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ABSTRACT

This thesis examined the Navy Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps program. Data from Defense Manpower Data Center accession and separation files were used to build a profile of this program. Statistical analysis performed provided information which is useful in measuring the performance of the Navy Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps program in relation to similar programs operated by the other military branches. Results of this analysis indicate the areas where the Navy Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps can become more efficient. An accurate means of tracking military accessions was also produced.

I. INTRODUCTION

A. PROBLEM

There used to be a time when the Department of Defense would be granted most of its requests for increased spending in order to strengthen the military power and defense posture of the United States military. Budget deficits became the norm. It was not until the budget deficits started growing at alarming rates that they became major political issues in the campaigns of politicians.

While candidates for political office gave promises to balance the budget if they were elected, these promises went unfulfilled. Congressional leaders have finally acknowledged that the free-spending spirit of the government must be curtailed. With the passage of the Gramm-Rudman Bill, legislators are now beginning to consider budget cuts in order to reduce the federal deficit.

Obviously, one of the major problems of budget cutting is trying to decide what types of cuts should be made. Many programs are undergoing some type of budget reduction. The Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) program has not been immune to these reductions. With an initial authorization level of 1,600 JROTC units divided among the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, and Air Force, the total for all services is presently frozen at 1,479 units. This is shown

in Table 1. As Table 1 indicates, the Services are presently at about 8 percent below their authorization level. Due to a reduced budget, the Services are not allowed to expand beyond their current levels.

Program Managers for the Navy Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (NJROTC) need information that will allow them to make more knowledgeable decisions about where and how their budgets can be trimmed.

This thesis attempts to provide an empirical analysis of the NJROTC program. In so doing, it answers several questions about NJROTC graduates such as:

- What states do those who enlist in the military come from?
- What branch of the military do they enter?

- What is their Armed Forces Qualification Test (AFQT) category?
- What age are they most likely to enter the military?
- What career fields do they enter?

Answers to these questions are not only valuable to program managers, but can also be of value to recruiters of NJROTC graduates. This will be shown in Section III of the thesis. Data used were for fiscal years 1977 through 1986. Fiscal year 1987 data were not used because final updates of data files for 1987 were not completed in time for inclusion in this study.

B. BACKGROUND

The JROTC program can trace its origins back to 1911. However, the Army JROTC program was not officially recognized until the National Defense Act of 1916. The ROTC Revitalization Act of 1964 increased the number of JROTC units authorized and required the Air Force, Navy, and Marine Corps to establish JROTC programs. By 1966, all of the Services had activated their respective programs.¹

The JROTC program is a Department of Defense-funded voluntary training program for high school men and women in grades 9 through 12. There are currently over 219,000 cadets enrolled in JROTC units nationwide. Their distribution by Service is shown in Table 2.²

The ROTC Revitalization Act of 1964 put the responsibility of establishing JROTC units on the Secretary of each of the Military Departments. The act also called for an equitable geographical distribution of JROTC units throughout the nation. A minimum of 100 students are necessary for establishment and continuation of a unit. Schools are required to provide adequate facilities for classrooms, equipment storage space, and drill areas, and conduct, as a minimum, a three-year course of military instruction. Course membership in JROTC is limited to students who maintain academic and discipline standards acceptable to the military. The Services are required to provide necessary texts, equipment, and uniforms, and to establish the performance standards for their units. No military obligation is incurred for participating in JROTC.³

To enroll in the JROTC program, a student must be:

1. A citizen of the United States.
2. 14 years of age or older.
3. In good academic standing in school.
4. Able to participate in the physical education program of the school.
5. Selected by the military instructor and school officials.
6. Able to pass prescribed screening tests.

