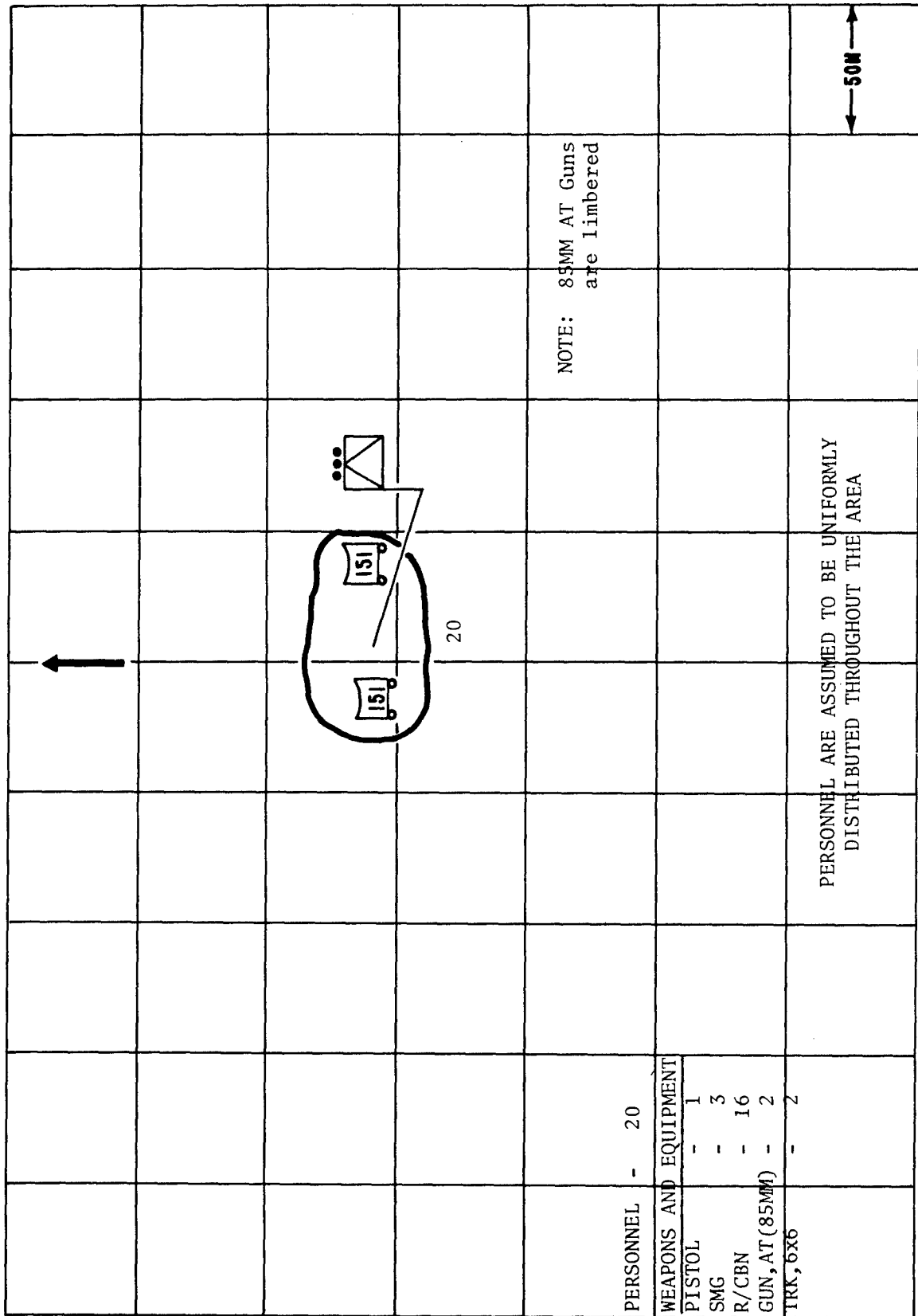


FIGURE A-82 (SECRET) ANTITANK PLATOON (85mm) (2)

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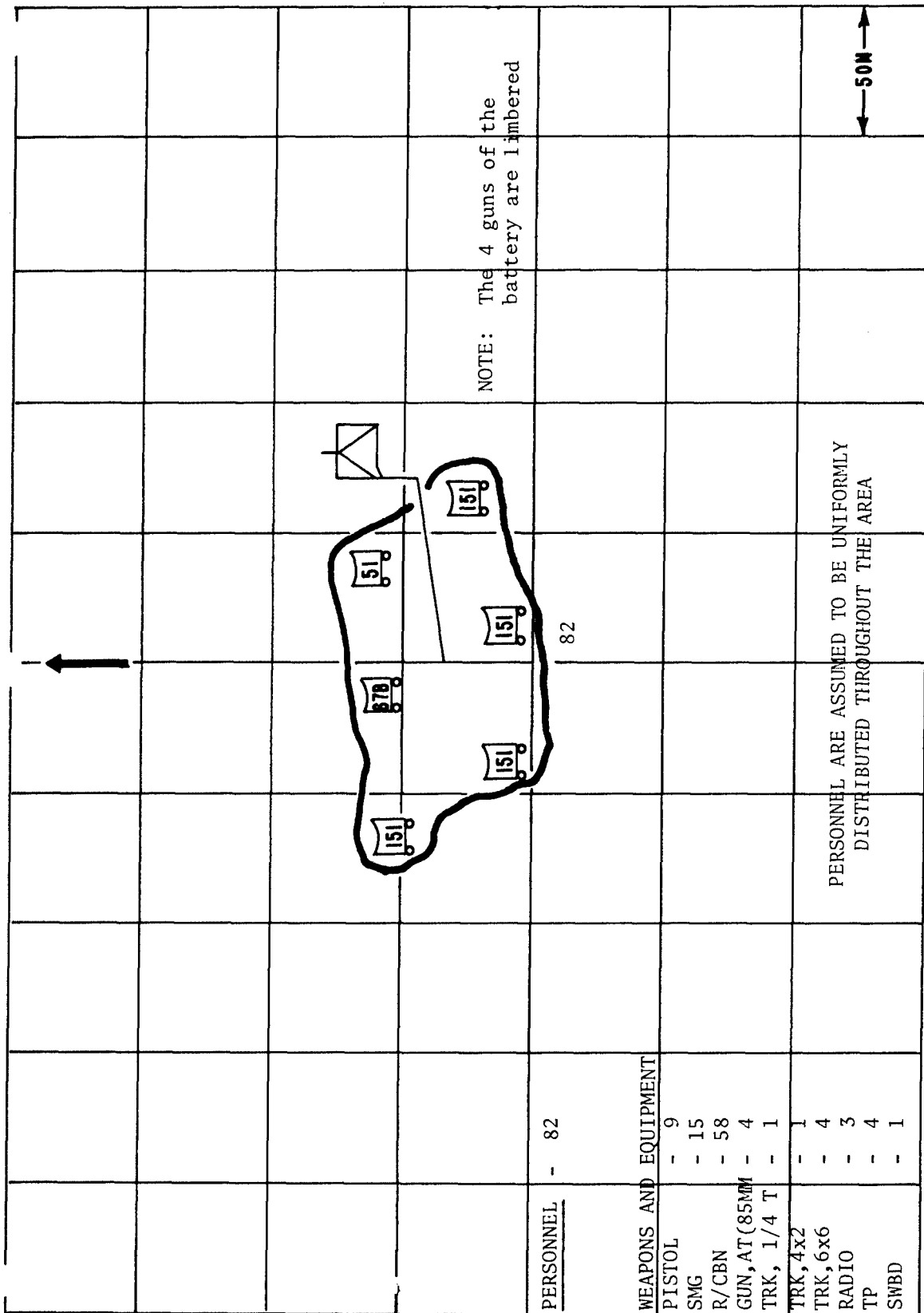


FIGURE A-83 (SECRET) ANTITANK BATTERY (85mm) (3)

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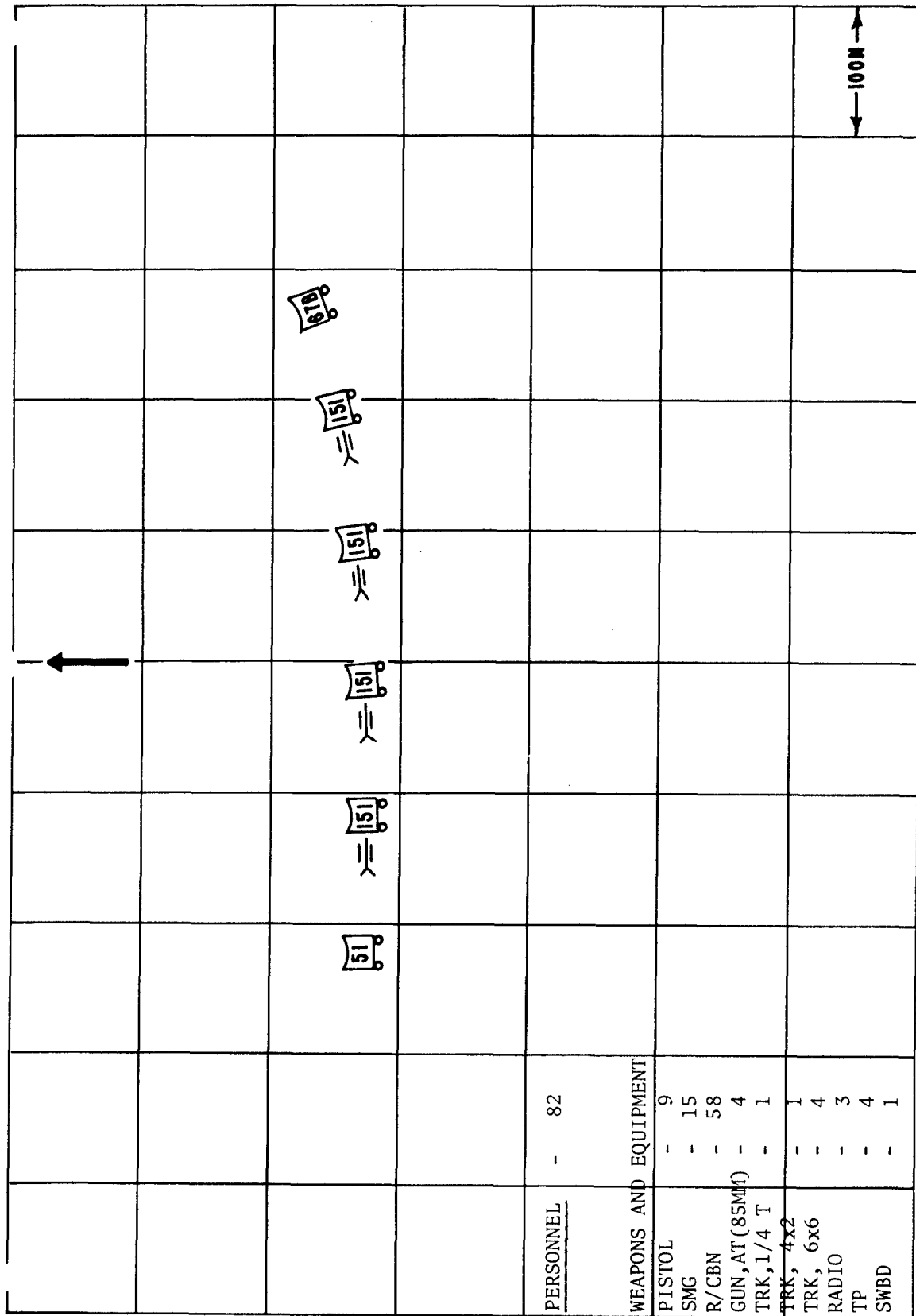


FIGURE A-84 (SECRET) ANTITANK BATTERY (85mm) (3)

