The "Wiktor III" station for non-professionals sounds very mysteriously. However, we will find out immediately that under this name a complicated radiolocation equipment of the 3rd generation is hidden. The operators belong to the squad of Janusz Jaworek, who is a senior private in the rank. The task which is being carried out scrupulously and precisely at any time of day or night is very important and responsible. They continuously watch on special monitors the air situation over the country's territory. Their job, which at first sight seems to be easy and simple, requires in reality perfect familiarization with the military equipment, good training and reliability. Not a simgle object in the air must slip away from the operators' attention who work on "Wiktor III".

The operators are immersed in concentration and quietness. They almost use gestures for communication between themselves. This was taught to them by captain stanislaw stachow - the commander, and by ensign Jerzy Presser - the equipment technician. Both of them are high class specialists who can not only operate and maintain the equipment, but also can repair any damage and prevent any disrepair on time. They are proud of their achievements in this field.

Senior private Janusz Jaworek's squad belongs to the best one. What is the reason for this success? May be because corporal Andrzej Smoliński, who is an operator of this squad, has fallen in love with Electronics since being a teenager? Or may be because of Stefan Sroka (a senior private) or simply called "the subunit golden hand" who can handle not only all complications connected with the equipment?

There are certain people who "hold responsible" corporal Jozef Sroka (the former squad commander) for that. At present he is in reserve.