The JROTC program is a joint effort by the military and local school authorities to provide high school students with military science information consistent with other fields in secondary education. The JROTC program is built upon contemporary concepts of education and its goals and objectives are tuned to the needs of today's student. As prescribed by the implementing legislation, certain traditional concepts are included. The JROTC program, however, is specifically designed to meet the requirements of this era of scientific achievement and technological development, and the program is expected to play a key part in preparing future citizens for their roles in modern society.⁴

The JROTC program provides an opportunity for secondary school students to learn about the basic elements and requirements for national security and their personal obligations as Americans. As described in the NJROTC

Information Booklet, the JROTC program has the following specific goals and objectives.⁵

1. Goals

- a. Develop informed and responsible citizens.
- b. Strengthen character.
- c. Promote an understanding of the basic elements and requirements for national security.
- d. Develop habits of self-discipline.
- e. Develop respect for and understanding of the need for constituted authority in a democratic society.
- f. Develop an interest in the military services as a possible career.

2. Objectives

- a. Students will be able to readily accept the responsibility and importance of citizenship as it relates to the democratic principles upon which our country is founded.
- b. Students will be able to use operative principles of military leadership to attain a given goal or objective.
- c. Students will be able to achieve group solidarity and unit pride through the use of teamwork concepts.
- d. Students will be able to learn to use the chain of command as a means for communicating a redress, request, or grievance.
- e. Students will be able to rely on the intrinsic value of good order and discipline in the accomplishment of assigned objectives.
- f. Students will have a sound knowledge of military operations, organization, and the military's role in national and international security.

C. OBJECTIVES

This thesis will examine the demographic and other characteristics of Navy JROTC program graduates who enlist in the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, and Air Force. It will also provide a solid foundation upon which to build further research. The data analysis should also furnish Navy JROTC program managers with new information that can be useful in conducting efficiency and cost-benefit analyses.

D. SCOPE, LIMITATIONS, AND ASSUMPTIONS

The goal of this thesis is to provide an analysis of data that can be used by NJROTC program managers to perform efficiency studies of the program and cost-benefit analysis during the present era of budget cutting. The results of this analysis, for example, should help to lay the basic groundwork for future research in areas of regression analysis. It is beyond the scope of this thesis to explain why certain characteristics occur. Rather, it is intended that this work will provide an initial, broadbased foundation of information upon which other researchers can design future studies.

Limitations that affected the research accomplished for this thesis included:

- Data records maintained by some JROTC program managers pertaining to the early years of this study, were unavailable.

- The only data available from JROTC program managers were "soft" (that is, survey data which is not considered very accurate).
- There was a lack of previous research work. No prior research work was done in this area. Therefore, this thesis could not build upon previous work.
- There was a scarcity of literature available for review. Furthermore, literature that was available was often too general in nature.

The following assumptions were made in the study:

- Errors in the data, caused by the incorrect filling out of data base file format sheets, are no greater than one percent.⁶
- Differences in totals between cross-tabulations of two variables versus three variables is also no greater than one percent.⁷
- The data used in this study start in 1976 - ten years after the program began.⁸ The assumption is made that the number of JROTC units has remained fairly constant. This is true for all branches except the Army JROTC, which has increased its total units by 35 percent between fiscal years 1977 and 1986. Since the data analysis is measured by percentages, it is assumed that this will not have a large influence on the findings.

E. LITERATURE REVIEW AND METHODOLOGY

The literature reviewed was mostly general in nature. No record of any prior research performed in this area could be found. Because this is apparently the first research work of its type using "hard" data, this thesis emphasizes the presentation of descriptive statistics supplied by the Defense Manpower Data Center (DMDC), in Monterey, California.

II. METHODOLOGY

A. DATA FILES

The data files were supplied by the Defense Manpower Data Center (DMDC) located in Monterey, California. DMDC has many data files dating back to fiscal year 1971. However, the files used for this thesis are the Active Duty Service Gain Files beginning with fiscal year 1977 and ending with fiscal year 1986. This ten-year period was chosen because the Active Duty Service Gain Files only maintain partial data for fiscal year 1976. Fiscal year 1977 was the first full year of complete data. Fiscal year 1987 data files were not completely updated at the time of this thesis research and, therefore, fiscal year 1986 was the last year of complete data available. These data files are updated on a quarterly basis. These files only cover active duty enlistments. They do not cover reservists or officer accessions.

