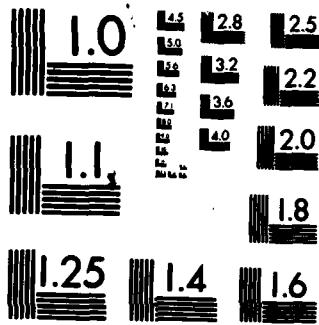

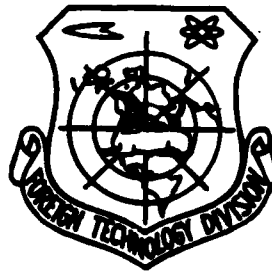

**AWARDING THE SECOND ORDER OF THE RED BANNER TO THE OMSK HIGHER
COMBINED ARMS COMMAND SCHOOL IMENI M. V. FRUNZE**

Siberian Military District, 14 March 1968: The Omsk Higher Combined Arms Command Red Banner School imeni M. V. Frunze has been awarded the second Order of the Red Banner for great services in the training of personnel for the Soviet Armed Forces and in connection with the 50th anniversary of the Soviet Armed Forces. A solemn ceremony awarding the decoration took place in the school on 12 March. The commander of the Siberian Military District, Hero of the Soviet Union Army General S. Ivanov, read the Ukaze of the Presidium of the USSR Supreme Soviet concerning the award to the school and he attached a second Order of the Red Banner to the red panel. In greeting the recipients, he recalled the combat traditions of the school, 19 of whose alumni have been awarded the lofty title of Hero of the Soviet Union, and he called on the teachers and officer candidates to multiply these glorious traditions in the future, too.

In their speeches the chief of the school, Major General S. Ulyamayev, deputy department chief Colonel M. Frolov, and officer candidate V.