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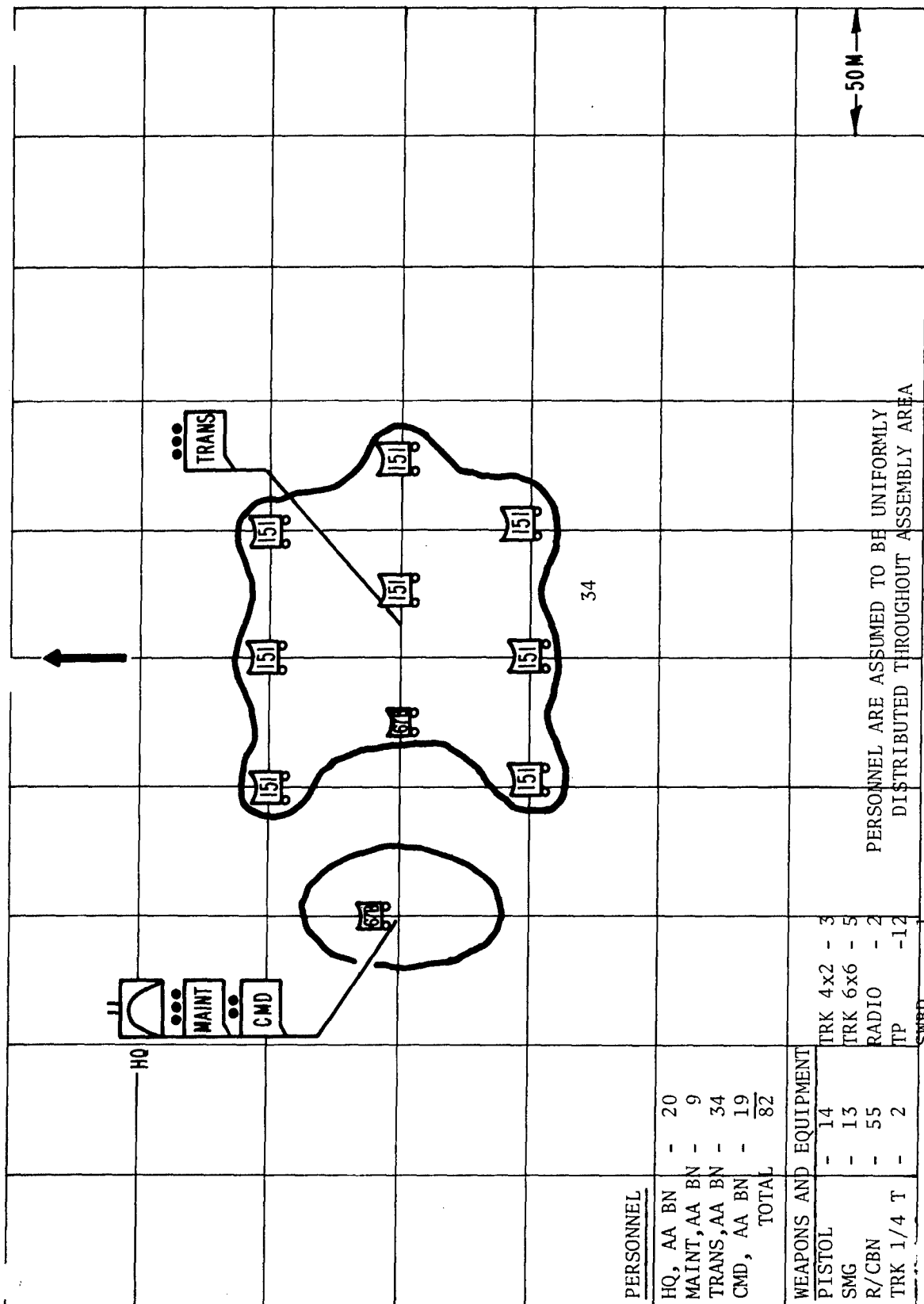
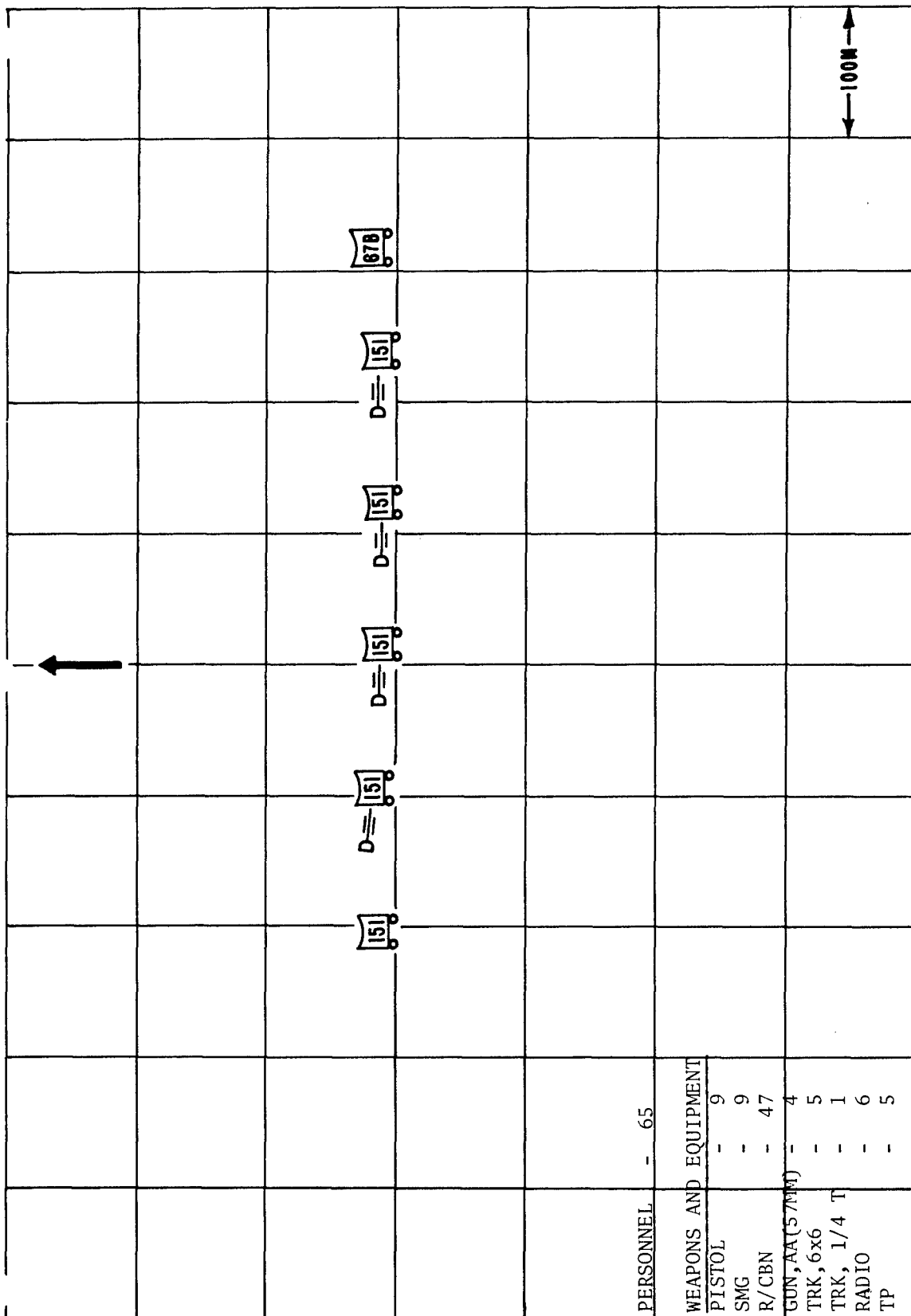


FIGURE A-85 (SECRET) HQ, ANTI-AIRCRAFT BATTALION
(ASSEMBLY AREA) (U)

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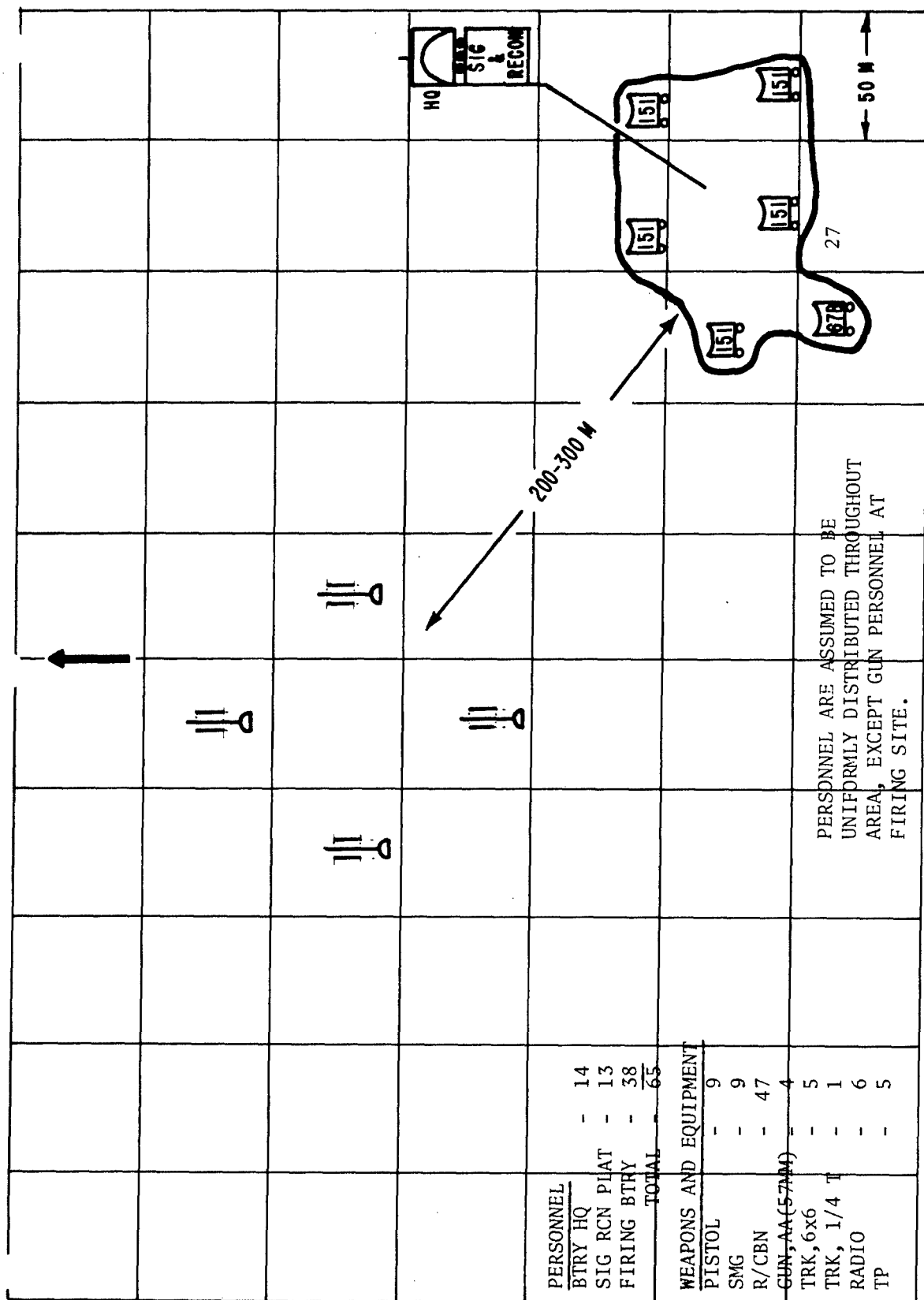
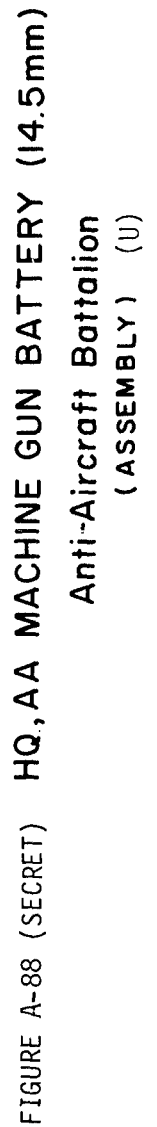


FIGURE A-87 (SECRET) ANTI-AIRCRAFT GUN BATTERY (57 mm) (3)