Another file which was used in this thesis research was the Active Duty Loss Transaction Files for fiscal years 1977 through 1986. These files are available back to fiscal year 1971. However, as with the Active Duty Service Files, data prior to fiscal year 1977 is incomplete and the fiscal year 1987 data files were not yet updated at the time of this research.

B. VARIABLES

An example of the data base file format sheet can be found in Appendix A. The variables to be analyzed and the corresponding columns of the data base file format are listed in Table 3.

C. STRUCTURE OF ANALYSIS

The Statistical Analysis System (SAS) computer package was used for the data analysis. Two-and three-way tables of cross-classification, also known as contingency tables, were used in the data analysis. In order to explore any possible pattern or relationship between variables, it is useful to first convert these results into percentages based on the following:⁹

1. The overall total
2. The row totals
3. The column totals

"Supertables" were also extensively used. A supertable is essentially a collection of cross-classification tables for the same column variable and categories. However, as many row variables as desired are included for comparison against the column variable. The data in each cell of the table are always given as a percentage of its corresponding row total. This permits line-by-line comparisons for the categories within a particular row variable as well as for the categories among the various row variables.¹⁰

The population size for data analysis is represented in Table 4. Total size is 56,852. This is the total population of JROTC graduates from all of the Services JROTC programs that enlisted into the active duty military in fiscal year 1977 through fiscal year 1986. This population was chosen because complete data was available for use in the following analysis.

III. ANALYSIS

A. ACCESSIONS DATA

When comparing Table 4 and Table 5, there is a difference of 526 accessions. This is due to one percent of the accessions coming from unknown JROTC units. These accessions were deleted from Table 5.

The first important observation is that while the Navy has 16.3 percent of the JROTC units (as shown in Table 6), only 15.02 percent of all active duty enlisted accessions come from Navy JROTC programs. But the Navy still comes out ahead, because 22.79 percent of JROTC graduate accessions enter the active duty Navy. Although 41.38 percent of Navy JROTC graduate accessions enlist in the Navy, another 31.8 percent enlist in the Army. One reason that might explain such a high percentage of Navy JROTC graduates enlisting in the Army could be a lack of interest generated by Navy JROTC summer camps. Another reason could be the fact that Navy JROTC units are usually located closer to Army bases. A third reason could be students who were interested in other service JROTC programs were forced to enter the Navy JROTC program because the other service programs were not available in their area. A survey could be used to determine the answer to this problem. A researcher could send out a survey form to Navy JROTC graduates, especially to

graduates who enlist in the military, to determine the enlistment propensities and attitudes of the graduates.

The data in Table 5 are also invaluable in determining a cost-benefit analysis of the Navy JROTC. In fiscal year 1986, the Navy JROTC costs were approximately \$10.7 million, while only 378 Navy JROTC graduates enlisted in the Navy. This converts to

an astounding cost of over \$28 thousand per accession. The cost decreases substantially if enlistments into other services are included. For example, with a total of 961 accessions across all Services, the cost per accession drops to about \$11 thousand. If other service JROTC graduates who enlist in the Navy are included, (a total of 1,463 accessions), the cost per Navy accession falls again to about \$7 thousand. The costs are eventually decreased even further if accessions into the reserve and officer programs are included.

Continuing with the data analysis, it was found that 72 percent of Navy JROTC graduates enlist for four years, while 6.5 percent enlist for greater than four years. In fiscal years 1985 and 1986, eight-year enlistments comprised five percent of total enlistments. Fifty-four percent of the Navy JROTC graduates enter at a paygrade of E-3, and 31 percent enter at paygrade E-2.

