



#### **INTERIM RULE AMENDS FAR 19.1505**

Effective June 24, 2014; DoD, GSA, and NASA have adopted as final, without change, an interim rule amending the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) to remove the dollar limitation for set-asides to economically disadvantaged womenowned small business concerns eligible under the Women-Owned Small Business Program.

The dollar limitations on set-asides for WOSBs and EDWOSBs had been \$6,500,000 for contracts assigned a manufacturing North American Industry Classification Systems (NAICS) code, and \$4,000,000 for all other contracts.


Section 1697 of the National Defense Authorization Act of Fiscal Year 2013 (Public Law 112-239) removed these statutory limitations, and the Small Business Administration (SBA) amended its regulations accordingly.