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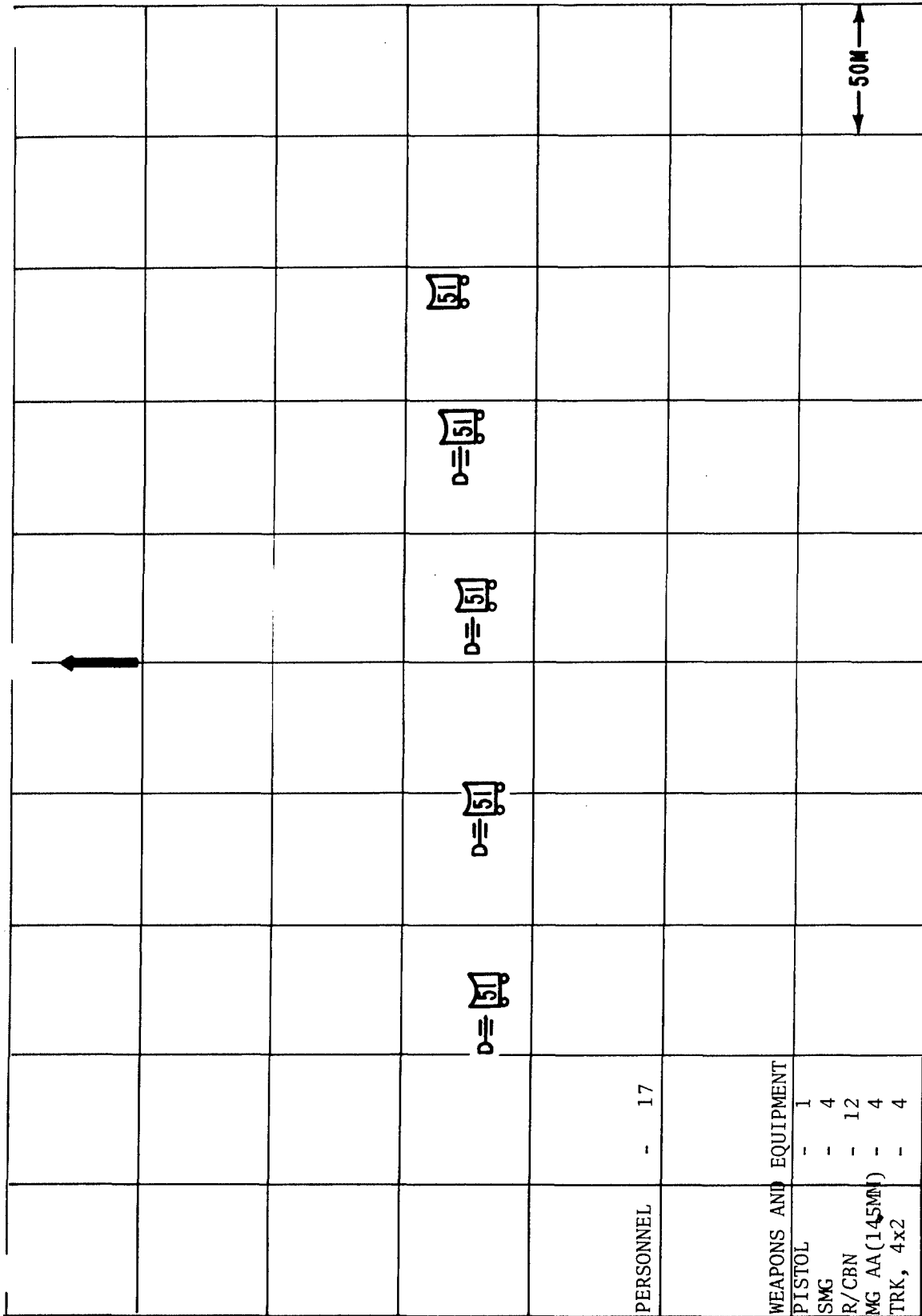


FIGURE A-89 (SECRET) ANTI-AIRCRAFT PLATOON (14.5mm) (3)

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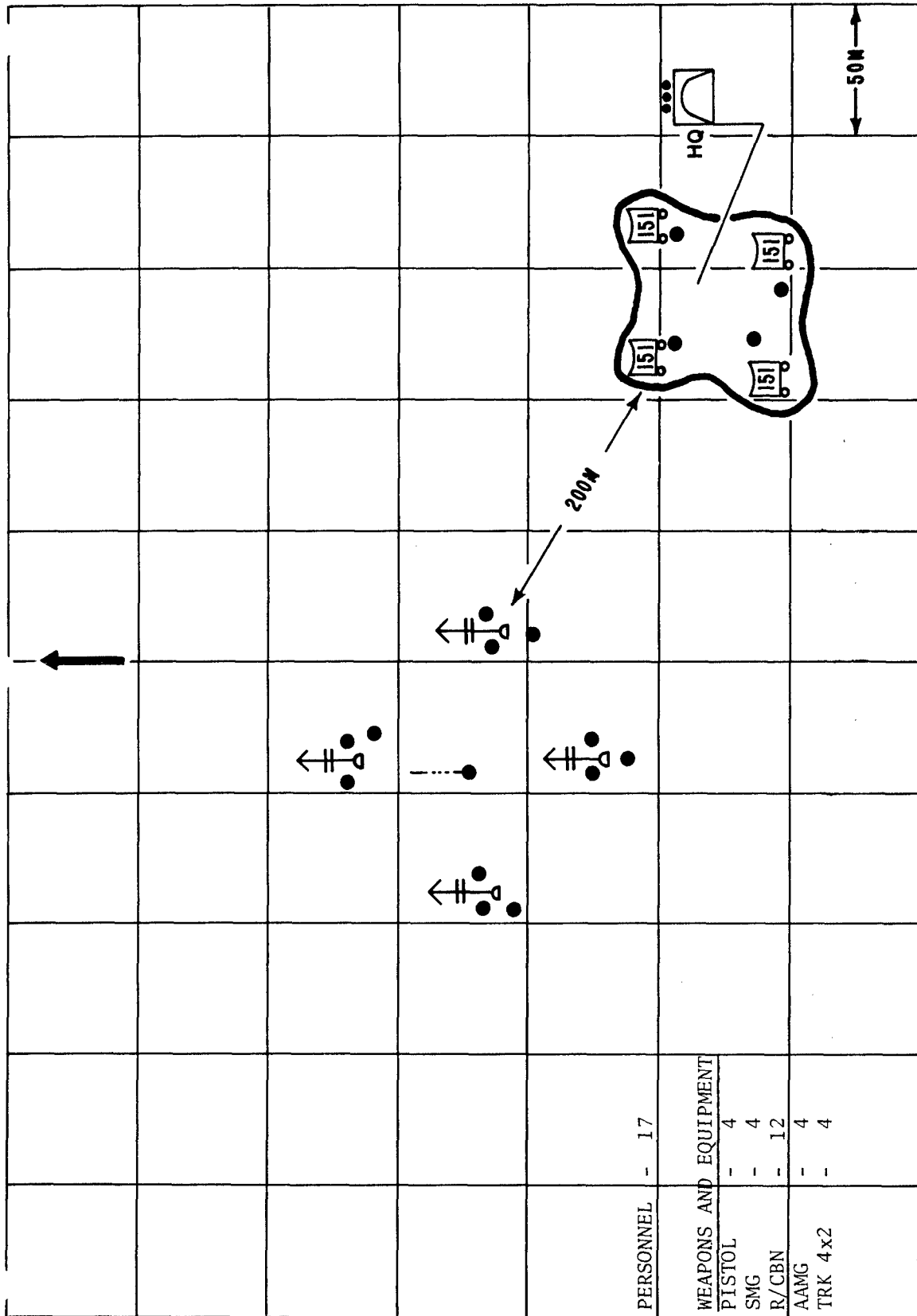


FIGURE A-90 (SECRET) AA MACHINE GUN PLATOON (14.5mm) (3)

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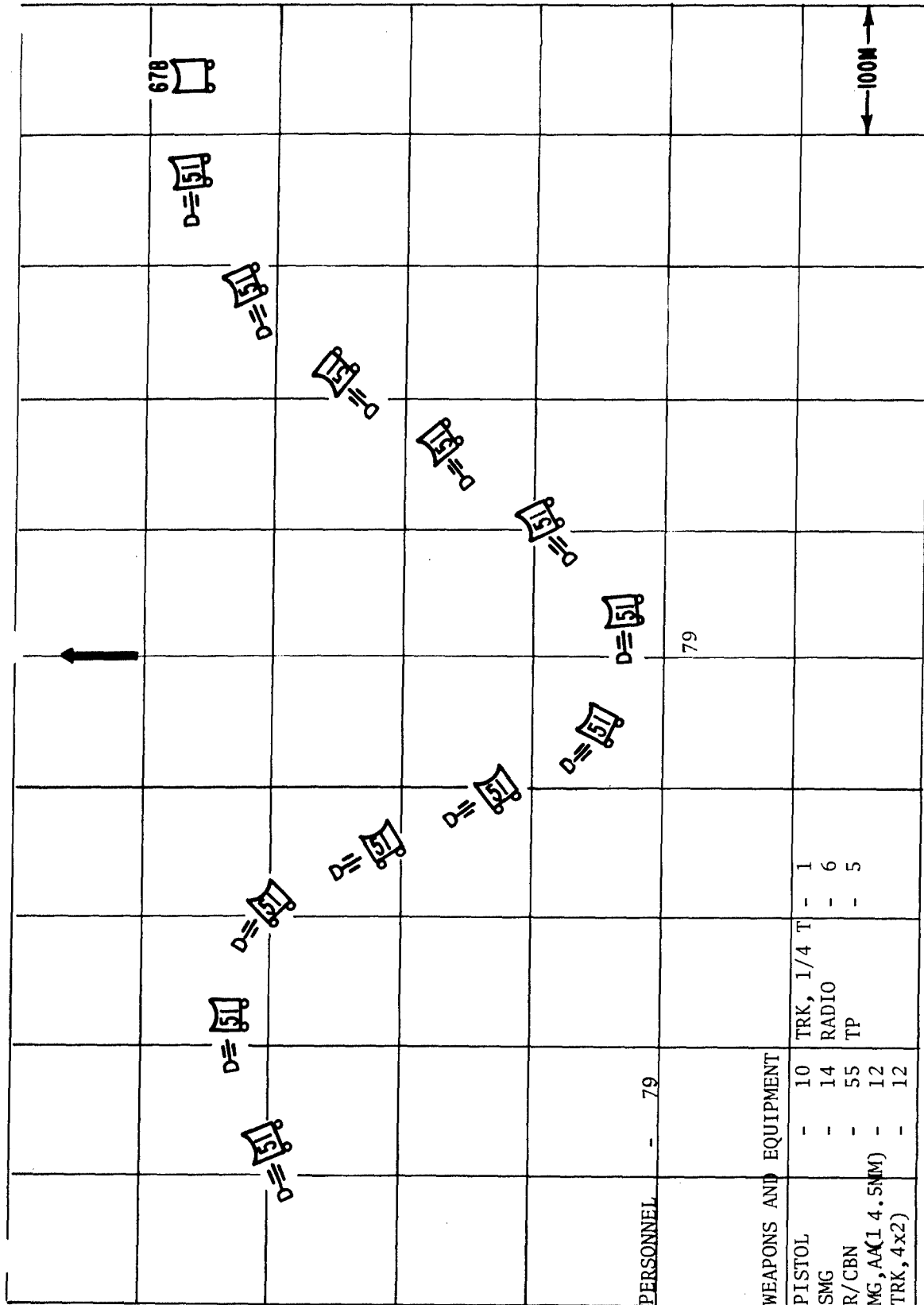


FIGURE A-91 (SECRET) ANTI-AIRCRAFT BATTERY (14.5 mm)