By studying the Home of Record data in Table 7, the Navy JROTC program manager can find the percentage of accessions "produced" by each state. An investigation of differences between high and low production states could help to isolate the important factors and possibly help to improve production in states at the bottom end of the distribution. The manager could also use other Home of Record data to discover what states are supplying Navy enlistments from other JROTC programs, such as Georgia and South Carolina, where 66.8 percent and 83.7 percent of Navy enlistments in these states, respectively, come from Army JROTC programs. The program manager could move more units into these areas and remove units from the less productive areas.

The age at which most NJROTC graduates enter the Navy is 18 years. Overall, about 42 percent enlist at this age, followed by 22 percent at 19 years. Thirteen percent are 17 years of age and 23 percent are 20 years or older. Ninety-one percent are men and nine percent are women. The proportion of whites who enlist from Navy JROTC programs is

62 percent, with blacks and Hispanics following at 20 percent and 15 percent, respectively. These percentages are the same for males, while there are five percent more black women and six percent less white women. Twenty-seven percent of white male JROTC graduates enlist in the Navy, while 19 percent black males and 18 percent Hispanic males

enter the Navy. Twenty-two percent of the white female JROTC graduates enlist in the Navy, while 18 percent and 16 percent of the black and Hispanic females, respectively, enter the Navy.

Of those JROTC graduates enlisting in the Navy, 47 percent fall into AFQT categories I through IIIa, with another 31 percent falling in AFQT category IIb and 14 percent falling in AFQT category IVa. Eighty-nine percent of the female enlistees have entrance scores in categories I through IIb, whereas only 77 percent of the male enlistees fall in these same categories. Looking at the AFQT levels of Navy JROTC graduates, 47 percent fall in categories I through IIIa, 31 percent in category IIb, and 13 percent in category IVa. Only the Air Force gets a higher percentage of AFQT category I through IIIa JROTC program graduates, at 53 percent. The Navy JROTC graduates who have entrance test scores in AFQT categories I through IIIa and eventually enlist do so at a rate of 45 percent into the Navy, 26 percent into the Army, 16 percent into the Air Force, and 13 percent into the Marines.

White males who score in AFQT categories I through IIIa do so at 58 percent, while the same categories of black and Hispanic males are 25 percent and 15 percent, respectively. White women in categories I through IIIa total 60 percent, compared with 44 percent of black women and 21 percent of Hispanic women.

Eighty-eight percent of the males completed high school, compared with 93 percent of women. These figures are the same for Navy JROTC graduates. White women are at 92 percent with black and Hispanic women at 94 percent. For Navy JROTC graduates, white women increase to 94 percent with black women at 93 percent and Hispanic women at 96 percent completing high school (as their highest year of education).

B. SEPARATIONS DATA

A separation is an any service JROTC program graduate who enlisted into any active duty branch of military service and was released from active duty any fiscal year between fiscal year 1977 and fiscal year 1986, inclusive. This data exhibits results that reflect what happened to earlier fiscal year cohorts because later fiscal year cohorts (e.g., fiscal year 1986) have only been in the military for two years and are still on active duty.

The number of separations in this sample can be found in Table 8. While 24.1 percent of all separations, by JROTC graduates are from the Navy, only 14.5 percent of these individuals were graduates of Navy JROTC programs.

Of these 4,257 separations, 51 percent were due to expiration of term of services; 31 percent were due to failure to meet minimum behavioral and performance criteria (such as drugs, financial irresponsibility); 7 percent were

due to medical disqualifications; 7 percent were other separations or discharges; and 2 percent were entered into officer commissioning programs. Eighty-two percent of these separations occurred at four or less years of service, while 44 percent occurred with between four and seven years of service. The greatest percentage of separations, 29 percent, occurred at the four-year point, and the second greatest, 22 percent, occurred at the one-year point. For those separations at the one-and two-year points, 59 percent were due to failure to meet minimum behavioral and performance criteria.

It is interesting to note that 73 percent of the separations discussed above were honorable, 10 percent were under honorable conditions, and 7 percent were under other than honorable conditions. This was the same for all JROTC graduates regardless of their JROTC program.

