

Vision: A world-class test and evaluation organization that advances global net-centric testing in support of warfighting capabilities






JITC's Four Unique Roles

1. **Joint Interoperability/Net Readiness Certifier**
for all of DoD's Information Technology (IT) and National Security Systems (NSS) – 80%
2. **Operational Test Agency**
for DISA and other DoD elements – 14%
3. **Warfighter Interoperability Support**
Providing technical support during COCOM exercises, contingencies, and operations – 6%
4. **Major Range and Test Facility Base (MRTFB)**
Manages and operates DISA's MRTFB facilities at Ft. Huachuca, AZ and Indian Head, MD