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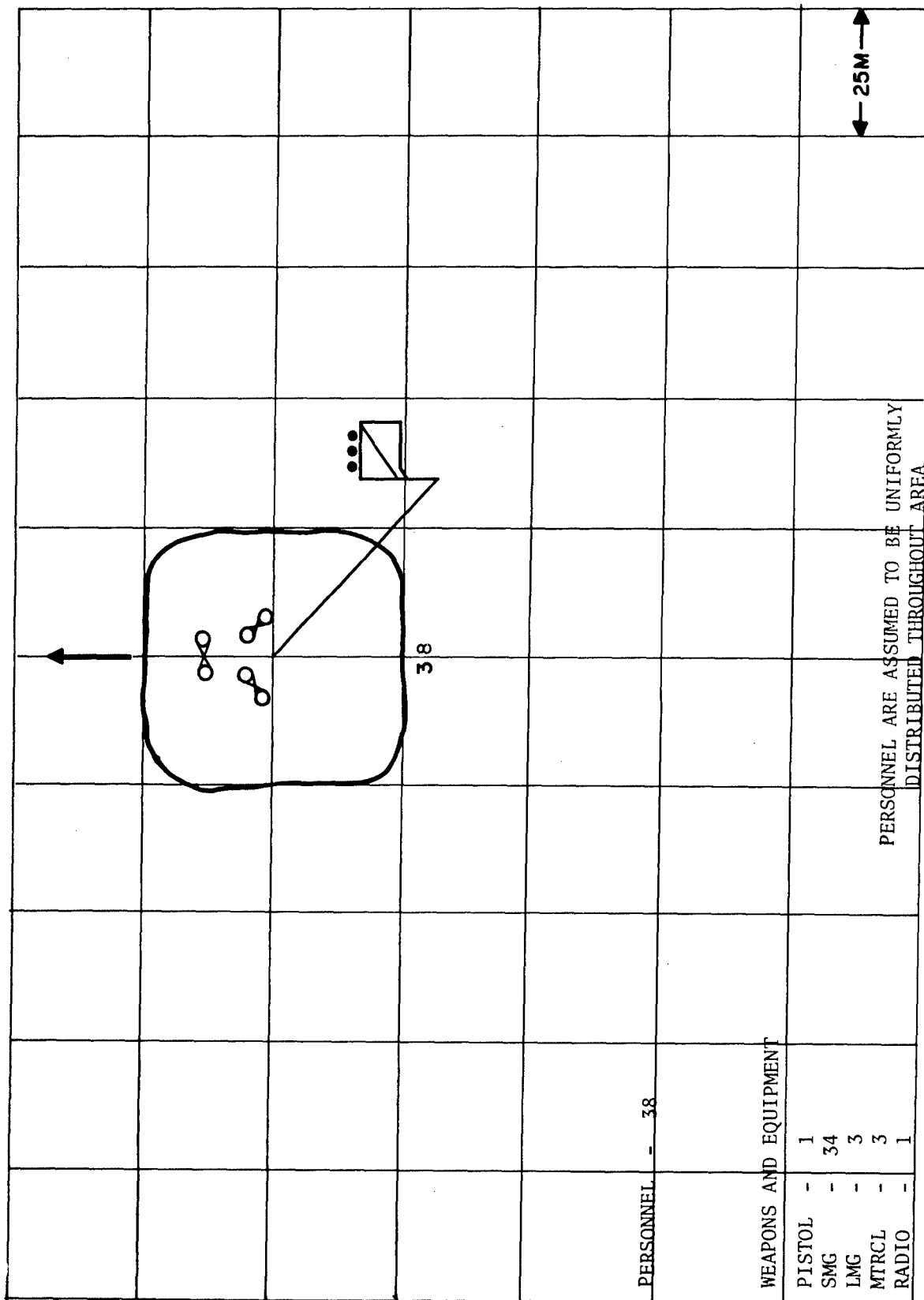


FIGURE A-93 (SECRET)

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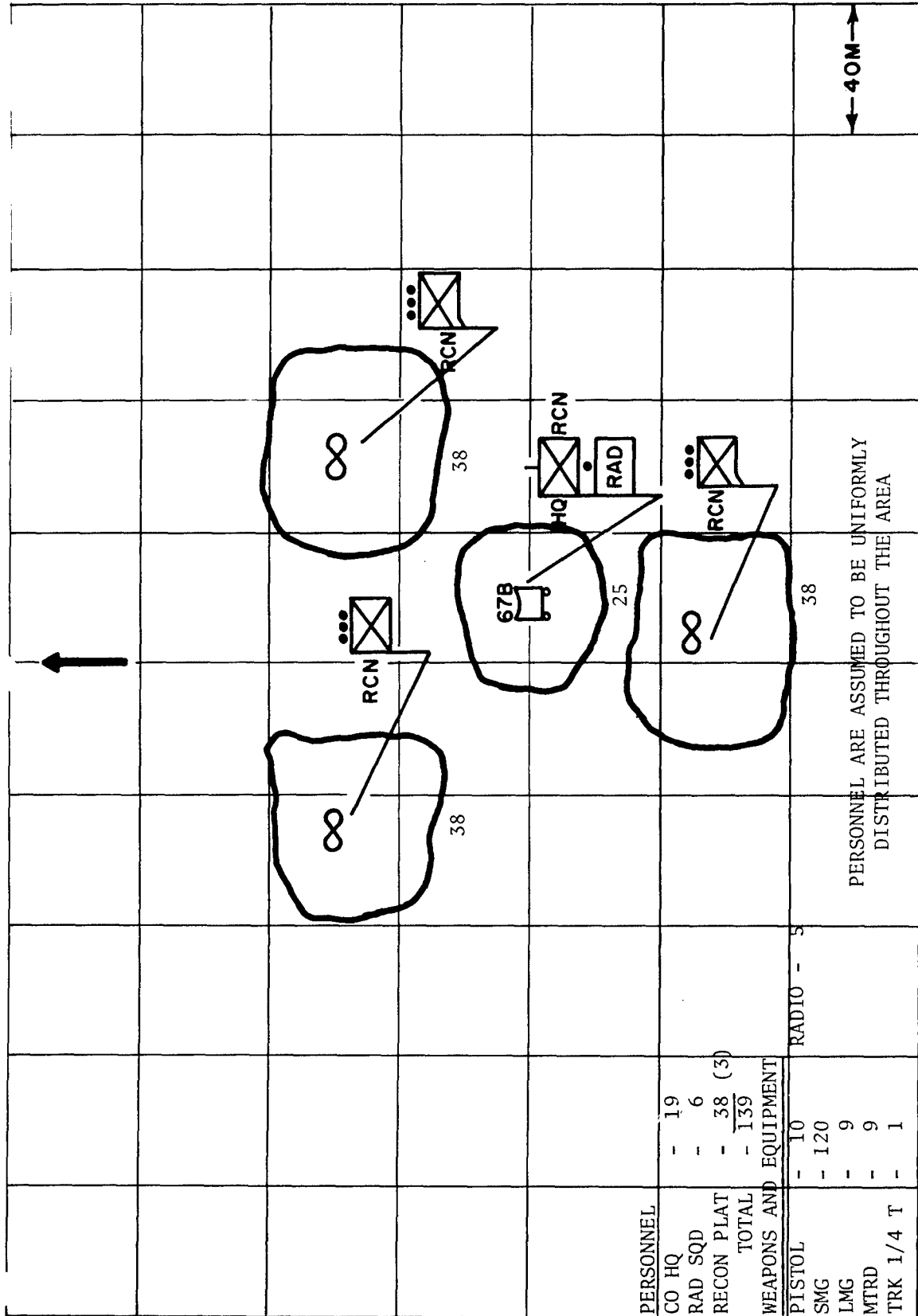


FIGURE A-94 (SECRET) RECONNAISSANCE COMPANY
(ASSEMBLY AREA) (U)

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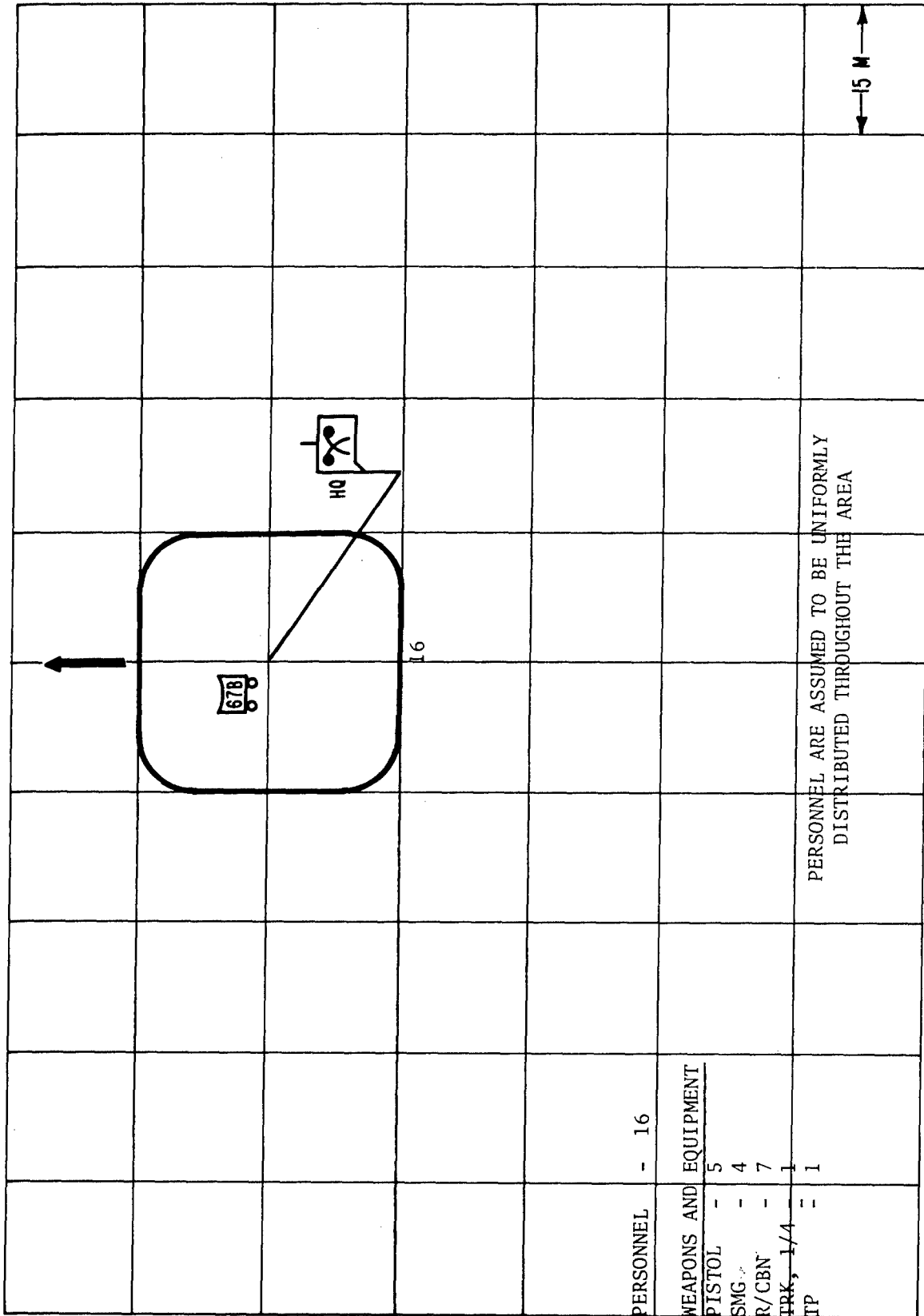


FIGURE A-95 (SECRET) HQ, CHEMICAL COMPANY
(ASSEMBLY AREA) (U)