The Navy JROTC graduates who separated from the military, regardless of branch of service, did so at the proportions of 69 percent being white, 19 percent were Hispanic, and 10 percent were black.

Among the different branches of service, the Navy had the highest percentage of whites who separated, as 47 percent left the service. The Army followed with 25 percent of its whites leaving. However, the Army had larger percentages of Hispanics and blacks who separated as 46 percent of the Hispanics and 39 percent of the blacks were

out of the military. The Hispanics and blacks who left the Navy, did so almost at equal proportions. Thirty-three percent of the Hispanics and 31 percent of the blacks separated from the Navy.

Out of all separations, 91 percent were men and 9 percent were women. The majority of these men and women separated from

the Navy. Forty-three percent of the males and 41 percent of the females were separated from the Navy.

Table 9 lists the proportions of Navy JROTC graduates within certain occupational areas as well as the non-occupational area. A non-occupational area includes patients and prisoners, students and trainees, and undesignated occupations. While the largest proportions, 24.48 percent, is in the non-occupational area, 19.56 percent is in the electrical/mechanical equipment repairs. Only 6.73 percent of the Navy JROTC graduates separated while in the electronics occupational area. This could be a signal to Navy JROTC program managers that there is a need to establish units with more technical courses.

IV. SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

A. SUMMARY

It has been found that the Navy JROTC program falls short in one of its goals of providing the military with accessions in the area of active duty enlistments. It was also found that, while only 41 percent of Navy JROTC graduates enter the Navy, 32 percent enlist in the Army. Forty-eight percent of those JROTC graduates who enlist in the Navy were graduates of the Army JROTC program while only 27 percent were Navy JROTC graduates. While the Navy holds only a 16 percent share of the JROTC units, second only to the Marines in fewest units, it manages to attract a 23 percent share of the total, all services JROTC program graduates.

Depending on what variables are used when performing a cost-benefit analysis, different results can be obtained. The survey data presently used by Navy JROTC program managers may give misleading results to this type of analysis.

An analysis of Home of Record data files can be of some help to program managers as this research has proven. States that produce low accession figures can be used for identifying units with problems that might exist. Iowa and West Virginia, with two of the lowest accession figures, are possible examples of this. The data are invaluable to the

Navy JROTC program manager who must find ways to efficiently make budget cuts. States with accessions from other JROTC units into the Navy, such as Georgia and South Carolina might produce more Navy accessions if more Navy JROTC units are established in these states.

The analysis also produced evidence that the AFQT levels of Navy JROTC graduates were actually lower than the levels of other enlisted accessions.¹¹ Another alarming find was that 31 percent of those Navy JROTC graduates who had separated from the military, did so by failing to meet "minimum behavioral and performance criteria."

B. RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the methods of analysis used in this thesis be used by the Navy JROTC program managers for keeping track of Navy JROTC graduate accessions. By using these methods, a more accurate cost benefit analysis can be performed and performances of JROTC units can be more closely monitored. From the occupational area data analyzed, it seems more emphasis needs to be placed on technical careers. A better job of recruiting by Navy JROTC unit commanders also could help.

C. FUTURE RESEARCH

Possible future research could entail developing a questionnaire and having a survey taken of Navy JROTC graduates as to why they did or did not enlist in the branch

of service of their JROTC unit. A regression analysis could also be performed using the variables from the survey and determining an equation for predicting military accessions of Navy JROTC graduates.

A cost-benefit analysis between the Navy JROTC program and other types of programs (e.g., sea cadets) could be researched. A cost benefit analysis between the different recruiting programs and the Navy JROTC could also be done.

Research could be performed in the area of military performance. An analyst could compare the military performance records and characteristics of JROTC graduates (by and across services) with non-JROTC graduates. This could show that JROTC graduates are better performers. The results of this research could have a large effect on any cost-benefit analysis performed.
