Description

PEO STRI has the basic requirements for IP&T. This Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity contract will meet the needs of U.S. Government entities to support requirements for Analyses specific to human performance improvement interventions, Courseware and Interactive Multimedia Instruction (IMI), Training devices designed, developed, tested, and verified, Design, installation, and implementation of Automated Electronic Classrooms and Infrastructure support for distributed training and PC based simulations. This effort may have split responsibility with the CSG managing the PEA and a PM for the IMI piece.

Iraqi Defense Forces Mi-17V5 Simulator

Description

PEO STRI intends to procure a Mi-17 Level 5 Flight Training Device (FTD) for the Iraqi Air Force. Actual FAA certification will not be required. Operator and maintenance manuals, written in English, and spare parts to support the device for one full year beginning at the Ready for Training (RFT) date, will be procured concurrent with the FTD. Contractor Logistics Support (CLS), for both maintenance and supply, will also be procured for a period of one year. Delivery of the device directly to Iraq will be accomplished by commercial transportation at contractor's expense. Options for one additional device and one additional year of CLS will be part of the initial contract.