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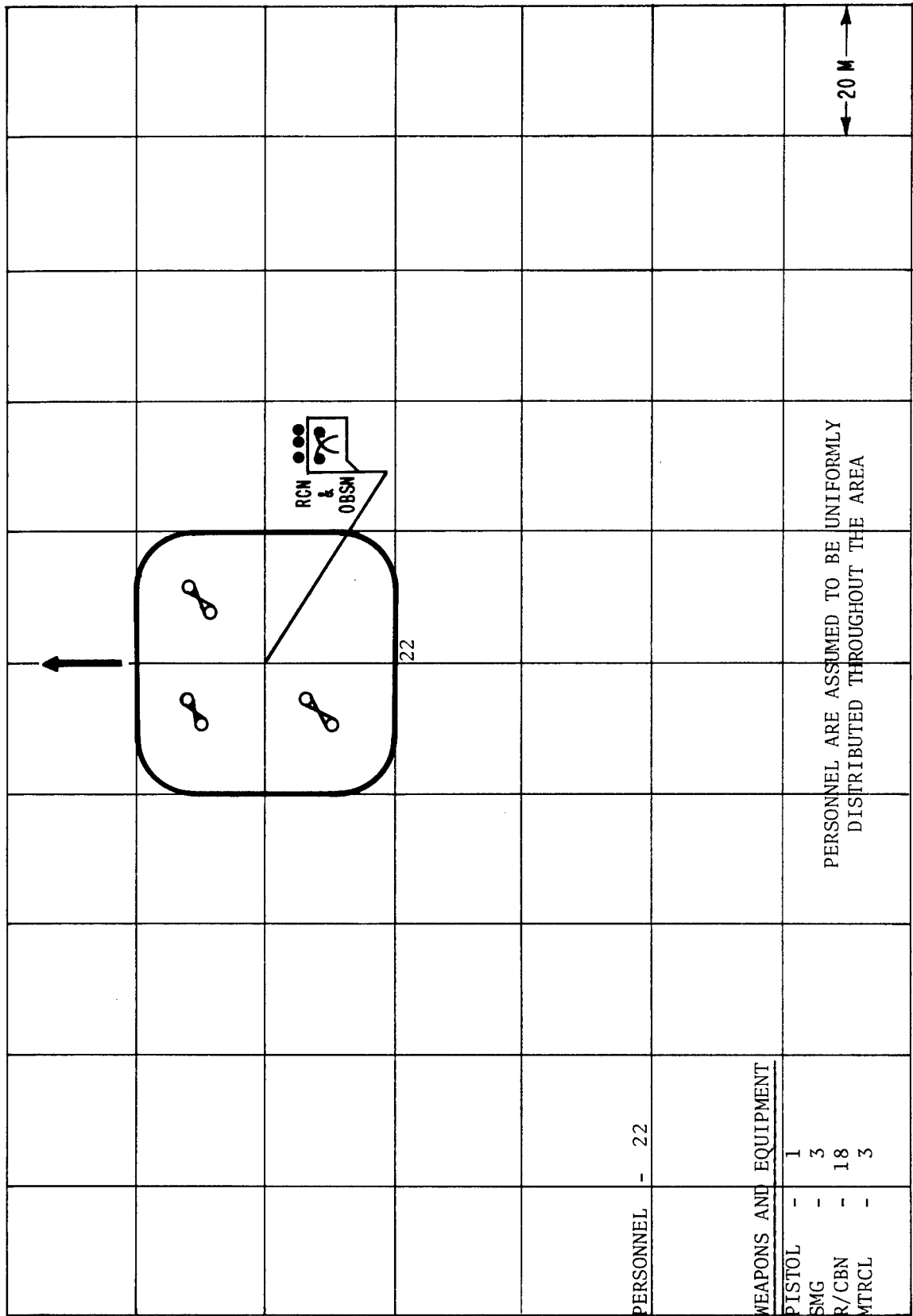


FIGURE A-96 (SECRET) RCN & OBSN PLATOON, CHEMICAL COMPANY
(ASSEMBLY AREA) (U)

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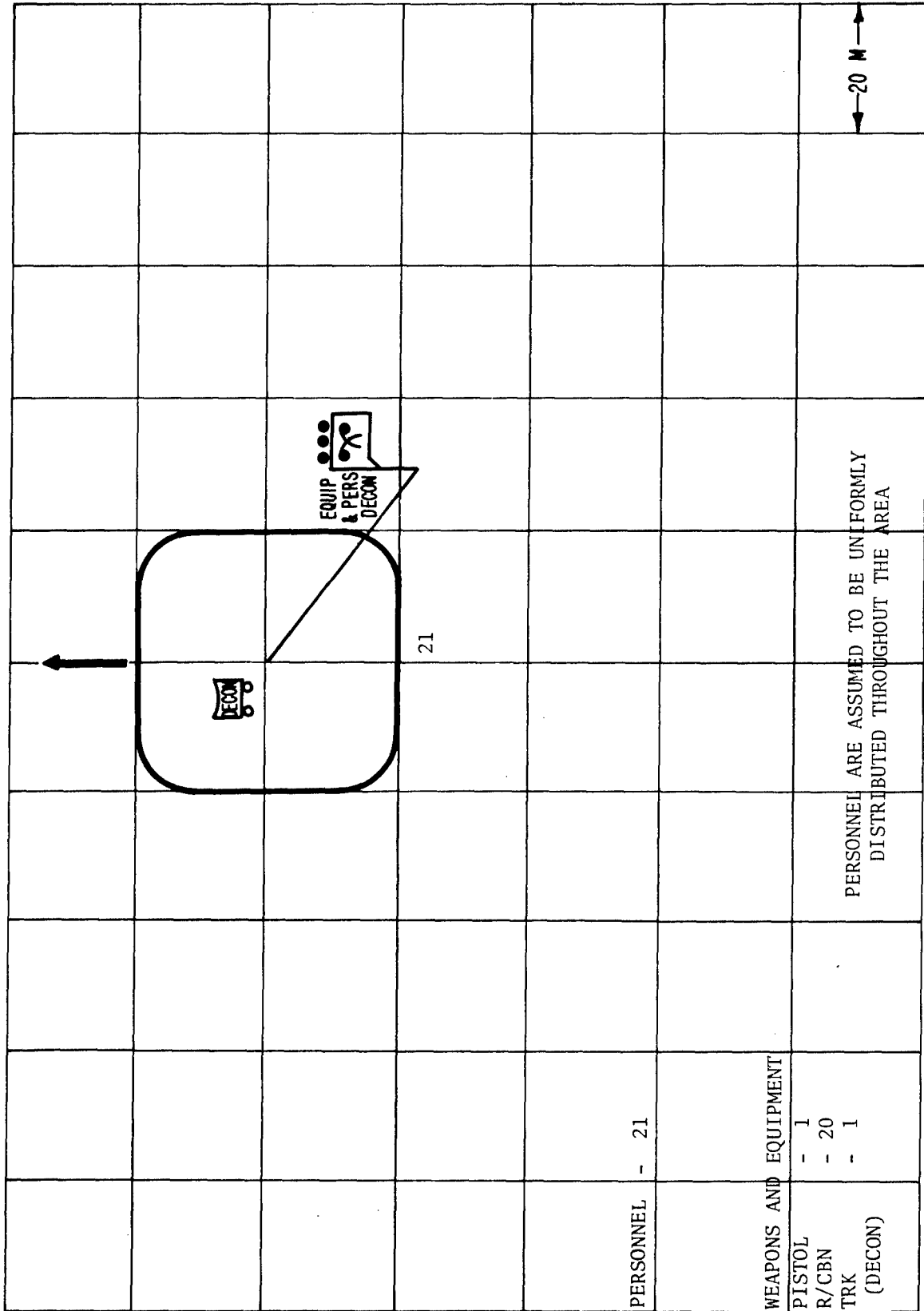


FIGURE A-97 (SECRET) EQUIP & PERSONNEL DECON PLATOON, CHEMICAL CO.
(ASSEMBLY AREA) (U)

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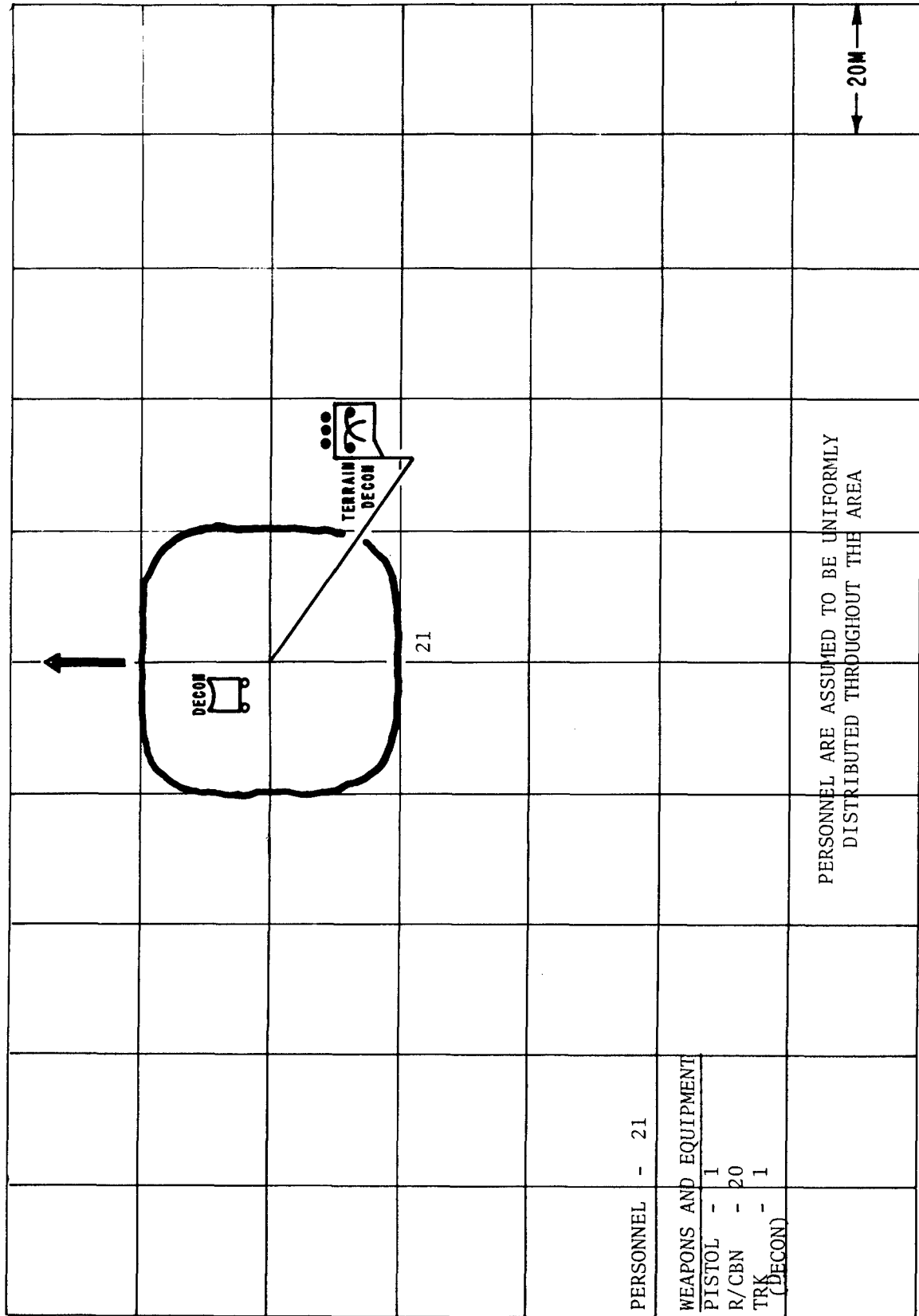


FIGURE A-98 (SECRET) TERRAIN DECON PLATOON

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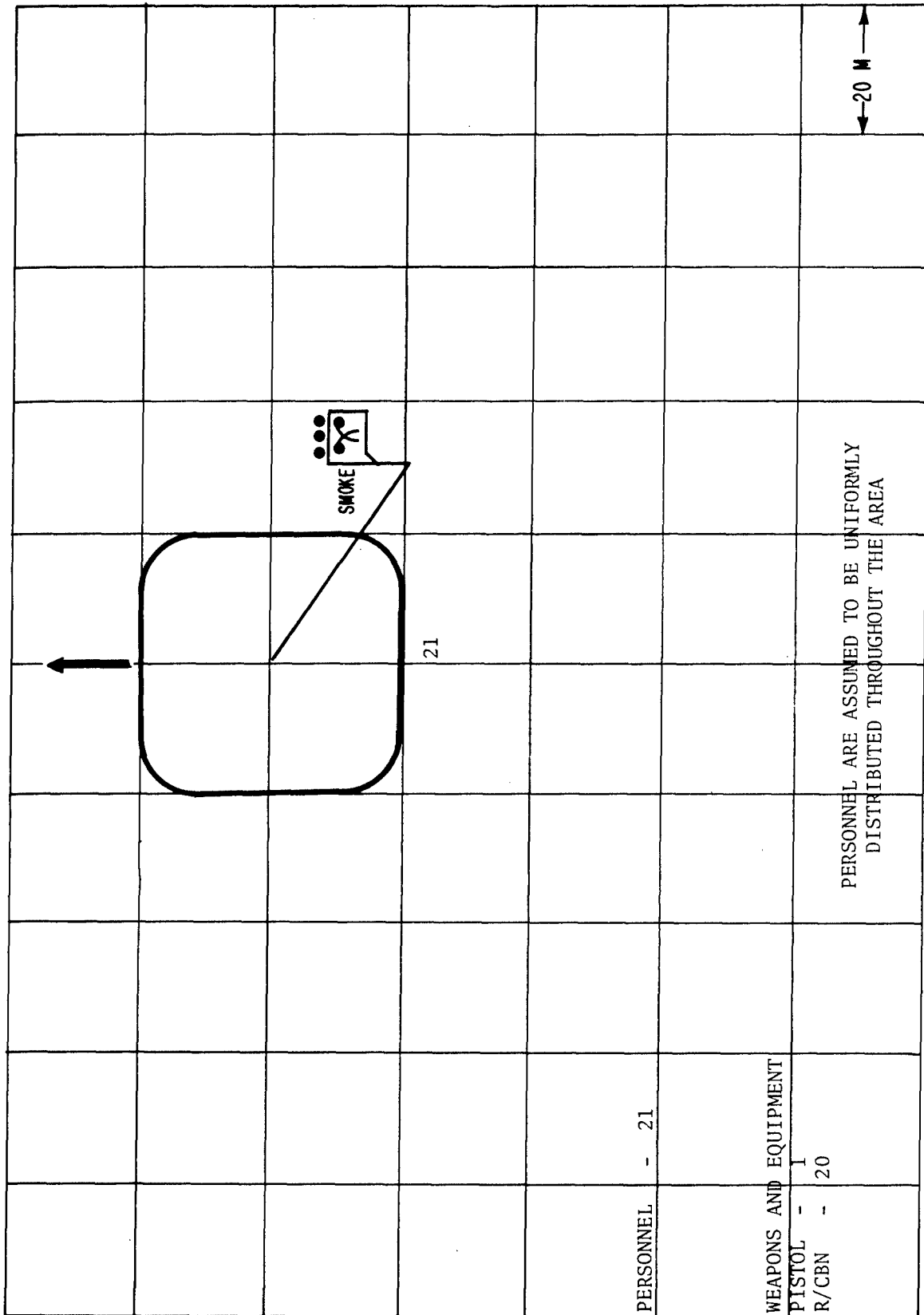


FIGURE A-99 (SECRET) SMOKE PLATOON, CHEMICAL COMPANY

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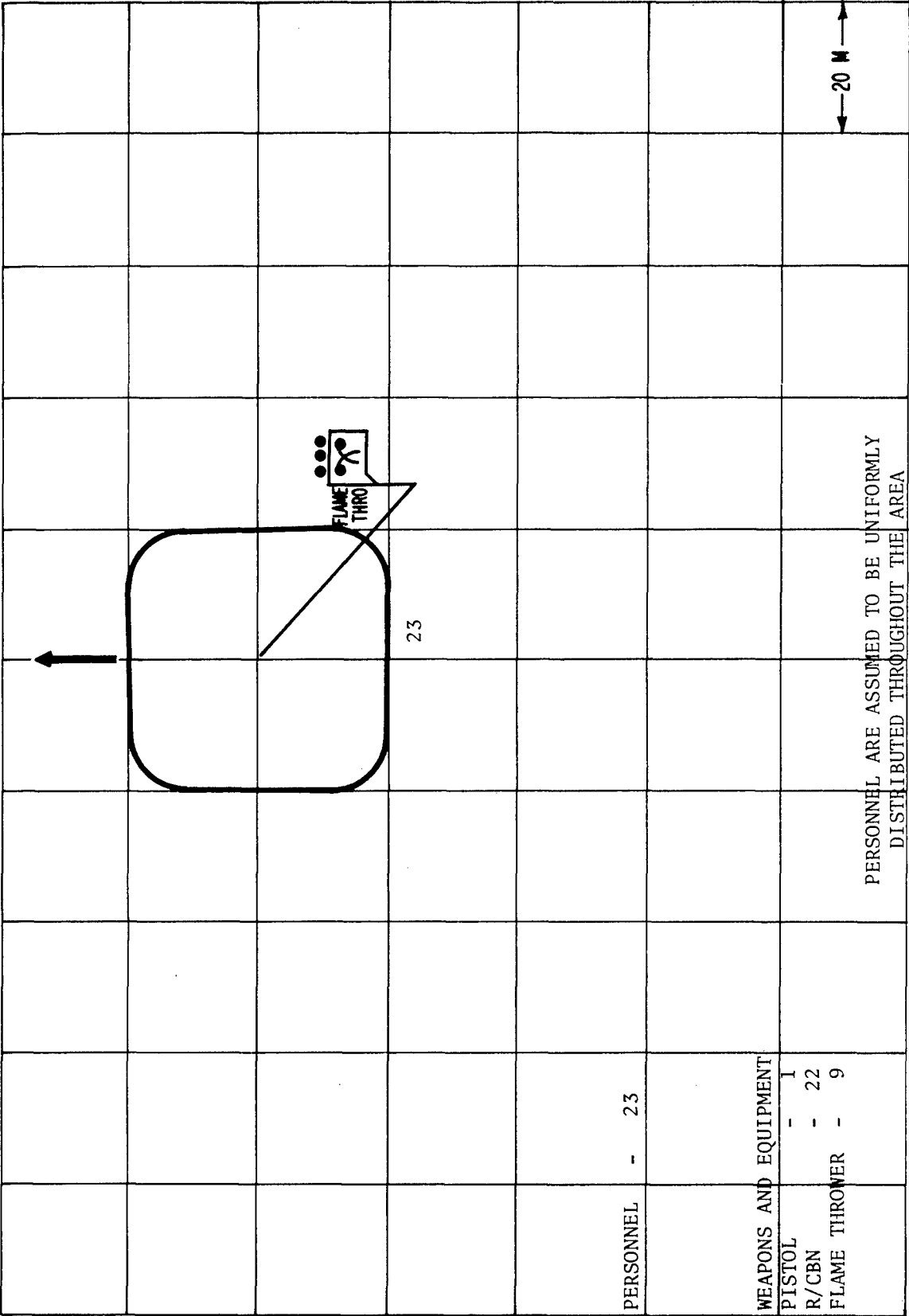


FIGURE A-100 (SECRET) FLAME THROWER PLATOON, CHEMICAL COMPANY
(ASSEMBLY AREA) (U)

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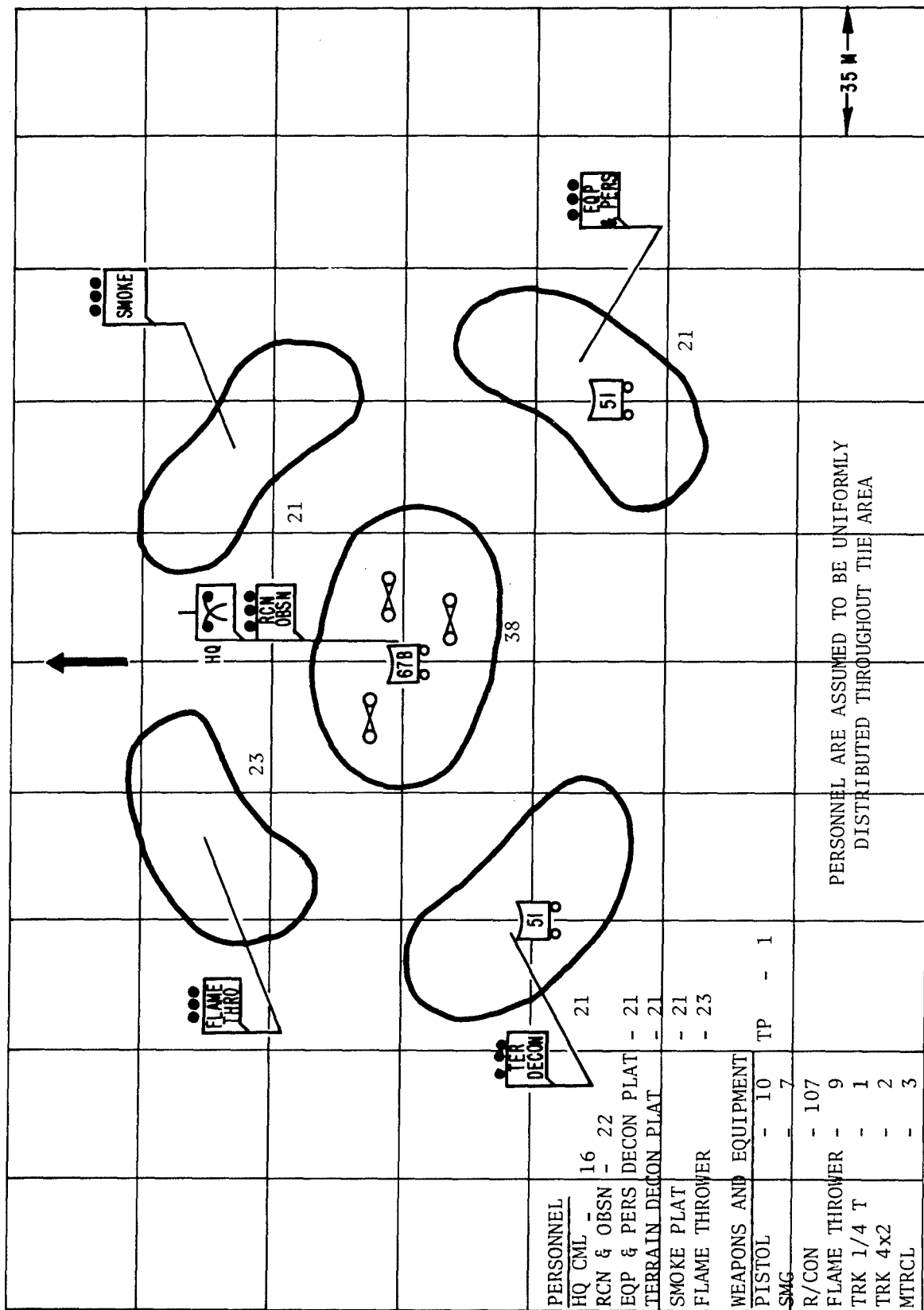


FIGURE A-101 (SECRET) CHEMICAL COMPANY
(ASSEMBLY AREA) (U)

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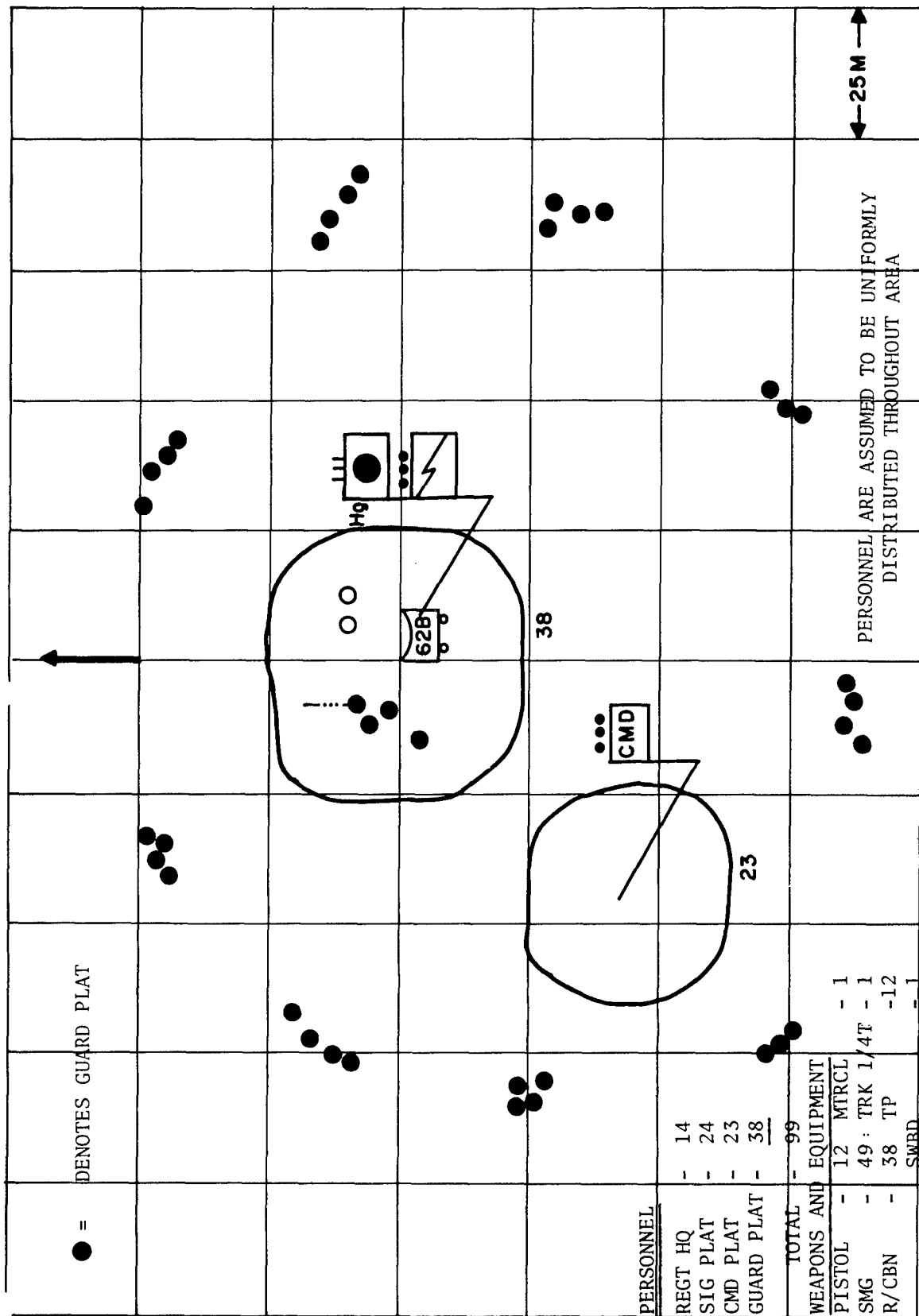


FIGURE A-102 (SECRET) HEADQUARTERS, ARTILLERY REGIMENT (U)

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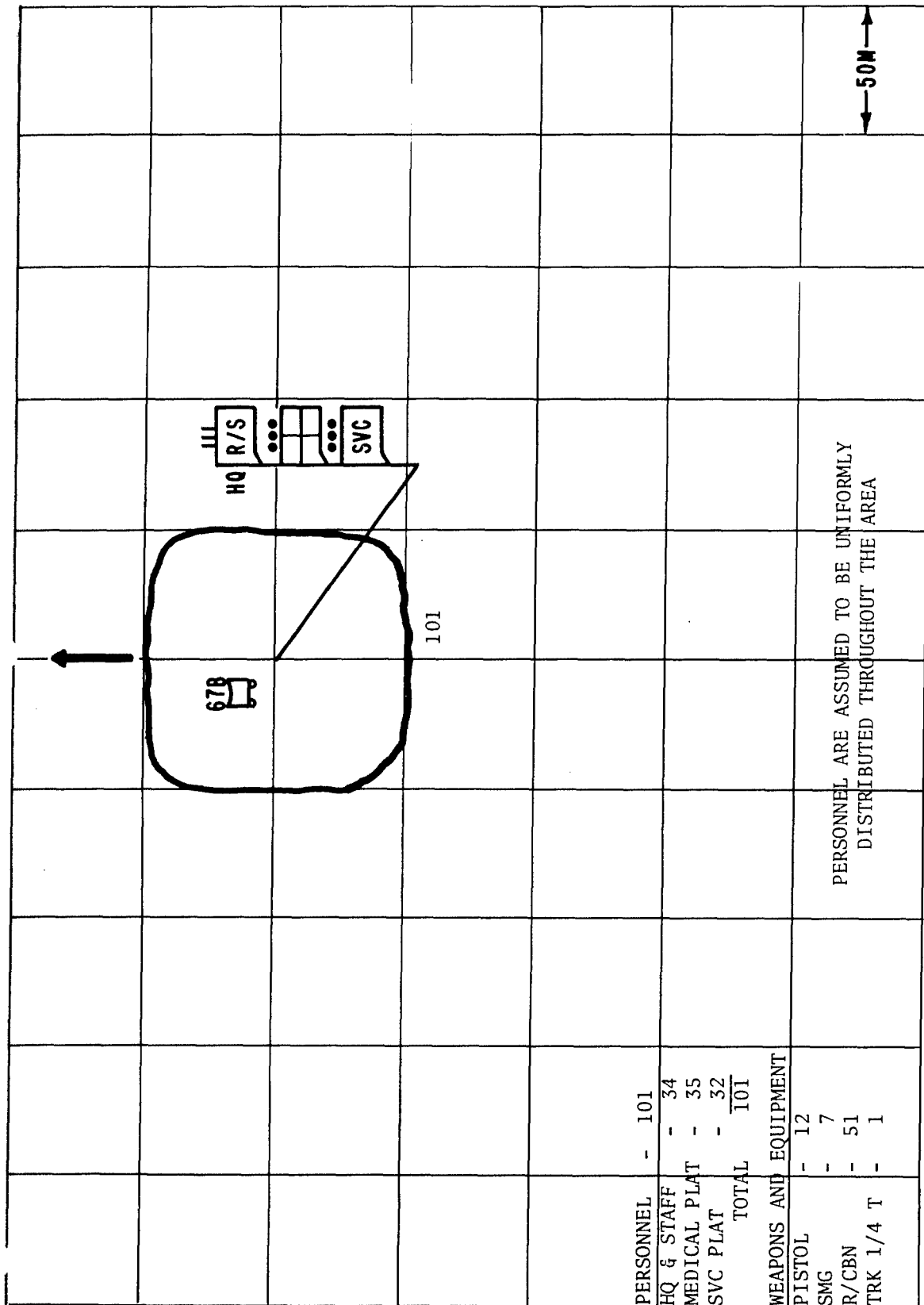


FIGURE A-103 (SECRET) HQ, REAR SERVICES

(ASSEMBLY AREA) (U)

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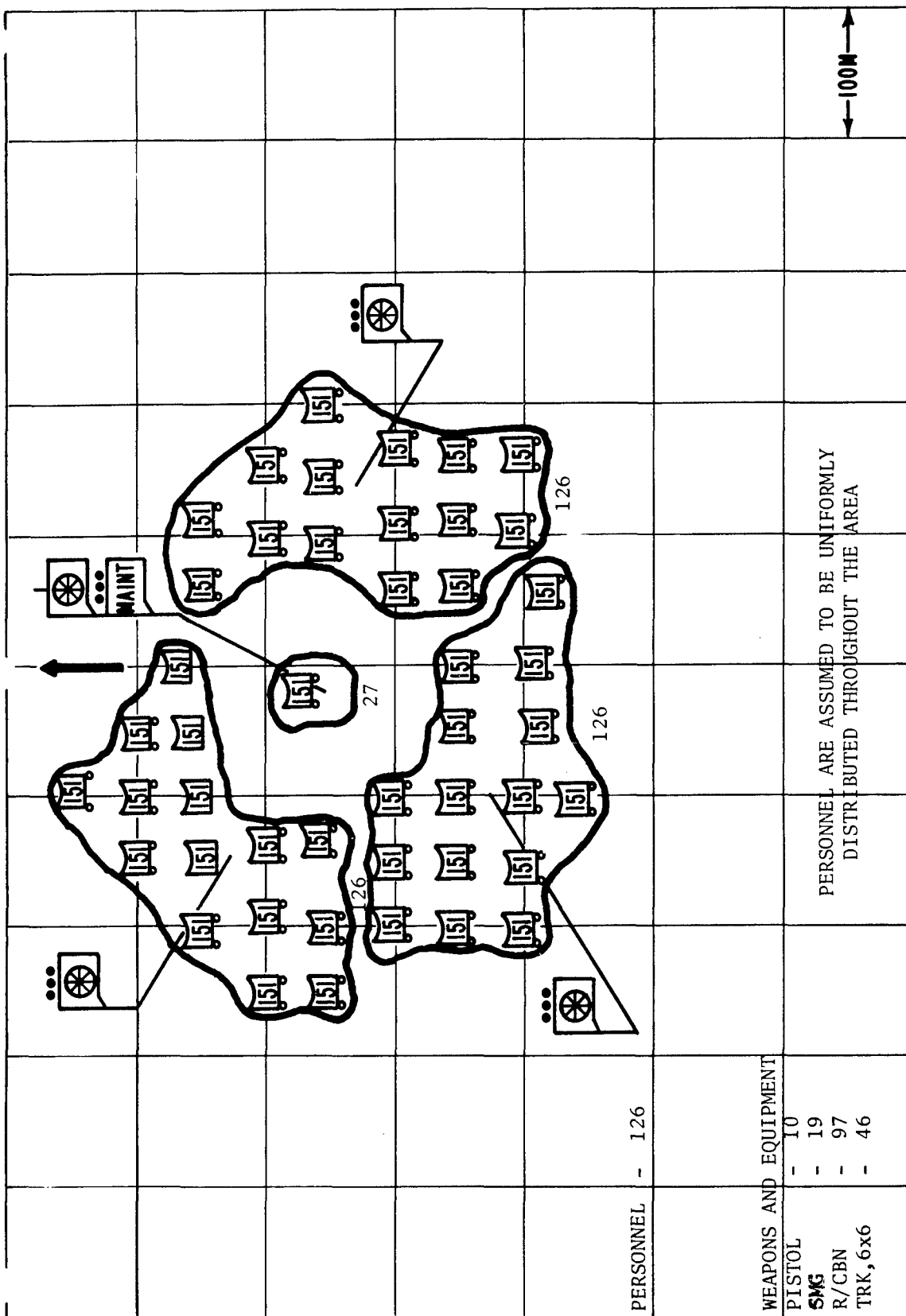


FIGURE A-104 (SECRET) TRANSPORTATION COMPANY

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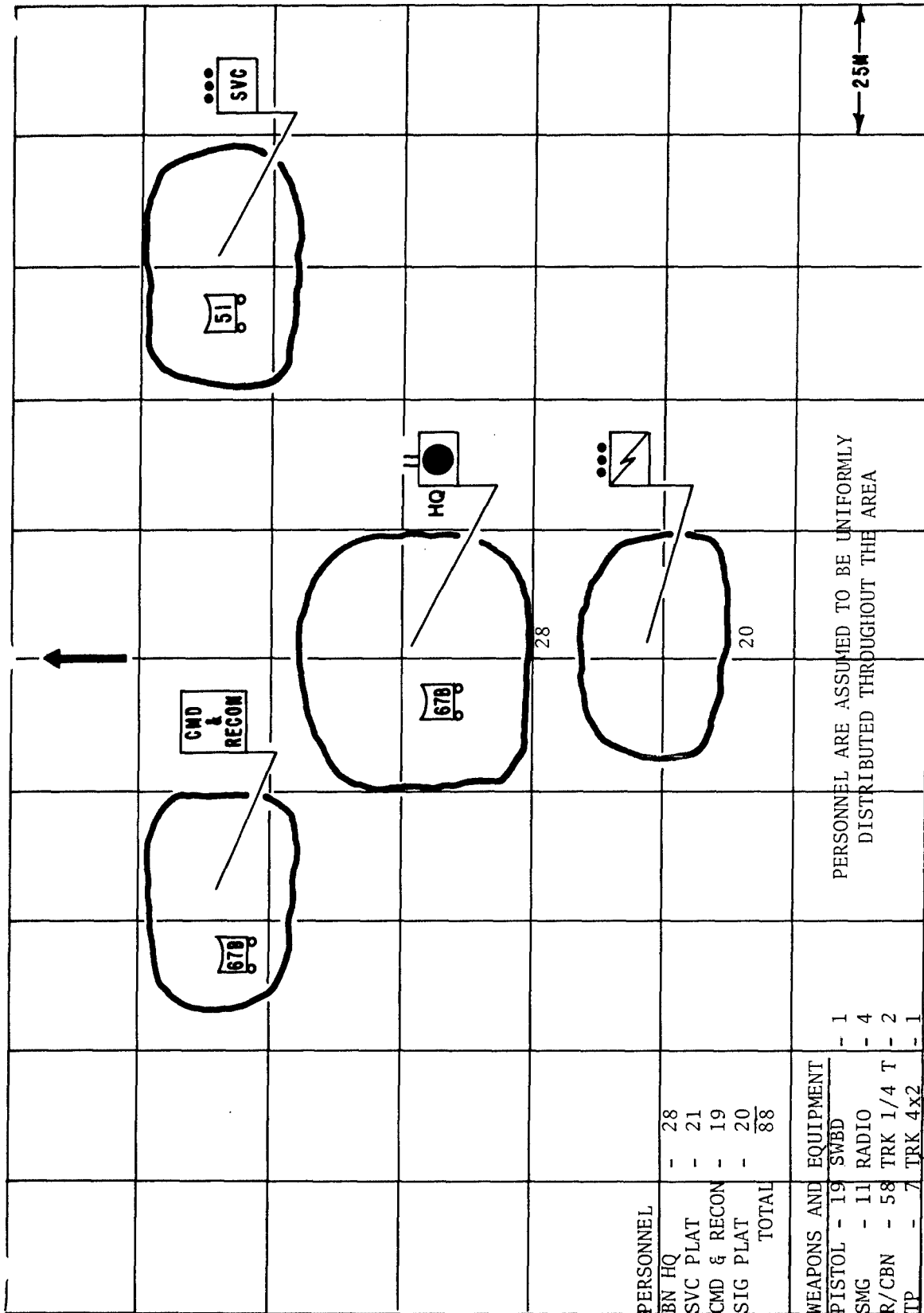


FIGURE A-105 (SECRET) HQ, 105mm HOWITZER BATTALION

Battalion (Reinforced) in the Attack (U)

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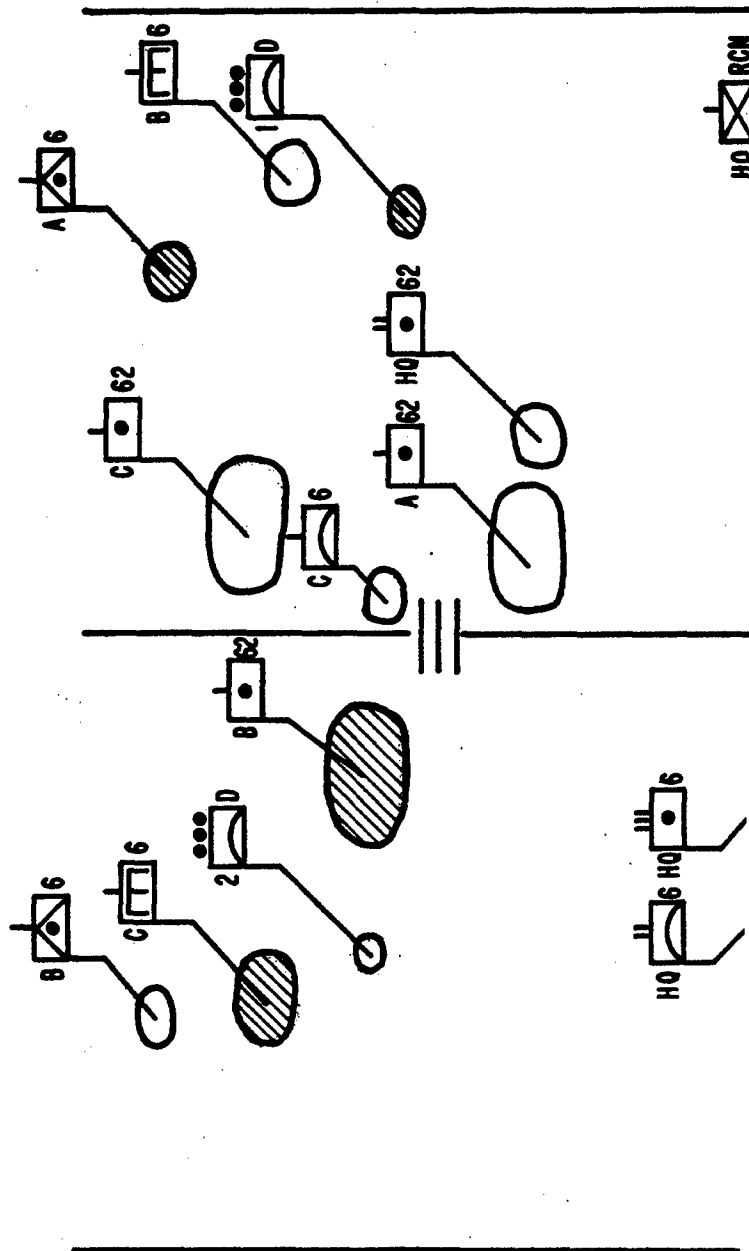




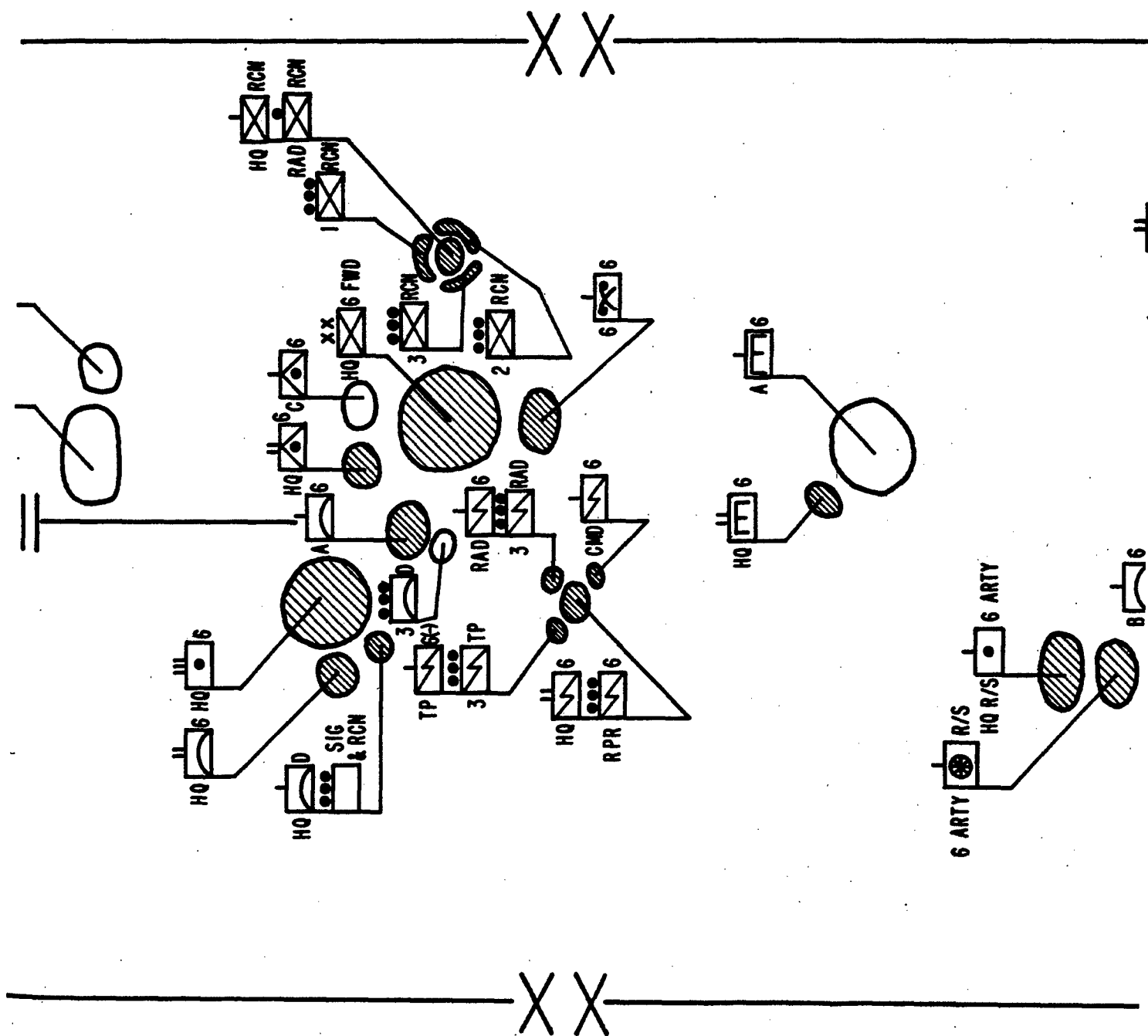
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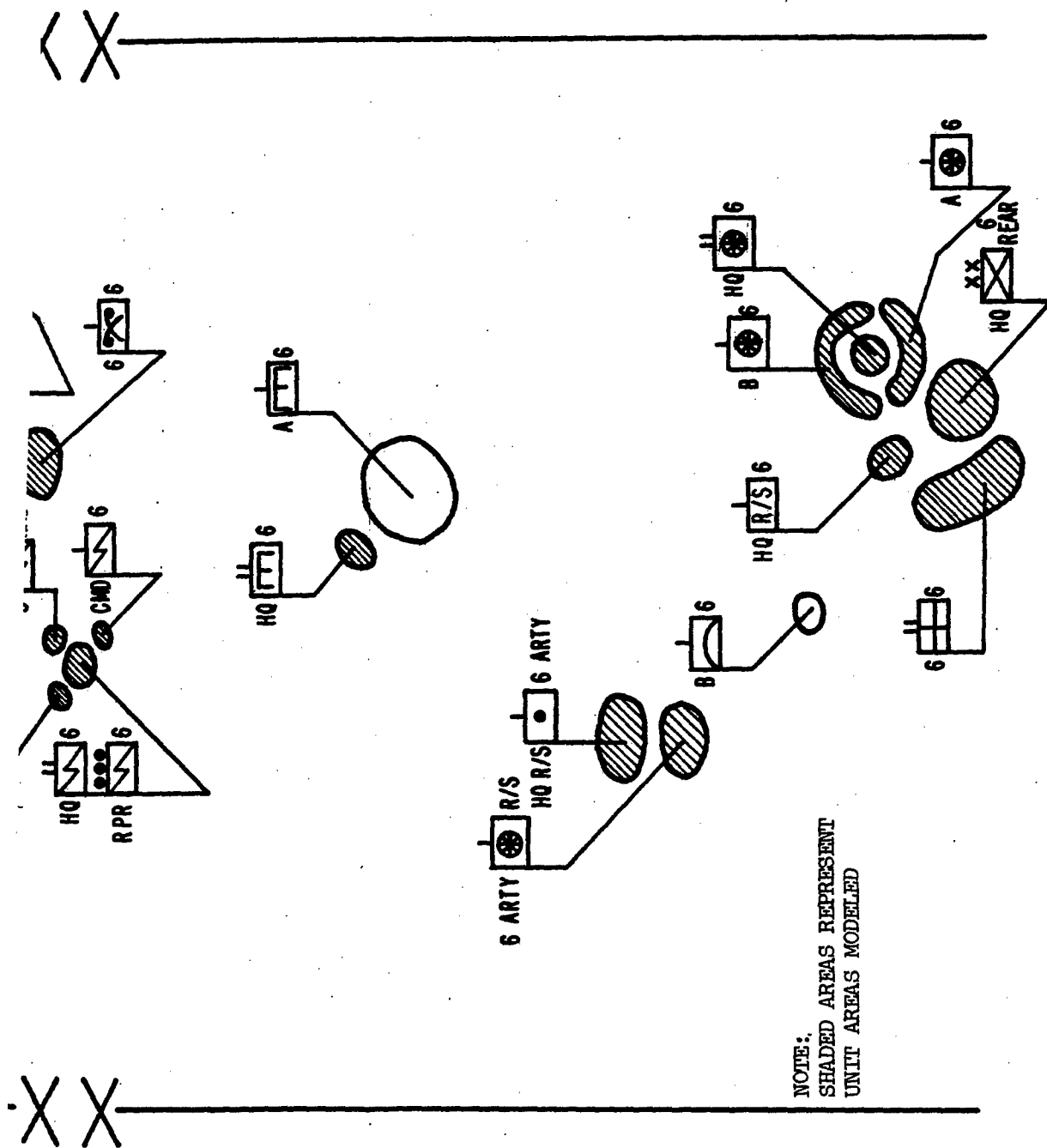


FIGURE B-3 (S). DIVISIONAL INSTALLATIONS (U)
